### ULM Notes

- Senior Majok Deng was named to the All-Sun Belt Conference First-Team, and senior Justin Roberson won Defensive Student-Athlete of the Year honors and All-SBC Second-Team. Deng is also the reigning Sun Belt Student-Athlete of the Week honoree. Junior Nick Coppola needs three more assists to become the all-time leader in school history

- ULM is on an nine-game winning streak, its longest in 17 seasons. It's also the third-longest active winning streak in the nation. The Warhawks also have the third-longest active road winning streak in the country with five (page 5)

- The Warhawks are looking to win 10 games in a row for the first time since 1993-94. The nine-game winning streak is the ninth longest in school history (page 8)

- ULM is one win away from back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time since 1989-90, 1990-91. ULM won 24 games last year. It would be just the third time in school history that the Warhawks had consecutive 20-win campaigns

- The Warhawks secured back-to-back winning seasons for the first time since 1992-93, 93-94. They also solidified back-to-back winning seasons in league play for the first time since 1998-99, 99-00

- With 15 SBC wins, the Warhawks improved their conference win total for the fourth consecutive year

- ULM was 13-0 (10-0 SBC) at home this season, 27-4 at home over the last two seasons and 417-173 all-time in Fant-Ewing Coliseum (page 3)

- The Warhawks hold a 29-11 SBC record over the last two years, best in the league by four games (page 8)

- ULM finished ahead of where it was projected in the SBC Preseason Poll for the third year in a row. The Warhawks were picked to finish third this year (page 5)

- The Warhawks clinched their 40th winning season in school history. ULM is in its 65th season of the Division I level

### ULM Student-Athlete Notes

- Deng is the 2015-16 SBC scoring champion and ranks fifth in the country among internationally-born players. Deng also finished first in the league blocks, third in minutes and offensive rebounds, fifth in three-point field goal percentage, sixth in three-pointers per game, seventh in rebounding and eighth in free throw percentage. Deng has

scored at least 13 points in 22 of his last 24 outings. He has a trio of 30-plus scoring games this year and 11 20-plus scoring games. Deng ranks fourth all-time in career blocks at ULM with 99 and swatted away a career-high nine at UT Arlington. Deng also has 14 career double-doubles and 50 career double-figure scoring games in two seasons at ULM

- Roberson's scoring sky-rocketed in conference play this year as he went on a 10 game stretch totaling the nine highest scoring games of his career, all of at least 20 points. He scored a career-high 26 points against Troy at home. He averages 14.1 points, 4.7 rebounds and 2.6 assists per game on the year. Roberson is leading the team in steals for the second straight season and averages 1.5 per game on the year, second-best in the league. Roberson has reached double-figures 22 times this year and is shooting .420 from beyond-the-arc which ranks third in the league. It is a remarkable improvement from his .186 (8-43) three-point percentage last season. He has started every game his year

- In the ULM career record book, Coppola ranks first all-time in minutes per game (35.7 mpg), second in assists (395), third in minutes played (3,425), fifth in games started (96), sixth in assists per game (4.1 apg) and seventh in three-pointers made (133). He's played at least 40 minutes 34 times in his career including a school record 54 minutes vs. Canisius. Coppola has started every game in his career. He played 1,384 minutes last year, third most in the nation and also third in single-season program history. Additionally, Coppola finished second in the SBC last season in both assist:turnover ratio (2.0) and assists (3.7 apg)

- This year, Coppola is averaging 11.3 points, 5.4 assists and 2.9 rebounds per game. He logs 36.8 minutes per game on the season which leads the conference and ranks top-25 in the country. In SBC-only games, Coppola finished first in the league in minutes (38.0 mpg) and second in both assists (5.8 apg) and assist:turnover ratio (3.1)

- Senior Jamaal Samuel has scored in double-figures 16 times this year and 24 times in his career. He scored 12 points in the regular-season finale vs. Georgia State and a game-high 15 points in the previous weekend at South Alabama. Samuel poured in a career-high 19 points at No. 14 West Virginia and scored ULM's first 15 points of the contest. He also recorded a 15-point game at Arkansas State. Samuel averages 9.4 points and 4.8 rebounds per game on the year. He's one of five Warhawks shooting at least 35 percent from three-point range

- ULM is 13-1 since inserting senior DeMondre Harvey into the starting lineup. He has hit 76-136 (.559) field goals this season and scored a career-high 20 points against South Alabama at home where he went 10-11 from the free throw line. Harvey is coming off a 17-point, seven rebound outing in the

regular-season finale against Georgia State. He also started three games earlier in the season in-place of Deng. Harvey led the team in field goal percentage in back-to-back years coming into this season. He's reached double-figures in scoring nine times this year and 13 times in his career

- Freshman Travis Munnings ranks fourth in the SBC in field goal percentage (.516) and averages 7.9 points and 5.6 rebounds per game on the year. He went on a six-game stretch in conference where he went 9-11 from three-point range. Munnings has four double-doubles on the season and 11 double-figure scoring games. He scored a career-high 22 points at Penn State and also pulled down 10 rebounds in the contest. Munnings is now looked upon as ULM's "sixth man" after starting the first 17 games of the season

- Senior Mack Foster completes ULM's usual seven-man rotation and comes in as a defensive specialist. However, his scoring production has gone up as of late as he's scored at least seven points in four of the last five games. In a road game at UT Arlington, he tipped in the game-winning basket and went 3-4 FG for a season-high 10 points. He scored a career-high 15 points last season at Troy

- The Warhawks have completed five season sweeps this year after taking both meetings against Appalachian State, Texas State, UT Arlington, South Alabama and Troy

- ULM finished 12-0 in conference play this season when it scored at least 70 points, 10-0 when it shot over 50 percent from the field and 9-0 when it had more points in the paint

- ULM ranks first in the league in field goal percentage (.455), second in assists (14.1 apg) and top-three in three-point field goal percentage (.354), rebounding margin (+2.9) and assist:turnover ratio (1.1)

- The Warhawks have won 11 weekly awards this year. Deng has won seven including National Mid-Major Player of the Week (Dec. 7), Louisiana Player of the Week (Dec. 21), College Sports Madness SBC Player of the Week (Jan. 25) and Sun Belt Conference Student-Athlete of the Week (March 7). He won three on Feb. 15 (SBC, LSWA and CSM). Roberson was named SBC Student-Athlete of the Week and Louisiana Player of the Week (Jan. 25), and Coppola won College Sports Madness SBC Player of the Week (Feb. 1) and Co-Louisiana Player of the Week (Feb. 22)

- Five different Warhawks have registered a double-double this season for a total of 16

- ULM won seven games in the month of February for the first time since 1995-96

- In ULM's last 48 games against SBC opponents, it has only allowed 75 points five times. Ironically, all five resulted in wins, and three times the opposition made at least 15 three-pointers. The Warhawks held a streak of 47 consecutive games overall of not allowing a 75-point scorer, the second longest active streak in the nation, which was snapped at Houston on a jumper with nine seconds left

- The Warhawks hold a win over first-place Little Rock, 86-82 at home on Feb. 11. The Trojans came into the game with the best record in the nation. They were also ranked No. 2 in the CollegiateInsider Mid-Major Top-25 Poll. It was ULM's second win over a top-10 team in the poll as it previously defeated No. 8 Chattanooga

- In the season sweep over Texas State, the Warhawks held the Bobcats to under 60 points in both contests. In the second meeting, the Warhawks jumped out to a 19-point advantage at halftime and never saw their lead drop below 15 points in the second half

- The season sweep over UTA saw two completely different flows. The first was a 99-88 three-point contest, while the second was a 64-61 defensive battle. At home, the Warhawks went 15-30 from three-point range. ULM was one three-pointer shy of tying the school record for most threes made in a game. It made 16 against Arkansas-Monticello on Dec. 3, 1996, and at Troy on Jan 27, 2007. Deng became the first Warhawk to make at least seven three-pointers in a game since Hugh Mingo in 2010-11. It was the 16th time in school history that a Warhawk made at least seven three-pointers in a game

- ULM's season sweep over Appalachian State was similar to UTA where the two games played out very differently. The Warhawks cruised to a wire-to-wire victory, 72-56 at home in the first meeting. The second came down to the very end as ULM scored the final six points of the game, including a game-winning drive by Coppola to put the Warhawks ahead 91-90 with 9.6 seconds left. ULM won despite the Mountaineers shooting a red-hot 60 percent from both the field and three-point range

- During ULM's first four-game SBC winning streak this year, it scored at least 85 points in three straight conference games for the first time since 1995-96 when it was a Southland Conference member

- ULM's 32-point win over South Alabama, 100-68, at home in the first meeting was its largest margin of victory over an SBC opponent since Feb. 22, 2007 when it thumped Denver, 87-51 at home

- Against UT Arlington at home, ULM came one point away from scoring 100 points in back-to-back games for the first time since the 1992-93 season when it defeated Nicholls State, 105-64 and Southern Miss, 113-106 (OT). The last time the Warhawks scored 100 points in back-to-back league games was in 1967-68 when ULM fell in overtime to both Northwestern State 114-111 and Southeastern Louisiana 103-101 as a member of the Gulf States Conference

- The Warhawks opened league play with an 81-70 win over Sun Belt Conference preseason favorite UL-Lafayette. ULM shot 9-15 from beyond-the-arc; the .600 percentage was the highest by an SBC team in a single game this season. The Warhawks never trailed in the contest. It was ULM's third consecutive win over the Ragin' Cajuns as it swept the season series last year

- ULM holds back-to-back wins over teams selected to win their leagues in the preseason polls as it defeated Chattanooga, 64-54, in addition to UL-Lafayette. The Mocs were picked to win the Southern Conference and were ranked No. 8 in the CollegelInsider Mid-Major Top-25 poll at the time of the game

- The Warhawks pushed a pair of Big Ten opponents to the brink. ULM led 51-50 with 6:44 remaining at Minnesota, and 40-39 with 5:34 left at Penn State. The Warhawks were without Deng against the Nittany Lions  
- Three of ULM's non-conference losses came without Deng (at Kent State, Penn State and West Virginia). He sat out for precautionary reasons due to a lower leg injury

- Keith Richard picked up his 200th career victory as a head coach in an 80-64 victory over NSU on Nov. 19. Both Deng and Munnings recorded double-doubles in the contest

- ULM opened the season with an 88-43 victory over McMurry. The 45-point margin of victory was ULM's largest in school history in a season opener. The Warhawks improved to 47-18 all-time in home openers

- Keith Richard is the reigning Sun Belt Conference and Louisiana Coach of the Year winner. It came after a 24-win season, the third-most in school history and also the third biggest turnaround in the country from the year before. It was ULM's first 20-win season since 2001-02. Richard has more-than doubled ULM's win totals in back-to-back years

- The Warhawks made a run to the CBI championship series last year for their 10th postseason appearance in school history and the first since 1995-96. They played their first-ever game in the month of April in their 64-year history. They were also the first team from the SBC to ever play a game in April

- ULM picked up a pair of preseason honors as Deng was named to the 2015-16 All-Conference Second-Team, while Coppola earned recognition on the Third-Team. Deng was also named to the College Sports Madness Preseason All-SBC First-Team while Coppola was Third-Team

### SCOUTING POTENTIAL SEMIFINAL OPPONENTS

Third-seeded UT Arlington (22-9, 13-7 SBC) is led by First-Team All-SBC selection Erick Neal who averages 13.0 points per game. Also averaging in double-figures, Jalen Jones scores 12.5 points per outing and shoots .388 from long-range, and Kaelon Wilson scores 10.0 per game. Scott Cross is the only Head Coach in school history to hold a winning record and has coached the Mavs to three of their top-five winningest seasons in school history including three post-season appearances.

Sixth-seeded Georgia State (16-13, 9-11 SBC) is led by Jeremy Hollowell and Kevin Ware who average 14.7 and 12.0 points per game, respectively. Isaiah Williams also aids the attack with 9.4 points per game and shoots .362 from beyond-the-arc. In four seasons, Head Coach Ron Hunter has taken GSU to the postseason three times. He's posted back-to-back 25-win seasons including last year where the Panthers defeated Baylor in the NCAA Tournament as a No. 14 seed. Hunter has tallied three of the four winningest seasons in school history.

Seventh-seeded Texas State (14-15, 8-12 SBC) is propelled by Third-Team All-SBC selection Emani Gant who averages 13.8 points and 7.7 rebounds per game. Also averaging in double-figures for the Bobcats, Kavin Gilder-Tlibury and Ethan Montalvo score 12.1 and 10.8 points per game, respectively. Cameron Naylor is just under 10 with 9.6 points per outing. Danny Kaspar is in his third season at Texas State, after coaching 13 seasons as the head coach at Stephen F. Austin, where he guided the Lumberjacks to a 246-141 record that included seven 20-win seasons. Last season Kaspar guided Texas State to a six-win improvement, the most in a single season since the 2006-07 year.

## In ULM's Last Outing...

### Senior Day Victory over Georgia State Extends Winning Streak to Nine, 13-0 at Home

**MONROE, La.** – The ULM men's basketball program will head into the semifinals of the Sun Belt Conference Championships on a nine-game winning-streak after defeating Georgia State, 91-78 on Senior Day at Fant-Ewing Coliseum on Saturday.

With the win, ULM (19-12, 15-5 SBC) finished the regular season with a perfect 13-0 record at home. The Warhawks have also won 13 of the last 14 games overall.

The Warhawks trailed GSU (16-13, 9-1 SBC) by 10 points in the first half when they ended the period on a 21-4 run to take control. ULM went into the intermission in front by nine points and its lead never dipped below that in the second half.

ULM shot .596 (31-52) from the field, its highest percentage in conference play this year. It posted a .667 (18-27) field goal percentage in the second half. The Warhawks also went 21-25 (.840) from the free throw line and dominated the Panthers on the glass, 34-20.

Senior Majok Deng registered a game-high 22 points to go along with his seven rebounds and three blocks. Senior Justin Roberson recorded 19 points and six rebounds. Senior DeMondre Harvey tallied 17 points and went 11-12 from the free throw line. Senior Jamaal Samuel finished with 12 points and six rebounds.

Junior Nick Coppola dished out 11 assists and needs just three more to match Larry Saulters for the all-time lead in school history with 398.

### Brief History Behind ULM Basketball

ULM first competed in 1931-32 as a junior college. The school's name was Ouchita Junior College (OJC). It won its first-ever game, defeating Louisiana College Freshmen. Basketball at the school was on-and-off for the next 20 years, being replaced by boxing for financial complications, but re-started and re-dissembled several times. Basketball stuck for good in 1951-52 when it became a senior college and competed at the Division I level. ULM (then-known as Northeast Louisiana, or NLU) joined the Gulf States Conference in 1953-54, the Atlantic Sun in 1978-79, the Southland Conference in 1982-83 and the Sun Belt in 2006-07. Calvin Natt is the school's all-time leading scorer with 2,581 points and played 10 seasons in the NBA after the New Jersey Nets drafted him eighth overall in the 1979 Draft. ULM has won 20 championships in 65 seasons and has made seven NCAA Tournament appearances.

### History Behind the 'Warhawk'

Moving into the Sun Belt Conference in the 2006-07 season, ULM's athletic department completed a transformation. The mascot holds a local historical connection to the P-40 'Warhawk' airplane flown by northeast Louisiana's General Claire Chennault and the Flying Tigers of WWII. The Warhawk is also symbolic of the red-shouldered hawk, a local predatory bird commonly found nesting along Bayou DeSiard and soaring above ULM's athletic facilities. ULM's Warhawk moniker is the only one at the NCAA Division I level. Prior to becoming the ULM Warhawks, the school competed as the Northeast Louisiana Indians.

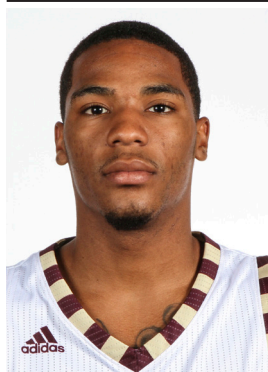
