### South Alabama Hosts Arkansas State in ESPN2 Showdown Tuesday

Week seven action in the Sun Belt gets off to an early start as South Alabama will host Arkansas State Tuesday night in an ESPN2 nationally televised game. Kickoff is set for 7 p.m. (CT) from Ladd-Peebles Stadium in Mobile.

Arkansas State holds a 3-0 edge all-time against South Alabama including last season's 45-10 win in Jonesboro. Both teams enter the contest having won their only conference games to date as both sit at 1-0 in the standings.

Arkansas State has built an impressive record under similar circumstances as Tuesday's contest as the Red Wolves have won 12 of their last 15 conference road games dating back to the 2011 season and holds an 11-6 record in all midweek games since its inaugural season in the Sun Belt Conference. They have won seven of its last 10 midweek contests. The Red Wolves, however, have started conference play 2-0 in only five occasions

in their 14 year history in the league. Meanwhile, South Alabama has never started conference play 2-0 in its brief three years in the conference.

Elsewhere around the league, Appalachian State, Georgia Southern, and UL Lafayette join Arkansas State and South Alabama with perfect starts to the season. However, of those teams only Georgia Southern has played two conference games. The Eagles are joined by longtime rivals App. State as the teams with the best overall records as both stand at 4-1.

Saturday's contests feature three conference games and one non-conference game with Georgia State traveling to Ball State.

Moving forward to next week, the Sun Belt will have two midweek nationally televised games as Arkansas State will host UL Lafayette on Tuesday, Oct. 20 and Appalachian State will host Georgia Southern on Thursday, Oct. 22.

### Sun Belt Student-Athlete Experience

The advantages of competing in college sports in the Sun Belt Conference are both immediate and lifelong. Sun Belt student-athletes are provided with unique opportunities to learn, compete and succeed. Sun Belt student-athletes have access to career services counselors assisting with writing resumes and identifying internships and summer jobs, career workshops, preparation for interviews/mock interviews, and etiquette classes. ### Jalen Nixon (UL Lafayette, QB, Jr., General Studies)

Making his second career start, completed 22 of 29 passes for 238 yards and three TDs, while rushing for 45 yards on seven carries with a TD to lead the Ragin' Cajuns to a 49-27 win over Texas State in the Sun Belt Conference opener for both teams on Saturday. The junior set career-best for completions, passing yards and touchdowns. Helped UL Lafayette score 28 unanswered points to help erase a 14-7 deficit in the second quarter. His 22-yard scoring pass to Al Riles tied the game at 7-7 in the first quarter before his 17-yard TD pass that Jamal Robinson made a spectacular one-handed grab, knotted the game at 14-14 heading into the half. Connected with Robinson on a 31-yard scoring pass in the third quarter that gave UL Lafayette the lead for good before adding an 18-yard TD run that gave the Ragin' Cajuns a 35-14 lead in the third quarter.

### Latrell Gibbs (Appalachian State, DB, So., Exercise Science)

Gibbs maintained his amazing one-interception-per-game pace this season when he made his fifth interception of the campaign and returned it 47 yards for a touchdown during Saturday's 37-3 win at Georgia State ... early in the fourth quarter, Gibbs plucked an errant pass by GSU quarterback Nick Arbuckle out of the air near the line of scrimmage, hurdled a would-be tackler and raced untouched to paydirt to close out the scoring for the Mountaineers ... Gibbs also recorded four tackles and a pass breakup in Saturday's win ... in addition to picking off his fifth pass in as many games, the sophomore scored his second touchdown in as many weeks (he returned an INT 91 yards for a score last Saturday against Wyoming) ... Gibbs and the rest of the Appalachian State defense limited Georgia State to just 225 total yards and 166 passing yards (227.5 and 179.8 below its season averages, respectively) ... Gibbs leads the Sun Belt and is tied for second nationally with 1.0 interceptions per game this season.

### Jeryl Brazil (UL Lafayette, DB, Jr., General Studies)

The junior tied a school-record with a 100-yard kick return in the third quarter that helped UL Lafayette earn a 49-27 victory over Texas State in the Sun Belt Conference opener for both teams on Saturday. Brazil's TD – the first of his collegiate career – followed a 95-yard kickoff return by Texas State's Brandon Smith that had cut the lead to 35-21 with 2:17 remaining in the period. The return by Brazil was the first kickoff return scored by the Ragin' Cajuns since Darryl Surgent returned a kickoff 100 yards for a score at Kansas State in 2013.

## 2015 SUN BELT CONFERENCE PRESEASON POLL

### Eagles Tabbed to Repeat as League Champions in 2015

NEW ORLEANS – Georgia Southern was picked as the favorite to repeat and win the conference championship in the 2015 Sun Belt Conference Football Preseason Poll, voted on by the league’s 11 head coaches.

The Eagles received six of the 11 first-place votes and tallied 110 points, narrowly surpassing the UL Lafayette Ragin’ Cajuns who tallied 108 points and three first-place votes. The Eagles claimed the 2014 Sun Belt regular season title with a perfect 8-0 conference record. The Cajuns finished 7-1 in league play and won their fourth consecutive R+L New Orleans Bowl.

Arkansas State was chosen third with 96 points and one first-place vote and was followed by Appalachian State in fourth with 82 points. The Red Wolves made their fourth consecutive appearance in the GoDaddy Bowl in 2014 as they look for yet another stellar campaign. The Mountaineers closed out 2014 with six consecutive victories – one of the five longest win streaks in the country heading into the 2015 season.

Texas State, with 78 points, was picked to finish fifth to round out the top five. South Alabama was picked to finish sixth and received the final first-place vote; UL Monroe was seventh followed by Troy in eighth. Georgia State was picked ninth, New Mexico State tenth and Idaho 11th.

The Eagles return 13 total starters to the team that finished 9-3 a year ago. A few key returners are dual-threat quarterback Kevin Ellison, All-Conference running back Matt Breida, running back L.A. Ramsby and All-Conference defensive back Matt Dobson.

## 2015 SUN BELT NEWS AND NOTES

### Sun Belt Membership

The Sun Belt Conference consists of 13 total institutions – two (Idaho and New Mexico State) are football only members and two (Little Rock and UT Arlington) are non-football members. Coastal Carolina accepted an invitation to the Sun Belt on September 1 and will begin competing in all sports, with the exception of football, beginning with the 2016-17 season. The Chanticleer football program will begin a transition to the Football Bowl Subdivision with its first year of full FBS status coming in 2018.

### Coastal Carolina to Join Sun Belt Conference

On September 1, Coastal Carolina University accepted an invitation to join the Sun Belt Conference and will begin competing in all sports, with the exception of football, beginning with the 2016-17 season. The Chanticleer football program will begin a transition to the Football Bowl Subdivision with its first year of full FBS status coming in 2018. During the transition, the Chanticleers will compete as a Sun Belt member in 2017 and have the opportunity to compete for the conference football championship, but they will not be eligible to participate in the postseason.

In the last two years alone the Sun Belt Conference has doubled its primary bowl partnerships from two in 2013 to four in 2015. From 2001 to 2009 the Sun Belt Conference had only one bowl partner.

### Arkansas State's Knighten Named Candidate for Senior Class Award

Arkansas State senior quarterback Fredi Knighten was one of 30 FBS student-athletes to be selected as a candidate for the 2015 Senior CLASS Award recently. The honor recognizes student-athletes, who excel both on and off the field of competition. In the community, Knighten has assisted with many service efforts. He helped with a tornado relief fund drive by assisting in the recovery process for the geographic regions hit by several tornadoes in the state and region. He has helped with the Life Champs program, which is a football camp held in his hometown of Little Rock, Ark., that helps kids with football and life lessons.

### 40 NFL Players from Sun Belt Conference Institutions on 2015 Rosters

The Sun Belt Conference has 40 players in the NFL representing its 11 football-playing member institutions for the 2015 season. The conference is represented on 23 of the 32 NFL teams. Appalachian State tops the list of active NFL players with seven, while Arkansas State and Troy have six each.

### Sun Belt Conference Part of NOVA Home Loans Arizona Bowl

The Arizona Sports and Entertainment Commission recently announced the creation of the NOVA Home Loans Arizona Bowl. The bowl game will debut on Dec. 29, 2015 and will match two teams from the Mountain West Conference, Conference USA and the Sun Belt Conference. The game will be played at the University of Arizona's stadium in Tucson, Ariz. The NOVA Home Loans Arizona Bowl is the first-ever bowl game to have a digitally-focused broadcast strategy to be orchestrated by primary digital media partner Campus Insiders. Details and technology partnerships along with the television broadcast partner will be announced at a later date.

### Mountaineer News and Notes

Appalachian State won its seventh-straight Sun Belt Conference game with a 37-3 win at Georgia State in its 2015 conference opener on Saturday.

Saturday's win was also the Mountaineers' 10th in their last 11 games overall and fifth in their last six road games.

For the third time in five games this season, Appalachian State's defense did not surrender a touchdown.

Over the past three games, the Mountaineers' defense has scored more touchdowns (3) than it has allowed (2) and accounted for more total points (21) than it has surrendered (16).

Appalachian State limited Georgia State, which came in to the game ranked among the nation's top 35 in both total offense (452.5 ypg - 32nd) and passing offense (345.8 ypg - 12th), to just 225 total yards and 166 passing yards (227.5 and 179.8 below its season averages, respectively).

Offensively, Appalachian State's 314 passing yards at Georgia State were a season high (prev.: 287 vs. Howard, Sept. 5) and its most in its most in 11 games, dating back to its 397 passing yards vs. Liberty on Oct. 11, 2014.

In two games against Georgia State (Saturday's 37-3 victory and last season's 44-0 win), Appalachian State has outscored GSU, 81-3, and outgained the Panthers, 1,065-287.

Appalachian State leads the nation in two defensive statistical categories this week (defensive touchdowns - 3 and red-zone defense - .250) and ranks among the nation's top 20 in first downs allowed (third - 70), scoring defense (fourth - 11.4 ppg), total defense (eighth - 267.4 ypg), rushing defense (11th - 99.0 ypg), passing defense (17th - 168.4 ypg), takeaways (20th - 12) and third-down conversion defense (20th - .290).

Not to be outdone, Appalachian State ranks fourth nationally in fewest sacks allowed (0.4 pg), ninth nationally in yards per completion (14.86), 10th in rushing (270.2 ypg) and 14th in passing efficiency (158.66) offensively.

Arkansas State stands 2-3 after five games for the second time (2013 & 2015) over the last three seasons . . . With its win over Idaho, A-State improved to 10-5 all-time in Sun Belt openers. It has now started the last three seasons with a league-opening victory for the first time since 2004-06 . . . The Red Wolves have won 26 of their last 32 Sun Belt Conference games . . . Senior wide receiver J.D. McKissic became the Sun Belt Conference's all-time leader in career receptions, completing the Idaho game with four catches to run his career total to 264 . . . Senior running back Michael Gordon recorded a career-high 221 rushing yards against Idaho, ending the game with the second most yards on the ground ever by an A-State player at Centennial Bank Stadium . . . A-State has recorded over 300 yards total offense in 61 of its last 69 games and scored 30 or more points 34 times over its last 52 regular-season outings . . . The Red Wolves' 521 yards total offense and 49 points scored against Idaho were both their second most of the season . . . With a career-high two interception against Idaho, senior cornerback Rocky Hayes became the fourth Sun Belt player this year with multiple picks in a game. Hayes is ranked 24th in the nation in career passes defended among active players . . . Dating back to the 2010 season, Arkansas State holds a 12-2 record over its last 14 games played in the month of October . . . A-State holds a 3-0 all-time record against South Alabama in the Sun Belt Conference series that dates back to just 2012 . . . ### Eagle News and Notes

Georgia Southern leads the all-time series with New Mexico State 1-0 after the Eagles downed the Aggies 36-28 last season in Las Cruces.

L.A. Ramsby ran for a career-high 136 yards and his 7-yard touchdown run with 11:37 left in the third quarter gave the Eagles their first lead of the night. Kevin Ellison put the game out of reach after an Aggie touchdown late in the fourth quarter with a 32-yard run up the middle with 2:41 remaining.

The Aggies jumped out to a 14-0 lead in the first quarter, but the Eagles scored 29 unanswered points to take their first lead of the game, a 29-14 advantage in the third quarter.

Not counting conference championship games, GS has the third-longest active conference winning streak in the FBS at 12 games (last 10 in the Sun Belt; won final two Southern Conference games in 2013), behind only Ohio State University (26) and Florida State University (24).

In games following an open week, Georgia Southern is 26-10. Head coach Willie Fritz is 12-4 in games following a bye week, including a pair of wins last year.

Georgia Southern is 26-6 on Homecoming and has won its last four Homecoming games.

Head coach Willie Fritz and his entire staff will be donning gold ribbons on their game polos this Saturday to raise awareness of childhood cancer. Childhood cancer awareness has hit home this year with the addition of Andre Sims to the Eagles' roster. Sims, a senior transfer who graduated from Michigan State, has a younger brother who has dealt with the disease. Sims' 14-year-old brother, Alan Sims, received a liver transplant in 2013 and is in remission from acute lymphoblastic leukemia (A.L.L.), which he was diagnosed with at the age of four. The transplant was the latest medical issue for Alan, a cancer survivor who completed treatments for A.L.L. in 2010. The Michigan State community stepped up to help the Sims family and volunteers raise money for COTA, a national charity and non-profit organization providing fundraising assistance free of charge. Alan is now an aspiring basketball player who wants to give back to other kids going through the same journey he went through.

### Panther News and Notes

Georgia State plays its final non-conference game as the Panthers travel to Ball State this week. This will be the Panthers' first game against any team from Mid-American Conference. The two schools are playing a two-year home-and-home, with the Cardinals coming to the Georgia Dome for the 2016 season opener.

The game at Ball State means Georgia State head coach Trent Miles will return to his home state. Miles is a native of Terre Haute, Ind., and a graduate of Indiana State, where he also served five years as head coach before moving to Atlanta.

Senior quarterback Nick Arbuckle leads the Sun Belt in passing yards (309.8 pg/13th NCAA) and stands second in touchdown passes (10), completion percentage (.647) and total offense (302.0 pg)

Senior linebacker Joseph Peterson leads the Sun Belt with 10.0 tackles per game. Already Georgia State's career tackling leader, he ranks fifth among all active FBS players with 315 career tackles. He is the Panthers' top tackler for the fourth straight year.

Senior Wil Lutz leads the Sun Belt and ranks 10th in the FBS with an average of 46.3 yards per punt. The Panthers net of 44.16 is fourth in the nation.

Lutz has hit 26 career field goals, including 21-of-23 from 40 yards and in. He is Georgia State's career scoring leader with 169 points.

Georgia State's leading receiver is freshman Penny Hart, who ranks third in the Sun Belt in receptions (5.8 pg) and receiving yards (88.0 pg) and second in touchdowns with four. Among all FBS freshmen, Hart is third in receptions, receiving yards and touchdowns.

Through five games junior linebacker Alonzo McGee has collected nine tackles for loss. He leads the Sun Belt and ranks 10th in the nation with 1.8 tackles for loss per game. McGee, a UAB transfer in his first year with the Panthers, will break the GSU season record with just one more tackle behind the line of scrimmage.

### Vandal News and Notes

Idaho players are atop the Sun Belt Conference in eight individual football statistical categories and five team rankings.

Sophomore quarterback Matt Linehan, who missed the Vandals' last game with an ankle injury, is No. 1 in the Sun Belt in completion percentage, completions per game and total offense, and is second in passing yards per game.

His top receiver, senior Dezmon Epps is No. 1 in the league in total receiving yards, receiving yards per game and receptions per game.

Their efforts helped Idaho to the conference's top ranking in completion percentage. Redshirt freshman quarterback Jake Luton, who scored three times on runs inside the five-yard line at Arkansas State, is a key factor in the Vandals leading the league in red zone offense, where they're tied with four other teams as the nation's best in the red zone.

Junior Austin Rehkow, who doubles as the Vandals kicker and punter, is tied with 11 other kickers with a perfect field goal percentage this fall, and senior defensive end Quinton Bradley is the Sun Belt leader in sacks with an average of .80 per game, which is 33rd nationally.

Here's how Linehan's league-leading numbers stack up nationally: Completions per game of 25.25 are ninth; Completion percentage of .678 is 12th; Total offense yards per game of 302.3 are 18th.

Additionally, he's second in the league in passing yards per game at 277.3, which is 21st nationally. As a team, he and Luton have the Vandals ranked first in the league in completion percentage at .649, which is 26th nationally. They've also combined to average 264.2 yards per game – second in the league and 32nd nationally.

They've achieved this behind a line that has allowed the second fewest tackles for loss per game (5.00) in the league (35th nationally).

For Epps, his top Sun Belt marks made the top 20 nationally: Receptions per game of 10.5 are third; Receiving yards per game of 132 are fifth; Total receiving yards of 528 are 20th.

### Ragin' Cajun News and Notes

The Louisiana Ragin' Cajuns football team used a 28-point third quarter to break free from a halftime tie and claim a 49-27 victory over Texas State in front of 21,377 Saturday evening at Cajun Field in the Sun Belt Conference opener for both teams.

UL Lafayette (2-3, 1-0 Sun Belt) won its Sun Belt opener for the eighth straight season. The 49 points scored by the Cajuns were a season-high and 526 yards of offense marked the highest output since the Northwestern State contest (Sept. 12).

Junior running back Elijah McGuire piled up a season-high 170 yards on a career-high 28 carries. As a team, the Cajuns rushed for 288 yards surpassing 200-plus for the third time in five outings.

Junior quarterback Jalen Nixon had a career night finishing 22-of-29 for 238 yards and four touchdowns, including three through the air.

Jamal Robinson posted his fifth multiple-touchdown game of his career hauling in two scores, the latter which proved to be the winning score in the third quarter. Robinson finished four catches and a season-high 67 yards – increasing his career total to 2,074 yards and two shy of tying Wayne Butler (1989-92) for sixth-place on the school's all-time list.

Al Riles led all receivers with nine catches for 98 yards. Torrey Pierce's 13 carries for 56 yards and Nixon's seven carries totaling 45 yards boosted the Cajuns rushing totals.

Jeryl Brazil's 100-yard kickoff return against Texas State – the first TD of his career – tied the school-record and was the first by a Ragin' Cajun since Darryl Surgent's 100-yard kick return at Kansas State in 2013. The Loranger, La., native is currently ranked eighth among FBS players in kick return average (32.0).

Robinson's 17-yard TD reception near the end of the first half against Texas State was his first since Oct. 4, 2014 when he caught two TDs in the Sun Belt Conference opener against Georgia State.

The Warhawks have teamed up with Susan G. Komen to raise awareness for breast cancer throughout the game.

ULM, one of four FBS teams to not have back-to-back home games all year, hits the road for its next three Sun Belt contests after the Mountaineers leave town.

ULM's 173 yards on the ground against Tulsa were its most against an FBS squad on the year.

The Tulsa contest was a homecoming for head coach Todd Berry, a quarterback for the Golden Hurricane from 1979-81. Brayle Brown, Will Collins, Colby Mitchell and Keaton Baggs also hail from the Sooner State. Berry attended Miami High School there as well.

The game marked ULM's first against an American Athletic Conference foe. Its previous game against anyone currently in the league was in 2013 versus Tulane.

The matchup was the final installation of a home-and-home series that began in 2007 when Tulsa came to Malone Stadium.

ULM ran 77 plays from scrimmage on Saturday. Its previous season-high was 66 against Nicholls State. It marked the most since having 78 in the 2013 Wake Forest win. ULM had season-highs of three sacks and 10.0 tackles-for-loss against Tulsa.

McNeal's 43-yard dash was his longest since unleashing a 77-yarder for a score at UL Lafayette in the 2013 finale. He missed the 2014 season due to injury.

Holley's 11 catches for 113 yards gives him 36 for 472 in his last four games.

The Golden Hurricane's 16-play drive in the middle of the second quarter was the longest against the Warhawks on the year.

Smith finished with 48 pass attempts, the most in his young career.

The NM State football team returns to conference play on Saturday as they travel to Statesboro, Ga. to take on Georgia Southern in a 6 p.m. contest. The game will air on ESPN3 and will be broadcast on AM 570.

The Aggies (0-5) garnered three turnovers compared to the Rebels two as they dropped a 52-3 decision to No. 13 Ole Miss on Oct. 10. NM State grabbed two fumble recoveries, both on punt returns, and one interception during the afternoon contest. Long snapper Andrew Kenney and defensive back Jacob Nwangwa each collected a fumble recovery and Terrill Hanks stepped in front of Chad Kelly's pass to get his second interception of the season.

Next week's Georgia Southern is coming off of their first bye week. The Eagles last faced ULM in Monroe on Oct. 3 as they captured a 51-31 victory. Matt Breida led the offensive efforts with 149 yards and two touchdowns on 19 rushing attempts.

The Red Wolves are the only program in the conference that USA has faced more than once and yet to beat, with ASU claiming each of the first three match-ups. ... The Red Wolves' 45-10 win in Jonesboro last November was the largest margin of defeat in USA history until this season's loss to North Carolina State on Sept. 26. ... Playing without starting QB Brandon Bridge, Jaguar quarterbacks combined to complete 9-of-25 attempts for 90 yards in last fall's game against ASU, just the third time in program history the USA offense was held to less than 100 yards through the air. ... The Jags' four turnovers against the Red Wolves were one fewer than they had committed in the previous five contests combined, and USA was just 1-of-12 (8.3%) on third-down conversions, its lowest percentage of the season. ... In last season's ASU game, Aleem Sunanon set the school career record with a 41-yard field goal at the end of the opening period, his 26th in less than two seasons, while Brandon McKee's 58-yard punt in the first quarter was the longest of his career at the time. ... DL DeMarion Harper was credited with a total of two tackles for loss in his first 14 games for the Jaguars, a figure he has now posted in a contest twice in the last three weeks after recording a pair in the victory over the Trojans. All five of the senior's stops behind the line of scrimmage have come in USA's three victories this fall, while in the team's two losses Harper has been credited with five tackles in all, with none of those for loss. ... With a game-high 91 yards rushing in the victory over the Trojans, sophomore Xavier Johnson moved into the top five on USA's career list in the category while entering (again) the season record books. With 849 yards over the last year-plus, Johnson ranks fifth all-time in rushing yards, and he also stands 10th on the list for yards on the ground in a season with a team-high 411 this fall; the running back's 438 yards last year rank ninth in the category. Johnson — who stands sixth in the conference in rushing and 10th in all-purpose yards — has been the leading ground gainer for the Jags in four of their first five outings. ... Blake Dees shared game-high honors with nine tackles last time out, the second occasion this fall that he has paced the squad; he's the second individual from the defense to lead the team in the category more than once this season, joining Reaves. The senior was credited with eight solo stops against the Trojans, equaling not only the most on the unit this year but the number of unassisted tackles he had in the previous three outings combined.

### Bobcat News and Notes

Texas State will have its second bye week in a span of three weeks as the Bobcats prepare to play South Alabama on Oct. 24. The Bobcats enter the game with a 1-4 record after suffering a 49-27 loss at UL Lafayette last Saturday night.

Texas State leads the Sun Belt Conference and ranks 28th nationally in total offense with an average of 458.4 yards per game this season. The Bobcats had 351 yards on offense at UL Lafayette after accumulating 401 yards at Houston after gaining 591 yards against Southern Miss, 649 yards versus Prairie View A&M and 300 yards at No. 10-ranked Florida State.

Texas State ranks 42nd nationally and is third among Sun Belt Conference teams in scoring offense after averaging 34.0 points per game through the first five contests. The Bobcats scored a season-best 63 points against Prairie View A&M and tallied 50 points versus Southern Miss. Texas State netted 27 points at UL Lafayette, 16 points at No. 10-ranked Florida State and 14 points at Houston.

Texas State is one of nine teams in the nation to rank among the NCAA's top 40 teams in both passing and rushing offenses this season. The other eight teams are Baylor, Houston, Notre Dame, TCU, West Virginia, Memphis, Cincinnati and Tulsa. The Bobcats also are the only Sun Belt Conference team to rank among the top four league leaders in both offensive categories.

The Bobcats scored a touchdown on their first drive in a game for just the second time this season at UL Lafayette when Tyler Jones hit Robert Lowe for a 37-yard touchdown pass. The other time came against Prairie View A&M.

Tyler Jones is the only Sun Belt Conference player ranked among the top 10 conference rushing and passing leaders this season. Jones rushed for 347 yards and five touchdowns on 58 carries the season to rank ninth among Sun Belt rushing leaders. He also ranks among the top four passing leaders with 230.8 passing yards per game.

Jones averages 300.2 yards per game in total offense ranks 20th nationally and is second among Sun Belt Conference leaders. He also is third in the SBC in passing efficiency with a rating of 134.0. He has completed 101 of 162 passes for 1,154 yards and seven touchdowns.

Tyler Jones is tied for fourth among the scoring leaders in the Sun Belt Conference with an average at 6.0 points per game. Jones scored his fifth rushing touchdown of the season at UL Lafayette. He also ran for a TD at Houston and rushed for three TD's against Southern Miss.

Senior quarterback Dallas Tidwell completed a season-high two passes, including a season-long eight yard pass ... Senior quarterback Dontreal Pruitt completed his first pass of the season. Pruitt went 12-of-17 on the day for 90 yards in the air while rushing for 56 yards ... Senior quarterback Dontreal Pruitt scored his second career touchdown on a 5-yard rush in the third quarter ... Senior running back Brandon Burks scored his ninth career rushing touchdown on a 74-yard run, a career-high rush, in the third quarter ...
