ULM Notes

- The Warhawks clinched a double-bye into the semifinals of the Sun Belt Conference Championships and will play on Saturday, March 12 at 3:30 p.m. as the No. 2 seed against an opponent to be determined (bracket on page 7)
- ULM is on an eight-game winning streak, its longest in 17 seasons. It's also the fourth-longest active winning streak in the nation. The Warhawks also have the fourth-longest active road winning streak in the country with five (page 5)
- The Warhawks secured back-to-back winning seasons for the first time since 1992-93, 93-94. They also solidified back-to-back winning seasons in league play for the first time since 1998-99, 99-00
- ULM is 12-0 (9-0 SBC) at home this season, 26-4 (.867) at home over the last two seasons and 416-173 all-time in Fant-Ewing Coliseum (page 3)
- The Warhawks hold a 28-11 SBC record over the last two years, best in the league by three and a half games (page 4)
- ULM will finish ahead of where it was projected in the SBC Preseason Poll for the third year in a row. The Warhawks were picked to finish third this year (page 5)
- The Warhawks clinched their 40th winning season in school history. ULM is in its 65th season at the Division I level
- The Warhawks have won eight games in a row and 12 of their last 13 since switching their starting lineup to junior Nick Coppola and seniors Justin Roberson, Majok Deng, Jamaal Samuel and DeMondre Harvey. Freshman Travis Munnings had started all 17 games previously and is now the "sixth man"
- ULM won seven games in the month of February for the first time since 1995-96
- Deng ranks third in the league in scoring (18.8 ppg) and third in SBC-only games (18.8 ppg). He ranks top-55 in the nation in scoring and top-five among internationally-born players

- Coppola needs 14 more assists to become the all-time leader at ULM and catch Larry Saulters who dished out 398

- ULM is coming off an 83-76 victory over Georgia Southern on Thursday. Both Deng and Harvey recorded double-doubles. ULM never trailed after the first 1:30 of the game

- The Warhawks are 5-5 all-time against Georgia State and 3-2 at home

- The Warhawks have completed five season sweeps this year after taking both meetings against Appalachian State, Texas State, UT Arlington, South Alabama and Troy

- ULM is 11-0 in conference play this season when it scores at least 70 points, 9-0 when it shoots over 50 percent from the field and 8-0 when it has more points in the paint

- ULM ranks first in the league in field goal percentage (.455), second in assists (13.9 apg) and top-three in three-point field goal percentage (.353), rebounding margin (+2.5) and assist:turnover ratio (1.1)

- Deng is the team's leading scorer, rebounder and shot blocker and shoots a team-high .810 from the free throw line. He has scored at least 13 points in 21 of his last 23 outings. He has a trio of 30-plus scoring games this year, 10 20-plus scoring games

- Deng ranks fifth all-time in career blocks at ULM with 96. He needs three more to move into fourth and catch Terry Martin. He swatted away a career-high nine last weekend at UT Arlington. Deng also has 14 career double-doubles and 48 career double-figure scoring games in two seasons at ULM

- Roberson's scoring sky-rocketed in conference play this year as he went on a 10 game stretch totaling the nine highest scoring games of his career, all of at least 20 points. He scored a career-high 26 points against Troy at home. He averages 13.9 points, 4.7 rebounds and 2.6 assists per game on the year. Roberson is leading the team in steals for the second straight season and averages 1.6 per game on the year, third-best in the league. Roberson has reached double-figures 21 times this year and is shooting .417 from beyond-the-arc which ranks fourth in the league. It is a remarkable improvement from his .186 (8-43) three-point percentage last season. He has started every game his year

- In the ULM career record book, Coppola ranks first all-time in minutes per game (35.6 mpg), second in assists (384), third in minutes played (3,386), fifth in games started (95), sixth in assists per game (4.0 apg) and seventh in three-pointers made (132). He's played at least 40 minutes 34 times in his career including a school record 54 minutes vs. Canisius. Coppola has started every game in his career. He played 1,384 minutes last year, third most in the nation and also third in single-season program history. Additionally, Coppola finished second in the SBC last season in both assist:turnover ratio (2.0) and assists (3.7 apg). This year, Coppola is averaging 11.4 points, 5.2 assists and

3.0 rebounds per game. He logs 36.8 minutes per game on the season which leads the conference and ranks top-25 in the country

- Samuel has scored in double-figures 15 times this year and 23 times in his career. He scored a game-high 15 points last weekend at South Alabama. Samuel poured in a career-high 19 points at No. 14 West Virginia and scored ULM's first 15 points of the contest. He also recorded a 15-point game at Arkansas State. Samuel averages 9.3 points and 4.8 rebounds per game on the year

- ULM is 12-1 since inserting Harvey into the starting lineup. He has hit 73-131 (.557) field goals this season and scored a career-high 20 points against South Alabama at home where he went 10-11 from the free throw line. He also started three games earlier in the season in-place of Deng. Harvey led the team in field goal percentage in back-to-back years coming into this season. He's reached double-figures in scoring eight times this year and 12 times in his career

- Munnings ranks fourth in the SBC in field goal percentage (.516) and averages 7.9 points and 5.7 rebounds per game on the year. He went on a six-game stretch in conference where he went 9-11 from three-point range. Munnings has four double-doubles on the season and 11 double-figure scoring games. He scored a career-high 22 points at Penn State and also pulled down 10 rebounds in the contest. Munnings is now looked upon as ULM's "sixth man" after starting the first 17 games of the season

- The Warhawks have won 10 weekly awards this year. Deng has won six including National Mid-Major Player of the Week (Dec. 7), Louisiana Player of the Week (Dec. 21) and College Sports Madness SBC Player of the Week (Jan. 25). He won three on Feb. 15 (SBC, LSWA and CSM). Roberson was named SBC Student-Athlete of the Week and Louisiana Player of the Week (Jan. 25), and Coppola won College Sports Madness SBC Player of the Week (Feb. 1) and Co-Louisiana Player of the Week (Feb. 22)

- In ULM's last 47 games against SBC opponents, it has only allowed 75 points four times. Ironically, all four resulted in wins, and three times the opposition made at least 15 three-pointers. The Warhawks held a streak of 47 consecutive games overall of not allowing a 75-point scorer, the second longest active streak in the nation, which was snapped at Houston on a jumper with nine seconds left

- Five different Warhawks have registered a double-double this season for a total of 16

- The Warhawks hold a win over first-place

Little Rock, 86-82 at home on Feb. 11. The Trojans came into the game

with the best record in the nation. They were also ranked No. 2 in the CollegiateInsider Mid-Major Top-25 Poll. It was ULM's second win over a top-10 team in the poll as it previously defeated No. 8 Chattanooga

- In the season sweep over Texas State, the Warhawks held the Bobcats to under 60 points in both contests. In the second meeting, the Warhawks jumped out to a 19-point advantage at halftime and never saw their lead drop below 15 points in the second half

- The season sweep over UTA saw two completely different flows. The first was a 99-88 three-point contest, while the second was a 64-61 defensive battle. At home, the Warhawks went 15-30 from three-point range. ULM was one three-pointer shy of tying the school record for most threes made in a game. It made 16 against Arkansas-Monticello on Dec. 3, 1996, and at Troy on Jan 27, 2007. Deng became the first Warhawk to make at least seven three-pointers in a game since Hugh Mingo in 2010-11. It was the 16th time in school history that a Warhawk made at least seven three-pointers in a game

- ULM's season sweep over Appalachian State was similar to UTA where the two games played out very differently. The Warhawks cruised to a wire-to-wire victory, 72-56 at home in the first meeting. The second came down to the very end as ULM scored the final six points of the game, including a game-winning drive by Coppola to put the Warhawks ahead 91-90 with 9.6 seconds left. ULM won despite the Mountaineers shooting a red-hot 60 percent from both the field and three-point range

- During ULM's first four-game SBC winning streak this year, it scored at least 85 points in three straight conference games for the first time since 1995-96 when it was a Southland Conference member

- ULM's 32-point win over South Alabama, 100-68, at home in the first meeting was its largest margin of victory over an SBC opponent since Feb. 22, 2007 when it thumped Denver, 87-51 at home

- Against UT Arlington at home, ULM came one point away from scoring 100 points in back-to-back games for the first time since the 1992-93 season when it defeated Nicholls State, 105-64 and Southern Miss, 113-106 (OT). The last time the Warhawks scored 100 points in back-to-back league games was in 1967-68 when ULM fell in overtime to both Northwestern State 114-111 and Southeastern Louisiana 103-101 as a member of the Gulf States Conference

- The Warhawks opened league play with an 81-70 win over Sun Belt Conference preseason favorite UL-Lafayette. ULM shot 9-15 from beyond-the-arc; the .600 percentage was the highest by an SBC team

in a single game this season. The Warhawks never trailed in the contest. It was ULM's third consecutive win over the Ragin' Cajuns as it swept the season series last year

- ULM holds back-to-back wins over teams selected to win their leagues in the preseason polls as it defeated Chattanooga, 64-54, in addition to UL-Lafayette. The Mocs were picked to win the Southern Conference and were ranked No. 8 in the CollegeInsider Mid-Major Top-25 poll at the time of the game

- The Warhawks pushed a pair of Big Ten opponents to the brink. ULM led 51-50 with 6:44 remaining at Minnesota, and 40-39 with 5:34 left at Penn State. The Warhawks were without Deng against the Nittany Lions

- Three of ULM's non-conference losses came without Deng (at Kent State, Penn State and West Virginia). He sat out for precautionary reasons due to a lower leg injury

- Keith Richard picked up his 200th career victory as a head coach in an 80-64 victory over NSU on Nov. 19. Both Deng and Munnings recorded double-doubles in the contest

- ULM opened the season with an 88-43 victory over McMurry. The 45-point margin of victory was ULM's largest in school history in a season opener. The Warhawks improved to 47-18 all-time in home openers

- Keith Richard is the reigning Sun Belt Conference and Louisiana Coach of the Year winner. It came after a 24-win season, the third-most in school history and also the third biggest turnaround in the country from the year before. It was ULM's first 20-win season since 2001-02. Richard has more-than doubled ULM's win totals in back-to-back years

- The Warhawks made a run to the CBI championship series last year for their 10th postseason appearance in school history and the first since 1995-96. They played their first-ever game in the month of April in their 64-year history. They were also the first team from the SBC to ever play a game in April

- ULM picked up a pair of preseason honors as Deng was named to the 2015-16 All-Conference Second-Team, while Coppola earned recognition on the Third-Team. Deng was also named to the College Sports Madness Preseason All-SBC First-Team while Coppola was Third-Team

- The Warhawks were picked to finished third in the SBC Preseason Poll. It comes after they finished in a tie for second-place in the SBC standings last season. In 2013-14, ULM was picked to finish dead last preseason

- ULM is in its second season without any APR penalties which Richard inherited when he took over at the helm. Richard has turned the program around athletically and academically as the Warhawks have won back-to-back-to-back Sun Belt Conference academic awards

- The Warhawks honored their 1985-86 NCAA Tournament team on Feb. 13 at halftime against Arkansas State for their 30th anniversary. The Warhawks won both the Southland Conference Regular Season and Postseason titles that year

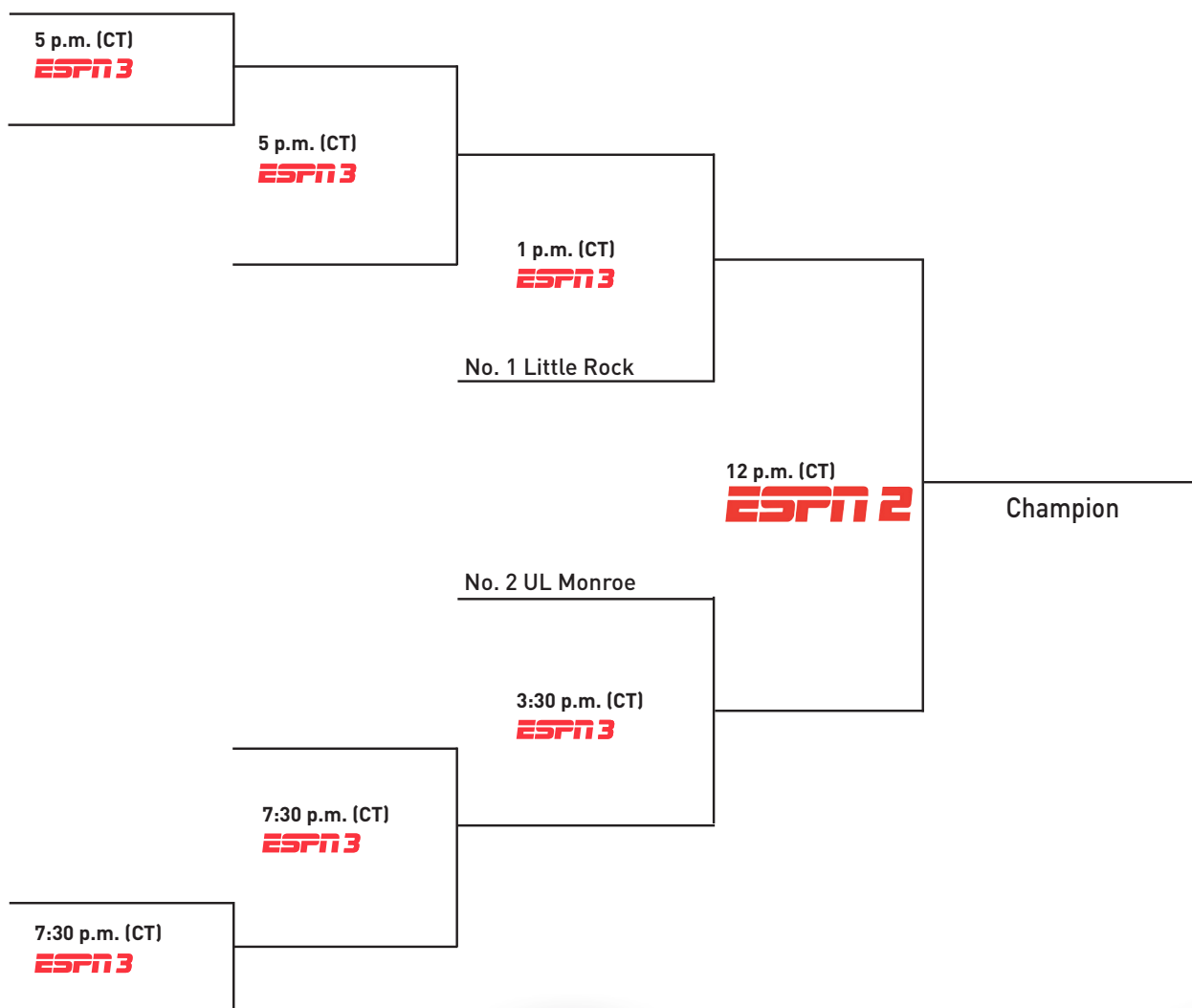

Scouting Georgia State

Georgia State (16-12, 9-10 SBC) is coming off back-to-back wins against Appalachian State at home, 83-70 and at UL-Lafayette, 72-69. The Panthers are the defending regular season and postseason SBC champions from last year.

Jeremy Hollowell leads the team with 14.7 points per game, while Kevin Ware averages 12.4 points per outing. Isaiah Williams aids the attack with 9.4 points per outing. Hollowell, Ware and Williams all shoot at least 37 percent from three-point range.

In conference games, GSU ranks second in the league in scoring defense, holding teams to just 66.4 points per game. It's also second in turnover margin (+1.9) and third in three-point field goal percentage, shooting at a .345 clip.

In four seasons, Ron Hunter has taken GSU to the postseason three times. He's posted back-to-back 25-win seasons including last year where the Panthers defeated Baylor in the NCAA Tournament as a No. 14 seed. Hunter has tallied three of the four winningest seasons in school history. In his first season, GSU won 22 games and advanced to the CIT. In 2014-15, the Panthers played in the NIT after winning the SBC regular season. Hunter previously coached 17 seasons at IUPUI and was the school's winningest coach, both in total wins and winning percentage. He coached IUPUI to its only NCAA Tournament appearance in school history in 2002-03.

ULM Falls to Georgia State Despite Strong Efforts off the Bench

ATLANTA – Juniors Prince Cooper and Marcus Washington recorded career-highs off the bench, but the ULM men's basketball couldn't overcome a slow start and dropped a 65-51 decision to Georgia State on Thursday at GSU Sports Arena.

ULM (6-10, 2-3 SBC) trailed Georgia State (11-3, 4-1 SBC) by 18 points at the half and 26 points in the second half, but came back to outscore the Panthers 16-4 over the last eight minutes.

Cooper finished with 12 points to match his career-high. He went five-for-seven from the field and grabbed five rebounds in 20 minutes. Washington set career-highs of 10 points and five rebounds.

The Warhawks outscored the Panthers 30-26 off the bench. Senior DeMondre Harvey pitched in with eight points on three-for-three shooting. It marked the first time this season that more than half of ULM's scoring in the game came from off the bench.

GSU, the defending Sun Belt Conference regular season and postseason champion, used a big 16-1 run in the first half to go up 31-13 with 5:07 remaining after making six of its first seven three-pointers. The Warhawks couldn't get into enough of a flow offensively to get back in it until the very end.

The Panthers were led by Jeff Thomas who scored 14 points and went four-for-five from long-range. Jeremy Hollowell and Isaiah Thomas scored 10 points apiece.

MONROE, La. – Junior DeMondre Harvey notched career-highs of 13 points and 15 rebounds, but the ULM men's basketball program fell, 58-50 to Georgia State on Thursday at Fant-Ewing Coliseum.

In ULM's Last Outing...

Double-Doubles from Deng, Harvey Propel ULM to Eighth-Straight Victory

MONROE, La. — Improving to 12-0 at home this season, the ULM men's basketball program won its eighth-consecutive game overall and 12th of its last 13 with an 83-76 victory over Georgia Southern on Thursday at Fant-Ewing Coliseum.

GSO (14-15, 10-9 SBC) scored the first basket of the game on a three-pointer, but the Warhawks (18-12, 14-5 SBC) quickly responded with a 10-0 run and never trailed again.

ULM finished on top despite the Eagles shooting 16-30 (.533) from three-point range. However, GSO was held to a 23-60 (.383) mark overall, while the Warhawks went 33-61 (.541) from the field.

Senior Justin Roberson registered a game-high 18 points. Senior Majok Deng finished with 16 points and 11 rebounds, while senior DeMondre Harvey ended with 16 points and 10 rebounds. Junior Nick Coppola tallied nine points, seven assists, five rebounds and just one turnover in 38 minutes.

All seven ULM student-athletes that played scored at least seven points as freshman Travis Munnings notched nine, senior Jamaal Samuel eight and senior Mack Foster seven.

GSO was led by Mike Hughes' 24 points, including five three-pointers. Tookie Brown recorded 17 points, Ike Smith 14 and Jake Allsmiller 12.

History Behind the 'Warhawk'

Moving into the Sun Belt Conference in the 2006-07 season, ULM's athletic department completed a transformation. The mascot holds a local historical connection to the P-40 'Warhawk' airplane flown by northeast Louisiana's General Claire Chennault and the Flying Tigers of WWII. The Warhawk is also symbolic of the red-shouldered hawk, a local predatory bird commonly found nesting along Bayou DeSiard and soaring above ULM's athletic facilities. ULM's Warhawk moniker is the only one at the NCAA Division I level. Prior to becoming the ULM Warhawks, the school competed as the Northeast Louisiana Indians.

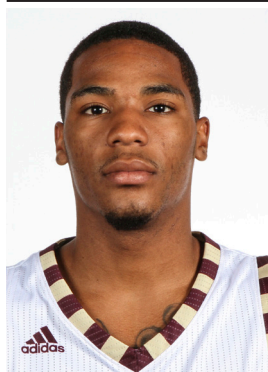
