## 2013 CLARION WARHAWK CLASSIC PRESENTED BY CYPRESS INN



### TIP-OFF

• ULM will close out a four-game, seven-day stretch as it hosts the 2013 Clarion Warhawk Classic Presented by Cypress Inn this weekend... The Warhawks will be joined by Alcorn State, East Carolina and Grand Canyon during the two-day event.

• Alcorn State and East Carolina will kickstart the event with a 5 p.m. contest Friday night.

• ULM will host Grand Canyon at 7 p.m. for the final game of the evening... The matchup between the Warhawks and the Antelopes will be the first-ever meeting between the two squads... Grand Canyon is in its first season at the Division I level after transitioning from Division II.

• On day two of the 2013 Clarion Warhawk Classic Presented by Cypress Inn, the consolation game of the tournament will take place at 5 p.m... The Championship game of the event is scheduled to tip at 7 p.m.

• Should ULM and East Carolina meet on Saturday it would be the first-ever meeting between the two programs... Should ULM and Alcorn State meet on Saturday, it would be the 12th meeting all-time between the two schools... ULM owns a 9-2 lead in the all-time series... The Warhawks have won five of the last six meetings with the Lady Braves, but it is potentially the first meeting since a 63-55 win by ULM at the New Mexico State Tournament (Nov. 27, 2010).

• Following their own tournament, the Warhawks will travel to Las Vegas, Nev., for the Duel in the Desert (Dec. 19-21)... At the three-day event, ULM will square off against Washington (Dec. 19), Pittsburgh (Dec. 20) and DePaul (Dec. 21), before breaking for the holidays... After the break, the Warhawks will be in conference mode for the remainder of the season as they open league play with UL-Lafayette on Jan. 4.

• In ULM's last outing, they dropped a 78-63 decision at McNeese State on Wednesday night.

• Ashleigh Simmons led the Warhawks as she finished with her fourth straight double-double behind 22 points and 10 rebounds... The senior also added one assist, one block and one steal in 37 minutes of action... She finished 8-of-12 from the floor and hit six free throws.

• Against the Cowgirls, Jasmine Shaw also reached double figures for the Warhawks as she finished with 14 points behind six field goals, including two three-pointers.

• Aside from her 14 points, Jasmin Shaw also grabbed six rebounds and blocked a game-high three shots... In fact, her three blocked shots matched the McNeese State total on the night.

• Both Elexar Tugler and Sharnice Brooks fell just one point shy of double-figures as both players finished with nine points at McNeese State.

• Elexar Tugler and Christina Gray each recorded three assists Wednesday night while Alexar Tugler added two assists to give the trio eight of the Warhawks' 14 assists on the night.

• At McNeese State, 12 ULM players saw time on the court... Seven of the 12 players logged 15 or more minutes in the contest and three players (Ashleigh Simmons; Elexar Tugler; Jasmine Shaw) logged 30 or more minutes in the road tilt.

## #ScoutingTheAntelopes

Grand Canyon enters the weekend on a two-game win streak following wins over Southeastern Louisiana (W, 62-57, Dec. 1) and at Nevada (W, 75-55, Dec. 10)... Overall, the Antelopes are 7-2 overall with their two losses coming on a neutral court against Mississippi State (L, 62-71, Nov. 29) and UCLA (L, 60-62, Nov. 30)... ULM and Grand Canyon have one common opponent on the season (Southeastern Louisiana)... ULM defeated the Lady Lions (87-77) on Nov. 15, while the Antelopes defeated Southeastern, 62-57, on Dec. 1.

Judy Jones, a native of Monroe, La., leads the team with 14.7 points per game, while three other players are also averaging double-figures (Kaitlyn Peterson, 13.3; Johnna Brown, 12.8; and Deanna Daniels, 11.2). Jones also leads the squad in both rebounds per game (9.3) and steals (21).

As a team, Grand Canyon is averaging 69.3 ppg, while limiting their opponents to just 55.4 per outing. The squad is also outrebounding its competition, on average, by just over five rebounds a game.

## #ScoutingTheLadyBraves

Alcorn State is currently on a four-game skid and the team currently sits at 1-5 on the season... The only win of the season for the Lady Braves came on Nov. 10, a 50-45 win over Nebraska-Omaha... ULM and Alcorn State have one common opponent on the season (Central Arkansas)... ULM fell to the Sugar Bears in overtime (L, 56-63) on Nov. 23, while the Lady Braves fell to UCA on Nov. 8 (L, 39-71).

Tierro Frost leads Alcorn State with 17.8 points per game... Frost leads the team in free throw makes (43) and free throw attempts (61); she ranks second on the team in rebounding at 5.8 rpg... Angelic Wilson-Reid is the leader in rebounding as she is averaging 6.5 rpg.

The Lady Braves are averaging 38.3 ppg, while opponents are scoring 77.3 ppg. Alcorn State is averaging 6.5 steals and 2.3 blocks per game.

## #ScoutingThePirates

East Carolina owns a perfect 7-0 record, but it will be the first game for the Pirates since a 75-66 win over Cleveland State on Dec. 1... The Pirates and the Warhawks do not share any common opponents this season.

Jada Payne leads East Carolina in both scoring (20.6 ppg) and rebounding (6.6 rpg)... Abria Trice is the only other Pirate averaging in double figures this season (16.1 ppg)... Andrea Shaw leads the club with 16 rejections through seven games (2.3 bpg) and sits second in rebounding (6.4 rpg).

East Carolina is averaging 79.0 ppg and it is limited the competition to just under 60 ppg (59.7)... The Pirates are also averaging 10.1 rebounds more per game than their opponents.

## #LastTimeOut

LAKE CHARLES, La. (Dec. 11, 2013) -- Playing its only road game during a four-game, seven-day stretch, the ULM women's basketball team dropped a 78-63 decision to McNeese State Wednesday night at Burton Coliseum.

McNeese State (5-3) held a 39-31 lead at intermission thanks to a 13-for-13 mark at the charity stripe. The Warhawks (3-4) were able to close the gap to just four points at the 17:50 mark of the second half. Ashleigh Simmons scored ULM's first six points of the second half as they cut into the lead and trailed, 41-37.

A four-minute scoring drought midway through the half doomed the Warhawks as the club was unable to get any closer as the Cowgirls eventually pushed its lead back to double digits en route to the 15-point victory.

Simmons led the Warhawks as she recorded her fourth straight double-double with 22 points and 11 rebounds. Jasmine Shaw also reached double figures as she totaled 14 points.

Allison Bagget led the Cowgirls with 22 points.

The two teams battled back-and-forth during the first 20 minutes and both teams made 12 field goals, with the Warhawks hitting one more three pointer than the Cowgirls.

## #PlayerOfTheMonth

Ashleigh Simmons was named Co-Louisiana Player of the Month (November) by the Louisiana Sports Writer's Association on Dec. 3.

For the month of November, Simmons averaged 18 points per contest and grabbed 8.2 rebounds... She shot 64.4% from the floor as she connected on 38-of-her 59 field goal attempts... She opened her senior season with an 11-point, five rebound performance at TCU on Nov. 9 in Fort Worth, Texas... In the home opener against Louisiana College, Simmons was one of four Warhawks to reach double figures in the 92-52 win over the Wildcats.

Simmons continued her strong play as she scored 16 points and grabbed eight rebounds in ULM's 87-77 win over Southeastern Louisiana at Fant-

Ewing Coliseum (Nov. 15)... The Warhawk forward has recorded double-doubles in back-to-back games (at Central Arkansas; at Ole Miss). Against the Sugar Bears, Simmons scored 13 points and grabbed 10 rebounds. In the team's most recent game, at Ole Miss, Simmons scored a career-high 34 points to go along with 10 rebounds.

### #DroughtEnds

Ashleigh Simmons became the first Warhawk since the 1997-98 season to score 30 or more points in a single game as she poured in a career-high 34 points at Ole Miss... Simmons finished 15-of-20 from the floor and was a perfect 4-for-4 at the charity stripe... She also grabbed 10 rebounds for her second-straight double-double.

The last Warhawk to tally 30 or more points in a single game was Terri Butler... Butler scored 31 points against Texas-San Antonio on Jan. 5, 1998 inside Fant-Ewing Coliseum.

### #FantEwingColiseum

The 2013 season marks the 40th consecutive year that the Warhawks have called Fant-Ewing Coliseum on the campus of ULM home... Named for former ULM basketball coach Lenny Fant and former part-owner and general manager of the Monroe News-Star Wilson Ewing, "The Beast" as it has become known has long been a formidable challenge for opposing teams... ULM posted the second-longest home winning streak in the nation in its confines, capturing 32 consecutive victories from the end of the 1983-84 season until finally having it snapped in 1986-87... The Warhawks have posted 15 campaigns with 10 or more victories at home and have an overall record of 302-170 (.640) inside the coliseum... In the Mona Martin era, ULM has posted a 140-87 (.617) on its home court.

### #The300Club

With a 92-52 victory over Louisiana College on Nov. 11, the Warhawks captured their 300th victory at home inside Fant-Ewing Coliseum, needing just 470 total games to reach that milestone. In the history of the program, ULM is 301-170 (.639) at home and 278-355 (.439) in all other contests, a division which clearly shows just how strong the home-court advantage is for the Warhawks.

### #ProgramMilestones

In addition to earning its 300th home victory, ULM is poised to capture its 500th victory at the Division I level. The Warhawks currently sit at 499-402 (.553) since moving to the Southland Conference prior to the 1982-83 season and could get the milestone victory as early as the matchup against Stephen F. Austin on Dec. 8.

The Warhawks are also currently on track to earn their 50th Sun Belt Conference victory this season once conference play gets underway. ULM holds a 48-76 (.387) record in conference matchups since joining the Sun Belt for the 2006-07 campaign... Five conference wins this season would also bring the program to the 300-win mark in conference play, counting the 247 victories that the Warhawks earned during their time in the Southland Conference.

### #60orMore

Dating back to last season, the Warhawks have posted an 12-7 record when they score 60 or more points... Below is a breakdown of the results when ULM reaches the 60-point barrier:

### #PostingUp

Asleigh Simmons and Sharnice Brooks have gotten off to fantastic starts at the post positions for ULM this season. Simmons (19.1) and Brooks (10.1) are the top two scorers for the Warhawks, while Alayshia Hunter (4.0) is currently sixth on the squad.

ULM was able to exploit the major difference in size against both Louisiana College and Southeastern Louisiana... By funneling the ball inside, pressure was taken off the guards to produce as much as they normally would, allowing the Warhawks to play a much more physical brand of basketball rather than relying on shooting alone.

The strong post play is not limited to points alone, however... Simmons (8.9) and Brooks (6.9) also lead the team in rebounding, while Hunter (2.3) and Tyler Holley (1.3) have also been strong on the glass in reserve roles.

### #PaintedUp

The Warhawks have been able to establish a powerful inside game in their last three contests and have been dominant both inside the paint and on second-chance opportunities this season.

For the season, ULM has outscored opponents by a score of 258-178 in the paint and 109-78 in second-chance points... With those 258 points in the paint, 51.4 percent of ULM's total scoring production this season has come from under the basket and just under 22 percent of the Warhawks' points have come on second-chance opportunities.

### #WonderTwins

Alexar and Elexar Tugler, known better by their nicknames "Peaches" and "Pumpkin", will once again play key roles for the Warhawks this season... The duo split time handling point guard duties last season and racked up 188 assists; both were also solid scorers as well, as Alexar averaged 10.8 points per game while Elexar chipped in 6.9 points of her own... Alexar was the team's leading three-point shooter, draining 36 baskets from behind the arc... On defense, the twins were Nos. 1 and 2 on the squad in steals as Elexar notched 56 and Alexar had 54... The two also combined for 20 blocks and 7.9 rebounds per game, further showing off their defensive prowess.

### #ExtendedPlayingTime

Jasmine Shaw and Alexar Tugler became just the fifth and sixth players in program history to log more than 1,000 minutes of playing time in a single season during the 2012-13 campaign... Shaw saw 1,101 minutes of action, the second-most behind only E.J. Ok's 1,124 during the 1984-85 season, and Tugler crossed the mark with 1,012 minutes on the court. Of the Warhawks' 6,225 minutes last season, 4,582 (73.6 percent) were played by the projected 2013-14 starting five.

## #FirstTimeForEverything

ULM is guaranteed to face five opponents for the first time in program history during the 2013-14 season and could also face a sixth depending on tournament outcomes... Grand Canyon, a new member of the WAC playing its first season of Division I basketball, will face the Warhawks on Dec. 13 on the opening day of the 2013 Clarion Warhawk Classic Presented by Cypress Inn... Should East Carolina win their opener in the tournament against Alcorn State, ULM would also have its inaugural meeting with the Pirates on Dec. 14.

At the Duel in the Desert in Las Vegas, all three of ULM's opponents will be first-timers... The Warhawks will face Washington, Pittsburgh and DePaul on consecutive days in mid-December as part of the prestigious tournament.

Finally, ULM will square off against Sun Belt newcomer Georgia State for the first time on Jan. 25... Texas State and UT Arlington are also joining the league, but the Warhawks have prior meetings against both due to their time spent in the Southland Conference.

## #BigTimeInBigEasy

With the addition of three new Sun Belt members, the format of the conference tournament has been altered for the 2013-14 season... Only the top eight teams with the best records in conference play will earn bids to the tournament, which begins on March 12 in New Orleans... Last season, ULM advanced to the quarterfinals after defeating Florida Atlantic 70-63 in the opening round; the Warhawks then gave Middle Tennessee everything that they could handle in a tight 59-56 defeat... The Blue Raiders would go on to win the tournament and earn the Sun Belt's automatic bid into the NCAA Tournament.

## #BlockParty

ULM has picked up right where it left off the last two seasons, recording 28 blocks through the first seven matchups of 2013-14... Jasmine Shaw leads the way with eight blocks, Sharnice Brooks has six, Ashleigh Simmons has five, Alayshia Hunter has three, Alexar Tugler has two, while Elexar Tugler, Tyler Holley, Christina Gray and Jasmine Taylor all have one.

The Warhawks had the fourth-highest single-season block total in school history during the 2012-13 season... All but three players recorded at least one block, and five reached double figures for the stat to contribute to the total of 131... Over the previous two seasons, ULM had 260 blocked shots and seems poised to continue that trend in 2013-14.

## #Chasing1000

Ashleigh Simmons (735), Alexar Tugler (673) and Jasmine Shaw (673) all have a shot at joining ULM's 1,000-point club... Each would have to average roughly 13 points per contest this season to join the exclusive list, made up of just 16 former Warhawks.

## #StillPlaying

MONROE, La. (Dec. 12, 2013) – Former ULM standout Larrie Williams signed a contract with Mulkiye, a professional team in the Turkish Basketball League.

The 23-year old Williams is in her second season of professional basketball and she scored 17 points in her debut with Mulkiye in a 76-67 loss to Yakin Dogu. Most recently, Williams appeared in 11 games with T71 Dudelange in the Luxembourg Total League. She averaged 17.0 points and 7.2 rebounds per contest as she helped the team claim the Peruvian Superior League Tournament Championship.
