Sun Belt's Top Teams Continue Winning Ways

The top three teams in the Sun Belt standings - Arkansas State, Appalachian State, and Georgia Southern - all cruised to conference victories this past Saturday. Meanwhile, South Alabama's win over UL Lafayette last Thursday put the Jaguars in a tie with the Cajuns for fourth place.

The upcoming week features the final Sun Belt primetime Thursday night game on ESPNU as UL Monroe faces Texas State in San Marcos. Then on Saturday, two conference games are on tap along with two games against SEC foes.

A-State and App State will enjoy off weeks while Georgia Southern will travel to play Georgia in Athens for a 6 p.m. [CT] ESPNU affair. Georgia Southern and Georgia's football programs are forever tied together by one man: Erk Russell. Russell was the defensive coordinator for the Bulldogs for 17 years (1964-1981) and left to resurrect the Georgia Southern program, becoming the Eagles' head football coach (1982-

1989).

South Alabama returns to the road after two weeks at home when the Jaguars travel to face Georgia State in Atlanta. The Jags and Panthers have met on four occasions previously - but only twice as Sun Belt members. USA has won both Sun Belt contests and holds a 3-1 overall advantage in the series.

Idaho also faces a SEC opponent this week when they matchup against Auburn. As a program this will be the sixth consecutive year that Auburn has faced an opponent from the Sun Belt. The game will be televised on the SEC Network and kickoff is slated for 3 p.m. [CT].

UL Lafayette will host New Mexico State on Saturday in a game that will air as part of the Sun Belt Network on ESPN3 package. The game will mark the 10th meeting between the schools with the Ragin' Cajuns holding a 6-3 lead. UL Lafayette has won the last two meetings in the series, including last year's 44-16 victory.

Sun Belt Student-Athlete Experience

The advantages of competing in college sports in the Sun Belt Conference are both immediate and lifelong. Sun Belt student-athletes are provided with unique opportunities to learn, compete and succeed. Sun Belt student-athletes have access to career services counselors assisting with writing resumes and identifying internships and summer jobs, career workshops, preparation for interviews/mock interviews, and etiquette classes. Sun Belt members have on average over 20 tutors for academic support and employ full-time academic advisors. During the 2014-15 academic year, Sun Belt member institutions awarded \$48,393,375.06 in scholarships to over 3,084 student-athletes. Sun Belt student-athletes have life experiences such as team building, domestic and foreign travel, community service, mentoring, and recognition through honors and awards.

Offensive Student-Athlete of the Week (Nov. 16)

Nick Arbuckle (Georgia State, Sr., QB, History)

Nick Arbuckle shattered the Georgia State passing record by throwing for 471 yards and four touchdowns to lead the Panthers to a 41-19 victory at Texas State. Arbuckle's performance led the Panthers to a GSU-record 643 yards of total offense and helped the Panthers top 40 points for the first time under head coach Trent Miles. Arbuckle needed just 23 completions on 34 attempts for his 471 yards as he had 10 completions of 20 yards or more to five different receivers. He got the air attack started immediately, hitting Robert Davis for a 44-yard completion on the Panthers' first play of the game and then connecting with Davis for a 34-yard touchdown three plays later. He also threw a pair of touchdowns to Donovan Harden, covering eight and four yards, and then a 17-yard scoring pass to Penny Hart to tie his own GSU record for touchdown passes. The Camarillo, Calif., native also had a 25-yard run for a first down, giving him a school-record 496 yards of total offense in the game.



Defensive Student-Athlete of the Week (Nov. 16)

Chandon Sullivan (Georgia State, So., DB, Journalism)

Sophomore cornerback Chandon Sullivan collected six tackles, an interception and two pass breakups to lead the Georgia State defense in a 41-19 victory at Texas State. GSU's starting defense held Texas State to one touchdown and two long field goals before the Bobcats added a late touchdown against the Panther reserves with just three seconds left in the game. Even with the late score, Georgia State equaled its low for points allowed under head coach Trent Miles. Sullivan's interception at the GSU 28-yard line came in the decisive second quarter in which the Panthers turned a 14-6 lead into a 31-12 halftime advantage, GSU held the Bobcats to 71 total yards and 0-for-3 on third downs. Sullivan and the GSU secondary allowed only three completions longer than 15 yards and none longer than 29 yards. For the season, Sullivan has 38 tackles with three tackles for loss and two sacks, two interceptions and five pass breakups. He was recently named to the Capital One Academic All-District team with a 3.7 GPA.



Special Teams Student-Athlete of the Week (Nov. 16)

Jeremy Reaves (South Alabama, So., DB, Leisure Studies)

Reaves blocked an extra-point attempt and intercepted a two-point conversion to help USA pick up a win Thursday over UL Lafayette, adding a tackle as part of the Jaguars' kickoff coverage unit. After the Ragin' Cajuns scored the first points of the game, Reaves blocked the point-after-touchdown try to keep the margin at six points, and following an interception return for touchdown his stop of UL Lafayette's two-point attempt left the Jags facing only a one-point deficit midway through the final period. Reaves also finished with nine total stops, as his efforts defensively helped USA limit the Cajuns to only 43 yards rushing and 313 total.

2015 SUN BELT NEWS AND NOTES

Sun Belt Membership

The Sun Belt Conference consists of 13 total institutions – two (Idaho and New Mexico State) are football only members and two (Little Rock and UT Arlington) are non-football members. Coastal Carolina accepted an invitation the Sun Belt on September 1 and will begin competing in all sports, with the exception of football, beginning with the 2016-17 season. The Chanticleer football program will begin a transition to the Football Bowl Subdivision with its first year of full FBS status coming in 2018.

Coastal Carolina to Join Sun Belt Conference

On September 1, Coastal Carolina University accepted an invitation to join the Sun Belt Conference and will begin competing in all sports, with the exception of football, beginning with the 2016-17 season. The Chanticleer football program will begin a transition to the Football Bowl Subdivision with its first year of full FBS status coming in 2018. During the transition, the Chanticleers will compete as a Sun Belt member in 2017 and have the opportunity to compete for the conference football championship, but they will not be eligible to participate in the postseason.

Arkansas State's Knighten Named Candidate for Senior Class Award

Arkansas State senior quarterback Fredi Knighten was one of 30 FBS student-athletes to be selected as a candidate for the 2015 Senior CLASS Award recently. The honor recognizes student-athletes, who excel both on and off the field of competition. In the community, Knighten has assisted with many service efforts. He helped with a tornado relief fund drive by assisting in the recovery process for the geographic regions hit by several tornadoes in the state and region. He has helped with the Life Champs program, which is a football camp held in his hometown of Little Rock, Ark., that helps kids with football and life lessons.

40 NFL Players from Sun Belt Conference Institutions on 2015 Rosters

The Sun Belt Conference has 40 players in the NFL representing its 11 football-playing member institutions for the 2015 season. The conference is represented on 23 of the 32 NFL teams. Appalachian State tops the list of active NFL players with seven, while Arkansas State and Troy have six each.

Sun Belt Conference Part of NOVA Home Loans Arizona Bowl

The Arizona Sports and Entertainment Commission recently announced the creation of the NOVA Home Loans Arizona Bowl. The bowl game will debut on Dec. 29, 2015 and will match two teams from the Mountain West Conference, Conference USA and the Sun Belt Conference. The game will be played at the University of Arizona's stadium in Tucson, Ariz. The NOVA Home Loans Arizona Bowl is the first-ever bowl game to have a digitally-focused broadcast strategy to be orchestrated by primary digital media partner Campus Insiders. Details and technology partnerships along with the television broadcast partner will be announced at a later date.

Mountaineer News and Notes

Appalachian State moved to 8-2 overall record and 5-1 in Sun Belt Conference play with Saturday's 47-20 victory at Idaho.

The Mountaineers' win at Idaho was their seventh in their last eight games, 14th in 16 games dating back to the midpoint of last season, their 11th in their last 12 Sun Belt games and their seventh in their last eight road games.

Appalachian State's 8-2 overall record is tied for the best 10-game start in Sun Belt history.

Saturday's win at Idaho was Appalachian State's first in seven all-time games played west of the Central time zone.

Appalachian State is one of only three teams that rank among the nation's top 20 in both scoring defense (88th - 18.5 ppg) and total offense (18th - 38.4 ppg) - Clemson and Navy are the others;

The Mountaineers are also one of only four teams that ranks among the nation's top 25 in both total defense (19th - 320.5 ypg) and total offense (24th - 478.2 ypg) - Clemson, Oklahoma and Boise State are the others;

For the fourth-straight week, Appalachian State is receiving votes in at least one of college football's two major polls. The Mountaineers pulled in two points in this week's Amway Coaches poll, good for a tie for 12th in the "others receiving votes" listing (tied for 37th overall).

A-State is receiving votes (2) in the top-25 coaches poll for the first time since the second week of the 2013 season . . . The Red Wolves have an open week following their 59-21 victory over ULM, which secured them a winning overall record for the fifth consecutive year for the first time since 1949-53 . . . A-State has won six straight games for the first time since the 2012 season. It's six-game winning streak is tied for the ninth longest in the nation . . . The Red Wolves hold a 7-3 or better overall record through 10 games for the time since the 2012 season and third time ever as an FBS member . . . A-State improved its conference record to 6-0 for the first time since the 2011 season when it went undefeated in Sun Belt play . . . A-State holds a 15-3 record in the month of November dating back to the 2011 campaign . . . A-State has won 31 of its last 37 Sun Belt Conference games . . . A-State holds an overall record over the last five seasons of 42-20 . . . Arkansas State has won 15 of its last 18 conference road games dating back to the 2011 season . . . All seven Arkansas State victories this season have come by at least 10 points and the Red Wolves average margin of victory in its six Sun Belt wins is 17.8 points . . . A-State has gone over 300 yards total offense 66 times over its last 74 games. Eagle News and Notes

Georgia Southern and the University of Georgia have met five times on the gridiron with the Bulldogs holding a 5-0 lead in the series that dates back to 1992. All five games in the series have been played in Athens with Georgia taking wins in 1992 (34-7), 2000 (29-7), 2004 (48-28), 2008 (45-21) and 2012 (45-14).

The Georgia Southern and Georgia football programs are forever tied together by one man: Erk Russell. Russell was the defensive coordinator for the Bulldogs for 17 years (1964-1981) and left to resurrect the Georgia Southern program, becoming the Eagles' head football coach (1982-1989). As the first head coach of Georgia Southern's football team after a 40-year dormancy, Russell established a standard of excellence during his tenure, winning three NCAA Division I-AA championships. He went 83-22-1 in his eight years as the head coach of the Eagles. Russell died in Statesboro, Georgia, on Sept. 8, 2006 following a stroke at age 80.

Saturday will be a reunion of sorts for the Theus family as three brothers play for the two squads taking the field. For the Bulldogs, it'll be left tackle John Theus and long snapper Nathan Theus. For the Eagles, it'll be freshman Jeremiah Theus. John, a senior starter, was all-conference last season while Nathan, a redshirt senior, has been the primary long snapper for the Bulldogs the past three seasons. Jeremiah is a true freshman for the Eagles. He played in one game this year and will seek a medical hardship waiver after injuring his shoulder and having surgery.

Georgia Southern has held its own against current "Power 5" schools in recent history. Last year, the Eagles led ACC opponents Georgia Tech and NC State late on the road, but fell 42-38 and 24-23, respectively. The program's biggest moment against a "Power 5" school came in 2013 when the Eagles beat SEC power Florida 26-20 in The Swamp.

Georgia Southern head coach Willie Fritz uses analytics in game to help guide a lot of his decisions, including fourth down. Those analytics have been paying off recently as the Eagles have converted 11 straight fourth-down conversions dating back to the ULM game on Oct. 3. The Eagles are 16 of 24 on the season and the 24 attempts ranks among the top five in the country.

Panther News and Notes

Senior quarterback Nick Arbuckle shattered the Georgia State passing record by throwing for 471 yards and four touchdowns to lead the Panthers to a 41-19 victory at Texas State. Arbuckle's performance led the Panthers to a Georgia State-record 643 yards of total offense and helped the Panthers top 40 points for the first time under head coach Trent Miles.

The GSU defense equaled its low for points allowed under Miles in holding Texas State to 19 points, which included a touchdown with just three seconds left in the game against the Panther backups.

Arbuckle leads the Sun Belt and ranks fifth in FBS in passing yards (348.3 pg). He is also first in the league in total offense (341.3 pg) and second in pass efficiency (154.8) and touchdowns (20). He needs just 149 yards passing to break the GSU season record of 3,283 yards that he set last season.

In 21 games in a Georgia State uniform, Arbuckle is averaging 305.6 yards passing per game. That ranks third among all active FBS quarterbacks, trailing only Washington State's Luke Falk and Cal's Jared Goff.

Freshman Penny Hart, who had six catches for 113 yards and a touchdown vs. Texas State, is the leading receiver in the Sun Belt, averaging 5.8 receptions and 94.6 yards per game. Among all FBS freshmen, Hart ranks second in receiving yards, third in receptions and sixth in touchdowns.

Junior Robert Davis had five receptions for a career-high 177 yards vs. Texas State, including a 34-yard touchdown catch. Davis came within nine yards of the GSU single-game record for receiving yards. Davis has caught a pass in every game he has played (33 straight) and has 2,220 career receiving yards, third among active Sun Belt receivers and 25th among all active FBS players. Davis is one of two 2,000-yard receivers for the Panthers. Donovan Harden had five catches for 58 yards and two touchdowns vs. Texas State and now has 2,004 receiving yards on 133 receptions with 18 touchdowns (including two seasons at Illinois State).

The Panthers also rushed for 172 yards, the second-highest total of the season that was bolstered by the return of Taz Bateman and Kyler Neal. Bateman, who missed six games with a broken arm, led the team with 51 yards on eight carries, including a 5-yard touchdown.

With his next tackle for loss, safety Tarris Batiste will become Georgia State's career leader. The senior has 19.5 career tackles for loss, just 0.5 behind record-holder Jarrell Robinson. Batiste is the Panthers' second-leading tackler with 72 tackles, 4.5 tackles for loss, one interception, five pass breakups and a forced fumble.

Vandal News and Notes

University of Idaho players – individually and collectively, still remain among the Sun Belt leaders in a number of statistical categories.

Individually, Vandals are among the top three in 14 rankings and as a team are among the top two in 12 categories – and they have reached some Idaho milestones along the way.

Junior kicker/punter Austin Rehkow became Idaho single-season record holder for field goals when he booted Nos. 19 and 20 against Appalachian State last Saturday. He broke Trey Farquhar's record of 19 set in 2012. He's just one-half of one percentage point off of Brian Decicio's all-time percentage record of .875 with his .870. His average of 2.0 per game is tops in the Sun Belt and second nationally, while his percentage is third in the league and 13th nationally. All that adds up to his being third in the conference and 29th in the NCAA in scoring with an average of 9.0 points per game.

Speaking of Rehkow, he continues to climb in the national punting statistics. He's fifth nationally with an average of 46.0, which leads the Sun Belt.

Senior running back Elijah Penny became the first Idaho back to rush for more than 1,000 yards since Deonte Jackson had 1,175 in 2007 when he hit 1,006 last Saturday. He's third in the Sun Belt and 26th nationally in total rushing yards, and fourth in the league and 32nd nationally in average per game. Penny also has the Sun Belt's third best (24th nationally) all-purpose average of 137.1 yards per game.

Sophomore quarterback Matt Linehan has made his mark in a number of categories. He's the Sun Belt leader in completion percentage (.638, 33rd nationally); Second in completions per game (23.33, 16th nationally); Second in total offense per game (296.0, 23rd nationally); Second in passing yards per game (247.1, 21st nationally); Second in total passing yards (2,471, 29th nationally), and Third in pass efficiency (134.9, 57th nationally).

Linehan's total offense tally (2,664) is the most since Nathan Enderle had 3,117 yards in 2010.

Defensively, senior end Quinton Bradley continued to be among the league's leaders in tackles for loss and sacks per game. He's third in the conference in each category, which translates to 36th in tackles for loss per game (1.3) and 49th in sacks per game (0.6) in the national numbers.

Ragin' Cajun News and Notes

The Louisiana Ragin' Cajuns football team will return to the friendly confines of Cajun Field after a two-game, five-day roadtrip on Saturday (Nov. 21) when it plays host to New Mexico State in a Sun Belt Conference game. Kickoff is slated for 4 p.m. and will be televised on ESPN3.

UL Lafayette (4-5, 3-2 SBC), which last played at home on Oct. 31 against ULM, rallied to edge Georgia State in Atlanta on Nov. 7, 23-21, before falling at South Alabama, 32-25, in a nationally-televised game on Nov. 12.

Senior receiver Jamal Robinson set career-highs in both receptions (10) and receiving yards (188) for the Ragin' Cajuns against South Alabama. The Slidell, La., native caught a 45-yard TD pass from Brooks Haack in the fourth quarter, the 19th of his career and tying him with Fred Stamps (2000-03) for fourth-place on the school's all-time list. Robinson, who now has 2,387 yards receiving in his career, recorded his ninth 100-yard receiving game as a Ragin' Cajun and moved past Ladarius Green (2,201) and Donald Richard (2,326) into third-place on the school's all-time list.

Australian punter Steven Coutts has continued his impressive freshman campaign for the Ragin' Cajuns, ranking 29th among all FBS punters and third among freshmen. Coutts has averaged 43.7 yards per attempt for UL Lafayette this season.

Savion Brown's 85-yard interception return for a touchdown against South Alabama was the fifth-longest in school history and the first by a Ragin' Cajun since Corey Trim's 82-yard return against Tulane in the 2013 R+L Carriers New Orleans Bowl.

Redshirt freshman Taboris Lee shattered career-highs in both tackles (10) and tackles for loss (3.0) in the Ragin' Cajuns game at South Alabama. The nose tackle entered the game with 11 tackles (5 solo) and one tackle for loss on the season.

The game against New Mexico State (2-7, 2-3 SBC) will mark the 10th meeting between the schools with the Ragin' Cajuns holding a 6-3 lead. UL Lafayette has won the last two meetings in the series, including last year's 44-16 victory which was the first-ever for the Ragin' Cajuns in Las Cruces.

ULM is seeking revenge after Texas State won 22-18 in Monroe last year, scoring 15 points in the fourth quarter to win 22-18. ULM won in San Marcos the previous season in the first meeting between the schools since 2000.

The ESPNU broadcast comes after ULM had two on the channel last year (Thursday night win over Wake Forest, game at LSU).

Saturday's game marked the first time ULM played a home game that had an afternoon kick time since the 2012 season (North Texas, Nov. 17, 2012, 3 p.m.).

Aaron Townsend recovered his first career fumble as he jumped on top of a Chris Qualls' punt that hit Arkansas State's Brandon Byner early in the first quarter.

Chris Qualls faked a punt and picked up a first down thanks to a first down rush midway through the first quarter. It was his second fake punt of the season and the second successful attempt (five yard pass to Harley Scioneaux for a first down in the second quarter at Alabama, Sept. 26).

Ben Banogu recorded his fourth sack of the season as he brought down Red Wolves' quarterback Fredi Knighten for a 10-yard loss late in the first quarter.

Michael Johnson picked up his second sack of the season as he brought down Fredi Knighten for a 16-yard loss early in the second quarter.

Marcus Green hauled in his fifth touchdown of the season as Earnest Carrington found him for a 39-yard touchdown pass in the second quarter. Green has now recorded a touchdown in five consecutive games.

Aggie News and Notes

After its second and final bye week of the season on Nov. 14, the NM State football team returns to action on Nov. 21 as they travel to UL Lafayette to take on the Ragin' Cajuns.

Prior to the week off, the Aggies collected back-to-back wins, the second being a 31-21 win over Texas State on the road. NM State jumped out to an early lead against the Bobcats as Larry Rose III scored his first touchdown of the night on a 22-yard rush up the right sideline. Parker Davidson extended the lead with a 27-yard field goal in the second quarter. Texas State took their first lead of the game as they garnered two touchdowns before halftime, but Clayton Granch caught scored his first touchdown as an Aggie to give the visiting team the lead again. Rose III scored twice in the fourth quarter to give NM State the win.

Rose III led the offensive attack with 207 rushing yards, three touchdowns and a game-high 292 all-purpose yards. The sophomore carried the ball 31 times and lost just five rushing yards on the night. This is his third 200-yard rushing game this season and his second in a row. Rose III now has 1,290 rushing yards this season to lead the Sun Belt in that category. These rushing yards also rank fourth in the NM State record books for rushing yards in a single season. With three games left in the season, the Fairfield, Texas native has already surpassed his 1,102 rushing yards from the 2014 season. After his two rushing touchdowns, Rose III now has 21 career rushing touchdowns to rank seventh all-time in the Aggie record books.

Nick Jeanty was 24-of-45 for 297 yards, two touchdowns and zero interceptions. With Jeanty guiding the Aggies, the team converted 13-of-23 third downs and 2-of-3 fourth downs. The team was also 3-for-3 in the red zone.

Jacob Nwangwa led NM State's defensive efforts as he amassed 10 tackles. Nwangwa grabbed two interceptions on the final two Bobcat drives of the game to secure the victory for the Aggies. With Texas State in the red zone, Nwangwa stepped in front of a Tyler Jones pass and collected his second interception of the season with 3:36 left in the game to prevent the Bobcats from cutting into the lead. On the final drive of the game, the sophomore again stepped in front of a pass to ensure NM State would win.

Nwangwa is second on the team in tackles with 61. He is tied for a team-high three interceptions and has 1.0 tackles for loss and one fumble recovery.

Jaguar News and Notes

The Jaguars close out the month with back-to-back trips to the Peach State, their final two Sun Belt Conference road contests of the campaign...This will be the fifth meeting between the Jags and Georgia State, the most USA has faced an opponent...The teams have split two games at the Georgia Dome, with USA winning the last match-up on the Panthers' home field in its final road game of the 2013 season...It will mark the second time this fall that the Jaguars will play at a National Football League venue after earning a 34-27 overtime victory over San Diego State at Qualcomm Stadium Sept. 19. ... The Jag roster includes 10 individuals from Georgia, including seven — Bull Barge (Moultrie), Antonio Carter (Columbus), Gerald Everett (Lithonia), Noah Fisher (Decatur), Brandon McKee (Cumming), T'Qwan Robinson (Marietta) and Joseph Scelfo (Bogart) — expected to contribute on Saturday. ... Xavier Johnson recorded back-to-back 100-yard rushing games for the first time in his career after posting a game-high 118 yards and two touchdowns on 23 carries to help lead the Jaguars to a victory over Louisiana-Lafayette on Thursday. The sophomore gave USA its first lead midway through the opening quarter with a nine-yard touchdown run, and when he reached the end zone from 16 yards out with three-and-a-half minutes remaining in the contest he provided to be the game-winning score. It was the second time this fall that he has rushed for two touchdowns and the first in which he has scored on the ground in consecutive outings, while Johnson finished with 184 all-purpose yards after adding 66 on three kick returns. ... DB Jeremy Reaves led a Jaguar defense that surrendered just 43 yards on the ground and 313 overall in a seven-point defeat of Louisiana-Lafayette Thursday, posting nine tackles — including one for loss — a forced fumble, two passes broken up and a blocked kick. In finishing one stop shy of equaling his career high the sophomore paced the unit in the category for the first time this fall in Sun Belt Conference action, while he set a new career high in passes defended. Reaves also blocked the Ragin' Cajuns' first extra-point attempt, and he also intercepted a two-point conversion attempt in the end zone to keep the Jag's deficit at just one point after UL Lafayette had regained the lead with eight-and-a-half minutes remaining in regulation. ... Senior QB Cody Clements guided an offense that has posted 400 or more yards in three straight outings after collecting 495 — the Jaguars' highest output in conference play this fall — with career highs of 281 yards passing and 299 all-purpose yards. In addition to completing 17-of-28 attempts, his highest percentage of the year, Clements caught a pass for a seven-yard touchdown in the opening minutes of the final period that extended the USA advantage to 11 points with less than 13 minutes to go. After throwing for 200-plus yards in five of the first six games this season, it marked the first time that he has surpassed 200 yards through the air since the Jags faced Arkansas State on Oct. 13.

The Texas State football team plays its final home game of the 2015 season on Thursday night when the Bobcats host UL Monroe in a Sun Belt Conference game that is nationally-televised on ESPNU.

Texas State enters the ULM game looking to improve its home record to 3-3 this season. The Bobcats have an all-time record of 119-86 in Bobcat Stadium.

Texas State will recognize 27 senior members of this season's team before Thursday night's game as they will be playing their final game in Bobcat Stadium. They are: Adrian Bellard, C. J. Best, Tyler Blades, Ryan Carden, Danta Clanton, Zach Crawford, Marcus Dallas, Mershad Dillon, Dondre Elvoid, Jafus Gaines, Ryan Garrey, Tim Gay, Herbert Gonzales, Stephan Jacobs, Jerrid Jeter-Gilmon, Robert Lowe, Trey McGowan, David Mims II, Rusmin Nikocecic, Chris Nutall, Jack Rhoades, Brandon Sarabia, Aaron Shaw, Brandon Smith, Blaire Sullivan, Lawrence White and Demetrius Woodard.

Texas State ranks among the nation's top 42 rushing teams and is fourth in the Sun Belt Conference with an overall average of 193.9 yards per game.

Robert Lowe ranks fifth among the Sun Belt Conference overall rushing leaders after averaging 89.4 yards in Texas State's first eight games.

In Sun Belt Conference games only, Lowe is fourth among the league's rushing leaders with an average of 112.4 yards in five Sun Belt games.

Lowe also is fifth among the Sun Belt Conference scoring leaders and 10th in the overall scoring leaders with an average of 6.9 points per game after scoring two touchdowns against Georgia State.

Tyler Jones ranks 32nd nationally and third among Sun Belt Conference leaders in total offense with an average of 269.9 yards per game after rushing for 529 yards and throwing for 1,900 yards.

Tyler Jones enters the ULM game having thrown for 5,700 yards in his career. This season, he has completed 174 of 297 passes for 1,900 yards, 10 touchdowns and eight interceptions.

Damani Alexcee is second among Sun Belt Conference leaders with 52 solo tackles after recording five solo stops against Georgia State and equaling his career best with a game-high 12 solo tackles against New Mexico State. He also ranks eighth among Sun Belt leaders and leads Texas State with 70 overall tackles this season.

Lumi Kaba ranks eighth nationally and is second among league leaders after averaging 45.2 yards on 47 punts this season after averaging 51.2 yards on five punts against Georgia State. He also kicked a 50-yard field goal and a 48-yard field goal against Georgia State.
