ULM Notes

- The Warhawks clinched a double-bye into the semifinals of the Sun Belt Conference Championships and will play on Saturday, March 12 at 3:30 p.m. as the No. 2 seed against an opponent to be determined (bracket on page 7)
- ULM is on a seven-game winning streak, its longest in 17 seasons. It's also the fifth-longest active winning streak in the nation. The Warhawks also have the fourth-longest active road winning streak in the country with five (page 5)
- The Warhawks secured back-to-back winning seasons for the first time since 1992-93, 93-94. They also solidified back-to-back winning seasons in league play for the first time since 1998-99, 99-00
- ULM is 11-0 (8-0 SBC) at home this season, 25-4 (.862) at home over the last two seasons and 415-173 all-time in Fant-Ewing Coliseum (page 3)
- The Warhawks hold a 27-11 SBC record over the last two years, best in the league (page 4)
- ULM will finish ahead of where it was projected in the SBC Preseason Poll for the third year in a row. The Warhawks were picked to finish third this year (page 5)
- The Warhawks clinched their 40th winning season in school history. ULM is in its 65th season at the Division I level
- ULM won seven games in the month of February for the first time since 1995-96 $\,$
- The Warhawks have won seven games in a row and 11 of their last 12 since switching their starting lineup to junior Nick Coppola and seniors Justin Roberson, Majok Deng, Jamaal Samuel and DeMondre Harvey. Freshman Travis Munnings had started all 17 games previously and is now the "sixth man"
- Deng ranks third in the league in scoring (18.9 ppg) and second in SBC-only games (18.9 ppg). He ranks top-55 in the nation in scoring and top-five among internationally-born players

- The Warhawks have completed five season sweeps this year after taking both meetings against Appalachian State, Texas State, UT Arlington, South Alabama and Troy
- ULM is 10-0 in conference play this season when it scores at least 70 points, 8-0 when it shoots over 50 percent from the field and 7-0

when it has more points in the paint

- In SBC-games only, ULM leads the league in assist:turnover ratio (1.3) and is second in both field goal percentage (.454) and three-point field goal percentage (.381)
- The Warhawks hold a win over first-place Little Rock, 86-82 at home on Feb. 11. The Trojans came into the game with the best record in the nation. They were also ranked No. 2 in the Collegelnsider Mid-Major Top-25 Poll. It was ULM's second win over a top-10 team in the poll as it previously defeated No. 8 Chattanooga
- Deng is the team's leading scorer, rebounder and shot blocker and shoots a team-high .807 from the free throw line. He has scored at least 13 points in 20 of his last 22 outings. He has a trio of 30-plus scoring games this year, 10 20-plus scoring games
- Deng ranks fifth all-time in career blocks at ULM with 93. He needs six more to move into fourth and catch Terry Martin. He swatted away a career-high nine last weekend at UT Arlington. Deng also has 13 career double-doubles and 47 career double-figure scoring games in two seasons at ULM
- Roberson's scoring sky-rocketed in conference play this year as he went on a 10 game stretch totaling the nine highest scoring games of his career, all of at least 20 points. He scored a career-high 26 points against Troy at home. He averages 13.8 points, 4.8 rebounds and 2.6 assists per game on the year. Roberson is leading the team in steals for the second straight season and averages 1.6 per game on the year, third-best in the league. Roberson has reached double-figures 20 times this year and is shooting .420 from beyond-the-arc which ranks fourth in the league. It is a remarkable improvement from his .186 (8-43) three-point percentage last season. He has started every game his year
- Coppola needs 21 more assists to become the all-time leader in school history. In the ULM career record book, he ranks first all-time in minutes per game (35.6 mpg), second in assists (377), third in minutes played (3,348), fifth in games started (94), sixth in assists per game (4.0 apg) and seventh in three-pointers made (132). He's played at least 40 minutes 34 times in his career including a school record 54 minutes vs. Canisius. Coppola has started every game in his career. He played 1,384 minutes last year, third most in the nation and also third in single-season program history. Additionally, Coppola finished second in the SBC last season in both assist:turnover ratio (2.0) and assists (3.7 apg). This year, Coppola is averaging 11.5 points, 5.1 assists and 2.9 rebounds per game. He logs 36.7 minutes per game on the season which leads the conference and ranks top-25 in the country

- Samuel has scored in double-figures 15 times this year and 23 times in his career. He scored a game-high 15 points last weekend at South Alabama. Samuel poured in a career-high 19 points at No. 14 West Virginia and scored ULM's first 15 points of the contest. He also recorded a 15-point game at Arkansas State. Samuel averages 9.3 points and 4.8 rebounds per game on the year
- ULM is 11-1 since inserting Harvey into the starting lineup. He has hit 66-121 (.545) field goals this season and scored a career-high 20 points against South Alabama at home where he went 10-11 from the free throw line. He also started three games earlier in the season in-place of Deng. Harvey led the team in field goal percentage in back-to-back years coming into this season. He's reached double-figures in scoring seven times this year and 11 times in his career
- Munnings ranks fourth in the SBC in field goal percentage (.514) and averages 7.9 points and 5.8 rebounds per game on the year. He went on a six-game stretch in conference where he went 9-11 from three-point range. Munnings has four double-doubles on the season and 11 double-figure scoring games. He scored a career-high 22 points at Penn State and also pulled down 10 rebounds in the contest. Munnings is now looked upon as ULM's "sixth man" after starting the first 17 games of the season
- The Warhawks have won 10 weekly awards this year. Deng has won six including National Mid-Major Player of the Week (Dec. 7), Louisiana Player of the Week (Dec. 21) and College Sports Madness SBC Player of the Week (Jan. 25). He won three on Feb. 15 (SBC, LSWA and CSM). Roberson was named SBC Student-Athlete of the Week and Louisiana Player of the Week (Jan. 25), and Coppola won College Sports Madness SBC Player of the Week (Feb. 1) and Co-Louisiana Player of the Week (Feb. 22)
- In ULM's last 46 games against SBC opponents, it has only allowed 75 points three times. Ironically, all three resulted in wins, and twice the opposition made 15 three-pointers. The Warhawks held a streak of 47 consecutive games overall of not allowing a 75-point scorer, the second longest active streak in the nation, which was snapped at Houston on a jumper with nine seconds left
- Five different Warhawks have registered a double-double this season for a total of 14

- The season sweep over UTA saw two completely different flows. The first was a 99-88 three-point contest, while the second was a 64-61 defensive battle. At home, the Warhawks went 15-30 from three-point range. ULM was one three-pointer shy of tying the school record for most threes made in a game. It made 16 against Arkansas-Monticello on Dec. 3, 1996, and at Troy on Jan 27. 2007. Deng became the first Warhawk to make at least seven three-pointers in a game since Hugh Mingo in 2010-11. It was the 16th time in school history that a Warhawk made at least seven three-pointers in a game
- ULM's season sweep over Appalachian State was similar to UTA where the two games played out very differently. The Warhawks cruised to a wire-to-wire victory, 72-56 at home in the first meeting. The second came down to the very end as ULM scored the final six points of the game, including a game-winning drive by Coppola to put the Warhawks ahead 91-90 with 9.6 seconds left. ULM won despite the Mountaineers shooting a red-hot 60 percent from both the field and three-point range
- During ULM's first four-game SBC winning streak this year, it scored at least 85 points in three straight conference games for the first time since 1995-96 when it was a Southland Conference member
- ULM's 32-point win over South Alabama, 100-68, at home in the first meeting was its largest margin of victory over an SBC opponent since Feb. 22, 2007 when it thumped Denver, 87-51 at home
- Against UT Arlington at home, ULM came one point away from scoring 100 points in back-to-back games for the first time since the 1992-93 season when it defeated Nicholls State, 105-64 and Southern Miss, 113-106 (OT). The last time the Warhawks scored 100 points in back-to-back league games was in 1967-68 when ULM fell in overtime to both Northwestern State 114-111 and Southeastern Louisiana 103-101 as a member of the Gulf States Conference
- The Warhawks opened league play with an 81-70 win over Sun Belt Conference preseason favorite UL-Lafayette. ULM shot 9-15 from beyond-the-arc; the .600 percentage was the highest by an SBC team in a single game this season. The Warhawks never trailed in the contest. It was ULM's third consecutive win over the Ragin' Cajuns as it swept the season series last year
- ULM holds back-to-back wins over teams selected to win their leagues in the preseason polls as it defeated Chattanooga, 64-54, in addition to UL-Lafayette. The Mocs were picked to win the Southern Conference and were ranked No. 8 in the CollegeInsider Mid-Major Top-25 poll at the time of the game

- The Warhawks pushed a pair of Big Ten opponents to the brink. ULM led 51-50 with 6:44 remaining at Minnesota, and 40-39 with 5:34 left at Penn State. The Warhawks were without Deng against the Nittany Lions
- Three of ULM's non-conference losses came without Deng (at Kent State, Penn State and West Virginia). He sat out for precautionary reasons due to a lower leg injury
- Keith Richard picked up his 200th career victory as a head coach in an 80-64 victory over NSU on Nov. 19. Both Deng and Munnings recorded double-doubles in the contest
- ULM opened the season with an 88-43 victory over McMurry. The 45-point margin of victory was ULM's largest in school history in a season opener. The Warhawks improved to 47-18 all-time in home openers
- Keith Richard is the reigning Sun Belt Conference and Louisiana Coach of the Year winner. It came after a 24-win season, the third-most in school history and also the third biggest turnaround in the country from the year before. It was ULM's first 20-win season since 2001-02. Richard has more-than doubled ULM's win totals in back-to-back years
- The Warhawks made a run to the CBI championship series last year for their 10th postseason appearance in school history and the first since 1995-96. They played their first-ever game in the month of April in their 64-year history. They were also the first team from the SBC to ever play a game in April
- ULM picked up a pair of preseason honors as Deng was named to the 2015-16 All-Conference Second-Team, while Coppola earned recognition on the Third-Team. Deng was also named to the College Sports Madness Preseason All-SBC First-Team while Coppola was Third-Team
- The Warhawks were picked to finished third in the SBC Preseason Poll. It comes after they finished in a tie for second-place in the SBC standings last season. In 2013-14, ULM was picked to finish dead last preseason
- ULM is in its second season without any APR penalties which Richard inherited when he took over at the helm. Richard has turned the program around athletically and academically as the Warhawks have won back-to-back-to-back Sun Belt Conference academic awards
- The Warhawks honored their 1985-86 NCAA Tournament team on Feb. 13 at halftime against Arkansas State for their 30th anniversary. The Warhawks won both the Southland Conference Regular Season and Postseason titles that year

The Eagles (14-14, 10-8 SBC) are coming off a 2-0 week after topping Georgia State, 54-52 and Appalachian State, 88-63 at home. They recently wrapped up a four-game homestand where they went 3-1 after splitting the previous weekend against Arkansas State (W, 90-59) and Little Rock (L, 75-61).

As a team, the Eagles lead the league in three-pointers made (9.4 3PG) and steals (7.8 spg). Brown and Hughes both shoot over 36.5 percent from long range and are the two league leaders in steals in front of Justin Roberson.

Mark Byington is in his third season as head coach. In his first year, he recorded the first 20-win season in a decade at Georgia Southern. Last season, he coached the Eagles to their first conference championship game in two decades after a 22-win campaign. Byington previously spent nine seasons as an assistant coach at the College of Charleston. CofC posted an overall record of 194-100 and a 108-51 mark in the SoCon during Byington's time there, including six 20-win seasons and three regular season titles.

Roberson's Career-High Not Enough for ULM at Georgia Southern

STATESBORO, Ga. – Senior Justin Roberson netted a career-high 20 points, but the ULM men's basketball program dropped a 66-51 decision to Georgia Southern on Saturday at Hanner Fieldhouse.

Roberson went 7-15 from the field and drained a trio of three-pointers. Senior Majok Deng also made a big contribution for ULM (6-11, 2-4 SBC) as he totaled 14 points and 11 rebounds. It was Deng's fourth double-double of the season.

Mike Hughes led the Eagles (6-10, 2-4 SBC) with 15 points and six rebounds. Ike Smith recorded 14 points and six rebounds, while Tookie Brown registered 12 points.

Georgia Southern shot 21-50 (.420) from the field and held the Warhawks to an 18-59 (.305) mark. The Eagles also went 16-20 (.800) from the free throw line.

Roberson scored the first four points of the second half to make it a 32-25 game with 16:42 to go. The Eagles made five consecutive field goals to push their lead up to 43-31 with 13:21 remaining. ULM answered with an 8-0 run which included a three-pointer by Deng and five points from Roberson to get the deficit down to 43-39 at the 10:58 mark.

GSO responded with a pair of three-pointers to go back up 49-39 at the nine-minute mark. The Eagles extended their lead to 56-42 with 5:39 remaining after a 7-0 run.

In ULM's Last Outing...

<u>Decisive 66-51 Win over Troy Extends Winning Streak to Seven,</u> <u>Longest in 17 Years</u>

TROY, Ala. – Clinching a double-bye to the semifinals of the Sun Belt Conference Championships, the ULM men's basketball program won its seventh consecutive game, 66-51 over Troy on Saturday at Trojan Arena.

It's the longest winning streak for the Warhawks (17-12, 13-5 SBC) since 1998-99. Also, with 17 wins ULM secured back-to-back winning seasons overall for the first time since 1992-93, 93-94.

ULM held Troy (9-20, 4-14 SBC) to a .291 shooting percentage in the game and .233 in the second half. The Warhawks shot exactly 13-29 (.448) in both halves.

Senior Majok Deng scored a team-high 16 points and grabbed seven rebounds. Reigning Co-Louisiana Player of the Week winner, junior Nick Coppola, finished with 14 points and five assists, and senior DeMondre Harvey tallied 11 points and seven rebounds.

The Trojans were led by John Walton III who scored a game-high 18 points. Jordon Varnado pitched in with 16, and Wesley Person had 10. Person entered the game as the team's leading scorer and the reigning SBC Freshman of the Year winner.

History Behind the 'Warhawk'

Moving into the Sun Belt Conference in the 2006-07 season, ULM's athletic department completed a transformation. The mascot holds a local historical connection to the P-40 'Warhawk' airplane flown by northeast Louisiana's General Claire Chennault and the Flying Tigers of WWII. The Warhawk is also symbolic of the red-shouldered hawk, a local predatory bird commonly found nesting along Bayou DeSiard and soaring above ULM's athletic facitilities. ULM's Warhawk moniker is the only one at the NCAA Division I level. Prior to becoming the ULM Warhawks, the school competed as the Northeast Louisiana Indians.
