Continental Tire Las Vegas Classic

ULM Notes

- Saturday marks the first-ever meeting between ULM and Penn State. It's the second of four games for the Warhawks in the Continental Tire Las Vegas Classic. The last two will be played in Las Vegas, Nev., on Dec. 22-23 against Canisius and either Hampton or Nicholls State
- ULM will look to defeat a school from a Power-Five conference for the first time since Nov. 30, 2007 when the Warhawks won at Iowa, 72-67 (OT)
- Senior Majok Deng was named National Mid-Major Player of the Week on Monday, selected by College Sports Madness. It came after he posted 22 points vs. Chattanooga and a career-high 30 points vs. UL-Lafayette, both resulting in ULM victories. Deng missed the last game at Kent State due to a lower leg injury and is out indefinitely for precautionary reasons
- ULM is 16-33 (.485) from three-point range in its last two games. In the four games prior, it shot a combined 10-58 (.172) from beyond-the-arc
- -The Warhawks lead the SBC and rank 22nd in the nation in three-point field goal percentage defense (.275). They held UL-Lafayette to a .111 (2-18) clip to open Sun Belt Conference play
- ULM has held opponents to under 75 points in 50 of the last 51 games. It held a streak of 47 consecutive games which was the second longest in the country. It was snapped at Houston on a jumper with nine seconds left
- The Warhawks fell 73-62 in their last outing against Kent State on Thursday. ULM led 35-33 at the intermission before the Golden Flashes came back with a big second half. ULM was without Deng
- ULM is the first team receiving votes in the latest College Insider Mid-Major Top-25 poll (page 7)
- -The Warhawks have been strong inside this season and have outscored the opposition 192-126 in the paint

- The Warhawks knocked off Sun Belt Conference preseason favorite UL-Lafayette, 81-70 last week. ULM shot 9-15 from beyond-the-arc the .600 percentage was the highest by an SBC team in a single game this season. The Warhawks never trailed in the contest. It was ULM's third consecutive win over the Ragin' Cajuns as they swept the season series last year
- ULM holds back-to-back wins over teams selected to win their leagues in the preseason polls as it also defeated Chattanooga, 64-54 last week. The

Mocs were picked to win the Southern Conference and were ranked No. 8 in the CollegeInsider Mid-Major Top-25 poll at the time of the game

- Deng leads the team with 18.3 points, 7.3 rebounds and 1.5 blocks per outing. He's coming off back-to-back career-high games. Deng earned All-Conference Third-Team honors last year and returned as the team's leading scorer, rebounder

and shot blocker. He's one of four returning starters and one of five seniors on the roster

- Junior Nick Coppola is coming off his fourth consecutive double-figure scoring game. Last week, he matched his career-high with 19 points against UL-Lafayette. In the game prior, he played his 25th career 40-minute game against UTC and scored 14 points. He ranks second all-time in program history in career minutes per game. He played 1,384 minutes last year, third most in the nation and also third in single-season program history. Additionally, Coppola finished second in the SBC last season in both assist:turnover ratio (2.0) and assists (3.7 apg). He's started every game of his career

- Seniors Jamaal Samuel is coming off a big 18-point game against Kent State which matched his career-high. He drained a career-high four three-pointers in the contest and also pulled down seven rebounds
- Senior DeMondre Harvey has been very efficient for the Warhawks off the bench as he's hit 17-28 (.607) field goals this season. He's also 18-22 (.818) from the free throw line, a big improvement compared to his 23-43 (.535) last season. He's led the team in field goal percentage in back-to-back years
- The Warhawks are 407-173 all-time in Fant-Ewing Coliseum and went 14-4 at home last season. They are 3-0 at home this year
- ULM never trailed in three out of its four wins this season (against McMurry, Northwestern State and UL-Lafayette)
- Keith Richard picked up his 200th career victory as a head coach in an 80-64 victory over Northwestern State on Nov. 19. Both Deng and Munnings recorded double-doubles in the contest
- At Minnesota, ULM trailed by 13 at half before coming back to take the lead, 51-50 with 6:44 remaining
- ULM opened the season with an 88-43 victory over McMurry. The 45-point margin of victory was ULM's largest in school history in a season opener. The Warhawks improved to 47-18 all-time in home openers
- Keith Richard is the reigning Sun Belt Conference and Louisiana Coach of the Year winner. It comes after a 24-win season, the third-most in school history and also the third biggest turnaround in the country from the year before. It was ULM's first 20-win season since 2001-02. Richard has more-than doubled ULM's win totals in back-to-back years
- The Warhawks made a run to the CBI championship series last year for their 10th postseason appearance in school history and the first since 1995-96. They played their first-ever game in the month of April in their 64-year history. They were also the first team from the SBC to ever play a game in April
- ULM picked up a pair of preseason honors as Deng was named to the 2015-16 All-Conference Second-Team, while junior Nick Coppola earned recognition on the Third-Team. Deng was also named to the College Sports Madness Preseason All-SBC First-Team while Coppola was Third-Team (page 10)
- The Warhawks were picked to finished third in the SBC Preseason Poll. It comes after they finished in a tie for second-place in the SBC standings last season. In 2013-14, ULM was picked to finish dead last preseason
- ULM enters its second season without any APR penalties which Richard inherited when he took over at the helm. Richard has turned the program around athletically and academically as the Warhawks have won back-to-back-to-back Sun Belt Conference academic awards

Penn State (6-3) defeated Canisius, 81-67 on Thursday in its first game of the Continental Tire Las Vegas Classic. It was PSU's first game at Rec Hall since 2013. The Nittany Lions also hold wins this season over VMI, DePaul, Bucknell,

Boston College and Eastern Michigan. Their only losses are to Duquesne, Radford and George Washington.

Brandon Taylor leads the team with 16.1 points and 6.3 rebounds per game. Shep Garner scores 15.8 points per outing and is 25-55 (.455) from three-point range. Payton Banks also averages in double-figures with 11.1 points per game.

Patrick Chambers was named head coach on June 6, 2011. He brought in a Top-30 recruiting class this season and has improved PSU's win total in each of the last three years. Last year he won 18 games which had been topped just four times since 2000. Chambers came to PSU from Boston University where he coached the Terries to the NCAA Tournament after winning the American East Conference Championship. He went 42-28 in two years at BU, winning at least 20 games each season.

Kent State Uses Big Second Half to Pull Away from Short-Handed Warhawks, 73-62

KENT, Ohio— Without leading scorer, rebounder and shot blocker Majok Deng, the ULM men's basketball program led 35-33 over Kent State at the intermission, but the Golden Flashes used a big second half to take a 73-62 result on Thursday at Memorial Athletic and Convocation Center.

Deng, who was named National Mid-Major Player of the Week on Monday by College Sports Madness, sustained a lower leg injury earlier in the week and will be out indefinitely for precautionary reasons.

Senior Jamaal Samuel matched a career-high with 18 points for ULM (4-3, 1-0 SBC) and also pulled down seven rebounds and swatted a trio of blocks. He drained four three-pointers in the contest. Junior Nick Coppola scored 15 points and dished out a game-high six assists. Senior DeMondre Harvey also aided the attack with 10 points.

Kellon Thomas and Xavier Pollard led Kent State (6-2) with 16 points apiece. Jaylin Walker pitched in with 11 points after going eight-for-eight from the free throw line. The Golden Flashes outscored the Warhawks, 40-27 in the second half.
