ULM Notes

- ULM has won the last six meetings against South Alabama to even the all-time series, 10-10. The Warhawks won the first match-up this season, 100-68 on Jan. 23. The 32-point win was ULM's largest margin of victory over an SBC opponent since Feb. 22, 2007 when it thumped Denver, 87-51 at home
- The Warhawks are looking to complete their fourth season sweep of the year after already taking both meetings against Appalachian St., Texas St. and UT Arlington
- ULM has secured back-to-back winning seasons in league play for the first time since 1998-99 & 1999-00 when it was a member of the Southland Conference
- The Warhawks clinched a spot in the Sun Belt Conference Championships in New Orleans for the third year in a row
- ULM holds a 25-11 SBC record over the last two seasons, best in the league
- The Warhawks have won five games in a row and nine of their last 10 since switching their starting lineup to junior Nick Coppola, senior Justin Roberson, senior Majok Deng, senior Jamaal Samuel and senior DeMondre Harvey. Freshman Travis Munnings had started all 17 games previously and is now the "sixth man"
- ULM has won at least five straight SBC games three times in the last two seasons
- The Warhawks are 11-0 (8-0 SBC) at home this season, 25-4 (.862) at home over the last two seasons and 415-173 all-time in Fant-Ewing Coliseum
- Deng ranks second in the league in scoring (19.3 ppg) and first in SBC-only games (19.5 ppg). He ranks 44th in the nation in scoring and fourth among internationally-born players. Deng is also second in the conference in blocks (1.7 bpg) and swatted away a career-high nine in his last outing at UT Arlington
- Coppola is the reigning Co-Louisiana Player of the Week winner along with Alex Hamilton from Louisiana Tech. Coppola scored a game-high 19 points in ULM's 64-61 road win at UT Arlington and drained four three-pointers. It came after he scored 15 points in a 73-59 road win at Texas State and hit a trio of long-range shots

- ULM is 10-0 in conference play this season when it scores at least 70 points and 8-0 when it shoots over 50 percent from the field
- On the year, ULM leads the SBC in field goal percentage (.455), is second in assists (13.9 apg) and top-three in threepoint field goal percentage (.360), rebounding margin (+2.8), assist:turnover ratio (1.1), free throw percentage (.703) and offensive rebounding percentage

- (.332). The Warhawks are shooting .459 from the field in conference-only games and have a 1.3 assist:turnover ratio which are also best in the league
- The Warhawks hold a win over first-place Little Rock, 86-82 at home on Feb. 11. The Trojans came into the game with the best record in the nation. They were also ranked No. 2 in the CollegeInsider Mid-Major Top-25 Poll. It was ULM's second win over a top-10 team in the poll as it previously defeated No. 8 Chattanooga
- Deng is the team's leading scorer, rebounder and shot blocker and shoots a team-high .824 from the free throw line. He has scored at least 13 points in 18 of his last 20 outings. He has a trio of 30-plus scoring games this year, 10 20-plus scoring games
- Deng ranks fifth all-time in career blocks at ULM with 91. He needs eight more to move into fourth and catch Terry Martin. Deng also has 13 career double-doubles and 46 career double-figure scoring games in two seasons at ULM
- In his last 11 games, Roberson has posted the nine highest scoring games of his career, all of at least 20 points. He scored a career-high 26 points against Troy. He averages 14.1 points, 4.8 rebounds and 2.6 assists per game on the year. Roberson is leading the team in steals for the second straight season and averages 1.6 per game on the year, third-best in the league. Roberson has reached double-figures 19 times this year and is shooting .403 from beyond-the-arc. It is a remarkable improvement from his .186 (8-43) three-point percentage last season. He has started every game his year
- In the ULM career record book, Coppola ranks first all-time in minutes per game (35.6 mpg), third in assists (368), third in minutes played (3,273), fifth in games started (92), sixth in assists per game (4.0 apg) and eighth in three-pointers made (129). He's played at least 40 minutes 34 times in his career including a school record 54 minutes vs. Canisius. Coppola has started every game in his career. He played 1,384 minutes last year, third most in the nation and also third in single-season program history. Additionally, Coppola finished second in the SBC last season in both assist:turnover ratio (2.0) and assists (3.7 apg). This year, Coppola is averaging 11.3 points, 5.1 assists and 2.9 rebounds per game. He logs 36.7 minutes per game on the season which leads the conference and ranks 31st in the country
- Samuel has scored in double-figures 14 times this year and 22 times in his career. He poured in a career-high 19 points at No. 14 West Virginia and scored ULM's first 15 points of the contest. He also recorded a 15-point game at Arkansas State. Samuel averages 9.3 points and 4.6 rebounds per game on the year
- ULM is 9-1 since inserting Harvey into the starting lineup. He has hit 60-109 (.550) field goals this season and scored a career-high 20 points against South Alabama where he went 10-11 from the free throw line. He also started three games earlier in the season in-place of Deng. Harvey led the team in field goal percentage in back-to-back years coming into this season. He's reached double-figures in scoring six times this year and 10 times in his career
- Munnings ranks third in the SBC in field goal percentage (.527) and averages 8.3 points and 5.8 rebounds per game on the year. He recently concluded a six-game stretch where he went 9-11 from three-point range. Munnings has four double-doubles on the season and 11 double-figure scoring games. Munnings scored a career-high 22 points at Penn State and also pulled down 10 rebounds in the contest. He is now looked upon as ULM's

"sixth man" after starting the first 17 games of the season

- The Warhawks have won 10 weekly awards this year. Deng has won six including National Mid-Major Player of the Week (Dec. 7), Louisiana Player of the Week (Dec. 21) and College Sports Madness SBC Player of the Week (Jan. 25). He won three on Feb. 15 (SBC, LSWA and CSM). Roberson was named SBC Student-Athlete of the Week and Louisiana Player of the Week (Jan. 25), and Coppola won College Sports Madness SBC Player of the Week (Feb. 1) and Co-Louisiana Player of the Week (Feb. 22)
- In ULM's last 44 games against SBC opponents, it has only allowed 75 points three times. Ironically, all three resulted in wins, and twice the opposition made 15 three-pointers. The Warhawks held a streak of 47 consecutive games overall of not allowing a 75-point scorer, the second longest active streak in the nation, which was snapped at Houston on a jumper with nine seconds left
- Five different Warhawks have registered a double-double this season for a total of 14
- In the season sweep over Texas State, the Warhawks held the Bobcats to under 60 points in both contests. In the second meeting, the Warhawks jumped out to a 19-point advantage at halftime and never saw their lead drop below 15 points in the second half
- The season sweep over UTA saw two completely different flows. The first was a 99-88 three-point contest, while the second was a 64-61 defensive battle. At home, the Warhawks went 15-30 from three-point range. ULM was one three-pointer shy of tying the school record for most threes made in a game. It made 16 against Arkansas-Monticello on Dec. 3, 1996, and at Troy on Jan 27. 2007. Deng became the first Warhawk to make at least seven three-pointers in a game since Hugh Mingo in 2010-11. It was the 16th time in school history that a Warhawk made at least seven three-pointers in a game
- ULM's season sweep over Appalachian State was similar to UTA where the two games played out very differently. The Warhawks cruised to a wire-to-wire victory, 72-56 at home in the first meeting. The second came down to the very end as ULM scored the final six points of the game, including a game-winning drive by Coppola to put the Warhawks ahead 91-90 with 9.6 seconds left. ULM won despite the Mountaineers shooting a red-hot 60 percent from both the field and three-point range
- During ULM's first four-game SBC winning streak this year, it scored at least 85 points in three straight conference games for the first time since 1995-96 when it was a Southland Conference member
- Against UT Arlington at home, ULM came one point away from scoring 100 points in back-to-back games for the first time since the 1992-93 season when it defeated Nicholls State, 105-64 and Southern Miss, 113-106 (OT). The last time the Warhawks scored 100 points in back-to-back league games was in 1967-68

team in a single game this season. The Warhawks never trailed in the contest. It was ULM's third consecutive win over the Ragin' Cajuns as it swept the season series last year

- ULM holds back-to-back wins over teams selected to win their leagues in the preseason polls as it defeated Chattanooga, 64-54, in addition to UL-Lafayette. The Mocs were picked to win the Southern Conference and were ranked No. 8 in the CollegeInsider Mid-Major Top-25 poll at the time of the game
- The Warhawks pushed a pair of Big Ten opponents to the brink. ULM led 51-50 with 6:44 remaining at Minnesota, and 40-39 with 5:34 left at Penn State. The Warhawks were without Deng against the Nittany Lions
- Three of ULM's non-conference losses came without Deng (at Kent State, Penn State and West Virginia). He sat out for precautionary reasons due to a lower leg injury
- Keith Richard picked up his 200th career victory as a head coach in an 80-64 victory over NSU on Nov. 19. Both Deng and Munnings recorded double-doubles in the contest
- ULM opened the season with an 88-43 victory over McMurry. The 45-point margin of victory was ULM's largest in school history in a season opener. The Warhawks improved to 47-18 all-time in home openers
- Keith Richard is the reigning Sun Belt Conference and Louisiana Coach of the Year winner. It comes after a 24-win season, the third-most in school history and also the third biggest turnaround in the country from the year before. It was ULM's first 20-win season since 2001-02. Richard has more-than doubled ULM's win totals in back-to-back years
- The Warhawks made a run to the CBI championship series last year for their 10th postseason appearance in school history and the first since 1995-96. They played their first-ever game in the month of April in their 64-year history. They were also the first team from the SBC to ever play a game in April
- ULM picked up a pair of preseason honors as Deng was named to the 2015-16 All-Conference Second-Team, while Coppola earned recognition on the Third-Team. Deng was also named to the College Sports Madness Preseason All-SBC First-Team while Coppola was Third-Team
- The Warhawks were picked to finished third in the SBC Preseason Poll. It comes after they finished in a tie for second-place in the SBC standings last season. In 2013-14, ULM was picked to finish dead last preseason
- ULM is in its second season without any APR penalties which Richard inherited when he took over at the helm. Richard has turned the program around athletically and academically as the Warhawks have won back-to-back Sun Belt Conference academic awards
- The Warhawks honored their 1985-86 NCAA Tournament team on Feb. 13 at halftime against Arkansas State for their 30th anniversary. The Warhawks won both the Southland Conference Regular Season and Postseason titles that year

In conference games, South Alabama ranks second in the league in three-point defense, holding teams to a .321 clip. The Jaguars are also second in blocks with 3.6 per contest. Don MuepoKelly is the team's leading shot blocker with 18 on the year.

In his third season as head coach, Matthew Graves made it top priority to change the culture at South Alabama. He brought with him 17 years of success at Butler University, both as a student-athlete and coach. Graves overhauled the team on and off the court last year, resulting in the team's highest GPA in five seasons.

During his tenure at Butler, Graves helped the program to an overall record of 244-98 (71.3%), a berth in national postseason tournaments each of the last eight seasons and eight straight years with 20-plus victories. Following the 2009-10 campaign that saw the Bulldogs finish 33-5 after falling to Duke 61-59 in the national title contest, he was promoted to associate head coach.

MONROE, La. — All five starters scored in double-figures for the ULM men's basketball program as the Warhawks remained undefeated at home with a lopsided 100-68 victory over South Alabama on Saturday at Fant-Ewing Coliseum.

ULM (8-11, 4-4 SBC) improved to 7-0 at home this season and 4-0 in conference play. The Warhawks shot 32-61 (.525) from the field and made a season-high 28 free throws on 34 attempts.

Foster Comes Up Clutch Off the Bench in 64-61 Road Win at UT Arlington

ARLINGTON, Texas — Senior Mack Foster scored seven of ULM's last 11 points in the game to guide the men's basketball program to its fifth straight victory, 64-61 over UT Arlington on Saturday at the College Park Center.

Foster, who entered the game with a season-high of five points, was called upon after two different ULM student-athletes fouled out. The Warhawks (15-12, 11-5 SBC) led by one with 2:02 left when Foster drilled his second three-pointer of the game to push the lead up to 58-54.

Foster finished the game with 10 points and five rebounds in 17 minutes. He went 3-4 from the field, 2-2 from long-range and 2-2 from the charity stripe. Foster also got his hands on a pair of steals in the contest.

Coppola scored a game-high 19 points and also recorded six assists and three steals in 40 minutes. Senior Justin Roberson also finished in double-figures with 10 points and eight rebounds.

History Behind the 'Warhawk'

Moving into the Sun Belt Conference in the 2006-07 season, ULM's athletic department completed a transformation. The mascot holds a local historical connection to the P-40 'Warhawk' airplane flown by northeast Louisiana's General Claire Chennault and the Flying Tigers of WWII. The Warhawk is also symbolic of the red-shouldered hawk, a local predatory bird commonly found nesting along Bayou DeSiard and soaring above ULM's athletic facitilities. ULM's Warhawk moniker is the only one at the NCAA Division I level. Prior to becoming the ULM Warhawks, the school competed as the Northeast Louisiana Indians.




