ULM Notes

- The Warhawks are participating in Suits and Sneakers Awareness Week, a Coaches vs. Cancer initiative that supports the American Cancer Society. In addition to sneakers, the staff will also be wearing gold Princess Lacey's Laces in honor of Lacey Holsworth, an 8-year-old hoops fan who passed away from pediatric cancer in 2014

- ULM student-athletes won three weekly awards on Monday. Senior Justin Roberson was named both Sun Belt Conference and Louisiana Student-Athlete of the Week, and senior Majok Deng won College Sports Madness SBC Player of the Week. Roberson posted the two highest scoring totals of his career with 26 points against Troy and 23 points against South Alabama

- The Warhawks are 7-0 (4-0 SBC) at home this season and 21-4 (.840) at home over the last two years. ULM is 411-173 all-time in Fant-Ewing Coliseum

- ULM has held SBC opponents to under 75 points in 36 straight games including postseason play. ULM went 47 consecutive games overall without allowing a 75-point scoring team which was the second longest in the country. It was snapped at Houston on a jumper with nine seconds left. The last time an SBC team scored 75 points against ULM was Feb. 20, 2014 at Georgia State

- The Warhawks are 47-16 all-time against UTA and 28-5 at home. The team's split the season series last year, both winning on the road

- ULM is coming off a 2-0 weekend, with wins over Troy (85-74) and South Alabama (100-68). The Warhawks scored 100 points in a conference game for the first time since Jan. 4, 2014 when they defeated UL-Lafayette, 103-98 in double overtime. The last time the Warhawks scored 100 points in regulation in a league-game was on Feb. 18, 1995 in a 108-83 victory over Sam Houston State in a Southland Conference affair

- The Warhawks scored at least 85 points in back-to-back conference games for the first time since January, 2007 when it beat Troy 91-78 and then lost 103-96 at WKU

- ULM's 32-point win over South Alabama was its largest margin of victory over an SBC opponent since Feb. 22, 2007 when it thumped Denver, 87-51 at home

- The Warhawks are the second-winningest program over the last two seasons in terms of Sun Belt Conference victories (page 4)

- On the season, ULM ranks top-three in the SBC in field goal percentage (.450), three-point field goal percentage defense (.319), assists (13.6 apg) and rebounding margin (+4.1)

- Five different Warhawks have registered a double-double this season for a total of 12. Last weekend, junior Nick Coppola tallied 14 points and 10 assists vs. Troy, followed by senior Jamaal Samuel's 14 points and 13 rebounds against South Alabama

- ULM switched its starting lineup last weekend and is now 2-0 with Coppola, Roberson, Samuel, Deng and senior DeMondre Harvey as its first-five. Freshman Travis Munnings had started all 16 games previously

- Deng ranks second in the league 42nd in the nation in scoring with 19.5 points per game. He averages 19.9 points per game in league play. Deng is also the team's leading rebounder (7.3 rpg) and shot blocker (1.4 bpg) and shoots a team-high .816 from the free throw line. He has scored at least 14 points in 11 of his last 12 outings. He has a trio of 30-plus scoring games this year and has won National Mid-Major Player of the Week (Dec. 7), Louisiana Player of the Week (Dec. 21) and College Sports Madness SBC Player of the Week (Jan. 25)

- Deng ranks seventh all-time in career blocks at ULM with 73. He needs 16 more to move into sixth and catch Rudy Turner. Deng also has 12 career double-doubles and 39 career double-figure scoring games in two seasons at ULM

- Roberson is coming off the three highest scoring games of his career. He netted 20 points at Georgia Southern last Saturday, a career-high 26 points vs. Troy on Thursday and 23 points against South Alabama. He averages 12.3 points, 4.5 rebounds and 2.7 assists per game on the year. Roberson is leading the team in steals for the second straight season and averages 1.9 per game in conference play to rank third in the league. Roberson has reached double-figures in scoring in nine of his last 10 outings and is shooting a team-high .444 from beyond-the-arc which is also second in the conference. The Natchitoches, La., native has averaged 23 points per game over the last three games after averaging 10.3 points through the first 16 games of the year. He has started every game his year

- Coppola ranks seventh all-time in career assists at ULM with 320 and needs four more to catch Casey Jones and move into sixth. Coppola also ranks seventh in both total minutes played career starts. He averages 35.2 minutes per game in his career, tied for the most in school history. He's played at least 40 minutes 29 times in his career including a school record 54 minutes vs. Canisius. Coppola has started every game in his career. He played 1,384 minutes last year, third most in the nation and also third in single-season program history. Additionally, Coppola finished second in the SBC last season in both assist:turnover ratio (2.0) and assists (3.7 apg). This year, Coppola is averaging 9.8 points, 4.8 assists and 3.1 rebounds per game. In SBC games only, he's second in the league in assist:turnover ratio (2.7) and minutes per game (35.6 mpg). He logs 35.5 minutes per game on the season which ranks top-50 in the country

- Samuel is coming off his first career double-double with 14 points and a career-high 13 rebounds vs. South Alabama. He has scored in double-digits 10 times this year and has started every game. Samuel poured in a career-high 19 points at No. 14 West Virginia and scored ULM's first 15 points of the contest. He also recorded a 15-point game at Arkansas State. Samuel averages 8.9 points and 4.5 rebounds per game on the year

- Harvey, who was inserted into the starting lineup last weekend, had been ULM's most efficient player off the bench as he's hit 38-68 (.559) field goals this season. Harvey is coming off a career-high 20 points against South Alabama and went 10-11 from the free throw line. He started three games earlier in the season in-place of Deng. Harvey led the team in field goal percentage in back-to-back years coming into this season

- Munnings ranks third in the SBC in field goal percentage (.549) and averages 9.4 points and 6.7 rebounds per game on the year. He has four double-doubles on the season and nine double-figure scoring games. Munnings scored a career-high 22 points at Penn State and also pulled down 10 rebounds in the contest. In his new role, he is looked upon as ULM's "sixth man" after starting the first 16 games of the season

- The Warhawks opened league play with an 81-70 win over Sun Belt Conference preseason favorite UL-Lafayette. ULM shot 9-15 from beyond-the-arc; the .600 percentage was the highest by an SBC team in a single game this season. The Warhawks never trailed in the contest. It was ULM's third consecutive win over the Ragin' Cajuns as it swept the season series last year

- ULM holds back-to-back wins over teams selected to win their leagues in the preseason polls as it defeated Chattanooga, 64-54, in addition to UL-Lafayette. The Mocs were picked to win the Southern Conference and were ranked No. 8 in the CollegeInsider Mid-Major Top-25 poll at the time of the game

- ULM posted a wire-to-wire victory over Appalachian State, 72-56, to improve to 2-0 in the league. The Warhawks used a 7-0 run in the second half to go up 54-38 with 12:47 remaining and their lead never dropped below 13 points after that

- The Warhawks pushed a pair of Big Ten opponents to the brink. ULM led 51-50 with 6:44 remaining at Minnesota, and 40-39 with 5:34 left at Penn State. The Warhawks were without Deng against the Nittany Lions

- Three of ULM's non-conference losses came without Deng (at Kent State, Penn State and West Virginia). He sat out for precautionary reasons due to a lower leg injury

- Keith Richard picked up his 200th career victory as a head coach in an 80-64 victory over NSU on Nov. 19. Both Deng and Munnings recorded double-doubles in the contest

- ULM opened the season with an 88-43 victory over McMurry. The 45-point margin of victory was ULM's largest in school history in a season opener. The Warhawks improved to 47-18 all-time in home openers

- Keith Richard is the reigning Sun Belt Conference and Louisiana Coach of the Year winner. It comes after a 24-win season, the third-most in school history and also the third biggest turnaround in the country from the year before. It was ULM's first 20-win season since 2001-02. Richard has more-than doubled ULM's win totals in back-to-back years

- The Warhawks made a run to the CBI championship series last year for their 10th postseason appearance in school history and the first since 1995-96. They played their first-ever game in the month of April in their 64-year history. They were also the first team from the SBC to ever play a game in April

- ULM picked up a pair of preseason honors as Deng was named to the 2015-16 All-Conference Second-Team, while Coppola earned recognition on the Third-Team. Deng was also named to the College Sports Madness Preseason All-SBC First-Team while Coppola was Third-Team (page 10)

- The Warhawks were picked to finished third in the SBC Preseason Poll. It comes after they finished in a tie for second-place in the SBC standings last season. In 2013-14, ULM was picked to finish dead last preseason

- ULM is in its second season without any APR penalties which Richard inherited when he took over at the helm. Richard has turned the program around athletically and academically as the Warhawks have won back-to-back-to-back Sun Belt Conference academic awards

- The Warhawks will honor their 1985-86 NCAA Tournament team on Feb. 12-13 for their 30th anniversary. The Warhawks won both the Southland Conference Regular Season and Postseason titles that year

Scouting UT Arlington

The Mavs were one of the hottest teams in the league non-conference as they went 9-2 with marquee wins at Ohio State and Memphis. They also won at Rice and UTEP, and at home against Fordham, Bradley and North Texas.

Overall, UTA is 14-4 and 5-2 in league play. Overall, UTA is 14-4 and 5-2 in league play. It will be without leading scorer and rebounder Kevin Hervey who is out for the season with a torn ACL. However, Kennedy Eubanks filled in nicely for the Mavs with 14 points against Little Rock and 23 points and 11 rebounds against Arkansas State in Hervey's absence.

In addition to Eubanks, the Mavs have a supporting cast that can pick up the slack without Hervey. Erick Neal averages 13.0 points per game, Jalen Jones 13.0, Drew Charles 9.0 and Kaelon Wilson 8.2. Charles shoots .386 from long-range.

As a team, UTA ranks second in the league in scoring with 81.2 points per game, and first in rebounding margin with a +9.7 mark. It's also first in three-pointers made per game (9.4), steals (8.6 spg) and offensive rebounds (16.6 orpg).

Scott Cross has coached UTA to three of its top-five winningest seasons in school history including the top-two. The Mavericks have gone to the postseason three times under his watch, including back-to-back trips in 2011-12 and 2012-13. That marked the first consecutive postseasons in program history. Over that two-year span, only two of Texas' 21 Division I programs had more wins than the Mavericks' 43.

UT Arlington had only one postseason trip in the 46 years prior to Cross' arrival. He's the only men's basketball coach in school history with a winning record. Cross is a UTA alum as he graduated in 1998.

Warhawks Dominant Offensively, Blow Past South Alabama 100-68

MONROE, La. – All five starters scored in double-figures for the ULM men's basketball program as the Warhawks remained undefeated at home with a lopsided 100-68 victory over South Alabama on Saturday at Fant-Ewing Coliseum.

ULM (8-11, 4-4 SBC) improved to 7-0 at home this season and 4-0 in conference play. The Warhawks shot 32-61 (.525) from the field and made a season-high 28 free throws on 34 attempts.

Senior Justin Roberson netted a game-high 23 points on 9-12 shooting as he scored at least 20 points for the third straight contest. Senior DeMondre Harvey posted a career-high 20 points and went 10-11 from the free throw line. Senior Majok Deng finished with 17 points and went 9-10 from the charity stripe.

Senior Jamaal Samuel registered his first career double-double with 14 points and a career-high 13 rebounds. Junior Nick Coppola tallied 13 points and buried a trio of three-pointers. Both Coppola and Roberson dished out seven assists. Roberson played 40 minutes for the second straight game.

USA (7-12, 2-6) was guided by Ken Williams who scored 14 points. Georgi Boyanov put in 13 points on 5-7 shooting.

History Behind the 'Warhawk'

Moving into the Sun Belt Conference in the 2006-07 season, ULM's athletic department completed a transformation. The mascot holds a local historical connection to the P-40 'Warhawk' airplane flown by northeast Louisiana's General Claire Chennault and the Flying Tigers of WWII. The Warhawk is also symbolic of the red-shouldered hawk, a local predatory bird commonly found nesting along Bayou DeSiard and soaring above ULM's athletic facilities. ULM's Warhawk moniker is the only one at the NCAA Division I level. Prior to becoming the ULM Warhawks, the school competed as the Northeast Louisiana Indians.

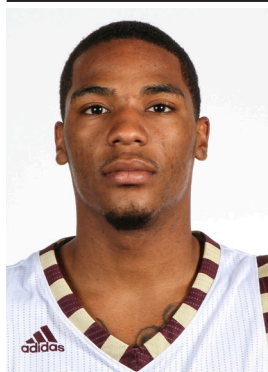
