### This Week for the Warhawks:

ULM looks to get back into the win column when it opens conference play at Florida Atlantic with a three-game series played on Mar. 6 and 7. The Warhawks stay in Boca Raton, Fla., for the FAU Invitational where they face Michigan State, Florida A&M, Kansas and Stony Brook.

### ULM Last Time Out:

ULM went 1-3 at the Northwestern State Lady Demon Invitational over the weekend. The Warhawks suffered losses to Northwestern State and Louisiana Tech in Friday's action but ended a three-game losing streak with an 8-0 win in five innings over Alcorn State to start play Saturday. ULM and Louisiana Tech added another page to their storied rivalry in Saturday's nightcap. The teams traded blows throughout, but the Lady Techsters emerged as the victors, 10-9. Senior Janel Salanoa led the way batting .667 with a 1.333 slugging percentage across the four games. She recorded her 100th career RBI on a solo home run against Louisiana Tech and became the fifth Warhawk to reach the milestone.

### Warhawk Notes:

Senior Janel Salanoa has 18 career HRs and is just two long balls away from surpassing Megan Miller for sixth on the ULM all-time home run list. • Salanoa became the fifth player in school history to record 100 RBI over the weekend. She did it on a solo home run. • Salanoa is currently on a seven-game hit streak and has reached base safely in 10 straight contests. •

## NEWS & NOTES

---

**WEEK FIVE STORYLINES:** ULM opens conference play at Florida Atlantic on Wednesday and concludes its first Sun Belt series in Thursday's doubleheader. After a day off, the Warhawks take on Michigan State, Florida A&M, Kansas and Stony Brook in the Florida Atlantic Invitational.

Senior Janel Salanoa is riding a seven-game hitting streak entering the weekend and has reached base safely in 10 straight contests.

As a team, the Warhawks lead the Sun Belt with 28 doubles and are second with six triples. ULM is in the middle of the pack in every other offensive category thusfar.

Individually, Salanoa ranks eighth in the league in slugging percentage. She is also tied for sixth with 14 runs scored. Freshman Faith Bohack's five doubles have her tied for third in the league.

Salanoa and sophomore Mackenzie Miller are each 8-of-8 in stolen base attempts this season. They are tied for second in the Sun Belt. Miller is also tied for second in the league with two triples.

**LAST TIME OUT:** ULM went 1-3 in the Northwestern State Lady Demon Invitational and finished second as the fourth seed. Senior Janel Salanoa led the way batting .667 with a 1.333 slugging percentage across the four games. She recorded her 100th career RBI on a solo home run against Louisiana Tech and became the fifth Warhawk to reach the milestone.

**WARHAWKS ONLINE:** While ULM is on the road, you can follow live stats at [ULMWarhawks.com](http://ULMWarhawks.com), get updates via Facebook (Warhawks) and through Twitter (@ULMWarhawks).

**WARHAWKS ON THE ROAD:** ULM travels a grand total of 9,642 miles this season. The majority of those miles come between Feb. 15 and Mar. 14. ULM is on the "home stretch" of the trip with seven games in Boca Raton, Fla., beginning Mar. 6.

**BASE THIEVES:** The Warhawks finished the 2012 campaign with 105 stolen bases, the second highest total in the Sun Belt and also a school record. Base runners were caught just 20 times last season. Meanwhile, ULM allowed just 44 steals on 56 attempts-the third lowest in the league. So far in 2013, ULM is 34-of-42 in stolen bases. The mark is tied for second in the conference.

**SALANOA'S SUCCESS:** Senior Janel Salanoa launched her second home run of the year and the 18th of her career in Natchitoches, La. The solo shot made her the fifth player in program history to reach 100 career RBIs. She entered 2013 ranked ninth on ULM's career batting avg. list. Salanoa is currently riding a seven-game hitting streak and has reached base safely in 10 straight games.

**PROGRAM MILESTONE:** ULM needs eight victories in 2013 to win its 800th game as a program.

**AT THE HELM:** Rosemary Holloway-Hill begins her 29th season as head coach. She is nine wins away from winning her 800th game as a head coach at any level. She is joined in the dugout by Associate Head Coach Sara Vogt. This is Vogt's third season in the role and fifth overall at ULM.

**FAMILIAR FACE:** Back in January, ULM head coach Rosemary Holloway-Hill announced the addition of Lindsay Rittenhouse-Becton to the staff as the Warhawks' pitching coach. Rittenhouse-Becton graduated from ULM in 2008 as the school's all-time saves leader.

**VETS & ROOKIES:** The 2013 Warhawks feature 10 returning players and nine newcomers, including eight freshmen. Four of the eight freshmen were high school teammates at Hahnville (La.) High School, where together they were state champions in 2011 and runners-up in 2010 and 2012. Three other Warhawks have played on state championship squads.

**MAKING THE GRADE:** ULM Softball posted a 3.478 GPA in the Fall 2012 semester. It was the highest team GPA among all ULM sports teams. The Warhawks 2011-12 team GPA ranked 41st in the Division I, according to the NFCA. That was one spot higher than Stanford and just below 2013 opponent St. Louis.

**PRESEASON PICKS:** The Warhawks were picked to finish eighth in the Sun Belt by the conference head coaches. UL-Lafayette was unanimously picked to repeat as Sun Belt champions.

**PRESEASON AWARDS:** Senior 1B Janel Salanoa was named to the CollegeSportsMadness.com All-Sun Belt second team earlier this year.

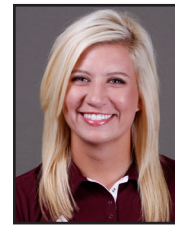

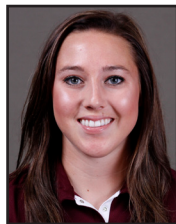
