This Week for the Warhawks:

ULM faces its toughest test of the season to date, going up against two Top-25 squads in Las Vegas and three other very good teams. The UNLV Easton Desert Classic also features the first match-up in any sport between ULM and Ohio since the Independence Bowl.

ULM Last Time Out:

ULM played 4-of-5 scheduled games in the Mardi Gras Classic before Sunday's festivities were rained out. The Warhawks opened their season with a 8-0 (5 inn.) win over Grambling. Stephanie Routzon and Savannah Dollar combined for the one-hit shut out. Alexis Cacioppo and Kayla Prater each went deep in their first at-bats of the year. In game two, defensive miscues hurt the Warhawks as UCSB cruised to a 6-1 victory. The lone Warhawk run came off a Prater RBI single. On the final day, ULM posted a 5-1 victory over SE Missouri State and a 3-1 win over Wichita State. Mackenzie Miller went a combined 5-for-5 with two triples, an RBI, three stolen bases, and two runs scored. In the SEMO game, Routzon dealt a no-hitter through 5.2 innings before allowing a base hit that lead to the Redhawks' only run. ULM did all its damage in the first inning against Wichita State. Hayley McCall's 2-RBI single proved to be the game winning hit. Haylie Willson surrendered just one run on six Shocker hits.

Janel Salanoa has 16 career HRs, and is just four long balls away from surpassing Megan Miller for sixth on the ULM all-time home run list. • Salanoa entered the year fifth all-time in RBI with 92 and ninth in batting average with a .306 career mark. • Alexis Cacioppo hit her 7th career home run last Thursday to tie for 9th in ULM history. • Kayla Prater's first collegiate at-bat was a 3-run homer vs. Grambling.

NEWS & NOTES

WEEK TWO STORYLINES: The Warhawks head to Las Vegas and face their toughest test of the season to date in the UNLV Easton Desert Classic. The Warhawks take on two perennial Top-25 teams in UCLA and Oregon. They will also have their work cut out for them against Ohio, Seattle, and Brigham Young.

It will be ULM's first meetings against Seattle and Ohio. The Warhawks have seen limited action against Oregon, UCLA and Brigham Young, meeting the schools a combined four times in ULM's 31 year history. ULM went 5-of-7 in stolen base attempts in the Mardi Gras Classic, and the stolen base is likely to be key to the Warhawks' success in Las Vegas.

ULM is tied for the Sun Belt lead in overall record heading into the weekend thanks in part to superb performances from Faith Bohack, Mackenzie Miller, Kayla Prater and Stephanie Routzon. Bohack leads the conference with a .538 batting average (league minimum: one game, 1.5 AB/Game, 2.5 plate appearance/game). Bohack's seven hits and two doubles also top the conference. Prater ranks second with a .875 slugging percentage and .636 on base percentage.

Miller's two triples leads the league while her six hits put her in a tie for second. Routzon enters the week with a 0.00 ERA and is holding opponents to a .097 batting average.

LAST TIME OUT: Alexis Cacioppo and Kayla Prater each started the season with home runs in their first at-bats of the year. Mackenzie Miller had a breakout start to the season, going a combine 6-of-7 at the plate with two triples and five stolen bases. Miller's triples were the first of her career. Stephanie Routzon earned CollegeSportsMadness.com Sun Belt Player of the Week honors for her performance in the circle over the weekend.

WARHAWKS ONLINE: While ULM is on the road, you can follow live stats at ULMWarhawks.com, get updates via Facebook (Warhawks) and through Twitter (@ULMWarhawks).

WARHAWKS ON THE ROAD: ULM will travel a grand total of 9,642 miles this season. The majority of those miles come between Feb. 15 and Mar. 14. with ULM's next 21 contests on the road.

AT THE HELM: Rosemary Holloway-Hill begins her 29th season as head coach. She is 14 wins away from winning her 800th game as a head coach at any level. She is joined in the dugout by Associate Head Coach Sara Vogt. This is Vogt's second season in the role and fifth overall at ULM.

FAMILIAR FACE: Last month, ULM head coach Rosemary Holloway-Hill announced the addition of Lindsay Rittenhouse-Becton to the staff as the Warhawks' pitching coach. Rittenhouse-Becton graduated from ULM in 2008 as the school's all-time saves leader.

VETS & ROOKIES: The 2013 Warhawks feature 10 returning players and nine newcomers, including eight freshmen. Four of the eight freshmen were high school teammates at Hahnville (La.) High School, where together they were state champions in 2011 and runners-up in 2010 and 2012. Three other Warhawks have played on state championship squads.

BASE THIEVES: The Warhawks finished 2012 campaign with 105 stolen bases, the second highest total in the Sun Belt and also a school record. Base runners were caught just 20 times during the season. Meanwhile, ULM allowed just 44 steals on 56 attempts-the third lowest in the league.

PROGRAM MILESTONE: ULM needs 13 victories in 2013 to win its 800th game as a program.

PRESEASON PICKS: The Warhawks were picked to finish eighth in the Sun Belt by the conference head coaches. UL-Lafayette was unanimously picked to repeat as Sun Belt champions.

PRESEASON AWARDS: Senior 1B Janel Salanoa was named to the CollegeSportsMadness.com All-Sun Belt second team earlier this year.

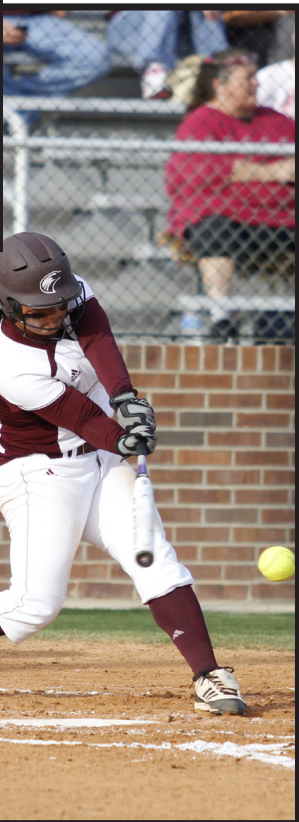
SUPERB vs. THE SWAC: ULM earned its 50th win over the SWAC in the Mardi Gras Classic with an 8-0 win over Grambling.

SALANOA'S SUCCESS: Janel Salanoa enters 2013 ranked ninth on ULM's career batting avg. list and needs one home run to take over sole possession of seventh place on the all-time leaderboard.

MAKING THE GRADE: ULM Softball posted a 3.478 GPA in the Fall 2012 semester. It was the highest team GPA among all ULM sports teams. The Warhawks 2011-12 team GPA ranked 41st in the Division I, according to the NFCA. That was one spot higher than Stanford and just below 2013 opponent St. Louis.

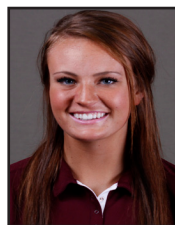
