ULM Notes

- The Warhawks are playing for their eighth NCAA Tournament bid, ninth tournament championship and 21st championship in school history. They are playing for their first NCAA Tournament appearance since 1995-96

- In the SBC semifinals, junior Nick Coppola became the all-time assist leader at ULM with 401. ULM won 82-71 as senior DeMondre Harvey netted a career-high 21 points on 9-9 field goals. All five ULM starters scored in double-figures

- Senior Majok Deng was named to the All-Sun Belt Conference First-Team, and senior Justin Roberson won Defensive Student-Athlete of the Year honors and All-SBC Second-Team. Deng is also the reigning Sun Belt Student-Athlete of the Week honoree

- ULM is on a 10-game winning streak, its longest since 1993-94 seasons. It's also the third-longest active winning streak in the nation. The Warhawks also have the third-longest active road winning streak in the country with five (page 5)

- ULM has posted back-to-back 20-win seasons for just the third time in school history and the first-time since 1989-90, 90-91. It won 24 games last year

- The Warhawks secured back-to-back winning seasons for the first time since 1992-93, 93-94. They also solidified back-to-back winning seasons in league play for the first time since 1998-99, 99-00

- With 15 SBC wins, the Warhawks improved their conference win total for the fourth consecutive year

- ULM was 13-0 (10-0 SBC) at home this season, 27-4 at home over the last two seasons and 417-173 all-time in Fant-Ewing Coliseum (page 3)

- The Warhawks hold a 29-11 SBC record over the last two years, best in the league by four games (page 8)

- ULM finished ahead of where it was projected in the SBC Preseason Poll for the third year in a row. The Warhawks were picked to finish third this year (page 5)

ULM Student-Athlete Notes

- Deng is the 2015-16 SBC scoring champion and ranks fifth in the country among internationally-born players. Deng also finished first in the league blocks, third in minutes and offensive rebounds, fifth in three-point field goal percentage, sixth in three-pointers per game, seventh in rebounding and eighth in free throw percentage. Deng has

scored at least 13 points in 23 of his last 25 outings. He has a trio of 30-plus scoring games this year and 11 20-plus scoring games. Deng ranks fourth all-time in career blocks at ULM with 101 and swatted away a career-high nine at UT Arlington. Deng also has 14 career double-doubles and 51 career double-figure scoring games in two seasons at ULM

- Roberson's scoring sky-rocketed in conference play this year as he went on a 10 game stretch totaling the nine highest scoring games of his career, all of at least 20 points. He scored a career-high 26 points against Troy at home. He averages 14.2 points, 4.7 rebounds and 2.8 assists per game on the year. Roberson is leading the team in steals for the second straight season and averages 1.7 per game on the year, second-best in the league. Roberson has reached double-figures 22 times this year and is shooting .419 from beyond-the-arc which ranks third in the league. It is a remarkable improvement from his .186 (8-43) three-point percentage last season. He has started every game his year

- In the ULM career record book, Coppola ranks first all-time in assists (401), first in minutes per game (35.7 mpg), third in minutes played (3,425), fifth in games started (96), sixth in assists per game (4.1 apg) and seventh in three-pointers made (133). He's played at least 40 minutes 34 times in his career including a school record 54 minutes vs. Canisius. Coppola has started every game in his career. He played 1,384 minutes last year, third most in the nation and also third in single-season program history. Additionally, Coppola finished second in the SBC last season in both assist:turnover ratio (2.0) and assists (3.7 apg)

- This year, Coppola is averaging 11.2 points, 5.4 assists and 2.9 rebounds per game. He logs 36.8 minutes per game on the season which leads the conference and ranks top-25 in the country. In SBC-only games, Coppola finished first in the league in minutes (38.0 mpg) and second in both assists (5.8 apg) and assist:turnover ratio (3.1)

- Senior Jamaal Samuel has scored in double-figures 17 times this year and 25 times in his career. Samuel netted five three-pointers (5-7) in the SBC semifinals against UTA. He scored 12 points in the regular-season finale vs. Georgia State and a game-high 15 points in the previous weekend at South Alabama. Samuel poured in a career-high 19 points at No. 14 West Virginia and scored ULM's first 15 points of the contest. He also recorded a 15-point game at Arkansas State. Samuel averages 9.4 points and 4.8 rebounds per game on the year. He's one of five Warhawks shooting at least 35 percent from three-point range

- ULM is 14-1 since inserting senior DeMondre Harvey into the starting lineup. He has hit 85-145 (.586) and is coming off a career-high 21 points against UTA in the SBC semifinals where he was a perfect 9-9 from the field. Harvey posted

a 17-point, seven rebound outing in the regular-season finale against Georgia State. He also started three games earlier in the season in-place of Deng. Harvey led the team in field goal percentage in back-to-back years coming into this season. He's reached double-figures in scoring nine times this year and 13 times in his career

- Freshman Travis Munnings ranks fourth in the SBC in field goal percentage (.516) and averages 7.9 points and 5.6 rebounds per game on the year. He went on a six-game stretch in conference where he went 9-11 from three-point range. Munnings has four double-doubles on the season and 11 double-figure scoring games. He scored a career-high 22 points at Penn State and also pulled down 10 rebounds in the contest. Munnings is now looked upon as ULM's "sixth man" after starting the first 17 games of the season

- Senior Mack Foster completes ULM's usual seven-man rotation and comes in as a defensive specialist. However, his scoring production has gone up as of late as he scored at least seven points in four of the last five regular season games. In a road game at UT Arlington, he tipped in the game-winning basket and went 3-4 FG for a season-high 10 points. He scored a career-high 15 points last season at Troy

- The Warhawks clinched their 40th winning season in school history. ULM is in its 65th season of the Division I level

- The Warhawks have completed five season sweeps this year after taking both meetings against Appalachian State, Texas State, South Alabama and Troy, and defeated UT Arlington three times

- ULM finished 12-0 in conference play this season when it scored at least 70 points, 10-0 when it shot over 50 percent from the field and 9-0 when it had more points in the paint

- ULM ranks first in the league in field goal percentage (.460), second in assists (14.1 apg) and top-three in three-point field goal percentage (.354), rebounding margin (+2.9) and assist:turnover ratio (1.1)

- The Warhawks have won 11 weekly awards this year. Deng has won seven including National Mid-Major Player of the Week (Dec. 7), Louisiana Player of the Week (Dec. 21), College Sports Madness SBC Player of the Week (Jan. 25) and Sun Belt Conference Student-Athlete of the Week (March 7). He won three on Feb. 15 (SBC, LSWA and CSM). Roberson was named SBC Student-Athlete of the Week and Louisiana Player of the Week (Jan. 25), and Coppola won College Sports Madness SBC Player of the Week (Feb. 1) and Co-Louisiana Player of the Week (Feb. 22)

- Five different Warhawks have registered a double-double this season for a total of 16

- ULM won seven games in the month

of February for the first time since 1995-96

- In ULM's last 49 games against SBC opponents, it has only allowed 75 points five times. Ironically, all five resulted in wins, and three times the opposition made at least 15 three-pointers. The Warhawks held a streak of 47 consecutive games overall of not allowing a 75-point scorer, the second longest active streak in the nation, which was snapped at Houston on a jumper with nine seconds left

- The Warhawks hold a win over first-place Little Rock, 86-82 at home on Feb. 11. The Trojans came into the game with the best record in the nation. They were also ranked No. 2 in the CollegeInsider Mid-Major Top-25 Poll. It was ULM's second win over a top-10 team in the poll as it previously defeated No. 8 Chattanooga

- In the season sweep over Texas State, the Warhawks held the Bobcats to under 60 points in both contests. In the second meeting, the Warhawks jumped out to a 19-point advantage at halftime and never saw their lead drop below 15 points in the second half

- The regular-season sweep over UTA saw two completely different flows. The first was a 99-88 three-point contest, while the second was a 64-61 defensive battle. At home, the Warhawks went 15-30 from three-point range. ULM was one three-pointer shy of tying the school record for most threes made in a game. It made 16 against Arkansas-Monticello on Dec. 3, 1996, and at Troy on Jan 27, 2007. Deng became the first Warhawk to make at least seven three-pointers in a game since Hugh Mingo in 2010-11. It was the 16th time in school history that a Warhawk made at least seven three-pointers in a game

- ULM's season sweep over Appalachian State was similar to UTA where the two games played out very differently. The Warhawks cruised to a wire-to-wire victory, 72-56 at home in the first meeting. The second came down to the very end as ULM scored the final six points of the game, including a game-winning drive by Coppola to put the Warhawks ahead 91-90 with 9.6 seconds left. ULM won despite the Mountaineers shooting a red-hot 60 percent from both the field and three-point range

- During ULM's first four-game SBC winning streak this year, it scored at least 85 points in three straight conference games for the first time since 1995-96 when it was a Southland Conference member

- ULM's 32-point win over South Alabama, 100-68, at home in the first meeting was its largest margin of victory over an SBC opponent since Feb. 22, 2007 when it thumped Denver, 87-51 at home

- Against UT Arlington at home, ULM came one point away from scoring 100 points in back-to-back games for the first time since the 1992-93 season when it defeated Nicholls State, 105-64 and Southern Miss, 113-106 (OT). The last time the Warhawks scored 100 points in back-to-back league games was in 1967-68 when ULM fell in overtime to both Northwestern State 114-111 and Southeastern Louisiana 103-101 as a member of the Gulf States Conference

- The Warhawks opened league play with an 81-70 win over Sun Belt Conference preseason favorite UL-Lafayette. ULM shot 9-15 from beyond-the-arc; the .600 percentage was the highest by an SBC team in a single game this season. The Warhawks never trailed in the contest. It was ULM's third consecutive win over the Ragin' Cajuns as it swept the season series last year

- ULM holds back-to-back wins over teams selected to win their leagues in the preseason polls as it defeated Chattanooga, 64-54, in addition to UL-Lafayette. The Mocs were picked to win the Southern Conference and were ranked No. 8 in the CollegiateInsider Mid-Major Top-25 poll at the time of the game

- The Warhawks pushed a pair of Big Ten opponents to the brink. ULM led 51-50 with 6:44 remaining at Minnesota, and 40-39 with 5:34 left at Penn State. The Warhawks were without Deng against the Nittany Lions
- Three of ULM's non-conference losses came without Deng (at Kent State, Penn State and West Virginia). He sat out for precautionary reasons due to a lower leg injury

- Keith Richard picked up his 200th career victory as a head coach in an 80-64 victory over NSU on Nov. 19. Both Deng and Munnings recorded double-doubles in the contest

- ULM opened the season with an 88-43 victory over McMurry. The 45-point margin of victory was ULM's largest in school history in a season opener. The Warhawks improved to 47-18 all-time in home openers

- Keith Richard is the reigning Sun Belt Conference and Louisiana Coach of the Year winner. It came after a 24-win season, the third-most in school history and also the third biggest turnaround in the country from the year before. It was ULM's first 20-win season since 2001-02. Richard has more-than doubled ULM's win totals in back-to-back years

- The Warhawks made a run to the CBI championship series last year for their 10th postseason appearance in school history and the first since 1995-96. They played their first-ever game in the month of April in their 64-year history. They were also the first team from the SBC to ever play a game in April

- ULM picked up a pair of preseason honors as Deng was named to the 2015-16 All-Conference Second-Team, while Coppola earned recognition on the Third-Team. Deng was also named to the College Sports Madness Preseason All-SBC First-Team while Coppola was Third-Team

- The Warhawks were picked to finished third in the SBC Preseason Poll. It comes after they finished in a tie for second-place in the SBC standings last season. In 2013-14, ULM was picked to finish dead last preseason

- ULM is in its second season without any APR penalties which Richard inherited when he took over at the helm. Richard has turned the program around athletically and academically as the Warhawks have won back-to-back-to-back Sun Belt Conference academic awards

- The Warhawks honored their 1985-86 NCAA Tournament team on Feb. 13 at halftime against Arkansas State for their 30th anniversary. The Warhawks won both the Southland Conference Regular Season and Postseason titles that year

Back-to-Back 20 Win Seasons in School History

SCOUTING LITTLE ROCK

Little Rock, the Sun Belt Conference regular season champion, defeated UL-Lafayette 72-65 in the SBC semifinals. It finished league play 17-3 and currently sits at 28-4 overall.

The Trojans are led by Josh Hagins, an All-Conference First-Team selection. He was one of three LR student-athletes selected as All-Conference as Marcus Johnson Jr. was named to the Second-Team and Roger Woods the Third-Team.

LR finished SBC play ranked first in the league ins coring defense (62.5 ppg), scoring margin (+9.4), three-point percentage (.420) and three-point percentage defense (.298). Woods finished second in the conference in field goal percentage at a .578 mark, and Johnson Jr. was second in three-point percentage at a .449 clip.

Chris Beard is in his first season as head coach and won Sun Belt Coach of the Year. He previously worked 10 years as an assistant coach at Texas Tech under Bobby Knight. Beard also sports a 141-45 (.758) in six seasons as a head coach, including a 47-15 mark over the last two years at Angelo State. Last season, Beard won NABC South Central Region and Lone Sar Conference Coach of the Year after Angelo State won a program-record 28 games. The Rams went 17-0 at home and finished the year ranked No. 19 nationally.

In ULM's Last Outing...

ULM Advances to Finals of SBC Championships; Coppola Breaks School Assist Record

NEW ORLEANS – All five starters scored in double-figures for the ULM men's basketball program as it defeated third-seeded UT Arlington, 82-71 in the semifinals of the Sun Belt Conference Championships on Saturday at Lakefront Arena.

The second-seeded Warhawks (20-12, 15-5 SBC) won their 10th straight game and will play in the finals of the SBC Championships for the first time in school history on Sunday at noon on ESPN2. It will take on top-seeded Little Rock (28-4, 17-3 SBC). The teams split the season series, each winning at home.

With four assists in the game, junior Nick Coppola improved his career total to 399, surpassing Larry Saulters who distributed 398 assists and held the title as ULM Assist King for 46 years.

Senior DeMondre Harvey registered a career-high 21 points on a perfect 9-for-9 shooting and also recorded seven rebounds and three blocks. His field goal percentage helped the Warhawks shoot at a .500 (27-54) clip for the game, while UTA (23-10, 13-7 SBC) was limited to a .408 (29-71) clip including .250 (7-28) from long range.

Senior Majok Deng, an All-Conference First-Team honoree and the reigning SBC Student-Athlete of the Week winner, poured in 18 points including a trio of three-pointers and also tallied seven rebounds and a pair of blocks. Senior Justin Roberson, the SBC Defensive Student-Athlete of the Year and All-Conference Second-Team selection, finished with 16 points and matched his career-high with eight assists.

With five three-pointers in the game, senior Jamaal Samuel ended with 15 points. Coppola aided the attack with 10 points.

Brief History Behind ULM Basketball

ULM first competed in 1931-32 as a junior college. The school's name was Ouchita Junior College (OJC). It won its first-ever game, defeating Louisiana College Freshmen. Basketball at the school was on-and-off for the next 20 years, being replaced by boxing for financial complications, but re-started and re-dissembled several times. Basketball stuck for good in 1951-52 when it became a senior college and competed at the Division I level. ULM (then-known as Northeast Louisiana, or NLU) joined the Gulf States Conference in 1953-54, the Atlantic Sun in 1978-79, the Southland Conference in 1982-83 and the Sun Belt in 2006-07. Calvin Natt is the school's all-time leading scorer with 2,581 points and played 10 seasons in the NBA after the New Jersey Nets drafted him eighth overall in the 1979 Draft. ULM has won 20 championships in 65 seasons and has made seven NCAA Tournament appearances.

History Behind the 'Warhawk'

Moving into the Sun Belt Conference in the 2006-07 season, ULM's athletic department completed a transformation. The mascot holds a local historical connection to the P-40 'Warhawk' airplane flown by northeast Louisiana's General Claire Chennault and the Flying Tigers of WWII. The Warhawk is also symbolic of the red-shouldered hawk, a local predatory bird commonly found nesting along Bayou DeSiard and soaring above ULM's athletic facilities. ULM's Warhawk moniker is the only one at the NCAA Division I level. Prior to becoming the ULM Warhawks, the school competed as the Northeast Louisiana Indians.

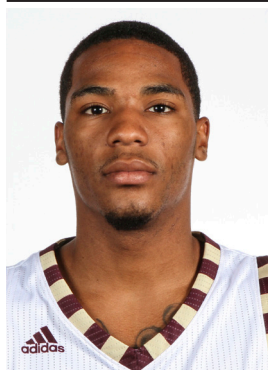
