ULM Quick Notes

- Senior Tylor Ongwae is the reigning Sun Belt Conference Player of the Week, College Sports Madness SBC Player of the Week and Warhawk of the Week winner. He's tallied five consecutive double-figure scoring games dating back to last season and was named to the Preseason All-Conference Second-Team

- ULM is off to its first 2-0 start since 2004-05. It is looking to open 3-0 for the first time since 1987-88 when it started with wins over Nicholls State, Southeastern Louisiana and Louisiana Tech

- The Warhawks are looking to knock off a top-10 team for the first time since Dec. 30, 1992 when they defeated No. 9 Arkansas, 87-78

- ULM is coming off a historic 106-39 victory over Champion Baptist in its home opener. The 67-point win broke the school record for largest margin of victory. It was also the most points ULM scored in a game since Feb. 17, 2001 in a game against UTSA

- ULM won its home opener by more-than 30 points for the second consecutive year after downing Samford, 86-52 last season

- The Warhawks opened the season with a 74-65 victory on the road over UAB. They had four double-figure scorers in Ongwae (18), junior Justin Roberson (18), sophomore Nick Coppola (14) and junior Majok Deng (13)

- It was the first opening night victory for ULM since Nov. 14, 2008 when it defeated Morehead State, 56-54 and the first opening night road win since Nov. 23, 1999 when it won at Samford, 67-60. Additionally, it was the largest opening night road victory since Dec. 1, 1979 when it beat Nicholls State, 79-69

ULM Quick Notes Continued...

- Friday's contest is part of the Battle 4 Atlantis tournament but is not part of the main bracket. The Warhawks will take on Coastal Carolina in the first of their bracketed tournament games on Wednesday, Nov. 26 in Chattanooga, Tenn.

- For the second consecutive game, Keith and Lance Richard will be going up against another father/son combo. They took on Eric and Josiah Capaci of Champion Baptist and now face Billy and Billy Donovan. Billy Jr. did not play in Florida's first two games. The Richard's and the Donovan's are two of seven father/son duos in Division I

- After two games, the Warhawks lead the Sun Belt Conference in scoring offense (90.0 ppg), scoring defense (52.0 ppg), scoring margin (+38.0), field goal percentage defense (.343), rebounding margin (+16.0), blocks (7.5 bpg), turnover margin (+9.0), assist/turnover ratio (1.8) and offensive rebound percentage (.431)

- Junior Majok Deng leads the conference in blocked shots with six on the season (3.0 bpg)

- ULM has 15 home games on the 2014-15 schedule, the most since 1985-86

- The Warhawks were tabbed for sixth in the Sun Belt Conference Preseason Poll. They return three starters and six players overall on a team that more-than doubled both its overall and conference win totals

- ULM brought back point guard Nick Coppola who started all 27 games last year as a true freshman and played 40 minutes nine times. He shot .407 from three-point range in conference games and also ranked top-10 in the league in assists

- The Warhawks return starting center Marvin Williams who ranked top-10 in the SBC in blocks last year. He tallied nine double-figure scoring games. Williams notched a 19-point performance against No. 5 Kansas and outscored both Andrew Wiggins and Joel Embiid, the first and third picks of the NBA draft

- The Warhawks enter the 2014-15 season without any APR penalties for the first time in five years. ULM head coach Keith Richard has turned the program around academically since inheriting APR sanctions when he took over at the helm, and the Warhawks have won back-to-back Sun Belt Conference academic awards

- For the first time since the NCAA instituted academic progress rate (APR) scores in 2003-04, the ULM men's basketball program tallied a perfect 1,000 score in the 2013-14 season

- Over the summer, ULM was the only Division I institution in the state of Louisiana to earn the Team Academic Excellence award from the NABC

- The ULM men's basketball program will honor legendary former head coach Mike Vining by raising a banner featuring the number "402" in a special halftime ceremony during the Warhawks game on Saturday, Jan. 24, 2015 against Georgia Southern at Fant-Ewing Coliseum. The 402 represents the total number of Vining's regular season and post-season victories over his 24 seasons as ULM head coach from 1981-2005

Scouting Florida

After reaching the NCAA Final Four last season, eighth-ranked Florida is off to a 1-1 start. The Gators defeated William & Mary, 68-45 in their season opener before dropping a very tight 69-67 decision to Miami (Fla.) on Monday.

Florida has four players averaging in double-figures as Dorian Finney-Smith averages 15.0 points per game, Eli Carter 14.5, Jon Horford 14.0 and Michael Frazier 13.5. Finney-Smith missed the Miami game and is questionable for Friday with two hairline fractures in his left hand. Finney-Smith and Frazier were both named to the Preseason All-SEC First-Team.

Billy Donovan is in his 19th season at the helm and holds a 452-170 record. He coached the Gators to a pair of national championships in 2006 and 2007, six regular season SEC championships and four SEC tournament championships. Additionally, he's reached the national championship game three times and the Final Four four times. Donovan is a three-time SEC Coach of the Year winner. Under Donovan, Florida has been ranked No. 1 in the country in five different seasons. Additionally, the Gators have tallied 16 straight 20-win seasons and three 30-win seasons.

In ULM's Last Outing...

ULM Runs Past Champion Baptist 106-39 in Record Breaking Home Opener

MONROE, La. — In its first showing in front of the home crowd at Fant-Ewing Coliseum in 2014-15, the ULM men's basketball program broke the school record for largest margin of victory in a 106-39 decision over Champion Baptist on Monday.

ULM (2-0) scored 53 points in each half and all 11 student-athletes who entered the game scored at least three points and grabbed a rebound. Junior Jamaal Samuel led the charge with a career-high 18 points and also pulled down six rebounds.

Samuel was one of four Warhawks to reach double-figures as senior Tylor Ongwae netted 16 points, junior Mack Foster 13 and senior Marvin Williams 11.

The Warhawks jumped out to an early 14-4 lead as Ongwae tallied eight points in the first four minutes. After CBC hit a three-pointer, ULM used an 8-0 run to go up 22-7 with 10:54 left.

ULM was in control the whole way and after leading 41-18, the Warhawks scored the final 12 points in the first half to go into the intermission ahead, 53-18. ULM shot an astounding .647 from the field.

The Warhawks opened the second half on a 17-2 run to go up 70-20 with 15:49 remaining in the game. They went up 91-30 on a layup by senior Chinedu Amajoyi at the 8:03 mark.

A three-pointer by Foster broke the 100-point plateau for the Warhawks with 2:39 to go. ULM closed it out with a free throw from sophomore Prince Cooper and a three-pointer from redshirt-freshman Lance Richard.
