ULM Quick Notes

- ULM takes on Ohio State in the first-ever meeting between the two programs
- The contest marks the second top-5 opponent for the Warhawks on the year after traveling to No. 5 Kansas to open the season
- ULM is looking to knock off a top-5 opponent for the first time in school history
- The Warhawks last defeated a ranked opponent on Dec. 30, 1992 over No. 9 Arkansas 87-78
- ULM's only win over a Big Ten school came on Nov. 30, 2007 when it defeated Iowa 72-67 (OT)
- ULM is looking for a .500 record after eight games for the first time since 2007-08 when it started 4-4
- The Warhawks lead the Sun Belt Conference in rebounding margin (+4.7), assists (14.9 apg) and steals (8.3 spg)
- Senior Amos Olatayo, who leads the team with 15.6 points per game, has scored in double-figures in 14 of the last 15 games dating back to last season. He tied his career-high with 30 points in ULM's 84-80 (OT) victory over Northwestern State on Nov. 21

ULM Quick Notes Continued...

- Junior Tylor Ongwae has posted six consecutive double-figure scoring games after scoring 20 against LA Tech included a career-high nine field goals made. He registered a career-high 22 in the win over Thomas on Dec. 9
- The Warhawks have had at least two double-figure scorers in every game and have had at least three double-figure scorers in six of seven games this season
- Freshman Nick Coppola ranks second in the Sun Belt Conference with 4.6 assists per game
- The Warhawks went 36 days inbetween their first two losses on the season. It was their longest stretch without a loss since 1993-94 when they went from Jan. 18 - Feb. 28 between defeats
- ULM scored 80 points and shot over 50 percent from the field in all three of its wins this season
- After defeating Thomas (Ga.) on Nov. 21, the Warhawks won three consecutive games for the first time since 2007-08. They got off to a 3-1 start on the season for the first time since 2004-05
- In ULM's home opener, it thumped Samford 86-52 on Nov. 18 and was up by 41 at one point in the second half. The 34-point win was the largest margin of victory for ULM since a 97-43 win over Union College (Ky.) on Jan. 3, 2009. It was ULM's most lop-sided score over a Division I program since Feb. 3, 2000 when it defeated Lamar 95-58
- Junior Marvin Williams posted a game-high 19 points against No. 5 Kansas in the season opener, outscoring Andrew Wiggins who was named Preseason National Player of the Year by cbssports.com. Williams went 8-for-13 from the field and grabbed a team-high six rebounds in 24 minutes
- Williams registered a double-double against Northwestern State with 13 points and 10 rebounds. The Warhawks trailed by 18 in the second half against the Demons before mounting their biggest comeback of the season
- ULM earned the 2012-13 SBC team academic award and was one of 21 NCAA Division I men's basketball programs to earn Team Academic Excellence Awards from the National Association of Basketball Coaches
- The Warhawks carry a full scholarship roster for the first time under head coach Keith Richard after inheriting APR penalties. Richard is in his fourth season with the program
- ULM holds a 903-800 all-time record and is in its 62nd season. It has 38 winning seasons and has reached 20 wins 10 times. The Warhawks have seven NCAA Tournament appearances and a pair of NIT appearances

Scouting Ohio State

Third-ranked and undefeated Ohio State (12-0) is coming off a thrilling come-from-behind 64-61 victory over Notre Dame on Saturday. The Buckeyes trailed 58-50 and outscored the Irish 14-3 over the last 50 seconds of the game. OSU had scored 17 points in the first 19:10 of the second half and 14 points in the final 50 seconds.

Other than their game against Notre Dame, the Buckeyes have defeated every opponent by at least 10 points this season. Their closest home game was a 76-64 decision over Delaware on Dec. 18.

OSU won its game in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge over Maryland 76-60 on Dec. 4.

The Buckeyes have four student-athletes averaging in double-figures including Lenzelle Smith Jr. who leads the team with 13.1 ppg and has hit 22-of-50 (.440) shots from long-range.

Amir Williams puts in 10.3 ppg and grabs a team-high 7.6 rpg. Also averaging in double-figures is LaQuinton Ross (12.8 ppg) and Aaron Craft (10.0 ppg). Craft earned Big Ten Tournament Most Outstanding Player last season.

OSU reached the Elite Eight last season before falling to Wichita State 70-66. It defeated Iona, Iowa State and Arizona in the NCAA Tournament after winning the Big Ten Tournament. It posted a 29-8 overall record including a 13-5 mark in conference play and 16-2 at home. The Buckeyes returned four starters from last year's squad.

Thad Matta is in his 10th season as head men's basketball coach at Ohio State. Matta has taken all 13 eligible teams to postseason play in his 14 years as an NCAA Division I head coach. He is the only coach to bring his team to at least the Sweet 16 in all of the last four seasons, and has won the Big Ten Tournament title three of the last four years. Matta is a three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year winner and has coached a pair of Big Ten Player of the Year honorees (Terence Dials, 2006 & Evan Turner, 2010).

In ULM's Last Outing...

ULM Falls to LA Tech in 2013 CenturyLink Classic

MONROE, La. – Wearing its yellow throwback Northeast Louisiana jerseys, the ULM men's basketball program fell 83-61 to Louisiana Tech on Sunday in the 2013 CenturyLink Classic at Fant-Ewing Coliseum.

Junior Tylor Ongwae poured in a game-high 20 points to propel ULM (3-4) offensively. He drained a career-high nine field goals, grabbed five rebounds and swatted a pair of blocks.

Ongwae was one of three ULM student-athletes to score in double-figures as seniors Jayon James and Amos Olatayo tallied 14 and 11, respectively. James also grabbed a team-high eight rebounds and dished out four assists.

LA Tech (10-3) was paced by Alex Hamilton who recorded 17 points, nine rebounds, five assists, two blocks and two steals. Cordarius Johnson and Jaron Johnson scored 12 points apiece.

The Bulldogs jumped out to an early 19-5 lead at the 12:30 mark in the first half and never looked back. They led by as many as 34-13 in the first half, but ULM cut it to a 44-28 deficit with 2:25 remaining after a three-pointer by Olatayo. LA Tech carried a 48-30 lead into the intermission.

LA Tech got off to another hot start in the second half and jumped ahead 66-38 with 12:04 left in the game. Senior R.J. McCray made it an 81-61 game on a layup with under one minute left, but the Warhawks could not get any closer.

ULM held a 36-34 rebounding edge and got its hands on nine steals in the contest.

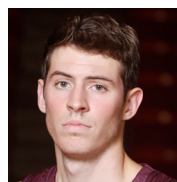

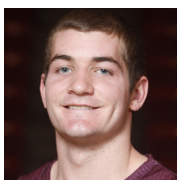

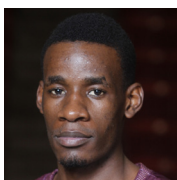
