ULM Notes

- The Warhawks will honor their 1985-86 NCAA Tournament team at halftime for their 30th anniversary. The Warhawks won both the Southland Conference Regular Season and Postseason titles that year
- The Warhawks are 10-0 (7-0 SBC) at home this season and have nine of the 10 games by double-figures. ULM is 24-4 (.857) at home over the last two seasons and 414-173 all-time in Fant-Ewing Coliseum
- ULM is 18-8 all-time against Arkansas State at home
- The Warhawks are coming off an 86-82 victory over first-place Little Rock. The Trojans came into the game with the best record in the nation. They were also ranked No. 2 in the CollegeInsider Mid-Major Top-25 Poll. It was ULM's second win over a top-10 team in the poll as it previously defeated No. 6 Chattanooga
- ULM has won six of its seven games since switching its starting lineup to junior Nick Coppola and seniors Justin Roberson, Majok Deng, Jamaal Samuel and DeMondre Harvey. Freshman Travis Munnings had started all 17 games previously and is now the "sixth man"
- On the season, ULM leads the SBC in field goal percentage (.459), is second in assists (13.8 apg) and top-three in three-point field goal percentage (.353), free throw percentage (.709), rebounding margin (+2.8), assist:turnover ratio (1.1) and offensive rebounding percentage (.330). The Warhawks are shooting .467 from the field in conference-only games and hold a 1.3 assist:turnover ratio which are also best in the league
- ULM is 6-0 in conference play when it scores at least 80 points and 7-0 when it shoots over 50 percent from the field
- The Warhawks hold a 22-11 SBC record over the last two seasons, the second best in the league
- ULM is at least three games over .500 after 13 league games for the second year in

- Five different Warhawks have registered a double-double this season for a total of 14. Most recently, Deng recorded 15 points and 10 rebounds last Saturday against Texas State
- The Warhawks have won six weekly awards this year. Roberson was named SBC Student-Athlete of the Week and Louisiana Player of the Week (Jan. 25), Coppola won College Sports Madness SBC Player of the Week (Feb. 1) and Deng won National Mid-Major Player of the Week (Dec. 7), Louisiana Player of the Week (Dec. 21) and **College Sports Madness** SBC Player of the Week (Jan. 25)

the league and 36th in the nation in scoring with 19.6 points per game. He averages 20.1 points per game in league play which ranks first. Deng is also the team's leading rebounder (7.0 rpg) and shot blocker (1.5 bpg) and shoots a team-high .825 from the free throw line. He has scored at least 13 points in 16 of his last 17 outings. He has a trio of 30-plus scoring games this year, nine 20-plus scoring games

- Deng ranks seventh all-time in career blocks at ULM with 82. He needs seven more to move into sixth and catch Rudy Turner. Deng also has 13 career double-doubles and 43 career double-figure scoring games in two seasons at ULM
- In his last eight games, Roberson has posted his seven highest scoring games of his career, all of at least 20 points. He scored a career-high 26 points against Troy. He averages 13.7 points, 4.7 rebounds and 2.5 assists per game on the year. Roberson is leading the team in steals for the second straight season and averages 1.6 per game on the year, third-best in the league. Roberson has reached double-figures 16 times this year and is shooting .446 from beyond-thearc which ranks second in the SBC. It is a remarkable improvement from his .186 (8-43) three-point percentage last season. He has started every game his year
- Coppola has scored at least 25 points in two of his last four games. He ranks fourth all-time in career assists at ULM with 349 and needs 16 more to catch Bob Carson and move into third. Coppola also ranks fourth all-time in minutes played (3,154) and first in career minutes per game (35.4). He's played at least 40 minutes 32 times in his career including a school record 54 minutes vs. Canisius. Coppola has started every game in his career and ranks sixth in school history with 88 starts. He played 1,384 minutes last year, third most in the nation and also third in single-season program history. Additionally, Coppola finished second in the SBC last season in both assist:turnover ratio (2.0) and assists (3.7 apg). This year, Coppola is averaging 11.1 points, 5.0 assists and 3.0 rebounds per game. He logs 36.3 minutes per game on the season which leads the conference and ranks 36th in the country
- Samuel has scored in double-figures in five of the last seven games including 17 points on five three-pointers against UL-Lafayette. He has scored in double-digits 13 times this year and has started every game. Samuel poured in a career-high 19 points at No. 14 West Virginia and scored ULM's first 15 points of the contest. He also recorded a 15-point game at Arkansas State. Samuel averages 9.3 points and 4.7 rebounds per game on the year

- ULM is 6-1 since inserting Harvey into the starting lineup. He has hit 54-96 (.563) field goals this season and scored a career-high 20 points against South Alabama where he went 10-11 from the free throw line. He also started three games earlier in the season in-place of Deng. Harvey led the team in field goal percentage in back-to-back years coming into this season. He's reached double-figures in scoring six times this year and 10 times in his career
- Munnings ranks second in the SBC in field goal percentage (.549) and averages 8.7 points and 6.0 rebounds per game on the year. He has four double-doubles on the season and 11 double-figure scoring games. Munnings scored a career-high 22 points at Penn State and also pulled down 10 rebounds in the contest. In his new role, he is looked upon as ULM's "sixth man" after starting the first 17 games of the season
- In ULM's last 41 games against SBC opponents, it has only allowed 75 points three times. Ironically, all three resulted in wins, and twice the opposition made 15 three-pointers. The Warhawks held a streak of 47 consecutive games overall of not allowing a 75-point scorer, the second longest active streak in the nation, which was snapped at Houston on a jumper with nine seconds left
- Lat weekend, ULM won a 91-90 thriller over Appalachian State. ULM scored the final six points of the game, including a drive by Coppola to put the Warhawks ahead with 9.6 seconds left. The Mountaineers shot 60 percent from the field and three-point range. It was ULM's second victory over APP this year after a wire-to-wire 72-56 win on Dec. 31, 2015
- The Warhawks have won at least four straight games in conference three times in the last two seasons
- During ULM's four-game winning streak this year, it scored at least 85 points in three straight conference games for the first time since 1995-96 when it was a Southland Conference member
- Against UT Arlington, ULM came one point away from scoring 100 points in back-to-back games for the first time since the 1992-93 season when it defeated Nicholls State, 105-64 and Southern Miss, 113-106 (OT). The last time the Warhawks scored 100 points in back-to-back league games was in 1967-68 when ULM fell in overtime to both Northwestern State 114-111 and Southeastern Louisiana 103-101 as a member of the Gulf States Conference

that a Warhawk made at least seven three-pointers in a game

- ULM's 32-point win over South Alabama was its largest margin of victory over an SBC opponent since Feb. 22, 2007 when it thumped Denver, 87-51 at home
- The Warhawks opened league play with an 81-70 win over Sun Belt Conference preseason favorite UL-Lafayette. ULM shot 9-15 from beyond-the-arc; the .600 percentage was the highest by an SBC team in a single game this season. The Warhawks never trailed in the contest. It was ULM's third consecutive win over the Ragin' Cajuns as it swept the season series last year
- ULM holds back-to-back wins over teams selected to win their leagues in the preseason polls as it defeated Chattanooga, 64-54, in addition to UL-Lafayette. The Mocs were picked to win the Southern Conference and were ranked No. 8 in the CollegeInsider Mid-Major Top-25 poll at the time of the game
- The Warhawks pushed a pair of Big Ten opponents to the brink. ULM led 51-50 with 6:44 remaining at Minnesota, and 40-39 with 5:34 left at Penn State. The Warhawks were without Deng against the Nittany Lions
- Three of ULM's non-conference losses came without Deng (at Kent State, Penn State and West Virginia). He sat out for precautionary reasons due to a lower leg injury
- Keith Richard picked up his 200th career victory as a head coach in an 80-64 victory over NSU on Nov. 19. Both Deng and Munnings recorded double-doubles in the contest
- ULM opened the season with an 88-43 victory over McMurry. The 45-point margin of victory was ULM's largest in school history in a season opener. The Warhawks improved to 47-18 all-time in home openers
- Keith Richard is the reigning Sun Belt Conference and Louisiana Coach of the Year winner. It comes after a 24-win season, the third-most in school history and also the third biggest turnaround in the country from the year before. It was ULM's first 20-win season since 2001-02. Richard has morethan doubled ULM's win totals in back-to-back years
- The Warhawks made a run to the CBI championship series last year for their 10th postseason appearance in school history and the first since 1995-96. They played their first-ever game in the month of April in their 64-year history. They were also the first team from the SBC to ever play a game in April
- ULM picked up a pair of preseason honors as Deng was named to the 2015-16 All-Conference Second-Team, while Coppola earned recognition on the Third-Team. Deng was also named to the College Sports Madness Preseason All-SBC First-Team while Coppola was Third-Team (page 10)
- The Warhawks were picked to finished third in the SBC Preseason Poll. It comes after they finished in a tie for second-place in the SBC standings last season. In 2013-14, ULM was picked to finish dead last preseason
- ULM is in its second season without any APR penalties which Richard inherited when he took over at the helm. Richard has turned the program around athletically and academically as the Warhawks have won back-to-back-to-back Sun Belt Conference academic awards

The Red Wolves will look to snap a two-game skid Saturday after falling to Troy, 71-70 and at UL-Lafayette, 83-73. ASU is 11-13 overall and 7-6 in conference. It started SBC play hot, winning the first three games, but has dropped three of the last four.

Devin Carter leads the team with 17.3 points per game and is shooting .420 from three-point

range. Anthony Livingston records 15.6 points and 8.8 rebounds per outing and shoots .884 from the free throw line. Sean Gardner also averages in double-figures with 10.3 points per game.

As a team, ASU leads the league in free throw percentage, shooting at a .741 clip. It is also first in blocks with 4.9 per game.

John Brady is in his eighth season as head coach at ASU and 25th year as a Division I head coach. In 2012-13 and 2013-14, Brady recorded 19 wins in both seasons and claimed the SBC West Division title in 2013-14. He also won a share of the SBC West Division crown in 2010-11. Brady posted back-to-back 10-plus SBC wins at ASU for the first time in 20 years. Prior to ASU, Brady spent over 10 seasons as head coach at LSU where he notched six postseason berths and a Sweet 16 appearance. He was a two-time SEC Coach of the Year winner. Brady also spent six seasons as head coach at Samford.

Back-And-Forth Overtime Affair Ends in ASU's Favor, 68-65

JONESBORO, Ark. – The ULM men's basketball trailed by nine points in overtime when it stormed back to make it a one-point game, but Arkansas State was able to hang on for a 68-65 result on Thursday at the Convocation Center.

In regulation, ULM (6-8, 2-1 SBC) held a 53-46 edge with 3:53 remaining before the Red Wolves (7-7, 3-0 SBC) got hot and came back to lead, 56-54 with six seconds left. Junior Nick Coppola was fouled with one second remaining and hit a pair of free throws to send the game

ASU's comeback in regulation was helped by ULM going 6-16 from the free throw line in the second half.

The Red Wolves scored the first nine points of overtime to go up 65-56 with 1:02 remaining after four made field goals including a three. Deng hit a three-pointer, and after ASU made one of two free throws, Coppola hit from long-range to cut the deficit to 66-62 with 26 seconds left. ULM stole the next in-bounds pass and Deng hit a three from the top of the key to make it 66-65 with 21 seconds.

After ASU made a pair of free throws, ULM attempted a tough three-pointer from the corner that resulted in a held-ball, but the Red Wolves had the possession arrow with under seven seconds left. The Warhawks had one last chance after ASU missed a pair of free throws, but a potential game-tying three-pointer at the buzzer was off the mark.

Senior Majok Deng finished with 26 points and seven rebounds. He recorded 24 points after halftime. Senior Jamaal Samuel ended with 15 points, all coming in the first half. Senior Justin Roberson also notched double-figures with 10 points and also grabbed four steals.

MONROE, La. – Improving to 10-0 at home this season, the ULM men's basketball program led for the entire second half and defeated Little Rock, the top-team in the Sun Belt Conference standings, 86-82 on Thursday at Fant-Ewing Coliseum.

Little Rock (21-3, 11-2 SBC) came into the game with the best record in the nation.

LR was led by Josh Hagins who registered 19 points. Jalen Jackson finished with 12 points, Mareik Isom 11, Roger Woods 10 and Lis Shoshi 10.

History Behind the 'Warhawk'

Moving into the Sun Belt Conference in the 2006-07 season, ULM's athletic department completed a transformation. The mascot holds a local historical connection to the P-40 'Warhawk' airplane flown by northeast Louisiana's General Claire Chennault and the Flying Tigers of WWII. The Warhawk is also symbolic of the red-shouldered hawk, a local predatory bird commonly found nesting along Bayou DeSiard and soaring above ULM's athletic facitilities. ULM's Warhawk moniker is the only one at the NCAA Division I level. Prior to becoming the ULM Warhawks, the school competed as the Northeast Louisiana Indians.


