Sun Belt Teams Enter Critical Stretch in Final Four Weeks of the 2015 Season

Thursday's Sun Belt on ESPNU telecast will feature two teams that are inching closer to bowl eligibility while they are also battling to claim the fourth best overall record in the conference. The matchup features UL Lafayette (4-4, 3-1 Sun Belt) and South Alabama (4-4, 2-2 Sun Belt) and kickoff is slated for 6:30 p.m. CT from Ladd-Peebles Stadium in Mobile, Ala.

The home team has won each of the first three match-ups in the series between the Jags and Ragin' Cajuns after UL Lafayette earned a 19-9 victory in Lafayette on Nov. 1 last season.

No team in the Sun Belt Conference is hotter than Arkansas State at the moment. The Red Wolves (6-3, 5-0 Sun Belt) impressed in this past Thursday's Sun Belt on ESPNU feature as they stymied Appalachian State (7-2, 4-1 Sun Belt) in the Mountaineers attempt at running their 10-game Sun Belt win streak to 11. Instead, it is the Red Wolves who have now rattled off five consecutive wins and are now bowl eligible for the fifth

consecutive year and eighth time over the last 11 seasons. A-State will face UL Monroe (1-8, 0-5 Sun Belt) this upcoming Saturday in Monroe, La.

App State, meanwhile, will look to rebound as they head west to face Idaho (3-6, 2-4 Sun Belt). Saturday's game will be Appalachian State's first-ever in the Pacific Time zone.

After a bye-week Georgia Southern (6-2, 4-1 Sun Belt) returns to action with a visit to face Troy (3-6, 2-3 Sun Belt) in a Sun Belt Network on ESPN3 affair. In games following an open week, Georgia Southern is 27-10 and head coach Willie Fritz is 13-4 in games following a bye week, including a win earlier this year. The Eagle defense will have their work cut out for them as they face a Troy team that has scored 51, 41, and 52 points respectively in their past three contests.

Texas State (2-6, 1-3 Sun Belt) hosts Georgia State (2-6, 1-3 Sun Belt) Saturday as both teams look to snap two-game losing streaks.

Sun Belt Student-Athlete Experience

Offensive Student-Athlete of the Week (Nov. 9)

Larry Rose III (NM State, RB, So., Communications)

Larry Rose III led the offensive attack with 207 rushing yards, three touchdowns and a game-high 292 all-purpose yards. The sophomore carried the ball 31 times and lost just five rushing yards on the night. With the Aggies trailing by a four points in the fourth quarter, Rose III amassed two touchdowns in the final 10:12 of the game to help NM State win their second game in a row. His final touchdown of the night was a flat pattern pass from quarterback Nick Jeanty, which Rose III took 77 yards to the end zone. This is his third 200-yard rushing game this season and his second in a row. Rose III now has 1,290 rushing yards this season to lead the Sun Belt in that category. These rushing yards also rank fourth in the NM State record books for rushing yards in a single season. With three games left in the season, the Fairfield, Texas native has already surpassed his 1,102 rushing yards from the 2014 season. After his two rushing touchdowns, Rose III now has 21 career rushing touchdowns to rank seventh all-time in the Aggie record books.



Defensive Student-Athlete of the Week (Nov. 9)

Blake Dees (South Alabama, Sr., LB, Interdisciplinary Studies)

Dees set a school game record with 20 total tackles — the most recorded in the Sun Belt this season — and forced a fumble that was returned for a touchdown to help the Jaguars earn a 52-45 victory over Idaho. With USA trailing by 10 points in the third quarter, the senior had both a solo and an unassisted stop to force two Vandal punts, then he stripped the ball on second down at the USA-42 for a fumble that was returned for a touchdown to cut the Jag deficit to three. It was the first time this fall that Dees has been credited with a double-figure tackle total, while it marked the fourth contest that the linebacker has paced the Jaguars in the category.



Special Teams Student-Athlete of the Week (Nov. 9)

Jed Solomon (Troy, Sr., K, Hospitality, Sport & Tourism Management)

Jed Solomon booted three field goals and finished with 15 points in Troy's victory over ULM. Solomon also tied a career-high with seven touchbacks on kickoffs. Solomon is now 12-of-14 on the year on field goal attempts and he finished just two points shy of setting the Troy single-game scoring record by a kicker.

Sun Belt Membership

The Sun Belt Conference consists of 13 total institutions – two (Idaho and New Mexico State) are football only members and two (Little Rock and UT Arlington) are non-football members. Coastal Carolina accepted an invitation to the Sun Belt on September 1 and will begin competing in all sports, with the exception of football, beginning with the 2016-17 season. The Chanticleer football program will begin a transition to the Football Bowl Subdivision with its first year of full FBS status coming in 2018.

Coastal Carolina to Join Sun Belt Conference

On September 1, Coastal Carolina University accepted an invitation to join the Sun Belt Conference and will begin competing in all sports, with the exception of football, beginning with the 2016-17 season. The Chanticleer football program will begin a transition to the Football Bowl Subdivision with its first year of full FBS status coming in 2018. During the transition, the Chanticleers will compete as a Sun Belt member in 2017 and have the opportunity to compete for the conference football championship, but they will not be eligible to participate in the postseason.

Arkansas State's Knighten Named Candidate for Senior Class Award

Arkansas State senior quarterback Fredi Knighten was one of 30 FBS student-athletes to be selected as a candidate for the 2015 Senior CLASS Award recently. The honor recognizes student-athletes, who excel both on and off the field of competition. In the community, Knighten has assisted with many service efforts. He helped with a tornado relief fund drive by assisting in the recovery process for the geographic regions hit by several tornadoes in the state and region. He has helped with the Life Champs program, which is a football camp held in his hometown of Little Rock, Ark., that helps kids with football and life lessons.

40 NFL Players from Sun Belt Conference Institutions on 2015 Rosters

The Sun Belt Conference has 40 players in the NFL representing its 11 football-playing member institutions for the 2015 season. The conference is represented on 23 of the 32 NFL teams. Appalachian State tops the list of active NFL players with seven, while Arkansas State and Troy have six each.

Sun Belt Conference Part of NOVA Home Loans Arizona Bowl

The Arizona Sports and Entertainment Commission recently announced the creation of the NOVA Home Loans Arizona Bowl. The bowl game will debut on Dec. 29, 2015 and will match two teams from the Mountain West Conference, Conference USA and the Sun Belt Conference. The game will be played at the University of Arizona's stadium in Tucson, Ariz. The NOVA Home Loans Arizona Bowl is the first-ever bowl game to have a digitally-focused broadcast strategy to be orchestrated by primary digital media partner Campus Insiders. Details and technology partnerships along with the television broadcast partner will be announced at a later date.

App State FB: 23rd Most Dominant Football Program

In a recent article, Business Insider magazine ranked Appalachian State University football as the 23rd-most dominant college football program in America. In its "25 Most Dominant College Football Programs" article, Business Insider ranks NCAA football programs based on its Niche college ranking (a measure designed to give prospective students an idea of which schools have the best football atmosphere based on a number of factors), games and championships won in the last 15 years and the amount of athletics department revenue generated by the football program. Coming in at No. 23 nationally, Appalachian State is the only Sun Belt Conference institution and the only program from the Carolinas listed in Business Insider's listing of the 25 most dominant college football programs. Appalachian is also the only NCAA Division I FBS "Group of 5" conference member among the top 25 — the only non-"Power 5" conference programs listed besides App State are four-time-defending NCAA Division I FCS national champion North Dakota State (No. 22) and Division III power Mount Union.

Mountaineer News and Notes

Appalachian State saw its 10-game Sun Belt Conference winning streak come to an end with a 40-27 loss to Arkansas State last Thursday evening.

The defeat also snapped Appalachian State's six-game overall and seven-game home winning streaks.

Despite the loss, the Mountaineers' 7-2 start remains tied for the best record through nine games in Sun Belt history (Georgia Southern - 2014, UL Lafayette - 2013, Arkansas State - 2011, UL Lafayette - 2011, Troy - 2009, Middle Tennessee - 2001).

Appalachian State sophomore quarterback Taylor Lamb became the ninth 4,000-yard passer in school history last Thursday. He has thrown for 4,219 yards in 21 career games (19 starts).

Appalachian State junior running back Marcus Cox needs only nine yards to become the first student-athlete in school history with 1,000 rushing yards as a freshman, sophomore and junior.

Saturday's game at Idaho is Appalachian State's first-ever in the Pacific time zone. The 2,499-mile trip to Moscow, Idaho is the second-longest in program history and the longest-ever for a game on the U.S. mainland. The longest trip in App State football history was a 4,622-mile journey to Hawaii for the 2003 season opener.

A-State is bowl eligible for the fifth consecutive year and eighth time over the last 11 seasons . . . A-State is bowl eligible after nine games played for the fourth time in school history (2015, 2014, 2012, 2011) . . . The Red Wolves have won five consecutive games for the first time since the 2012 season when it won eight straight . . . Since Georgia Southern re-started its football program for the 1982 season, the Eagles are 4-2 against Troy, including 2-0 at Veterans Memorial Stadium. The two teams played every year from 1935-1941 with the Trojans winning all eight contests.

You'll have to forgive the Eagles if they seem a little shocked when they take the field on Saturday as they'll be playing in a new environment. Saturday's 2:30 p.m. (CT) kickoff marks the first day game for the Eagles this season as the previous eight have all kicked at 6 p.m. or later.

Georgia Southern will take on Georgia next Saturday and then will finish up at home with a pair of 2 p.m. games against South Alabama and Georgia State.

The Eagles are 6-8 all-time in games played in the state of Alabama, falling to Alabama (2011) and Auburn (1991), and downing Jacksonville State (1999). Additionally, Georgia Southern is 2-2 at Samford, 1-0 at South Alabama, 2-4 at Troy (2-0 in the modern era).

Overall, Georgia Southern is 14-16 against teams from Alabama: 4-0 vs. Jacksonville State; 1-0 vs. South Alabama; 5-4 vs. Samford; 4-10 vs. Troy; 0-1 vs. Alabama; 0-1 vs. Auburn

Two players on the Georgia Southern dress squad will be returning to play in the state they began their college football careers in. Starting long snapper Jake Banta redshirted at UAB in 2011 before transferring to GS for the past three seasons. Starting offensive guard Roscoe Byrd's path is a little more unusual as the senior played three seasons at UAB and was a starter on the offensive line as a junior. He left Birmingham when the program was ended after last season and is playing his final season in Statesboro. Defensive end Lennie Richardson began his career at Troy, but is out with a shoulder injury and isn't expected to play against the Trojans.

In games following an open week, Georgia Southern is 27-10. Head coach Willie Fritz is 13-4 in games following a bye week, including a win earlier this year.

Panther News and Notes

The Georgia State defense turned in a strong performance in the Panthers' 23-21 loss to UL Lafayette, despite playing without both starting inside linebackers due to injury, including leading tackler Joseph Peterson. The Panthers' defense held ULL to 307 total yards and just one offensive touchdown.

Freshman Penny Hart just missed his fourth 100-yard game with five catches for 97 yards vs. ULL. He leads the Sun Belt in receiving yards per game (92.3) and ranks second in receptions (5.8 pg). Among all FBS freshmen, Hart ranks second in receiving yards per game, fourth in receptions per game and fourth in touchdowns.

Quarterback Nick Arbuckle passed for 313 yards and three touchdowns vs. ULL. He leads the Sun Belt and ranks seventh in FBS in passing yards (333.0 pg). Arbuckle ranks fourth among all FBS quarterbacks in career passing yards per game (297.4).

Tight end Keith Rucker caught two touchdowns vs. UL Lafayette, including a one-handed grab that was worthy of the SportsCenter Top 10. That gives Rucker four touchdowns in the last two games. He is Georgia State's third-leading receiver on the season (24-277-5), including 17 receptions, 170 yards and four TDs over the last three contests. Rucker is fourth in the Sun Belt with five touchdown receptions.

Junior receiver Robert Davis had four receptions for 86 yards as he topped the 2,000-yard mark for career receiving yards. He has caught at least one pass in 32 straight games. With Davis at 2,043 career receiving yards, senior Donovan Harden needs just 54 yards to give the Panthers two 2,000-yard receivers. Harden has 1,946 career yards, including 1,282 yards at GSU and 664 yards in two seasons at Illinois State.

Sophomore cornerback Chandon Sullivan was named last week to the Capital One Academic All-District football team. The journalism major with a 3.7 GPA has 32 tackles, three tackles for loss, three pass breakups and one interception, which he returned 25 yards for a touchdown.

With his next tackle for loss, safety Tarris Batiste will become Georgia State's career leader. The senior has 19.5 career tackles for loss, just 0.5 behind record-holder Jarrell Robinson. Batiste is the Panthers' second-leading tackler with 72 tackles, 4.5 tackles for loss, one interception, five pass breakups and a forced fumble.

Vandal News and Notes

A handful of University of Idaho football players are making their names known through their on-field performances this fall with seniors Quinton Bradley (defensive end) and Elijah Penny (running back), junior Austin Rehkow (kicker/punter) and sophomore Matt Linehan (quarterback) leading the way.

Bradley is second in the Sun Belt Conference in both tackles for loss per game and quarterback sacks per game. He is averaging 1.4 tackles for loss per game (which is 19th nationally) and .67 sacks per game (which is 36th nationally). His play earned him a place on the Ted Hendricks Award mid-season watch list. The Hendricks award annually recognizes college football's best defensive end.

Rehkow, who was a Ray Guy Award finalist last year after being a semifinalist as a freshman, this year added the distinction of being one of college football's top kickers as well. He is a Lou Groza Award semifinalist after being ranked first in the Sun Belt and second nationally in field goals per game with 2.00. He has climbed back near the top of the national punting list and is first in the Sun Belt with an average of 45.1 yards per kick – eighth nationally.

Linehan is fourth in single-season completion percentage (.635) and, on the career lists, is third in passing yards per game (250.9), fourth in completion percentage (.606) and 10th in total passing yards (4,768).

Rehkow, already the Vandals' career punting leader, made his way onto some kicking lists this season with the second-most field goals made (18) in a single season with the second-best single-season percentage (.857). On the career field goal lists, he is third in percentage (.68.4) and fourth in field goals made (39) and attempted (57).

Penny has been a workhorse for the Vandals of late. In the past three games, he has had carry totals that are fifth (36) and sixth (35) all-time for a single game.

Linehan is utilizing his tight ends to power the passing game with Deon Watson's 109 yards last week-end the 13th best all-time for a single-game for a Vandal – and just two yards more than fellow tight end Trent Cowan who was pushed to 14th with 107 against Wofford in September.

Ragin' Cajun News and Notes

The Louisiana Ragin' Cajuns look to build on a two-game win streak when it returns to action on Thursday, Nov. 12, against South Alabama in a nationally-televised Sun Belt Conference contest at Ladd-Peebles Stadium.

UL Lafayette (4-4, 3-1 SBC) earned its second consecutive win – and first on the road this season – as it rallied in the second half to edge Georgia State, 23-21, last Saturday in the Georgia Dome. The Ragin' Cajuns built a 17-7 lead after the first quarter before getting a pair of second-half field goals from freshman Stevie Artigue to earn the win.

Artigue kicked field goals of 40, 49 and 21 yards overall for the Ragin' Cajuns with Al Riles recording a career-high 103 yards on eight receptions. Dominique Tovell recorded seven tackles for the Ragin' Cajuns and added a pair of sacks to increase his Sun Belt-leading total to seven.

The Ragin' Cajuns will make their second-ever trip to Mobile to face South Alabama (4-4, 2-2 SBC) with the Jaguars earning a 30-8 victory on Dec. 7, 2013. The home team has won each of the three meetings in the series with the Ragin' Cajuns earning a 52-30 victory in 2012, and a 19-9 win in last year's game at Cajun Field.

Stevie Artigue's 49-yard field goal in the third quarter was the longest by a Ragin' Cajun since Brett Baer's 50-yard kick against East Carolina in the 2012 R+L New Orleans Bowl.

Jamal Robinson caught three passes for 33 yards, increasing his career total to 2,199 and two yards shy of tying former Ragin' Cajun and current San Diego Chargers tight end Ladarius Green (2,201 yards from 2008-11).

Freshman Gary Haynes' 42-yard punt return in the fourth quarter was the team's longest of the season.

Warhawk News and Notes

Last year's contest between the Warhawks and Red Wolves was an unconventional one, as both teams were scoreless going into the halftime locker room. Arkansas State took a 14-0 lead before Ajalen Holley hauled in a 59-yard touchdown pass that got ULM within seven. The Red Wolves ultimately pulled away, 28-14.

Both squads were frequent foes of each other throughout the 1990s as I-AA members. The series became more intermittent when each went I-A in the early-mid 1990s and resumed as the Sun Belt took ULM and Arkansas State as charter football members.

Arkansas State holds a five-game winning streak heading into its contest at Malone Stadium, making it three consecutive visiting Warhawk opponents to have three-game or better win streaks prior to playing at ULM.

The loss to Troy snapped ULM's four-game winning streak against Troy and was the first defeat on the road in the series since Halloween 2009.

ULM's 169 first-quarter yards were its most since having 203 in the third at Tulsa (Oct. 10).

The three-point second half was the ULM defense's best of the year outside of the shutout over Nicholls State.

Mitch Lane blocked a fourth-quarter field goal, the Warhawks' second of the season (Lorenzo Jackson, at Tulsa). Caleb Tucker also had a blocked punt against Nicholls State. The safety Lane also had was his first sack of the season.

The 245 yards in the first half marked back-to-back games of 230 or more before the break.

Marcus Green's 47-yard touchdown catch was the longest of his career. It was also his fourth consecutive game with a TD reception. He previously had scoring grabs of 11, 27 and 31 yards on the year.

Aggie News and Notes

After its second and final bye week of the season on Nov. 14, the NM State football team returns to action on Nov. 21 as they travel to UL-Lafayette to take on the Ragin' Cajuns.

Prior to the week off, the Aggies collected back-to-back wins, the second being a 31-21 win over Texas State on the road. NM State jumped out to an early lead against the Bobcats as Larry Rose III scored his first touchdown of the night on a 22-yard rush up the right sideline. Parker Davidson extended the lead with a 27-yard field goal in the second quarter. Texas State took their first lead of the game as they garnered two touchdowns before halftime, but Clayton Granch caught scored his first touchdown as an Aggie to give the visiting team the lead again. Rose III scored twice in the fourth quarter to give NM State the win.

Rose III led the offensive attack with 207 rushing yards, three touchdowns and a game-high 292 all-purpose yards. The sophomore carried the ball 31 times and lost just five rushing yards on the night. This is his third 200-yard rushing game this season and his second in a row. Rose III now has 1,290 rushing yards this season to lead the Sun Belt in that category. These rushing yards also rank fourth in the NM State record books for rushing yards in a single season. With three games left in the season, the Fairfield, Texas native has already surpassed his 1,102 rushing yards from the 2014 season. After his two rushing touchdowns, Rose III now has 21 career rushing touchdowns to rank seventh all-time in the Aggie record books.

Nick Jeanty was 24-of-45 for 297 yards, two touchdowns and zero interceptions. With Jeanty guiding the Aggies, the team converted 13-of-23 third downs and 2-of-3 fourth downs. The team was also 3-for-3 in the red zone.

Jacob Nwangwa led NM State's defensive efforts as he amassed 10 tackles. Nwangwa grabbed two interceptions on the final two Bobcat drives of the game to secure the victory for the Aggies. With Texas State in the red zone, Nwangwa stepped in front of a Tyler Jones pass and collected his second interception of the season with 3:36 left in the game to prevent the Bobcats from cutting into the lead. On the final drive of the game, the sophomore again stepped in front of a pass to ensure NM State would win.

Nwangwa is second on the team in tackles with 61. He is tied for a team-high three interceptions and has 1.0 tackles for loss and one fumble recovery.

Jaguar News and Notes

The Jaguars play back-to-back home games for the first time since Oct. 18-24 last year when Louisiana-Lafayette visits Thursday night. ... The home team has won each of the first three match-ups in the series between the Jags and Ragin' Cajuns after ULL earned a 19-9 victory in Lafayette on Nov. 1 last season. ... All three of those decisions have been by a double-digit total, though the combined scores of the two teams has dropped from 82 in 2012 to 28 last fall; the first figure is tied for the most combined in USA's record books, the second is the third-lowest total recorded by both squads. ... The Jaguars have a 4-1 record all-time when playing with less than a week between games after splitting a pair of such contests a year ago; USA defeated Troy on Oct. 24 but fell to Navy Nov. 28, with both games played on a Friday six days after the Jags' previous outing. ... USA has won both contests at Ladd-Peebles Stadium against schools from Louisiana, having swept ULL and Louisiana-Monroe at home in a three-week span at the end of the 2013 campaign. ... The Jaguars snapped a two-game losing streak last time out with a 52-45 Homecoming victory over Idaho on Saturday, with USA scoring 45 points after the intermission. After falling behind 24-0 midway through the second quarter, the Jags set a new school mark for largest deficit overcome in a victory, surpassing the 14 points the Jags trailed Florida Atlantic by on Oct. 20, 2013, before coming back for a 37-34 double-overtime win. The 97 points scored by the two teams were also the most combined in a Jaguar game, surpassing the previous standard by 15. ... In the victory over the Vandals, the Jaguars scored a touchdown on offense, defense and special teams, marking the first time that has happened since they defeated Pikeville (Ky.) on Sept. 4, 2010. ... Xavier Johnson returned the opening kickoff of the second half 100 yards for a touchdown, sparking a 45-point performance by South Alabama over the final 30 minutes in a come-from-behind win over Idaho. He also had a 41-yard kickoff return after USA fell behind 24-0 in the second quarter, and he added a career-best 148 yards on just nine carries — highlighted by a 61-yard run in the final period for the final margin of victory — to post a school game-record 289 all-purpose yards. In addition to becoming the first individual in school history to ever surpass 200 all-purpose yards in a game, Johnson's 141 kick return yards were the second-highest total in program history. ... Blake Dees set a school game record with 20 total tackles — the most recorded in the Sun Belt this season — and forced a fumble that was returned for a touchdown to help the Jaguars earn a 52-45 victory over Idaho. With USA trailing by 10 points in the third quarter, the senior had both a solo and an unassisted stop to force two Vandal punts, then he stripped the ball on second down at the USA-42 for a fumble that was returned for a touchdown to cut the Jag deficit to three. It was the first time this fall that Dees has been credited with a double-figure tackle total, while it marked the fourth contest that the linebacker has paced the Jaguars in the category.

Bobcat News and Notes

Texas State looks to improve its record to 3-2 this Saturday when the Bobcats host Georgia State. The Bobcats opened a three-game home stand with a 31-21 loss against New Mexico State to fall to 2-2 in home games this season.

Quarterback Tyler Jones ran for two touchdowns and has rushed for a career-best eight touchdowns this season. His eight touchdown runs are the most by a Bobcat quarterback since Barrick Neely rushed for 13 TDs in 2005.

Senior running back Robert Lowe led the Bobcats in rushing for the third straight game after running for 88 yards on 22 carries against New Mexico State. Lowe has run for 427 yards and three touchdowns on 72 carries in the last three games.

Lowe enters the Georgia State game ranked among the top four rushing leaders in Sun Belt Conference games with an average of 118.5 yards in Texas State four league games. He also is seventh in the league's scoring leaders with five touchdowns (three rushing, two receiving) in Texas State's four league games.

Lowe ranks sixth among Texas State's career rushing leaders with 2,829 yards on 487 carries during his career. He needs to gain 80 more yards to move among Texas State's top five career rushing leaders.

C. J. Best led Texas State's receivers with six catches for 74 yards against New Mexico State. His 74 yards equal his season-best effort. He enters the Georgia State game ranked among the top nine Sun Belt Conference receiving leaders with 34 catches for 328 yards.

Lumi Kaba averaged 49.8 yards on five punts against New Mexico State. He had three 50-yard punts, including the second-longest of his career (66 yards). He also placed three punts inside the 20 and had one punt result in a touchback against the Aggies.

Kaba enters the Georgia State game leading the Sun Belt in conference games only after averaging 46.8 yards on 24 punts in Texas State's four Sun Belt games. He has 10 punts land inside the 20-yard line and eleven 50-yard punts. Overall, Kaba ranks second among league leaders with an average of 44.5 yards on 42 punts. He is tied for second among league leaders with thirteen 50-yard punts this season.

Junior safety Damani Alexcee is second among Sun Belt Conference leaders with 47 solo tackles after collecting a career and game-high 12 solo and total tackles against New Mexico State. He also ranks sixth among Sun Belt leaders and leads Texas State with 65 overall tackles this season.

Troy scored 27 points in the first quarter. It is the most points scored in the first quarter since 2000 when Troy scored 31 first quarter points in a 62-19 victory over Alabama State. ... Troy has scored 144 points in the past three games, the most points in a three-game stretch in Troy's FBS era, and the most since scoring 157 in 1993 (63 vs Alcorn State, 52 at Samford, 42 vs. Stephen F. Austin) ... Sophomore John Johnson caught a 26-yard pass, his season-long, on the first offensive play for Troy ... Senior Bryan Holmes caught a 43-yard touchdown pass in the first quarter. That reception was his longest of the season ... With his touchdown, Bryan Holmes moved into a tie for seventh in career receiving touchdowns with 15 ... Bryan Holmes has had a touchdown reception against ULM in each of the past three years ... Sophomore quarterback Brandon Silvers connected with Brandon Burks for a 75-yard touchdown in the first quarter, the longest touchdown pass of the season for Troy ... The touchdown pass to Burks in the second quarter was the longest TD pass of Silvers' career. It was also Burks' first touchdown reception of the season, second of his career, and longest of his career ... Silvers surpassed 300 yards passing in today's game, the first 300-yard passing game for a quarterback since Corey Robinson did so in 2013 against ULM ... Senior wide receiver Trey Page had two catches, his first receptions of the season ... Four of ULM's first six plays ended in tackles for loss for the Trojans ... The Trojans forced six turnovers, the most since forcing seven against Alcorn State in 2008. It was the most against an FBS team since forcing seven against Idaho in 2004 ... Senior defensive end Tyler Roberts was credited with three tackles for loss; he now ranks fourth in Troy history with 34.0 tackles for loss ... Troy scored two defensive touchdowns for the first time since Middle Tennessee in 2004 ...
