#### **ULM Notes**

- -Thursday's game features the top-two scorers in the SBC. Frank Eaves from APP and senior Majok Deng are the only two averaging at least 20 points per game
- ULM and APP met for the first time last year and split two meetings, both winning at home. The Warhawks won 69-58 in Monroe as Deng and senior Justin Roberson each had 13 points. ULM limited Eaves to 4 points (0-7 FG)
- The Warhawks will look to begin 2-0 SBC for the first time since 2006-07 when they started 3-0 and went on to become SBC West Co-Champions
- ULM has played the toughest schedule in the Sun Belt Conference to date, according to NCAA RPI Strength of Schedule rankings. ULM's strength schedule ranks 104th in the country, 41 spots ahead of the next highest team in the league, Georgia State (page 7)
- The Warhawks are 4-0 at home this season and 18-4 (.818) at home over the last two years. ULM is 408-173 all-time in Fant-Ewing Coliseum
- ULM has held SBC opponents to under 75 points in 29 straight games including postseason play. It limited UL-Lafayette to 70 points to begin conference action this year. ULM went 47 consecutive games overall without allowing a 75-point scoring team which was the second longest in the country. It was snapped at Houston on a jumper with nine seconds left
- The Warhawks knocked off Sun Belt Conference preseason favorite UL-Lafayette, 81-70 to begin league action. ULM shot 9-15 from beyond-the-arc; the .600 percentage was the highest by an SBC team in a single game this season. The Warhawks never trailed in the contest. It was ULM's third consecutive win over the Ragin' Cajuns as it swept the season series last year
- ULM holds back-to-back wins over teams selected to win their leagues in the preseason polls as it also defeated Chattanooga, 64-54. The Mocs were picked to win the Southern Conference and were ranked No. 8 in the CollegeInsider Mid-Major Top-25 poll at the time of the game

- Deng has scored at least 20 points in four of his last five outings. He ranks second in the league and 29th in the nation in scoring (20.0 ppg) and is second in the SBC in free throw percentage (.870). He has a pair of 30-plus scoring games and has won National Mid-Major Player of the Week (Dec. 7) and Louisiana Player of the Week (Dec. 21) this season
- -Three of ULM's non-conference losses came without Deng (at Kent State, Penn State and West Virginia). He sat out for precautionary reasons due to a lower leg injury
- Freshman Travis Munnings ranks second in the SBC in field goal percentage (.573). He's second on the team in scoring (11.5 ppg) and is ULM's leading rebounder (8.3 rpg).

Munnings has four double-doubles on the season and has reached double-figures in scoring in four of the last five games. He scored a career-high 22 points at Penn State and also pulled down 10 rebounds in the contest

- Junior Nick Coppola ranks eighth all-time in career assists at ULM with 286. He needs 14 more to catch John Pickett and move into seventh. Coppola also ranks ninth in both career starts and total minutes played. He averages 35.1 minutes per game in his career, second in school history. He's played at least 40 minutes 27 times in his career including a school record 54 minutes vs. Canisius. Coppola has started every game in his career. He played 1,384 minutes last year, third most in the nation and also third in single-season program history. Additionally, Coppola finished second in the SBC last season in both assist:turnover ratio (2.0) and assists (3.7 apg). This season, Coppola is averaging 10.8 points per game and ranks third in the league with 4.8 assists per outing. He's registered three consecutive double-figure scoring games

#### **ULM Notes Continued...**

- Senior Justin Roberson averages 10.3 points, 4.6 rebounds and 2.7 assists per game on the year. He's shooting .429 from beyond-the-arc. Roberson leads the team in steals for the second year in a row and has 19 this season. He's notched three consecutive double-figure scoring games including a career-high 19 against Central Baptist
- Senior Jamaal Samuel records 9.6 points and 4.0 rebounds per outing on the season. He's scored in double-digits in six of the last seven games. Samuel poured in a career-high 19 points at No. 14 West Virginia and scored ULM's first 15 points of the contest
- Senior DeMondre Harvey has been very efficient for the Warhawks off the bench as he's hit 27-49 (.551) field goals this season and went 7-7 from the field against Canisius in 40 minutes. He started three games in-place of Deng. Harvey is 26-34 (.765) from the free throw line, a big improvement compared to his 23-43 (.535) last season. He's led the team in field goal percentage in back-to-back years
- The Warhawks pushed a pair of Big Ten opponents to the brink. ULM led 51-50 with 6:44 remaining at Minnesota, and 40-39 with 5:34 left at Penn State. The Warhawks were without Deng against the Nittany Lions
- ULM never trailed in three out of its five wins this season (against McMurry, Northwestern State and UL-Lafayette)
- Keith Richard picked up his 200th career victory as a head coach in an 80-64 victory over Northwestern State on Nov. 19. Both Deng and Munnings recorded double-doubles in the contest
- ULM opened the season with an 88-43 victory over McMurry. The 45-point margin of victory was ULM's largest in school history in a season opener. The Warhawks improved to 47-18 all-time in home openers
- Keith Richard is the reigning Sun Belt Conference and Louisiana Coach of the Year winner. It comes after a 24-win season, the third-most in school history and also the third biggest turnaround in the country from the year before. It was ULM's first 20-win season since 2001-02. Richard has more-than doubled ULM's win totals in back-to-back years
- The Warhawks made a run to the CBI championship series last year for their 10th postseason appearance in school history and the first since 1995-96. They played their first-ever game in the month of April in their 64-year history. They were also the first team from the SBC to ever play a game in April
- ULM picked up a pair of preseason honors as Deng was named to the 2015-16 All-Conference Second-Team, while Coppola earned recognition on the Third-Team. Deng was also named to the College Sports Madness Preseason All-SBC First-Team while Coppola was Third-Team (page 10)
- The Warhawks were picked to finished third in the SBC Preseason Poll. It comes after they finished in a tie for second-place in the SBC standings last season. In 2013-14, ULM was picked to finish dead last preseason
- ULM is in its second season without any APR penalties which Richard inherited when he took over at the helm. Richard has turned the program around athletically and academically as the Warhawks have won back-to-back-to-back Sun Belt Conference academic awards

# **Scouting Appalachian State**

The Mountaineers finished a daunted non-conference schedule 2-9. They defeated Jacksonville and Liberty, but fell to Furman, Hampton, Tulane, Mercer, Stephen F. Austin, Hofstra, Texas, Charlotte and North Carolina.

Frank Eaves leads the Sun Belt Conference in scoring with 20.1 points per game. He's shooting an astounding .477 (41-86) from three-point range. Eaves is the only Mountaineer averaging in double-figures. Ronschad Shabazz

puts in 9.6 points per game and Chris Burgess 8.9. Griffin Kinney is the team's leading rebounder, pulling down 4.7 per game and also scores 6.9 points per outing.

As a team, Appalachian State makes .397 percent of its three-pointers, but gives up .430 from beyond-the-arc. Along with Eaves, Burgess also shoots over 40 percent from long-range at a .406 (17-42) clip.

ULM and Appalachian State split a pair of meetings last season with both coming out on top at home. ULM won 69-58 on Feb. 14, 2015, but the Mountaineers came back two weeks later with a 66-43 result on Feb. 28, 2015.

Jim Fox is in his second year at the helm. Last season, the Mountaineers were picked last preseason but finished sixth overall. They defeated two NCAA Tournament teams in Georgia State and Hampton. Fox came to App State after 13 years at Davidson including the last two as Associate Head Coach. Fox helped coach the Wildcats to their most successful 13-year stint in the program's history. It included 10 SoCon regular season championships and six SoCon Tournament titles. Fox coached seven SoCon Player of the Year winners and three SoCon Freshmen of the Year. Most notably, Stephen Curry was a two-time All-American and the nations leading scorer.

#### **Warhawks Fall in Non-Conference Finale to Hampton**

**LAS VEGAS** – The ULM men's basketball program closed out its non-conference slate with a 75-64 defeat to Hampton on Wednesday at Orleans Arena in the Continental Tire Las Vegas Classic.

Senior Majok Deng registered a team-high 16 points for the Warhawks (5-7, 1-0 SBC) and also grabbed five rebounds. Senior Justin Roberson and junior Nick Coppola scored 12 points apiece.

Hampton (5-6, 1-0 MEAC) was led by 19 points from both Quinton Chievous and Brian Darden. Reginald Johnson Jr. finished with 16 points. The team held a 44-26 edge in points in the paint.

The Warhawks made the first two baskets of the second half from Roberson and Deng cut the deficit to 42-34. The Pirates responded with a 6-0 run to go back up 48-34 with 17:40 remaining. Hampton extended its edge to 52-36 at the 14:11 mark.

ULM kept fighting the whole way and got it down to 70-61 with 2:12 to go after a free throw by Roberson.

It was a quick turnaround for a ULM squad that played a triple overtime game against Canisius the day before and had less than 24 hours to recover. Three different players saw at least 52 minutes of action against the Golden Griffins.

# History Behind the 'Warhawk'

Moving into the Sun Belt Conference in the 2006-07 season, ULM's athletic department completed a transformation. The mascot holds a local historical connection to the P-40 'Warhawk' airplane flown by northeast Louisiana's General Claire Chennault and the Flying Tigers of WWII. The Warhawk is also symbolic of the red-shouldered hawk, a local predatory bird commonly found nee\sting along Bayou DeSiard and soaring above ULM's athletic facitilities. ULM's Warhawk moniker is the only one at the NCAA Division I level. Prior to becoming the ULM Warhawks, the school competed as the Northeast Louisiana Indians.


