ULM Quick Notes

- ULM opened the season with a 74-65 victory on the road over UAB. The Warhawks had four double-figure scorers in senior Tylor Ongwae (18), junior Justin Roberson (18), sophomore Nick Coppola (14) and Majok Deng (13)
- It was the first opening night victory for ULM since Nov. 14, 2008 when it defeated Morehead State, 56-54 and the first opening night road win since Nov. 23, 1999 when it won at Samford, 67-60. Additionally, it was the largest opening night road victory since Dec. 1, 1979 when it beat Nicholls State, 79-69
- ULM looks to win its home opener for the second consecutive year after downing Samford, 86-52 last season
- The Warhawks seek their first 2-0 start since 2004-05 when they opened with wins against Texas College and Baylor
- Monday's game marks the first of 15 home contests for ULM, the most since 1985-86
- It's one of just two Monday games of the season for the Warhawks. They take on Arkansas State at home on Monday, Jan. 5, 2015
- Ongwae has tallied four consecutive double-figure scoring games dating back to last season and has reached that plateau 25 times in his career
- Ongwae was named to the Preseason All-Conference Second-Team and College Sports Madness All-SBC Second Team. Ongwae ranked fourth in the league in scoring last year and earned recognition on the NABC All-District Second-Team, All-Louisiana Third-Team and College Sports Madness SBC Fourth-Team

ULM Quick Notes Continued...

- The Warhawks were tabbed for sixth in the Sun Belt Conference Preseason Poll. They return three starters and six players overall on a team that morethan doubled both its overall and conference win totals
- ULM brought back point guard Nick Coppola who started all 27 games last year as a true freshman and played 40 minutes nine times. He shot .407 from three-point range in conference games and also ranked top-10 in the league in assists
- The Warhawks return starting center Marvin Williams who ranked top-10 in the SBC in blocks last year. He tallied nine double-figure scoring games. Williams notched a 19-point performance against No. 5 Kansas and outscored both Andrew Wiggins and Joel Embiid, the first and third picks of the NBA draft
- The Warhawks enter the 2014-15 season without any APR penalties for the first time in five years. ULM head coach Keith Richard has turned the program around academically since inheriting APR sanctions when he took over at the helm, and the Warhawks have won back-to-back Sun Belt Conference academic awards
- For the first time since the NCAA instituted academic progress rate (APR) scores in 2003-04, the ULM men's basketball program tallied a perfect 1,000 score in the 2013-14 season
- Over the summer, ULM was the only Division I institution in the state of Louisiana to earn the Team Academic Excellence award from the NABC
- The ULM men's basketball program will honor legendary former head coach Mike Vining by raising a banner featuring the number "402" in a special halftime ceremony during the Warhawks game on Saturday, Jan. 24, 2015 against Georgia Southern at Fant-Ewing Coliseum. The 402 represents the total number of Vining's regular season and post-season victories over his 24 seasons as ULM head coach from 1981-2005

The Tigers men's basketball team is a member of the Association of Christian College Athletics (ACCA) but schedules games against a wide variety of leagues including the NCAA, NAIA and NJCAA. Within the ACCA, the Tigers can qualify for a postseason tournament and compete for a National Championship.

In its short eight year career, the Champion Baptist Tigers basketball team has made eight ACCA National Tournament appearances. They have won three National Championships in 2007, 2009, and 2010. CBC has produced one ACCA Player of the year, two ACCA tournament MVPs, five different All-Tournament team players, five ACCA All-Americans, and over 20 different ACCA Academic All-Americans.

The Tigers are coached by Brother Eric Capaci and assisted by Charles Cotton. Capaci previously coached the Gospel Light Lions high school team for 15 years and led them to seven state championships.

Like ULM, Champion Baptist has a father/son combo in Eric and Josiah Capaci. Josiah is a 5'7 guard who is playing in his senior season. He is one of two seniors on the team along with Cole Johnson, a 5'9 guard from Baton Rouge, La.

In ULM's Last Outing...

Warhawks Shine in 74-65 Opening Night Victory over UAB

BIRMINGHAM, **Ala.** – Senior Tylor Ongwae and junior Justin Roberson each tallied 18 points to propel the ULM men's basketball program to a big 74-65 win over UAB in the 2014-15 season opener on Saturday at Bartow Arena in the first game of the Battle 4 Atlantis tournament.

ULM (1-0) trailed 3-0 after UAB (0-1) hit a three-pointer to open the game, but the Warhawks responded with a pair of baskets and never surrendered the lead. Ongwae finished one rebound away from a double-double with nine boards.

Roberson hit six field goals and was a perfect 6-6 from the free throw line to go with his five assists. Sophomore Nick Coppola registered 14 points and six assists, and came up huge with three three-pointers in the second half.

In his first appearance in a ULM uniform, junior Majok Deng netted 13 points including a pair of long-range shots. He also rejected four blocks.

For UAB, Tosin Mehinti led the way with 15 points and 10 rebounds. Hakeem Baxter recorded 11 points and Tyler Madison had 10.

The Warhawks led early, 9-7, when they went on an 8-0 run which included a three-pointer from junior Jamaal Samuel to go up 17-9 at the 12:55 mark. ULM took its biggest lead of the half, 29-20, after a jumper from Roberson with 3:55 left.

Leading 31-25, the Warhawks were able to hold for the final possession and Coppola drove and converted a lay-up in the closing seconds. ULM took the 33-25 into the intermission.

The Warhawks increased their lead to 44-33 after Ongwae converted an and-one with 15:14 left early in the second half.

The Blazers answered with a 5-0 run to cut the deficit to 44-39 as ULM called timeout with 12:28 remaining. UAB further chopped the lead to 46-43, but Roberson responded with a jumper and two free throws to push the lead back up to 50-43 with 8:40 left.

ULM pulled away with three long-range shots from Coppola to go up 63-50. Ongwae followed it with a jumper for ULM's biggest lead of the game, 65-60, with 3:37 remaining.


