WARHAWK QUICK HITS

- ULM is in its 61st season of basketball. The Warhawks have won 10 regular season conference championships, eight conference tournament championships and have made seven NCAA Tournament appearances.
- The Warhawks have led or been tied in the second half with three teams from power six conferences this season, including against a pair of ranked opponents (Texas A&M and Mississippi State).
- Thursday marks the Warhawks' final home game of the season and senior night. ULM will honor its four seniors -- Fred Brown, Hugh Mingo, Christian Bibi Ndongo and Fabio Ribeiro -- prior to the game.
- Brown led the Warhawks in the two games this past week, averaging 16.0 points per game. Brown ranks ninth in the Sun Belt in scoring with 12.6 points per game. He also ranks second in the Sun Belt in free-throw percentage (.857).
- Sophomore guard Marcellis Hansberry has been very productive over ULM's past five games, averaging 12.0 points, 3.7 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game during that stretch. Hansberry has scored in double figures in four of the last five games.
- ULM is one of the top 3-point shooting teams in the Sun Belt and enters the week ranked fourth in the conference in 3-point percentage (.360). Freshman Trent Mackey ranks fourth individually in the conference in 3-point percentage (.440) while sophomore Charles Winborne is fifth (.434). As a team ULM ranks fourth in the conference with 6.4 3-point makes per game.

GAME BASICS

ULM (2-25, 1-13 SBC) wraps up its home slate Thursday by hosting Middle Tennessee (24-4, 13-1 SBC) at 7:30 p.m. The Warhawks will honor their four seniors -- Fred Brown, Hugh Mingo, Christian Bibi Ndongo and Fabio Ribeiro -- prior to the game. The game can be heard on 105.3 FM in Monroe or online at ulmwarhawks.com, with Nick White calling the action. Live stats and a live video stream are available by visiting ulmwarhawks.com.

The game will follow the ULM-South Alabama women's game, which tips off at 5:30 p.m. Doubleheader tickets can be purchased for \$5, \$10 and \$12 by contacting the ULM Ticket Office.

UPDATING THE WARHAWKS

- ULM lost 76-57 at Denver Saturday in the last ever conference meeting between the two teams. The Pioneers connected for 16 3-pointers in the game and shot 55.3 percent from the field.

- The Warhawks had three players in double figures Saturday, paced by 15 points from senior guard Fred Brown. Brown finished 5 of 11 from the field and 1 of 4 from 3-point range. He came into the game as the conference's leading free-throw shooter but finished 4 of 6 from the line. Brown now has 1,118 career points (includes two seasons at Kansas State).

- Sophomore guard Charles Winborne contributed 14 points (10 in the first half) and sophomore guard Marcelis Hansberry finished in double figures with 12 points. The two combined to go 9 of 15 from the field and 4 of 5 from 3-point range.

- Winborne is one of the conference's best 3-point shooters as he entered the week ranked fifth in 3-point percentage (.434). He leads the team with 53 makes from deep this season. He needs 14 makes in ULM's final two games to reach the top 10 in school history for single-season 3-pointers.

- Hansberry has been one of ULM's most consistent players in the month of February as he has scored in double figures in four of ULM's last five games. Hansberry is averaging 12.0 points, 3.7 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game during that stretch.

- ULM has two of the top 3-pointer shooters in the Sun Belt in freshman Trent Mackey and Winborne. Mackey ranks fourth in the conference (.440) while Winborne is fifth (.434). As a team, the Warhawks rank fourth in the Sun Belt in 3-point percentage (.360).

- ULM ranks 11th in the conference in field-goal percentage (.404), fourth in 3-point percentage (.360) and eighth in free-throw percentage (.661). The Warhawks also rank fourth in the Sun Belt with 6.4 3-pointers made per game.

OTHER NOTES

- The Warhawks' 76-71 overtime loss to Western Kentucky (Dec. 29) was their first overtime game since Dec. 31, 2008 at UALR.

- ULM is 1-7 this season in games decided by five points or less, including 1-4 in Sun Belt play.

- ULM shot a season-best 62 percent from the field against Nicholls State (Nov. 28). It was the Warhawks' highest shooting percentage in a game since December of 2009.

- ULM has hung tough with some of the best teams in the country this season. The Warhawks led then No. 25 Mississippi State by two points with 14:13 remaining (Nov. 21) and most recently were tied 43-all at No. 22 Texas A&M with 13:20 to play (Dec. 10). In addition, ULM also had a second-half lead at Tennessee on Nov. 16.

- The Warhawks made at least 10 3-pointers in back-to-back games earlier this season. ULM had 11 3s against Harding (Nov. 26) and followed it up with 12 3s against Nicholls State (Nov. 28).

- The Warhawks are playing the 2011-12 season with just nine active scholarship players and are banned from participating in postseason play due to NCAA APR sanctions.

PREVIEWING THE BLUE RAIDERS

- Middle Tennessee has proven to be one of the best mid-major teams in the country this season with a record of 24-4. The Blue Raiders have key victories this season at Loyola Marymount (58-51), at UCLA (86-66), Belmont (65-62), Akron (77-53) and Ole Miss (68-56). Middle Tennessee leads the conference in scoring offense (71.7 ppg), scoring margin (+10.6), field-goal defense (.387) and 3-point defense (.306). Middle Tennessee is ranked No. 5 in this week's College Insider Mid-Major Top 25 poll.

- LaRon Dendy leads three Blue Raiders in double-figure scoring with 14.9 points and 7.1 rebounds per game. Dendy is shooting 52.9 percent from the field and 61 percent from the free-throw line. Marcos Knight records 11.9 points while JT Sulton adds 10.8 points per game.

- Kermit Davis is coaching Middle Tennessee to a banner season in his 10th year as the Blue Raider's leader. Davis has an overall record of 176-130 at Middle Tennessee, making him the winningest coach in school history. The Blue Raider's 24 victories this season set a school record and they need just one more victory to set a school record for conference wins in a season. 2012 will mark the eighth time in ten seasons that the Blue Raiders have finished with a winning record under Davis.

SERIES HISTORY

ULM and Middle Tennessee have split 12 all-time meetings with the Blue Raiders claiming four straight in the series. Middle Tennessee edged the Warhawks last season in Murfreesboro, 60-54. ULM is 3-4 against Middle Tennessee since joining the Sun Belt prior to the 2006-07 season.

UP NEXT

ULM concludes its season Saturday at rival UL-Lafayette at 7:15 p.m. inside the Cajundome.

BROWN REACHES 1,000 POINTS

Senior guard Fred Brown topped the 1,000-point milestone for his career with 16 points against FIU (Feb. 7). Brown, who scored 380 points in two seasons with Kansas State, has been the leading scorer for ULM the past two years. He has notched double figures in scoring 52 times in his career, including 17 times this season.

ULM CLOSING IN ON 900 WINS

In its 61st season of men's basketball, ULM is just five wins shy of reaching 900 in its history. The men's basketball program has been one of the finest at ULM over the years as the Warhawks have captured 10 regular season conference titles, eight conference tournament championships and have appeared in the NCAA Tournament seven times and the NIT twice.

MCCLELLAN MAKES SEASON DEBUT

Sophomore Steven McClellan saw his first action of the season Dec. 3 against Louisiana Tech. McClellan came off the bench with six points, seven rebounds and a blocked shot in 21 minutes of action. The 6-foot-7 center was slated to redshirt this season, but adds much needed height to the ULM frontcourt.

WARHAWK INK TWO IN EARLY SIGNING PERIOD

ULM men's basketball head coach Keith Richard announced Thursday the signing of high school seniors Kyle Koszuta and Taylor Birchett to national letters of intent. Koszuta and Birchett are the first two players to sign with the Warhawks for the 2012-13 season.

"We are excited about Kyle and Taylor joining our team next season," Richard said. "They're great kids that come from great families and will help us move this program forward."

Koszuta, a 6-1 point guard, attends Niceville High School in Niceville, Fla. Koszuta averaged 16.1 points and 1.5 assists as a junior, helping the Eagles to a 15-9 record. He scored a season-best 31 points on 12-of-23 shooting against Bainbridge (Ga.) last season.

Birchett, a 6-4 shooting guard, attends Roswell High School in Roswell, Ga. He led his team in scoring with 16.5 points as a junior and helped Roswell to its first Georgia 'Sweet 16' appearance in 14 years. He shot 43.2 percent from the field (118-of-273) and 40.3 percent from 3-point range (54-of-134) as a junior and was named to the 6-5A all-region team and the All-North Fulton Prep Rally first team.

EKE TO REDSHIRT IN 2011-12

ULM men's basketball head coach Keith Richard announced Tuesday that sophomore Ife Eke will redshirt during the 2011-12 season and will have three years of eligibility remaining starting next season. The Warhawks will play the season with nine scholarship players.

Eke suffered a season-ending injury by tearing his anterior cruciate ligament (ACL) in practice last week and is expected to have surgery in the near future.

FAMILIAR FOES

ULM will renew in-state rivalries against former Southland Conference foes Northwestern State, Southeastern Louisiana and Nicholls State in 2011-12. The Warhawks will also face Louisiana Tech for the fourth consecutive season.

ULM has faced Northwestern State more than any other team as the two will meet for the 118th time this season. The Warhawks and Demons have not faced each other since 2005-06, the last season ULM competed in the Southland. Similarly, the Warhawks will meet Southeastern Louisiana for the 91st time and Nicholls State for the 71st time in school history.

BROWN TABBED PRESEASON ALL-SUN BELT

Senior guard Fred Brown has picked up plenty of preseason accolades as he was named to virtually everyone's preseason All-Sun Belt team. Brown was chosen to All-Sun Belt Third Team by the conference coaches and College Sports Madness. Brown was also picked as one of the top five players in the Sun Belt by Jon Teitel of collegehoops.net.

BROWN, MINGO NAMED TEAM CAPTAINS

Head Coach Keith Richard named seniors Fred Brown and Hugh Mingo team captains for the 2011-12 season. Brown and Mingo are the two leading returning scorers from last season. They combined to make 58 starts and averaged over 32 minutes per game a year ago.

WARHAWKS PICKED SIXTH IN SUN BELT WEST DIVISION

ULM was picked to finish sixth in the West Division of the Sun Belt by its conference coaches. Arkansas State received 64 points and was picked to win the West, followed by UL-Lafayette (60), North Texas (50), Denver (40), UALR (26) and ULM (12).

Florida Atlantic got all but one first-place vote to earn the top spot in the East Division. The Owls were followed by Middle Tennessee (59), Western Kentucky (41), South Alabama (33), FIU (31) and Troy (17).

FANT-EWING COURT GETS NEW LOOK

The court inside Fant-Ewing Coliseum will have a new look to it when the ULM men's and women's basketball teams begin play in November.

The court has been redesigned and repainted with a fresh look, which includes the primary ULM logo at center court and "Warhawks" on each baseline. It is the first major renovation to the court since the fall of 2006.

The redesign also accommodates the new women's 3-point line, which moves back a foot to 20 feet, 9 inches (the same as the men) and the addition of the charge circle underneath each basket.

Fant-Ewing Coliseum has received several upgrades since 2009, including a new scoreboard and new scorer's tables.

HEAD COACH KEITH RICHARD

Keith Richard returned to his alma mater to become ULM's seventh men's basketball head coach on April 22, 2010. Now in his second season, Richard seeks to restore the rich tradition of the ULM men's basketball program — something he knows very well.

Richard became the second ULM men's basketball coach — joining Mike Vining — to have also been a student-athlete and an assistant coach for the program. He was with the Warhawks in both capacities for six of the program's seven NCAA Tournament appearances in the 80s and 90s.

The Warhawks finished 7-24 in Richard's first season that was plagued by scholarship limits and youth. Despite the record, the Warhawks were competitive, losing seven games by six points or less. The season highlight came in an 82-75 victory at North Texas in the final week of the regular season. The Warhawks also took down Big Sky Tournament champion Northern Colorado 78-75 in Fant-Ewing Coliseum on Dec. 22.

As a student-athlete, Richard bridged the transition from Lenny Fant to Benny Hollis to Vining. He played on Fant's final team, played two seasons for Hollis and then completed his playing career on Vining's first team. ULM won three Trans-America Athletic Conference championships during his four years and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 1982, the school's first-ever appearance, and the NIT in 1979. He twice led the team in assists and was team captain in 1980-81 and 1981-82.

Following his playing career, Richard spent two seasons as a graduate assistant at ULM (1984-86), assisting as his alma mater won the Southland Conference regular season and tournament titles in 1985, earning a trip to the NCAA Tournament.

Richard moved on to Marshall University for three years from 1986-89, helping the Thundering Herd win two Southern Conference crowns and a Southern Conference tournament title. Marshall participated in the 1987 NCAA Tournament and the 1988 NIT while Richard was on staff.

He returned to ULM for the 1989-90 season, spending five seasons as an assistant coach. In those five years, ULM won four Southland Conference regular season championships, four Southland Conference tournaments and made four appearances in the NCAA Tournament (1990, 1991, 1993, 1994). He departed in 1994 to join the staff at Louisiana Tech.

In his first season at Louisiana Tech, Richard helped the Bulldogs to the second biggest turnaround in the nation as they won 14 games after winning just two in the season prior to his arrival.

The following year Richard was promoted from assistant coach to associate head coach, spending three seasons in that capacity. He helped the Bulldogs reach the championship game of the Sun Belt Tournament in 1997, the school's first appearance in five seasons.

Richard became the head coach at Louisiana Tech prior to the 1998-99 season, guiding the Bulldogs for nine seasons. In his time at the helm of Louisiana Tech, Richard compiled a record of 150-117, the third-most wins in school history. In nine seasons, Richard had 11 players named all-conference, including three-time NCAA rebounding champion Paul Millsap, who went on to be drafted by the Utah Jazz. This season, Millsap will begin his fifth year with the Jazz.

During Richard's tenure at Louisiana Tech, the Bulldogs went on the road and won money games against the likes of Auburn, Baylor, Memphis (coached by John Calipari) and Texas Tech (coached by Bob Knight).

In his first season as head coach, Louisiana Tech won the Sun Belt regular season championship. Richard was named Sun Belt Conference Coach of the Year and two players, Lonnie Cooper and Craig Jackson, earned all-conference accolades.

The next year, Richard guided Louisiana Tech to a 21-win season, the school's first of three 20-plus win seasons under Richard. Gerrod Henderson and Jackson earned All-Sun Belt honors that year, with Henderson named the Sun Belt's Most Valuable Player.

In 2001-02, Louisiana Tech moved from the Sun Belt into the Western Athletic Conference, where Richard immediately turned the Bulldogs into a contender for the conference crown, posting a 22-10 overall record, 14-4 in conference play. Led by Henderson, who earned All-WAC honors, Richard's Bulldogs earned a berth in the NIT, where they defeated Louisiana-Lafayette and Vanderbilt before falling to Villanova.

Richard took the Bulldogs to the postseason again during the 2005-06 season as Louisiana Tech won 20 games and earned a trip to the NIT. That year, Millsap was named as an All-WAC performer for the third consecutive season while also leading the nation in rebounding for the third-straight season.

In nine years as the head coach at Louisiana Tech, Richard's teams posted a conference record of 90-60, going 32-14 in three seasons in Sun Belt and 58-46 in six years in the WAC. At ULM, Richard returns to the Sun Belt where he currently stands as the league's 10th winningest coach in conference games, with a .696 winning percentage.

Prior to returning to guide his alma mater, Richard spent the past two seasons as an assistant coach at LSU, where he helped the Tigers win the 2008-09 SEC regular season championship and reach the second round of the NCAA Tournament before losing to eventual national champion North Carolina.

The Mean Green (15-11, 8-5 SBC) shot 47.8 percent from the field and was led by Tony Mitchell, who finished with 18 points, 15 rebounds and six blocked shots. Alzee Williams contributed 12 points, Tyler Hall had 11 points and Roger Franklin chipped in 10 points for the Mean Green.

Senior guard Fred Brown paced the Warhawks (2-24, 1-14 SBC) with 17 points and two assists, while sophomore Marcellis Hansberry continued his solid play with 10 points and a career-high nine rebounds off the bench.

DENVER - The Denver Pioneers hit a season-high 16 3-pointers en route to a 76-57 victory over ULM Saturday afternoon inside Magness Arena.

Denver, in the midst of its best season since joining Division I, finished the game shooting 55.3 percent from the field and went 16 of 34 from 3-point range. The Warhawks shot 47.6 percent from the field and put up a good effort in the first half, but the Pioneers pulled away in the second half behind its hot 3-point shooting.

Senior guard Fred Brown led the Warhawks with 15 points and two assists, while sophomore Charles Winborne chipped in 14 points and sophomore Marcellis Hansberry added 12 points.

Denver opened the second half on an 18-5 run that stretched the margin to 56-34. Brian Stafford knocked home a 3 to cap the run at the 11:54 mark for the Pioneers. Denver led by as many as 23 points.

Stafford led all scorers with 25 points, including six 3-pointers. He finished an efficient 8 of 11 from the field and 3 of 3 from the free-throw line. Brett Olson was the only other Denver player in double figures with 15 points.

The Warhawks held Chris Udofia, the conference's leading scorer, to just eight points.

With the game tied at 20, Denver took control with a 9-0 run to take lead for good. Olson hit a 3-pointer from the top of the key to break the tie, followed by a three-point play from Stafford with 7:11 to play in the half. Royce O'Neale capped the run with a 3 at the 6:29 mark.

The Warhawks answered back with free throws from Winborne and Hansberry, and a jumper from sophomore R.J. McCray to cut the lead to 29-24 with 4:13 before halftime.

Stafford hit back-to-back 3-pointers for the Pioneers to extend the lead back to nine at 35-26. Denver finished with 8 of 18 from deep in the first half and led 37-29.

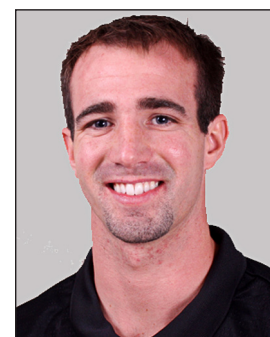
