ULM Notes

- ULM is 2-1 all-time against Appalachian State. They split the season series last year and the Warhawks took the opener this season on Dec. 31, 2015

- In the first meeting this year, the Warhawks posted wire-to-wire victory, 72-56, to improve to 2-0 in the league. The Warhawks used a 7-0 run in the second half to go up 54-38 with 12:47 remaining and their lead never dropped below 13 points after that. Senior Majok Deng scored a game-high 18 points. Appalachian State's Frank Eaves was limited to 12 points on 3-9 shooting, 0-4 3FG. Eaves leads the conference in scoring with 20.1 points per game

- ULM has won four of its last five games after a perfect 4-0 homestand that ended last weekend. The Warhawks are 9-0 (6-0 SBC) at home this season and have won every game by double-figures. ULM is 23-4 (.852) at home over the last two seasons and 413-173 all-time in Fant-Ewing Coliseum

- Junior Nick Coppola is the reigning College Sports Madness SBC Player of the Week winner. It came after he notched a double-double against UT Arlington and a career-high 26 points vs. Texas State. It marked the fourth weekly award in the last two weeks for ULM. Last week, senior Justin Roberson won both Sun Belt Conference and Louisiana Student-Athlete of the Week, and senior Majok Deng was named CSM SBC Player of the Week

- ULM has held SBC opponents to under 75 points in 38 of the last 39 games. It held a streak of 47 consecutive games overall, the second longest active streak in the nation, which was snapped at Houston on a jumper with nine seconds left. The 36-game SBC streak was snapped vs. UT Arlington in a 99-88 win where both teams made 15 three-pointers

- ULM switched its starting lineup two weekends ago and is now 4-1 with Coppola, Roberson, Deng, senior Jamaal Samuel and senior DeMondre Harvey as its first-five. Freshman Travis Munnings had started all 16 games previously

- Five different Warhawks have registered a double-double this season for a total of 14. Most recently, Deng recorded 15 points and 10 rebounds last Saturday against Texas State

- On the season, ULM leads the SBC in field goal percentage (.454), is second in assists (14.0 apg) and top-three in rebounding margin (+2.6), assist:turnover ratio (1.1), three-point field goal percentage (.344), three-point field goal percentage defense (.318) and offensive rebounding percentage (.707). The Warhawks are shooting .458 from the field in conference-only games which is also best in the league

- ULM is over .500 after 11 league games for the second year in a row

- Deng ranks second in the league top-45 in the nation in scoring with 19.3 points per game. He averages 19.6 points per game in league play. Deng is also the team's leading rebounder (7.2 rpg) and shot blocker (1.6 bpg) and shoots a team-high .814 from the free throw line. He has scored at least 13 points in 14 of his last 15 outings. He has a trio of 30-plus scoring games this year, seven 20-plus scoring games and has won National Mid-Major Player of the Week (Dec. 7), Louisiana Player of the Week (Dec. 21) and College Sports Madness SBC Player of the Week (Jan. 25)

- Deng ranks seventh all-time in career blocks at ULM with 81. He needs eight more to move into sixth and catch Rudy Turner. Deng also has 13 career double-doubles and 41 career double-figure scoring games in two seasons at ULM

- In his last six games, Roberson has posted his five highest scoring games of his career. He netted 20 points at Georgia Southern, a career-high 26 points vs. Troy, 23 against South Alabama, 24 against UT Arlington and 21 at UL-Lafayette. He averages 12.9 points, 4.7 rebounds and 2.7 assists per game on the year. Roberson is leading the team in steals for the second straight season and averages 1.6 per game on the year. Roberson has reached double-figures 14 times this year and is shooting a league-best .446 from beyond-the-arc. It is a remarkable improvement from his .186 (8-43) three-point percentage last season. He has started every game his year

- Coppola is tied for fifth all-time in career assists at ULM with 339 and needs two more to catch Bobby Douglas and move into fourth. Coppola also ranks fifth all-time in minutes played (3,083) and first in career minutes per game (35.4). He's played at least 40 minutes 32 times in his career including a school record 54 minutes vs. Canisius. Coppola has started every game in his career and ranks sixth in school history with 86 starts. He played 1,384 minutes last year, third most in the nation and also third in single-season program history. Additionally, Coppola finished second in the SBC last season in both assist:turnover ratio (2.0) and assists (3.7 apg). This year, Coppola is averaging 10.5 points, 5.0 assists and 3.0 rebounds per game. In SBC games only, he is second in the league in assist:turnover ratio (3.0). He logs 36.4 minutes per game on the season which leads the conference and ranks 31st in the country

- Samuel has scored in double-figures in three of the last four games including 17 points on five three-pointers on Tuesday against UL-Lafayette. He has scored in double-digits 12 times this year and has started every game. Samuel poured in a career-high 19 points at No. 14 West Virginia and scored ULM's first 15 points of the contest. He also recorded a 15-point game at Arkansas State. Samuel averages 9.3 points and 4.6 rebounds per game on the year

- ULM is 4-1 since inserting Harvey into the starting lineup. He has hit 48-85 (.565) field goals this season. He scored in double-figures in back-to-back games during ULM's homestand with 13 points against UTA and a career-high 20 points against South Alabama where he went 10-11 from the free throw line. He also started three games earlier in the season in-place of Deng. Harvey led the team in field goal percentage in back-to-back years coming into this season. He's reached double-figures in scoring six times this year and 10 times in his career

- Munnings ranks third in the SBC in field goal percentage (.545) and averages 8.8 points and 6.2 rebounds per game on the year. He has four double-doubles on the season and 10 double-figure scoring games. Munnings scored a career-high 22 points at Penn State and also pulled down 10 rebounds in the contest. In his new role, he is looked upon as ULM's "sixth man" after starting the first 16 games of the season

- During ULM's four-game winning streak, it scored least 85 points in three straight conference games for the first time since 1995-96 when it was a Southland Conference member

- The Warhawks have won at least four straight games in conference three times in the last two seasons

- Against UT Arlington, ULM came one point away from scoring 100 points in back-to-back games for the first time since the 1992-93 season when it defeated Nicholls State, 105-64 and Southern Miss, 113-106 (OT). The last time the Warhawks scored 100 points in back-to-back league games was in 1967-68 when ULM fell in overtime to both Northwestern State 114-111 and Southeastern Louisiana 103-101 as a member of the Gulf States Conference

- The Warhawks went 15-30 from three-point range against the Mavs. ULM was one three-pointer shy of tying the school record for most threes made in a game. It made 16 against Arkansas-Monticello on Dec. 3, 1996, and at Troy on Jan 27, 2007. Deng became the first Warhawk to make at least seven three-pointers in a game since Hugh Mingo in 2010-11. It was the 16th time in school history that a Warhawk made at least seven three-pointers in a game

- ULM's 32-point win over South Alabama was its largest margin of victory over an SBC opponent since Feb. 22, 2007 when it thumped Denver, 87-51 at home

- The Warhawks opened league play with an 81-70 win over Sun Belt Conference preseason favorite UL-Lafayette. ULM shot 9-15 from beyond-the-arc; the .600 percentage

- ULM holds back-to-back wins over teams selected to win their leagues in the preseason polls as it defeated Chattanooga, 64-54, in addition to UL-Lafayette. The Mocs were picked to win the Southern Conference and were ranked No. 8 in the CollegeInsider Mid-Major Top-25 poll at the time of the game

- ULM posted a wire-to-wire victory over Appalachian State, 72-56, to improve to 2-0 in the league. The Warhawks used a 7-0 run in the second half to go up 54-38 with 12:47 remaining and their lead never dropped below 13 points after that

- The Warhawks pushed a pair of Big Ten opponents to the brink. ULM led 51-50 with 6:44 remaining at Minnesota, and 40-39 with 5:34 left at Penn State. The Warhawks were without Deng against the Nittany Lions

- Three of ULM's non-conference losses came without Deng (at Kent State, Penn State and West Virginia). He sat out for precautionary reasons due to a lower leg injury

- Keith Richard picked up his 200th career victory as a head coach in an 80-64 victory over NSU on Nov. 19. Both Deng and Munnings recorded double-doubles in the contest

- ULM opened the season with an 88-43 victory over McMurry. The 45-point margin of victory was ULM's largest in school history in a season opener. The Warhawks improved to 47-18 all-time in home openers

- Keith Richard is the reigning Sun Belt Conference and Louisiana Coach of the Year winner. It comes after a 24-win season, the third-most in school history and also the third biggest turnaround in the country from the year before. It was ULM's first 20-win season since 2001-02. Richard has more than doubled ULM's win totals in back-to-back years

- The Warhawks made a run to the CBI championship series last year for their 10th postseason appearance in school history and the first since 1995-96. They played their first-ever game in the month of April in their 64-year history. They were also the first team from the SBC to ever play a game in April

- ULM picked up a pair of preseason honors as Deng was named to the 2015-16 All-Conference Second-Team, while Coppola earned recognition on the Third-Team. Deng was also named to the College Sports Madness Preseason All-SBC First-Team while Coppola was Third-Team (page 10)

- The Warhawks were picked to finish third in the SBC Preseason Poll. It comes after they finished in a tie for second-place in the SBC standings last season. In 2013-14, ULM was picked to finish dead last preseason

- ULM is in its second season without any APR penalties which Richard inherited when he took over at the helm. Richard has turned the program around athletically and academically as the Warhawks have won back-to-back-to-back Sun Belt Conference academic awards

- The Warhawks will honor their 1985-86 NCAA Tournament team on Feb. 12-13 for their 30th anniversary. The Warhawks won both the Southland Conference Regular Season and Postseason titles that year

Scouting Appalachian State

Appalachian State is led by Frank Eaves who leads the league in scoring with 20.1 points per game. He's shooting .424 from three-point range and .820 from the free throw line. Eaves has made 70 three-pointers on the season, the most in the conference.

Also averaging in double-figures, Ronshad Shabazz puts in 11.0 per contest and shoots .351 from beyond-the-arc. Chris Burgess is another long-range threat, shooting .395 from distance and averages 7.8 points per outing.

The Mountaineers are looking to snap a two-game skid. They fell at South Alabama last weekend, 73-60 and dropped an 87-76 decision to UL-Lafayette on Thursday. Appalachian State enters the contest with a 6-16 overall record and 4-7 in conference. It is 2-3 at home in SBC play and 2-4 on the road.

Jim Fox is in his second year at the helm. Last season, the Mountaineers were picked last preseason but finished sixth overall. They defeated two NCAA Tournament teams in Georgia State and Hampton. Fox came to App State after 13 years at Davidson including the last two as Associate Head Coach. Fox helped coach the Wildcats to their most successful 13-year stint in the program's history. It included 10 SoCon regular season championships and six SoCon Tournament titles. Fox coached seven SoCon Player of the Year winners and three SoCon Freshmen of the Year. Most notably, Stephen Curry was a two-time All-American and the nations leading scorer.

ULM Downs Appalachian State 72-56 to Improve to 2-0 SBC

MONROE, La. — After an eight-day layoff, the ULM men's basketball program returned to the court strong and defeated Appalachian State, 72-56 in Sun Belt Conference action on Thursday at Fant-Ewing Coliseum.

ULM (6-7, 2-0 SBC) led by nine with 14:29 left in the second half when it went on a 7-0 run to leap ahead, 54-38 with 12:47 remaining. ULM's lead never dropped below 13 points after that.

Senior Majok Deng led the charge with a game-high 18 points and also pulled down seven rebounds. He was one of four ULM student-athletes in double-figures as junior Nick Coppola and senior Justin Roberson finished with 11 points apiece and freshman Travis Munnings ended with 10.

Off the bench, senior DeMondre Harvey had a solid outing of nine points and seven rebounds.

Appalachian State (2-10, 0-1 SBC) was led by Bennett Holley's 13 points and Tyrell Johnson ended with 11.

Frank Eaves, who entered the game leading the SBC in scoring with 20.1 points per game and shooting .477 from beyond-the-arc, recorded 12 points and was held to 0-4 from long-range.

The Warhawks shot 27-55 (.491) in the game and held the Mountaineers to a 17-53 (.321) mark.

Warhawks Drop Road Finale at Appalachian State

BOONE, N.C. — The ULM men's basketball program closed out its 2014-15 road slate with a 66-43 defeat at Appalachian State on Saturday at the Holmes Center.

Sophomore Nick Coppola scored a team-high 12 points for ULM (19-10, 13-5 SBC) after hitting a pair of three-pointers. Junior Justin Roberson also reached double-figures with 10 points.

Senior Tylor Ongwae and junior Majok Deng pulled down five rebounds apiece.

Frank Eaves notched a game-high 28 points for the Mountaineers (10-17, 7-11 SBC). He drained five three-pointers and shot 9-for-14 from the field.

Early three-pointers from Roberson and junior Jamaal Samuel built ULM a 10-8 lead. The Mountaineers came back with a big 15-0 run to go up 23-10 with 6:32 left. A three-pointer at the buzzer by Dustin Clarke gave Appalachian State a 34-19 lead at the half.

The Warhawks cut the deficit to 14 in the second half, 44-30, after a three-pointer by Coppola with 12:04 remaining but could not get any closer.

LAFAYETTE, La. — The ULM men's basketball program trailed by six with 1:38 remaining in the game when it came back to force overtime, but UL-Lafayette was able to outlast the Warhawks for a 72-65 final on Tuesday at the Cajundome.

The Cajuns were led by Long's 28 points and 17 rebounds. He helped ULL to a 51-20 rebounding advantage including 20-9 on the offensive end. Johnathan Stove also reached double-figures with 13 points.

History Behind the 'Warhawk'

Moving into the Sun Belt Conference in the 2006-07 season, ULM's athletic department completed a transformation. The mascot holds a local historical connection to the P-40 'Warhawk' airplane flown by northeast Louisiana's General Claire Chennault and the Flying Tigers of WWII. The Warhawk is also symbolic of the red-shouldered hawk, a local predatory bird commonly found nesting along Bayou DeSiard and soaring above ULM's athletic facilities. ULM's Warhawk moniker is the only one at the NCAA Division I level. Prior to becoming the ULM Warhawks, the school competed as the Northeast Louisiana Indians.

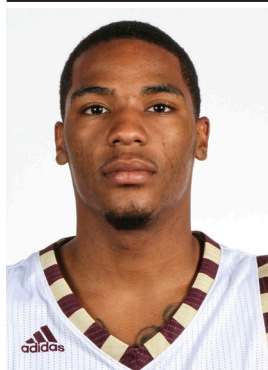
Notes on Harvey
