ULM Notes

- Senior Majok Deng won a trio of weekly awards on Monday including Sun Belt Conference Student-Athlete of the Week, Louisiana Player of the Week and College Sports Madness SBC Player of the Week. It came after he averaged 25.0 points per game in a 2-0 weekend over first-place Little Rock and Arkansas State. Deng leads the conference and ranks 36th in the nation in scoring with 19.7 points per outing. He ranks third in the country in scoring among internationally-born players
- ULM is 48-16 all-time against UTA, 29-5 at home and 17-9 on the road. The Warhawks won the first meeting this season in a shootout, 99-88 after both teams made 15 three-pointers. Deng scored a game-high 29 points while senior Justin Roberson poured in 24. UTA's Erick Neal finished with a triple-double of 27 points, 12 assists and 10 rebounds
- The Warhawks have won the last four games and eight of their last nine since switching their starting lineup to junior Nick Coppola, Roberson, Deng, senior Jamaal Samuel and senior DeMondre Harvey. Freshman Travis Munnings had started all 17 games previously and is now the "sixth man"
- ULM is 10-0 in conference play when it scores at least 70 points and 8-0 when it shoots over 50 percent from the field and
- -The Warhawks have won at least four straight SBC games four times in the last two seasons. The Warhawks are at least five games over .500 after 15 league games for the second straight year
- ULM holds a 24-11 SBC record over the last two seasons, best in the league
- The Warhawks are 11-0 (8-0 SBC) at home this season, 25-4 (.862) at home over the last two seasons and 415-173 all-time in Fant-Ewing Coliseum.
- On the year, ULM leads the SBC in field goal percentage (.458), is second in assists (13.8 apg) and top-three in three-point field goal percentage (.357), rebounding margin (+2.7), assist:turnover ratio (1.1) and offensive rebounding percentage (.329). The Warhawks are shooting .461 from the field in conference-only games and have a 1.3 assist:turnover ratio which are also best in the league

- Last weekend, the Warhawks posted an 86-82 victory over first-place Little Rock. The Trojans came into the game with the best record in the nation. They were also ranked No. 2 in the CollegeInsider Mid-Major Top-25 Poll. It was ULM's second win over a top-10 team in the poll as it previously defeated No. 6 Chattanooga
- ULM followed it up with a 78-73 overtime on Saturday
- over Arkansas State. The Warhawks committed just six turnovers in the game, a season-low. Deno scored a game-high 27 points

- season-low. Deng scored a game-high 27 points
- Deng averages 20.3 points per game in league play which ranks first. Deng is also the team's leading rebounder (6.9 rpg) and shot blocker (1.3 bpg) and shoots a teamhigh .818 from the free throw line. He has scored at least 13 points in 18 of his last 19 outings. He has a trio of 30-plus scoring games this year, 10 20-plus scoring games
- Deng ranks seventh all-time in career blocks at ULM with 82. He needs seven more to move into sixth and catch Rudy Turner. Deng also has 13 career double-doubles and 46 career double-figure scoring games in two seasons at ULM
- In his last 10 games, Roberson has posted the nine highest scoring games of his career, all of at least 20 points. He scored a career-high 26 points against Troy. He averages 14.2 points, 4.7 rebounds and 2.6 assists per game on the year. Roberson is leading the team in steals for the second straight season and averages 1.6 per game on the year, third-best in the league. Roberson has reached double-figures 18 times this year and is shooting .435 from beyond-the-arc. It is a remarkable improvement from his .186 (8-43) three-point percentage last season. He has started every game his year
- In the ULM career record book, Coppola ranks first all-time in minutes per game (35.5 mpg), third in total minutes played (3,233), fourth in assists (362), fifth in games started (91), sixth in assists per game (4.0 apg), and ninth in three-pointers made (125). He's played at least 40 minutes 33 times in his career including a school record 54 minutes vs. Canisius. Coppola has started every game in his career. He played 1,384 minutes last year, third most in the nation and also third in single-season program history. Additionally, Coppola finished second in the SBC last season in both assist:turnover ratio (2.0) and assists (3.7 apg). This year, Coppola is averaging 11.0 points, 5.1 assists and 3.0 rebounds per game. He logs 36.5 minutes per game on the season which leads the conference and ranks top-30 in the country
- Samuel has scored in double-figures in five of the last eight games including 17 points on five three-pointers against UL-Lafayette. He has scored in double-digits 14 times this year and has started every game. Samuel poured in a career-high 19 points at No. 14 West Virginia and scored ULM's first 15 points of the contest. He also recorded a 15-point game at Arkansas State. Samuel averages 9.4 points and 4.7 rebounds per game on the year
- ULM is 8-1 since inserting Harvey into the starting lineup. He has hit 57-103 (.553) field goals this season and scored a career-high 20 points against South Alabama where he went 10-11 from the free throw line. He also started three games earlier in the season in-place of Deng. Harvey led the team in field goal percentage in back-to-back years coming into this season. He's reached double-figures in scoring six times this year and 10 times in his career
- Munnings, who has made nine of his last 11 three-pointers over a six-game span, ranks second in the SBC in field goal percentage (.543) and averages 8.5 points and 5.8 rebounds per game on the year. He has four double-doubles on the season and 11 double-figure scoring games. Munnings scored a career-high 22 points at Penn State and also pulled down 10 rebounds in the contest. In his new role, he is looked

upon as ULM's "sixth man" after starting the first 17 games of the season

- In ULM's last 43 games against SBC opponents, it has only allowed 75 points three times. Ironically, all three resulted in wins, and twice the opposition made 15 three-pointers. The Warhawks held a streak of 47 consecutive games overall of not allowing a 75-point scorer, the second longest active streak in the nation, which was snapped at Houston on a jumper with nine seconds left
- Five different Warhawks have registered a double-double this season for a total of 14
- The Warhawks have won nine weekly awards this year. In addition to Deng's three this week, Roberson was named SBC Student-Athlete of the Week and Louisiana Player of the Week (Jan. 25), Coppola won College Sports Madness SBC Player of the Week (Feb. 1) and Deng won National Mid-Major Player of the Week (Dec. 7), Louisiana Player of the Week (Dec. 21) and College Sports Madness SBC Player of the Week (Jan. 25)
- ULM completed a season-sweep over Texas State, holding the Bobcats to under 60 points in both contests. In the second meeting, the Warhawks jumped out to a 19-point advantage at halftime and never saw their lead drop below 15 points in the second half
- Two weekends ago, ULM won a 91-90 thriller over Appalachian State. ULM scored the final six points of the game, including a drive by Coppola to put the Warhawks ahead with 9.6 seconds left. The Mountaineers shot 60 percent from the field and three-point range. It was ULM's second victory over APP this year after a wire-to-wire 72-56 win on Dec. 31, 2015
- During ULM's first four-game SBC winning streak this year, it scored at least 85 points in three straight conference games for the first time since 1995-96 when it was a Southland Conference member
- Against UT Arlington, ULM came one point away from scoring 100 points in back-to-back games for the first time since the 1992-93 season when it defeated Nicholls State, 105-64 and Southern Miss, 113-106 (OT). The last time the Warhawks scored 100 points in back-to-back league games was in 1967-68 when ULM fell in overtime to both Northwestern State 114-111 and Southeastern Louisiana 103-101 as a member of the Gulf States Conference
- -The Warhawks went 15-30 from three-point range against the Mavs. ULM was one three-pointer shy of tying the school record for most threes made in a game. It made 16 against Arkansas-Monticello on Dec. 3, 1996, and at Troy on Jan 27. 2007. Deng became the first Warhawk to make at least seven three-pointers in a game since Hugh Mingo in 2010-11. It was the 16th time in school history that a Warhawk made at least seven three-pointers in a game

Warhawks never trailed in the contest. It was ULM's third consecutive win over the Ragin' Cajuns as it swept the season series last year

- ULM holds back-to-back wins over teams selected to win their leagues in the preseason polls as it defeated Chattanooga, 64-54, in addition to UL-Lafayette. The Mocs were picked to win the Southern Conference and were ranked No. 8 in the CollegeInsider Mid-Major Top-25 poll at the time of the game
- The Warhawks pushed a pair of Big Ten opponents to the brink. ULM led 51-50 with 6:44 remaining at Minnesota, and 40-39 with 5:34 left at Penn State. The Warhawks were without Deng against the Nittany Lions
- Three of ULM's non-conference losses came without Deng (at Kent State, Penn State and West Virginia). He sat out for precautionary reasons due to a lower leg injury
- Keith Richard picked up his 200th career victory as a head coach in an 80-64 victory over NSU on Nov. 19. Both Deng and Munnings recorded doubledoubles in the contest
- ULM opened the season with an 88-43 victory over McMurry. The 45-point margin of victory was ULM's largest in school history in a season opener. The Warhawks improved to 47-18 all-time in home openers
- Keith Richard is the reigning Sun Belt Conference and Louisiana Coach of the Year winner. It comes after a 24-win season, the third-most in school history and also the third biggest turnaround in the country from the year before. It was ULM's first 20-win season since 2001-02. Richard has more-than doubled ULM's win totals in back-to-back years
- The Warhawks made a run to the CBI championship series last year for their 10th postseason appearance in school history and the first since 1995-96. They played their first-ever game in the month of April in their 64-year history. They were also the first team from the SBC to ever play a game in April
- ULM picked up a pair of preseason honors as Deng was named to the 2015-16 All-Conference Second-Team, while Coppola earned recognition on the Third-Team. Deng was also named to the College Sports Madness Preseason All-SBC First-Team while Coppola was Third-Team
- The Warhawks were picked to finished third in the SBC Preseason Poll. It comes after they finished in a tie for second-place in the SBC standings last season. In 2013-14, ULM was picked to finish dead last preseason
- ULM is in its second season without any APR penalties which Richard inherited when he took over at the helm. Richard has turned the program around athletically and academically as the Warhawks have won back-to-backto-back Sun Belt Conference academic awards
- The Warhawks honored their 1985-86 NCAA Tournament team on Feb. 13 at halftime against Arkansas State for their 30th anniversary. The Warhawks won both the Southland Conference Regular Season and Postseason titles that year

Scouting UT Arlington

Like ULM, the Mavs enter play on a four-game winningstreak after their come-from-behind 84-83 victory in overtime over UL-Lafayette on Thursday. They started their winning-streak with wins at Georgia State and Texas State before returning home to crush Appalachian State by 31 points.

UTA lost its leading scorer and rebounder, Kevin Hervey, just before the mid-point of conference play but have been able to make up his 18.1 points and 9.8 rebounds per game. Erick Neal has flipped the switch and averages

13.8 points and 5.8 assists per game which leads the league. Jalen Jones scores 12.8 points per outing and shoots .402 from beyond-the-arc. In conference games, Jones is shooting at a .453 clip from long-range.

In SBC-only games, the Mavs lead the league in scoring, averaging 81.6 points per contest. They are also first in three-pointers made (9.9 3fgm) steals (6.9 spg), assists (17.4 apg), assist:turnover ratio (1.3), offensive rebounds (13.6 orpg), defensive rebounds (29.7 drpg) and second in rebounding margin with a +6.7 clip.

Scott Cross has coached UTA to three of its top-five winningest seasons in school history including the top-two. The Mavericks have gone to the postseason three times under his watch, including back-to-back trips in 2011-12 and 2012-13. That marked the first consecutive postseasons in program history. Over that two-year span, only two of Texas' 21 Division I programs had more wins than the Mavericks' 43.

UT Arlington had only one postseason trip in the 46 years prior to Cross' arrival. He's the only men's basketball coach in school history with a winning record. Cross is a UTA alum as he graduated in 1998.

<u>ULM's Offensive Surge Continues with 99-88</u> Victory over UT Arlington

MONROE, La. – What was once a defensive team has turned into an offensive juggernaut as the ULM men's basketball program outscored UT Arlington 99-88 in a three-point contest on Thursday at Fant-Ewing Coliseum.

Both teams made 15 three-pointers in the game. ULM (9-11, 5-4 SBC), which won its third consecutive game and improved to 8-0 (5-0 SBC) at home, went 15-30 from long-range, while UTA (14-5, 5-3 SBC) finished 15-40.

Though overall from the field, the Warhawks were 34-63 (.540) and held the Mavs to a 32-75 (.427) clip.

All five ULM starters scored in double-figures for the second straight game. Senior Majok Deng, who won College Sports Madness SBC Player of the Week on Monday, made seven three-pointers, all in the second half, to end with a game-high 29 points and had a careerhigh five blocks.

Senior Justin Roberson, the reigning Sun Belt Conference and Louisiana Student-Athlete of the Week winner, went 4-5 from beyond-the-arc and posted 24 points and seven rebounds. Though he only played 21 minutes due to foul trouble.

Junior Nick Coppola notched a double-double with 12 points and a season-high 11 assists with just two turnovers in 40 minutes. Senior Jamaal Samuel also registered 12 points, while senior DeMondre Harvey recorded 13 points, a career-high four assists and three steals.

Huge Second Half, Clutch Overtime Plays Lift ULM Over UTA, 76-73

ARLINGTON, Texas – A defensive battle in the first half turned into a second half scoring fest as the ULM men's basketball program surged to send the game to overtime and gutout a 76-73 victory over UT Arlington.

The Warhawks (8-6, 2-1 SBC) were cold in the first half and shot just .267 (8-30) from the field and scored 20 points. However, ULM flipped the script in the second with 47 points, shooting .515 (17-33) and made clutch plays in overtime to pull out the thriller despite three players fouling out.

ULM trailed by 13 early in the second half before coming back to tie it, 43-43 at the 13:14 mark. The Warhawks then had to come back again after UTA went on a 9-0 run to go up 54-45, and ULM fought its way to a 61-60 lead with 4:23 remaining. The Warhawks had a chance to win it on their final possession, but junior Mack Foster's three-pointer at the buzzer came just short.

In overtime, senior Marvin Williams came up huge, scoring eight of ULM's nine points to cap his second consecutive monster performance. He made a big lay-up to put ULM up three with 1:14 left, and then finished after finding a loose ball with three seconds left to put the Warhawks up four.

Williams matched both his point and rebounding career-highs with 22 and 13, respectively. Junior Majok Deng also registered a career-high with 15 points. Foster got the nod for his second straight start and posted 11 points.

ULM Pulls Away from Texas State Early, Cruises to Fourth Straight Win

SAN MARCOS, Texas – The ULM men's basketball program took control of the game in the first half and never looked back in a 76-57 victory over Texas State on Thursday at Strahan Coliseum.

ULM (14-12, 10-5 SBC) went up by 19 points at the intermission on the Bobcats (10-12, 4-9 SBC) and never saw the lead drop below 15 points in the second half. All 10 ULM student-athletes that played in the contest scored at least two points.

The Warhawks shot 31-60 (.517) from the field and held Texas State to an 18-49 (.367) clip. ULM also held a big 37-28 rebounding edge.

History Behind the 'Warhawk'

Moving into the Sun Belt Conference in the 2006-07 season, ULM's athletic department completed a transformation. The mascot holds a local historical connection to the P-40 'Warhawk' airplane flown by northeast Louisiana's General Claire Chennault and the Flying Tigers of WWII. The Warhawk is also symbolic of the red-shouldered hawk, a local predatory bird commonly found nesting along Bayou DeSiard and soaring above ULM's athletic facitilities. ULM's Warhawk moniker is the only one at the NCAA Division I level. Prior to becoming the ULM Warhawks, the school competed as the Northeast Louisiana Indians.


