ULM Notes

- ULM swept the season series against UL-Lafayette last season and has also won the last two meetings at home. The Warhawks have won three of the last four total in the series dating back to 2013-14

- The 67-55 victory for ULM over ULL at home last year was the 400th win in Fant-Ewing Coliseum history. Senior Majok Deng scored 16 points and senior Justin Roberson netted 14 points. ULM held ULL to 55 points in both meetings last season

- The Warhawks are 18-16 all-time against the Cajuns at home. In 2013-14, ULM knocked off a ULL team (103-98, 2OT) that advanced to the NCAA Tournament

- The Ragin' Cajuns were picked to win the league in the Sun Belt Conference Preseason Poll while ULM was tabbed for third

- ULM is coming off a 64-54 victory over Chattanooga on Monday. The Mocs won at Georgia and vs. Illinois before traveling to ULM. UTC is ranked No. 8 in the latest CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top-25 poll and received a first-place vote

- The Warhawks have been strong inside this season and have outscored all five of their opponents in the paint. On the year, ULM has outscored the opposition 144-62 in the paint

- ULM has held opponents to under 75 points in 48 of the last 49 games. It held a streak of 47 consecutive games which was the second longest in the country. It was snapped at Houston on a jumper with nine seconds left

- The Warhawks are 406-173 all-time in Fant-Ewing Coliseum and went 14-4 at home last season. They are 2-0 at home this year

- ULM leads the Sun Belt Conference in three-point percentage defense (.284) and ranks top-45 in the country. The Warhawks are also 23rd in the nation in scoring defense (60.8 ppg) and second in the league

ULM Player Notes...

- Deng leads the team with 16.0 points per game and is tied for the team lead with 7.2 rebounds per outing. Deng earned All-Conference Third-Team honors last year and returned as the team's leading scorer, rebounder and shot blocker. He's one of four returning starters and one of five seniors on the roster

- Also averaging in double-figures, freshman Travis Munnings scores 12.2 points per game and pulls down 7.2 rebounds per contest. Munnings ranks 44th in the country in field goal percentage at a .609 clip

- Ranking 29th in the nation and also leading the league, Roberson has gotten his hands on 12 steals through five games (2.4 spg). He posted a career-high five at Northwestern State which followed up on his four steals at Minnesota

- Coppola is coming off his 25th career 40-minute game against UTC and scored 14 points. He ranks second all-time in program history in career minutes per game. He played 1,384 minutes last year, third most in the nation and also third in single-season program history. Additionally, Coppola finished second in the SBC last season in both assist:turnover ratio (2.0) and assists (3.7 apg). He's started every game of his career

- Senior DeMondre Harvey has been extremely efficient for the Warhawks off the bench as he's hit 13-19 (.684) field goals this season. He's also 16-20 (.800) from the free throw line, a big improvement compared to his 23-43 (.535) last season

ULM Notes Continued...

- ULM is one of three teams in the SBC ranked top-75 in the NCAA RPI rankings (as of Dec. 1). Little Rock is 11, UTA 57 and ULM 71

- Keith Richard picked up his 200th career victory as a head coach in an 80-64 victory over Northwestern State on Nov. 19. Both Deng and Munnings recorded double-doubles in the contest

- Two of ULM's three wins this season have been wire-to-wire victories where the Warhawks never trailed in games against McMurry and Northwestern State

- At Minnesota, ULM trailed by 13 at half before coming back to take the lead, 51-50 with 6:44 remaining

- ULM opened the season with an 88-43 victory over McMurry. The 45-point margin of victory was ULM's largest in school history in a season opener. The Warhawks improved to 47-18 all-time in home openers

- Keith Richard is the reigning Sun Belt Conference and Louisiana Coach of the Year winner. It comes after a 24-win season, the third-most in school history and also the third biggest turnaround in the country from the year before. It was ULM's first 20-win season since 2001-02. Richard has more-than doubled ULM's win totals in back-to-back years

- The Warhawks made a run to the CBI championship series last year for their 10th postseason appearance in school history and the first since 1995-96. They played their first-ever game in the month of April in their 64-year history. They were also the first team from the SBC to ever play a game in April

- ULM picked up a pair of preseason honors as Deng was named to the 2015-16 All-Conference Second-Team, while junior Nick Coppola earned recognition on the Third-Team. Deng was also named to the College Sports Madness Preseason All-SBC First-Team while Coppola was Third-Team (page 10)

- The Warhawks were picked to finished third in the SBC Preseason Poll. It comes after they finished in a tie for second-place in the SBC standings last season. In 2013-14, ULM was picked to finish dead last preseason

- ULM enters its second season without any APR penalties which Richard inherited when he took over at the helm. Richard has turned the program around athletically and academically as the Warhawks have won back-to-back-to-back Sun Belt Conference academic awards

Scouting UL-Lafayette

The Ragin' Cajuns (2-2) average 96.0 points per game after four games this season. They hold wins over Louisiana College (108-68) and Loyola-New Orleans (106-62), and fell at Miami (93-77) and at Alabama (105-93).

SBC Preseason Player of the Year Shawn Long averages a double-double with 21.3 points and 12.0 rebounds per outing. He was named to the All-Conference First-Team last season. Kasey Shepherd averages 12.3 points per game, Jay Wright 11.0 and Devonta Walker 10.0. The Cajuns rank first in the league in field goal percentage, shooting at a .513 mark.

Bob Marlin is in his sixth season as head coach of the Cajuns and 23rd season in his career. He coached ULL to the 2014 NCAA Tournament after winning the SBC Championships as the No. 3 seed. Marlin spent 12 seasons at Sam Houston State where he was named Southland Conference Coach of the Decade (2000-10). He was the winningest coach in SHSU history with a 225-131 record. Previously, Marlin boasted a 123-35 record in five seasons at Pensacola Junior College. He began his coaching career at ULM where he was a graduate assistant under legendary coach Mike Vining from 1981-83.
