## FIRST AND TEN

• The 593 yards of total offense (391 passing, 202 rushing) against Nicholls State were the most by a ULM squad since Nov. 3, 2007 against Middle Tennessee State (624).

• The Warhawks went to intermission with a 40-0 lead. It marked the most points by ULM in a half since the same date in 2009 (42-0 first-half lead versus Texas Southern).

• ULM held Nicholls State to 260 yards of offense, the fewest any opponent has had on the Warhawks since Texas A&M had 243 on Nov. 1, 2014.

• ULM limited the Colonels to just 18 yards of offense in the first quarter on three three-and-outs.

• The victory improved ULM's record in the series to 23-3 against the long-ago Southland Conference foe. It was the first meeting between the schools since Sept. 16, 2000.

• Rashon Ceaser continued his torrid pace that dates back to the 2014 finale. He caught 10 passes for 97 yards against the Colonels, giving him 31 catches for 388 yards in his last three outings.

• Ajalen Holley had eight catches for 155 yards, all in the first half. His career-high of 175 yards came at home as well (175 yards, Idaho, September 6, 2014).

• Holley tied a career-high as he hauled in his second TD of the quarter, a 47-yard touchdown reception with 1:21 to play in the opening half. Marcus Green hauled in his first career reception, a 48-yard pitch-and-catch with QB Garrett Smith late in the second quarter.

• Garrett Smith hit 26 of his 33 passes for 370 yards and three touchdowns, all in just over a half of play. He begins his Warhawk career with a 79 percent completion rate (49 for 62).

• Smith had a 28-yard rush against Nicholls State on the heels of having a 24-yard scramble against Georgia in his collegiate debut.

• Harley Scioneaux caught his first touchdown of the season, a 17-yard reception, to put ULM in front 31-0 with 2:09 to play in the second quarter.

• Caleb Tucker blocked a Chris Sciambra punt with 1:37 to play in the first half and the ball went out of the endzone for a safety to increase the lead to 33-0. It is the second consecutive season that the defense as ULM recorded a safety in last season's game vs. Texas State (Oct. 25, 2014).

• Gerrard Johnson tallied a pair of tackles for loss in the opening half and finished with six total stops in the first 30 minutes. He also had multiple tackles behind the line for the fourth time in five games.

• Michael Johnson led the Warhawks in tackles with seven total stops in the opening half.

## ULM VS. ALABAMA

ULM and Alabama will meet on the gridiron for the third time as the two teams square off this Saturday in Tuscaloosa, Ala... ULM won the most recent meeting in Tuscaloosa, a 21-14 win on November 17, 2007... In the first-ever meeting between the two teams in 2006, Alabama claimed a 41-7 win (September 16)... The win by Alabama in 2006 was later vacated.

## SCOUTING THE CRIMSON TIDE

Alabama enters the final weekend of September with a 2-1 record after wins over then-No. 20 Wisconsin in Dallas on September 5 (W, 35-17) and Middle Tennessee on September 12 (W, 37-10)... In the Crimson Tide's most recent outing (September 19), they fell to then-no. 15 Ole Miss, 43-37 in the SEC opener for both teams.

Jake Coker has started two of three games under center and the senior has completed 51 of his 91 pass attempts for 628 yards with five touchdowns and three interceptions... Derrick Henry leads the club in rushing as he has tallied 370 rushing yards on 54 attempts with seven rushing scores... ArDarius Stewart leads the team in receptions with 13 while O.J. Howard is the team leader in receiving yards at 175... Through the first three games of the season, a total of five Alabama receivers have totaled 100 or more receiving yards this season.

On the defensive side of the ball, Reggie Ragland leads the team in total tackles with 30 and he has also tallied 1.5 tackles for loss... Jonathan Allen is the Crimson Tide's leader in sacks as he has record three sacks for 23 yards this season... Eddie Jackson and Cyrus Jones have each intercepted one pass this season... As a unit, the defense has recorded 13 tackles for loss (49 yards) and five sacks (36 yards).

Kicker Adam Griffith is 14-of-14 on PATs and 1-of-5 on FG attempts... Griffith has kicked off 18 times for 1107 yards (61.5 avg) with five touchbacks... Punter JK Scott has punted 11 times for 432 yards (39.3 avg) with two landing inside the opponent 20 yard line.

## DEFENSIVE SHUTOUT

ULM picked up a 47-0 win over Nicholls State in its home opener on September 12, 2015... It was the first shutout win for the Warhawks since December 3, 2011 when ULM blanked Florida Atlantic, 26-0, in Boca Raton, Fla... The 47-0 win over Nicholls State was the first shutout win at home for the Warhawks since a 58-0 win over Texas Southern on September 12, 2009.

## QUICK SCORING

ULM took a 40-0 lead into the locker room at intermission against Nicholls State as the Warhawks tallied 30 points in the second quarter... 16 of the 30 points came in a span of just 48 seconds late in the opening half... With 2:09 to play in the second quarter, Garrett Smith connected with Harley Scioneaux for a 17-yard touchdown and Craig Ford hit the PAT to put ULM ahead 31-0... Just 32 seconds later, Caleb Tucker blocked a Chris Sciambra punt and it went out of the endzone for a safety, putting the Warhawks ahead, 33-0... After a Colonel free kick, the Warhawks needed just one play to increase the lead to 40-0 as Garrett Smith found Ajalen Holley for a 47-yard TD and Craig Ford hit the PAT to conclude ULM's 16 points in 48 seconds.

## DEFENSIVE PRESSURE

The ULM defense limited Nicholls State to just 32 yards of total offense in the opening quarter of the September 12th contest... The Colonels did not pickup a first down as they ran nine total plays in the first quarter... In all, the Warhawks limited the Colonels to just 260 yards of total offense and ULM recovered a pair of fumbles and turned them in 14 points... The defense also blocked a punt for a safety and in all the Warhawks finished with nine tackles for loss (17 yards) and two sacks (five yards).

## COACH TO CURE MD

For the eighth year in a row, football coaches nationwide will band together for the Coach to Cure MD program, which will be held during games on Saturday, September 26. The annual effort has raised more than \$1.25 million to battle Duchenne muscular dystrophy.

On Saturday, September 26, American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) members will wear a Coach to Cure MD logo patch on the sidelines. College football fans will be asked to donate to research projects supported by Parent Project Muscular Dystrophy (PPMD), the largest nonprofit organization in the U.S. to focus solely on Duchenne muscular dystrophy.

The Coach to Cure MD patches will also be worn on non-Saturday games the same weekend, and teams who do not play will wear the patches during other games throughout the season. Additionally, more than 60 teams will recognize a local Duchenne family on the field before or during the game.

13 catches and went over the 150 yard mark for the first time in his career as he tallied 153 receiving yards... He also tied a career high with two touchdown receptions in the contest against the Bulldogs.

His 13 grabs are tied for third in ULM single-game history and it marks the second time in the Warhawks' last three games that a player had 13 receptions (Kenzee Jackson, 13, at New Mexico State, Nov. 22, 2014)... Ceaser's 13 catches pushed his career total to 175 and he now ranks sixth in ULM history... His 153 yards increased his career total to 2,251 as he moved from eighth to fifth in program history.

In addition to his Sun Belt honor, Ceaser was also named College Sports Madness' Sun Belt Offensive Player of the Week as well as Warhawk of the Week.

### ROAD WARRIORS

At a quick glance, it's not hard to notice the Warhawks play a total of 13 games this season... What may get overlooked is that ULM plays a total of eight games away from the friendly confines of JPS Field at Malone Stadium... ULM is the only FBS program this season that will play a total of eight road games... Via Google Maps the distance from JPS Field at Malone Stadium to all eight road venues comes to a total of 8,612 miles and that is just one direction -- double that amount and the round trip from ULM to each road venue comes to 17,224 miles.

Not only do the Warhawks play a total of eight road games this season, they have a stretch in late October to early November where they play three consecutive conference games... The Warhawks open up the stretch with an October 24th contest at Idaho inside the Kibbie Dome... A week later, on Halloween, the Warhawks battle in-state rival UL Lafayette at Cajun Field... The three-game road stretch comes to a close on Nov. 7 with a Sun Belt tilt at Troy.

The Warhawks are just one of four FBS programs to play three consecutive conference games away from home this season... Joining ULM on the list is fellow Sun Belt Conference member Arkansas State as well as Southeastern Conference members Arkansas and Florida... ULM is the only one to play three straight weeks in true road games... Arkansas State has a bye week during its three-game conference road stretch from Thursday, November 5th to Saturday, November 28th (Bye Week - November 21)... Arkansas and Florida each play three straight games away from home, but one of those is a neutral site game (Arkansas vs. Texas A&M, Arlington, Texas - Saturday, September 26th; Florida vs. Georgia, Jacksonville, Fla., Saturday, October 31).

### ZERO BACK-TO-BACK HOME GAMES

ULM is one of six teams in FBS that will not play back-to-back home games this season and they are the only Sun Belt School on the list... Joining the Warhawks on the list are FIU, Middle Tennessee, San Diego State, UMass and Western Kentucky... UMass plays two games in its home state, but one is in Amherst vs. Kent State on Oct. 17, followed by a game at Gillette Stadium in Foxboro, Mass. on Oct. 24.

### KING CEASER

Rashon Ceaser hauled in 13 catches in ULM's season opener at No. 9 Georgia. He followed that up with 10 catches in the home opener against Nicholls State and the Clinton, La., native now has caught at least one pass in 33 consecutive games, a streak that ranks fourth in FBS.

### FIRST LINE OF DEFENSE

Entering the 2015 season, ULM's Gerrard Johnson is just one of six players in the FBS ranks to have tallied 200 or more tackles in a career and 20 or more tackles for loss... Johnson is the only player from the Sun Belt Conference on the list and he is also the only defensive lineman to make up the group of six... The Rayville, La., native enters his final collegiate season with 200 tackles and 29.5 tackles for loss... The list was compiled by Art Chase, Asst. AD / External Affairs at Duke.

Through two games in 2015, Johnson has tallied 11 total tackles and two tackles for loss to push his career totals to 211 tackles and 31.5 tackles for loss.

### GETTING TO THE QUARTERBACK

In the 2014 season, the Warhawks tallied 36 total sacks, the most for the program during its time in the Sun Belt Conference (previous high 27, in 2009)... It was also the first time the Warhawks tallied 30 or more sacks in a single season since 1998 when the squad finished with 31 sacks... The sack total of 36 was also the most for the squad since the 1997 campaign when the Warhawks sacked the quarterback a total of 39 times.

The Warhawks have also tallied at least one sack in 18 of their last 19 games dating back to the 2013 campaign; the only game in which ULM didn't record a sack in 2014 was on Nov. 8, 2014 at Appalachian State.

## PUTTING POINTS ON THE BOARD

Since the Warhawks joined the Sun Belt Conference to begin the 2001 season, the club has scored in 158 of its 167 games (dating back to Sept. 1, 2001 vs. Sam Houston State)... The Warhawks have scored at least one time in each of the last 10 games... ULM was shutout in the 2008 season opener at No. 10 Auburn, snapping a streak of 32 consecutive games of recording at least one score... A 59-0 loss at Ole Miss later that season marked the first time that ULM had been shutout multiple times in the same season since 2000 (Memphis; Middle Tennessee; Central Florida)... The squad was shutout in its road tilt at LSU (Sept. 13, 2014) and it snapped a streak of 13 straight games with a score.

## NEW TURF, NEW NAME

Thanks to a generous donation of \$450,000, the largest single gift in ULM athletics history, the Warhawk football team is in year two of playing on FieldTurf Revolution... The donation from JPS Aviation/JPS Equipment Rental covered the cost of the new FieldTurf Revolution and for the donation, the name of the field will now be JPS Field at Malone Stadium... The length of the naming rights was set at a minimum of eight years... The new FieldTurf stretches wall-to-wall and totals 78,000 square feet... It is the same playing surface the Warhawks played on at Wake Forest in 2013 and other notable FBS schools that have the FieldTurf Revolution are: Louisville, Michigan, Nebraska, Ohio State, Ole Miss, Oregon, Texas, Texas Tech and Wisconsin... There are also 23 NFL football teams that have the FieldTurf Revolution.
