ULM Quick Notes

- Junior Marvin Williams posted a game-high 19 points against No. 5/6 Kansas, outscoring Andrew Wiggins who was named Preseason National Player of the Year by cbssports.com. Williams went 8-for-13 from the field and grabbed a team-high six rebounds in 24 minutes

- Senior Amos Olatayo has scored in double-figures in nine consecutive games dating back to last season. Olatayo put in 11 points on 5-for-10 shooting against Kansas. He was ULM's leading scorer in 2012-13, averaging 17 points per game in league action

- ULM is 384-163 all-time in Fant-Ewing Coliseum (42 seasons)

- The Warhawks are 15-6 all-time against teams in the Southern Conference

- ULM won its non-conference home opener last season, 68-61 over Southeastern Louisiana in overtime

- Senior Jayon James was named to the SBC Preseason All-Conference Third-Team after leading the squad in minutes, rebounds, assists, blocks and steals last season. James and Olatayo were both named to the College Sports Madness SBC Preseason All-Conference Third-Team

- ULM earned the 2012-13 SBC team academic award and was one of 21 NCAA Division I men's basketball programs to earn Team Academic Excellence Awards from the National Association of Basketball Coaches

- The Warhawks carry a full scholarship roster for the first time under head coach Keith Richard after inheriting APR penalties. Richard is in his fourth season with the program

Alma Mater: ULM

Keith Richard returned to his alma mater to become ULM's seventh men's basketball head coach on April 22, 2010. Now in his fourth season, Richard seeks to restore the rich tradition of the program -- something he knows very well.

Richard became the second ULM men's basketball coach - joining Mike Vining - to have also been a student-athlete and an assistant coach for the program. He was with the Warhawks in both capacities for six of the program's seven NCAA Tournament appearances in the 1980s and early 1990s.

Richard has compiled 164 victories in his 12 seasons as a head coach at ULM and Louisiana Tech.

More importantly, Richard completely rebuilt the program academically in his first three seasons. The team's Academic Progress Rate (APR) has increased dramatically in each of Richard's three seasons. The NCAA has lifted many of the sanctions against the program due to its outstanding improvement.

Most recently, the Warhawks earned Team Academic Excellence Awards from the National Association of Basketball Coaches for the 2012-13 season. ULM was one of only 21 NCAA Division I men's basketball programs to be honored for achieving a team cumulative GPA above 3.0.

As a student-athlete, Richard bridged the transition from Lenny Fant to Benny Hollis to Vining. He played on Fant's final team, played two seasons for Hollis and then completed his playing career on Vining's first team. ULM won three Trans-America Athletic Conference championships during his four years and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 1982, the school's first-ever appearance, and the NIT in 1979. He twice led the team in assists and was team captain in 1980-81 and 1981-82.

Following his playing career, Richard spent two seasons as a graduate assistant at ULM (1984-86) as his alma mater won the Southland Conference regular season and tournament titles in 1985, earning a trip to the NCAA Tournament.

Richard moved on to Marshall University for three years from 1986-89, helping the Thundering Herd win two Southern Conference crowns and a Southern Conference tournament title. Marshall participated in the 1987 NCAA Tournament and the 1988 NIT while Richard was on staff.

He returned to ULM for the 1989-90 season, spending five seasons as an assistant coach. In those five years, ULM won four Southland Conference regular season championships, four Southland Conference tournaments and made four appearances in the NCAA Tournament (1990, 1991, 1993, 1994). He departed in 1994 to join the staff at Louisiana Tech.

In his first season at Louisiana Tech, Richard helped the Bulldogs to the second biggest turnaround in the nation as they won 14 games after winning just two in the season prior to his arrival.

The following year Richard was promoted from assistant coach to associate head coach, spending three seasons in that capacity. He helped the Bulldogs reach the championship game of the Sun Belt Tournament in 1997, the school's first appearance in five seasons.

Richard became the head coach at Louisiana Tech prior to the 1998-99 season, guiding the Bulldogs for nine seasons. In his time at the helm of Louisiana Tech, Richard compiled a record of 150-117, the third-most wins in school history. In nine seasons, Richard had 11 players named all-conference, including three-time NCAA rebounding champion Paul Millsap, who went on to be drafted by the Utah Jazz. This season, Millsap will begin his fifth year with the Jazz.

During Richard's tenure at Louisiana Tech, the Bulldogs went on the road and won money games against the likes of Auburn, Baylor, Memphis (coached by John Calipari) and Texas Tech (coached by Bob Knight). In his first season as head coach, Louisiana Tech won the Sun Belt regular season championship. Richard was named Sun Belt Conference Coach of the Year and two players, Lonnie Cooper and Craig Jackson, earned all-conference accolades.

The next year, Richard guided Louisiana Tech to a 21-win season, the school's first of three 20-plus win seasons under Richard. Gerrod Henderson and Jackson earned All-Sun Belt honors that year, with Henderson named the Sun Belt's Most Valuable Player.

In 2001-02, Louisiana Tech moved from the Sun Belt into the Western Athletic Conference, where Richard immediately turned the Bulldogs into a contender for the conference crown, posting a 22-10 overall record and 14-4 in conference play. Led

by Henderson, who earned All-WAC honors, Richard's Bulldogs earned a berth in the NIT, where they defeated Louisiana-Lafayette and Vanderbilt before falling to Villanova.

Richard took the Bulldogs to the postseason again during the 2005-06 season as Louisiana Tech won 20 games and earned a trip to the NIT. That year, Millsap was named as an All-WAC performer for the third consecutive season while also leading the nation in rebounding for the third-straight season.

In nine years as the head coach at Louisiana Tech, Richard's teams posted a conference record of 90-60, going 32-14 in three seasons in Sun Belt and 58-46 in six years in the WAC. At ULM, Richard returns to the Sun Belt where he currently stands as the league's 10th winningest coach in conference games, with a .696 winning percentage.

Prior to returning to guide his alma mater, Richard spent the past two seasons as an assistant coach at LSU, where he helped the Tigers win the 2008-09 SEC regular season championship and reach the second round of the NCAA Tournament before losing to eventual national champion North Carolina.

Richard and his wife Holly have three children: sons Luke and Lance, and daughter Lexie. He earned a bachelor's degree from ULM in 1982 and a master's degree from ULM in 1986.

Scouting Samford

The Bulldogs come to Monroe after a tough 105-59 loss to Indiana on Friday. They opened the season with a 79-62 win over Martin Methodist before falling to Sun Belt Conference opponent UT-Arlington 88-75.

Head coach Bennie Seltzer enters his second season at the helm and posted an 11-21 record in his first season. The Bulldogs finished 9-9 in conference. Seltzer previously held assistant coach positions at Indiana (2008-12), Marquette (2006-08) and Oklahoma (1997-2006). He played collegiately for four years at Washington State (1989-93) before playing professionally in Turkey, Venezuela, Poland and Holland. He is currently 12-23 in his career at Samford.

Samford has four players averaging double-figures in points after its three games. Rajion Kelly leads the team with 14.0 points per game, followed by Tim Williams (12.7 p/g), Isaiah Williams (11.7 p/g) and Tyler Hood (10.3 p/g). Tim Williams averages a double-double as he also grabs 12.3 rebounds per game.

The Bulldogs shoot .343 as a team from three-point range (24-for-70). Hood is 4-for-9 (.444) on the season, Kelly is 7-for-18 (.389) and Isiah Williams and Connor Miller are both 6-for-16 (.500).

Samford uses primarily a nine-man rotation, each student-athlete averaging over 10 minutes per game. Rajion Kelly and Tim Williams were both named to the SoCon Preseason Team. They are two of four returning starters from last year. The Bulldogs also returned eight letter-winners and lost five.

Samford holds an all-time school record of 1029-1250, including a 504-636 mark in Division I. It has two NCAA Tournament appearances with the last coming in 2000.

Game 1 Recap - ULM at Kansas

ULM Hangs Tough Against No. 5/6 Kansas in Season Opener

LAWRENCE, Kan. – Junior Marvin Williams notched a game-high 19 points as the ULM men's basketball program hung around with No. 5/6 Kansas for much of a 80-63 defeat on Friday night at Allen Fieldhouse.

Williams, from Memphis, Tenn., drained a game-high eight field goals on 13 attempts as he stood his ground inside for ULM (0-1). He also grabbed a team-high six rebounds in 24 minutes.

Senior Amos Olatayo pitched in with 11 points on 5-for-10 shooting. It marked his ninth consecutive game reaching double-figures dating back to last season. Olatayo and senior Jayon James played 33 minutes each to lead ULM.

In his first collegiate game, freshman Nick Coppola registered 10 points and took it to the hole strong. He was one of three newcomers to earn the start along with Williams and junior Tylor Ongwae.

"I was really encouraged with how we played. Our guys played hard and showed a lot of effort. If we stay on the right path then we have a good chance to win a few games this year," said ULM head coach Keith Richard.

It was a seesaw battle early in the game as ULM and KU exchanged baskets in the first seven minutes. The Warhawks led, 15-13, with 13 minutes remaining in the half. Olatayo and Ongwae threw down back-to-back dunks to force a KU timeout.

The Warhawks stood tough and trailed just 34-30 after a pair of free throws by senior Millaun Brown with 3:22 left in the half. The Jayhawks took a 10 point lead, 42-32, into the intermission after a slight 8-2 run.

Williams had a game-high 12 points and five rebounds at the half and was six-for-eight from the floor. Olatayo drained four field goals for eight points.

ULM started the second half on a 5-0 run to cut the deficit to 42-37 after a three-pointer by Coppola and a lay-in by Williams. The Warhawks hung around for much of the second half, and were down just 51-43 at the 12:36 mark.

Kansas (1-0) opened up an 18-point lead when sophomore Daniel Grieves answered with back-to-back threes to again cut the lead to 12 points, 73-61 with 2:35 remaining.

The Jayhawks were led by Andrew Wiggins with 16 points in a game-high 34 minutes. Wiggins was named the Preseason National Player of the Year by cbssports.com. Perry Ellis and Andrew White III tallied 12 points each.

ULM mixed and matched its lineups as 12 different student-athletes saw action, including seven newcomers.

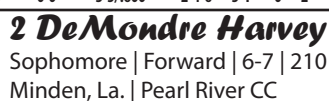

James Named to SBC Preseason All-Conference Third-Team

ULM men's basketball senior Jayon James earned a spot on the 2013-14 Sun Belt Conference Preseason Third-Team, the conference office announced.

The preseason All-SBC teams were voted on by the league's 10 head coaches. Coaches were not permitted to vote for their own players.

James, a forward, led the Warhawks in minutes, rebounds, assists, blocks and steals last year. He averaged 9.4 points per game and scored in double-figures 13 times. He posted a career-high 26 points against Florida Atlantic on Dec. 29, 2012.

The Paterson, N.J. native recorded five double-doubles on the season. Four of which came from points and rebounds, and he registered 11 points and 15 assists at FIU on Feb. 2. He appeared in all 27 games last season and led the team with 26 starts.

James ranked second in the Sun Belt and 58th nationally with 5.1 assists per game last season. His 137 assists ranks seventh on ULM's all-time single-season list. He led the team in assists in 20 games.

The 2013-14 season will be the first time the program will have a full scholarship roster under head coach Keith Richard after inheriting APR penalties.

James, Olatayo Named to CSM Preseason All-SBC Third-Team

Seniors Jayon James and Amos Olatayo were named to the 2013-14 College Sports Madness Sun Belt Preseason All-Conference Third-Team and return as two of the team's four starters from last season.

Olatayo, a guard, returns as ULM's leading scorer from last season after ranking fourth in the conference with 15.8 points per game. He scored in double figures 17 times last season, including each of the last eight games.

The Alief, Texas product tallied at least 20 points in eight conference games, including a season-high 30 at FIU on Feb. 2. He also poured in 24 against Middle Tennessee on Jan. 12 after shooting 9-of-15 from the field.
