## FIRST AND TEN

• Running back Austin Vaughn became the sixth different leading rusher for ULM this season with his 110-yard afternoon at Appalachian State. Quarterback Garrett Smith and running back Thomas Koufie have lead the rushing attack three times apiece this season, while running back Ben Lockett has done so twice and quarterback Will Collins, running back Duke Carter and Vaughn have each now led ULM in one game this season.

• Vaughn's afternoon against Appalachian State was the second consecutive week the Warhawks saw a running back have a career day. Vaughn had entered the game with 22 carries for 97 yards and touchdown on the season, with touches in three previous games, before his 110-yard, one touchdown afternoon on 15 carries at Appalachian State.

• ULM is hit with an oddity in college football this time of the year – an off week leading into its final game of the season. The Warhawks fell at Auburn coming off their first free Saturday earlier this season.

• Dating back to the 2010 season (including earlier in 2016), the Warhawks are 2-3 overall coming off of an extra week of preparation. Two seasons featured games at SEC opponents (at Auburn, 2016, and at Alabama, 2015) and they also had two seasons with no open week (2010 and 2012), instead starting the season during the second week of the national schedule.

• ULM is 2-1 in Sun Belt Conference games following an extra week of preparation, including victories in its last two situations – both at home – in 2014 against Troy (22-20 W) and 2013 against Georgia State (38-10 W). The Warhawks' last loss to a Sun Belt opponent following an extra week was in 2011 when they fell 24-19 at home to Arkansas State.

• The Warhawks finish the 2016 slate 1-6 on the road and have an opportunity to end the year 4-1 at home with a victory over the Ragin' Cajuns. The four home wins would be the most for ULM in a season since a pair of back-to-back 4-1 home records in the 2009 and 2010 campaigns.

• Saturday's contest will be the 52nd all-time meeting between the two teams, by far the Warhawks' most common opponent. This year will be the 20th consecutive season the teams will meet.

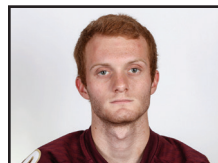

## WARHAWKS VS. RAGIN' CAJUNS

ULM and the Ragin' Cajuns will meet on the gridiron for the 52nd time on Saturday afternoon as the two squads square off on Senior Day for ULM inside JPS Field at Malone Stadium... The Ragin' Cajuns lead the all-time series, 26-24. ULM is 6-8 inside Malone Stadium and 11-11 in Monroe overall (5-3 at Brown Stadium)... ULM's most storied rival, the Warhawks and Ragin' Cajuns have met each year since 1997... this is the 20th consecutive season with a meeting, surpassing the teams' streak of 19 straight seasons with a contest (from 1953-1971)... after the 1971 meeting, the teams only played 12 times scattered over the next 26 years before the current game streak began in the 1997 season.

## KOUFIE RE-WRITES THE RECORD BOOKS

Sophomore running back Thomas Koufie signed his name across several sections of the ULM record book with his historical performance on Nov. 12 against Georgia State. Koufie became the first Warhawk back to ever score five rushing touchdowns in a single game, while his 201 rushing yards is now the sixth-highest single game total in program history, and the first back over 200 yards since the 1993 season. Koufie's 201 yards on the ground against Georgia State surpassed his season total through the first nine games of the season, where he had tallied 175 rushing yards.

## THREE'S COMPANY....AGAIN THIS SEASON

With Caleb Evans' three-touchdown game in the overtime win over South Alabama, the Warhawks have now seen three different quarterbacks - Garrett Smith, Will Collins and Caleb Evans - all throw for two or more touchdowns in a game, marking the second consecutive season ULM has notched the obscure stat.

## GETTING IT DONE ON THE GROUND

Through 10 games this season, the Warhawks have accumulated 1,835 total yards on the ground, averaging 183.5 yards per game. That rushing yardage is 497 yards more than the team's final rushing yardage of the 2015 season (1,338 yards in 13 total games). ULM's 1,835 total rushing yards to date is better than its final season rushing yardages the past three seasons, and is one yard shy the team's final 1,836 total yard rushing tally from the 2011 season. The largest rushing total over the past 10 ULM seasons was a 2,207 rushing yard season in 2009.

## ON THE ROAD

The Warhawks have a pretty even split among their 12 total games this season with five games at home and seven on the road... Of the seven road contests, ULM will play in the Eastern Time Zone (3 times), Central Time Zone (3 times) and Mountain Time Zone (1 time). Via Google Maps the distance from JPS Field at Malone Stadium to all seven road venues comes to a total of 4,900 miles and that is just one direction -- double that amount and the round trip from ULM to each road venue comes to 9,800 miles. The Warhawks played three-straight road games for the second consecutive season, however, this year there was a bye week tucked between the first two road trips (at Oklahoma, at Georgia Southern) and the third game (at Auburn).

## BACK-TO-BACK AT HOME

After being one of six teams in FBS that did not play back-to-back home games last season (only Sun Belt School on the list) the Warhawks played two consecutive home games inside JPS Field at Malone Stadium when they hosted Idaho (Oct. 8) and Texas State (Oct. 15 / Homecoming).

## NEW FIELDHOUSE FACILITY

ULM officially unveiled the new Football Fieldhouse Facility to the public on August 2. The 11,750 square foot facility, which cost \$4.1 million, was funded entirely by 31 private donors. It is the first athletic facility in ULM history to be completely funded by private donations and was the first new athletic facility built at ULM since 1983.

## NEW TURF, NEW NAME

Thanks to a generous donation of \$450,000, the largest single gift in ULM athletics history, the Warhawk football team is in year three of playing on FieldTurf Revolution... The donation from JPS Aviation/JPS Equipment Rental covered the cost of the new FieldTurf Revolution and for the donation, the name of the field will now be JPS Field at Malone Stadium... The length of the naming rights was set at a minimum of eight years... The new FieldTurf stretches wall-to-wall and totals 78,000 square feet... It is the same playing surface the Warhawks played on at Wake Forest in 2013 and other notable FBS schools that have the FieldTurf Revolution are: Louisville, Michigan, Nebraska, Ohio State, Ole Miss, Oregon, Texas, Texas Tech and Wisconsin... There are also 23 NFL football teams that have the FieldTurf Revolution.

### POSTGAME NOTES

-ULM come out and scored on its first two possessions of the second half, turning what had been a 14-12 halftime lead into a 24-12 advantage after a six-play, 44 yard drive capped by a Garrett Smith 28-yard touchdown pass to Marcus Green and a Craig Ford 24-yard field goal.  
-Smith hurt Southern through the air and the ground Saturday night, finishing with 208 yards passing and a pair of touchdowns while also leading the Warhawks on the ground with a 150-yard running night and a touchdown. He finished 20-for-33 in the air, with two touchdowns and a pair of interceptions.  
-He becomes the first Warhawk to rush for 150 yards since Jyruss Edwards racked up 191 yards against Middle Tennessee (Nov 12, 2011). Smith also became the first ULM quarterback to toss around 200+ yards in the air since Pete Thomas' 307 yards passing at Georgia Southern (Nov. 29, 2014).  
-As a team, ULM amassed 533 offensive yards, balanced with 325 total yards on the ground and Smith's 208 yards passing.  
-The Warhawks finished the night with six different players recording at least one rush, while seven players caught passes.  
-ULM tabbed an 11-17 mark in third down completions Saturday and was 1-for-1 in its fourth down attempt. The Warhawks cashed in on four of five redzone trips, with the only miscue coming in the opening second half possession when Smith was picked off at the goal line.  
-Viator is now 7-3 in season openers all-time in addition to his 10-0 mark in home openers going back to his time at McNeese State.

### POSTGAME NOTES

-Oklahoma struck first, traveling 75 yards in the opening two minutes before quickly getting the ball back and going on a two minute, 64-yard drive to jump out to the two touchdown lead. They closed the first quarter with their third 60+ yard drive to take a 21-0 lead after the first 15 minutes.

### POSTGAME NOTES

-Aided by two interceptions and a blocked punt, Idaho jumped out to a 16-0 lead after the first quarter. ULM proceeded to outscore Idaho 21-8 in the second quarter to get back in the game and trailed by three at halftime.  
-The Warhawks marched down the field with a five play, 80 yard drive late in the fourth quarter to tie the game at 31-all, but Idaho covered 67 yards over the final 2:28 and ended the game with Austin Rehkow's 27-yard field goal as time expired.  
-Garrett Smith finished the night 20-for-38 passing with the two touchdowns and three interceptions. The sophomore totaled 302 yards through the air, the second time in his career he has surpassed 300 passing yards (370 yards - Sept. 2015 vs. Nicholls). Smith has now passed for over 200 yards in four of ULM's five games this season, with the outlier coming last week at Auburn.  
-Five different Warhawks tallied rushes in the game, led by Smith's 88 yards. After struggling on the ground in recent weeks, ULM tallied 221 total rushing yards, the second-highest total of the season (325 team rushing vs. Southern).  
-ULM finished 9-of-15 on third downs against Idaho after converting only 11 combined third downs over the previous three weeks.  
-The Warhawks totaled 523 yards on Saturday night, 109 more total yards than Idaho (414 yards), while ULM also outrushed (221 to 203) the visitors and tallied more passing yards (302 to 211).

### POSTGAME NOTES

-With starting quarterback Garrett Smith knocked out of the game due to injury early in the second quarter, redshirt-freshman Will Collins stepped up and tossed his first two collegiate touchdowns, both later in the second quarter, as part of a 9-for-16 passing stat line with 125 yards in the air as he led the Warhawks to the victory.  
-As a group, the Warhawks outscored Texas State 23-0 in the second quarter to seize control of the game.

-Texas State scored 20 of the second half's 27 points, starting with a 57-yard interception return for a touchdown five minutes into the third quarter, and then a pair of fourth quarter scores.

## Game Ten: ULM 37, Georgia State 23

### POSTGAME NOTES

-Sophomore running back Thomas Koufie became the first player in ULM program history to rush for five touchdowns in a single game on Saturday afternoon as the Warhawks won their first road game in nearly two years with a 37-23 victory over Georgia State inside the Georgia Dome.  
-Leading 9-7 at the half, ULM jumped on the back of Koufie, as he scored three touchdowns in the third quarter - from 18 yards out and a pair of one-yard scores - as the Warhawks took control of the game. Koufie recorded 141 of his 201 total yards in the second half.  
-Koufie notched 201 yards rushing on 31 carries, as the ULM running back group combined for 264 yards on 54 carries.  
-Koufie becomes the first ULM running back in program history with five rushing touchdowns. The last time a running back had recorded four touchdowns in a game was Marquis Williams against UL Lafayette on Oct. 25, 1997.  
-Koufie finished with 201 rushing yards, becoming the first ULM running back with 200+ rushing yards since Irving Spikes (231 yards - Nov. 20, 1993 vs Idaho), and his 201 yards is now the sixth-most in a single game in program history, and the first over 200 yards since the 1993 season.  
-ULM finished the night with 457 total offensive yards, its fifth game this season with over 400 yards of offense and first game on the road with over 400 yards. It was the second week in a row the Warhawk offense was over 450 total yards after amassing 460 yards last week in the win over South Alabama.  
-In his second start, freshman quarterback Caleb Evans finished the night 17-for-31 with 193 yards passing, adding 44 yards on the ground across 13 attempts.  
-ULM recorded its first road victory since Nov. 22, 2014 at New Mexico State (30-17 win) with the victory over Georgia State.  
-Since 2011, the Warhawks are now 21-5 in games scoring 28 or more points.

-Appalachian State struck first on Cox's first touchdown of the day, followed by ULM's answering drive resulting in a Craig Ford field goal. The Mountaineers quickly answered back with a 60 yard touchdown pass and led 14-3 at the end of one.

-The teams traded touchdowns in the second quarter, with Appalachian State adding to its lead on a three-yard touchdown pass on fourth and goal before the Warhawks responded with Caleb Evans' four yard touchdown run towards the end of the half.

-Out of the halftime break, Appalachian State rattled off a pair of third quarter rushing touchdowns – first from five yards out by Cox before a 35 yard score from Lamb.

-ULM's Austin Vaughn scored from 16 yards out seconds into the fourth quarter to pull the Warhawks closer but Cox ended the night with a 25 yard touchdown run to set the all-time mark.

-ULM finished with 361 total offensive yards, including 225 yards on the ground. The Warhawks ran more plays than Appalachian State (76-69) but the hosts averaged 9.2 yards per play compared to ULM's 4.8 yards per play.

-Caleb Evans finished the night 13-for-32 passing for 136 yards and an interception, adding 55 yards and the touchdown on the ground.

-Austin Vaughn led the rushing attack with 110 yards on 15 carries, averaging 7.3 yards per carry. Thomas Koufie added 34 yards on the ground and Duke Carter tallied 15 yards.

-Temperature at game time was 35 degrees, and winds were blowing at 20-25 miles per hour, as ULM played its coldest game this season.
