ULM Quick Notes

- Senior Tylor Ongwae has tallied six consecutive double-figure scoring games dating back to last season and was named to the Preseason All-Conference Second-Team. He's made eight field goals in all three games this year and won SBC Player of the Week and College Sports Madness SBC Player of the Week on Nov. 18. He's averaging a team-highs of 17.7 points and 7.9 rebounds per game with a .585 field goal percentage (24-41)
- Sophomore Nick Coppola leads the Sun Belt Conference in three-point field goal percentage at .636 (7-11) and assist:turnover ratio (4.0). He's averaging 10.7 points per game on the year
- ULM is playing its first regular season neutral court game since Nov. 26-28, 2010 when it played in the Global Sports Roundball Classic in Normal, Ill.
- The Warhawks are coming off an overtime thriller against No. 8 Florida where the Gators came out on top, 61-56. Coppola hit a three-pointer with 19 seconds left to level the score at 51 and send the game into overtime. He played a career-high 45 minutes in the contest. ULM led 54-53 with 3:00 remaining in overtime after a three-point play from Ongwae
- The 61 points-against versus No. 8 Florida was the lowest ULM has ever let up against a ranked opponent in program history
- With a 2-1 record, ULM is off to its best start since 2004-05
- After three games, the Warhawks lead the Sun Belt Conference in scoring defense (55.0 ppg), blocks (6.3 bpg), blocks in a game (10), turnover margin (+7.3.), point margin in a game (+67) and FG made in a game (41)

Fifth Year at ULM 14th Season Overall

ULM Quick Notes Continued...

- ULM has won the turnover margin in all three games this season
- The Warhawks have had seven different student-athletes reach double-figure scoring in a game this season. Junior Jamaal Samuel is the third Warhawk to average in double-figures with 10.0 ppg in addition to Ongwae and Coppola. Junior Justin Roberson is just shy of the plateau with 9.7 ppg
- ULM posted a historic 106-39 victory over Champion Baptist in its home opener. The 67-point win broke the school record for largest margin of victory. It was also the most points ULM scored in a game since Feb. 17, 2001 in a game against UTSA
- ULM won its home opener by more-than 30 points for the second consecutive year after downing Samford, 86-52 last season
- The Warhawks opened the season with a 74-65 victory on the road over UAB. They had four double-figure scorers in Ongwae (18), junior Justin Roberson (18), Coppola (14) and junior Majok Deng (13)
- It was the first opening night victory for ULM since Nov. 14, 2008 when it defeated Morehead State, 56-54 and the first opening night road win since Nov. 23, 1999 when it won at Samford, 67-60. Additionally, it was the largest opening night road victory since Dec. 1, 1979 when it beat Nicholls State, 79-69
- ULM has 15 home games on the 2014-15 schedule, the most since 1985-86
- The Warhawks were tabbed for sixth in the Sun Belt Conference Preseason Poll. They return three starters and six players overall on a team that more-than doubled both its overall and conference win totals
- ULM brought back point guard Coppola who started all 27 games last year as a true freshman and played 40 minutes nine times. He shot .407 from three-point range in conference games and also ranked top-10 in the league in assists
- -The Warhawks return starting center Marvin Williams who ranked top-10 in the SBC in blocks last year. He tallied nine double-figure scoring games. Williams notched a 19-point performance against No. 5 Kansas and outscored both Andrew Wiggins and Joel Embiid, the first and third picks of the NBA draft
- Keith and Lance Richard are one of seven father/son combos in Division I. They have already played against two other father/son duos in Josiah and Eric Capaci at Champion Baptist and Billy and Billy Donovan at Florida. They will also take on the Neal's of New Mexico and the Hunter's of Georgia State
- The Warhawks enter the 2014-15 season without any APR penalties for the first time in five years. ULM head coach Keith Richard has turned the program around academically since inheriting APR sanctions when he took over at the helm, and the Warhawks have won back-to-back Sun Belt Conference academic awards
- For the first time since the NCAA instituted academic progress rate (APR) scores in 2003-04, the ULM men's basketball program tallied a perfect 1,000 score in the 2013-14 season. Over the summer, ULM was the only Division I institution in the state of Louisiana to earn the Team Academic Excellence award from the NABC
- The ULM men's basketball program will honor legendary former head coach Mike Vining by raising a banner featuring the number "402" in a special halftime ceremony during the Warhawks game on Saturday, Jan. 24, 2015 against Georgia Southern at Fant-Ewing Coliseum. The 402 represents the total number of Vining's regular season and post-season victories over his 24 seasons as ULM head coach from 1981-2005

Scouting Coastal Carolina

After reaching the NCAA Tournament last season, Coastal Carolina (3-1) was picked as the Big South Preseason favorite to repeat in 2014-15. The team returns four starters and 10 letterwinners from last year.

The Chanticleers brought back Warren Gillis, the Big South Tournament MVP, who is averaging 13.3 points per game. Josh Cameron leads the team in scoring with 14.5 points per game, all coming from off the bench. Elijah Wilson, who averages 8.8 points per game, was named Big South Preseason All-Conference along with Gillis.

Coastal Carolina opened the season with a 79-36 win over Trinity Baptist before falling to UCLA, 84-71. The Chanticleers bounced back with 30-plus point victories over Columbia International and Piedmont International. In four games, Coastal Carolina has outscored its opponents, 308-204.

Head coach Cliff Ellis ranks 26th all-time in career victories in Division I with 671. He's one of 10 coaches in NCAA Division I history to lead four different schools to the NCAA Tournament. He's won two regular season and one post-season championship at Coastal Carolina. Over his 39-year coaching career, Ellis became one of two coaches in NCAA Division I history to post over 100 wins at four different institutions. Ellis still stands as the winningest coach in South Alabama history with 171 victories in nine seasons. He also won championships at Clemson and Auburn.

Its the second-ever meeting between ULM and Coastal Carolina, both on neutral courts. The first came on Dec. 18, 1992 when the Chanticleers finished on top, 77-68 in the Hawaii Early Season Tournament in Honolulu.

In ULM's Last Outing...

Warhawks Give Eighth-Ranked Florida an Overtime Scare

GAINESVILLE, Fla. – A three-pointer from sophomore Nick Coppola late in regulation sent the ULM men's basketball program to overtime with eighth-ranked Florida, but the Gators were able to hold off the upset minded Warhawks, 61-56 at the Stephen C. O'Connell Center on Friday.

Coppola's three-pointer came with 19 seconds left which helped ULM (2-1) erase an eight-point deficit with just under two minutes remaining. The Warhawks were able to force a Florida (2-1) turnover with 1.5 seconds left, but a half-court attempt from junior Justin Roberson was no good to send the game into overtime.

The Gators were up 53-51 in overtime when senior Tylor Ongwae converted an old-fashion three-point play to put ULM back on top, 54-53 with 3:00 left. Florida came back with a 5-0 spurt to go up 58-54, but the Warhawks stayed alive with a lay-in from Ongwae to cut it to 58-56 with 19 seconds left. ULM was unable to come any closer.

Ongwae led the Warhawks with 19 points and eight rebounds in the game. The Warhawks led by as many as 12 in the first half and took a two-point lead into the intermission.

Coppola finished with 11 points including a trio of three-pointers. Junior Majok Deng grabbed a team-high nine rebounds.


