- ULM has the second best conference record among Football Bowl Subdivision teams in the state of Louisiana over the past six seasons  
LSU (28-12, .700)  
**ULM (19-16, .543)**  
Louisiana-Lafayette (18-17, .514)  
Louisiana Tech (21-20, .512)  
Tulane (10-31, .244)
- ULM has been the only Sun Belt Conference team to defeat the league champion in each of the past two seasons -- 2007, Florida Atlantic (33-30); 2008, Troy (31-30).
- Four players (offense & defense) made the first starts of their careers at Texas (Emmanuel Lockett, Keavon Milton, Theo Smith & Jonathan Gill). The 22 players that started last week have combined to start 301 games / 13.7 per player.
- ULM ranked seventh in the nation last season with just 14 turnovers. The Warhawks lost just five fumbles on the year to rank fifth in the NCAA and threw just nine interceptions to rank 23rd in the NCAA.
- The Warhawks forced three Texas turnovers in the season opener (two fumbles & one interception). The last time a team forced the Longhorns into three turnovers was Texas A&M in November 2007.
- The Warhawks will play three teams for the first time in school history, and they are the first three games of the season. ULM's meetings with Texas, Texas Southern and Arizona State will all be firsts for the Warhawks. ULM's meeting with Sun Belt newcomer Western Kentucky will be just the fifth meeting between the schools and first since 1955.


## HAWK TALK

Troy has had ULM's number over the years winning seven of the 11 meetings (one tie) including all five games in Troy. Then backup quarterback Trey Revell led the Warhawks on a 9-play, 72-yard game-winning drive last season. He was a perfect 4-for-4 on the drive and also rushed for 29 yards to lead the Warhawks to victory.</i>      |

# TEAM NOTES

## THE SERIES

This is the first-ever meeting between ULM and Texas Southern and the fifth for the Warhawks against a member of the SWAC. ULM's last meeting against one of TSU's conference foes came last season in a 37-15 ULM victory over Alabama A&M in a game that got moved to Friday night that same morning.

ULM has outscored its SWAC opponents 245-89 in its four previous meetings. The Warhawks are 24-7 in Malone Stadium openers and have won two of the last three home openers.

## TEAM CAPTAINS SELECTED

The Warhawks selected their team captains for the 2009 season with a representative from the offense, defense and special teams. Punter Scott Love and hawk James Truxillo are captains for the second straight season, while quarterback Trey Revell and linebacker Josh Thomas are first-year leaders for the Warhawks.

## WARHAWKS IN FRONT OF BIG CROWDS

The 2009 season opener at Texas saw 101,096 fans watch the Warhawks and Longhorns play -- the second largest crowd to ever watch a ULM game. The Warhawks set the Malone Stadium record in 2007 as 30,101 packed the stadium to watch the game against Grambling State -- the crowd was also the fifth largest for an on-campus game in Sun Belt history at the time.

Three of the top eight Malone Stadium crowds have come in the past three seasons and six of the top seven all-time crowds to watch a ULM game have come in the past seven seasons.

## FRESH STARTS

Five players made their first career starts in the season opener at Texas -- offensive linemen Emmanuel Lockett and Jonathan Gill, tight end Keavon Milton, linebacker Theo Smith and kickoff specialist Grant Clayton. Milton and Gill are both redshirt freshmen and Clayton is a true freshman.

## MESSING WITH TEXAS

While the Warhawks were not able to get out Austin, Texas, with a win over No. 2 Texas, ULM was able to accomplish a few things against the Longhorns.

- ULM became the first team since Texas A&M on Nov. 23, 2007, to force the Longhorns into three turnovers.
- ULM's Otis Stamps intercepted Colt McCoy in the second quarter -- McCoy only threw eight picks all of last season.
- ULM scored 20 points on the Longhorns -- the most ever by a SBC team. UT didn't allow a team to score 20 points against it last season until No. 1 Oklahoma in game number six of the season.
- ULM rushed for 101 yards in the game against UT. Only five teams rushed for over 100 yards against Texas last season as the Longhorns ranked third in the NCAA against the run.
- Trey Revell's 75-yard touchdown pass to Luther Ambrose was the longest play against the Longhorns since Tulane's J.P. Losman threw a 77-yard TD pass on Sept. 23, 2003.
- The ULM offensive line didn't allow a sack the entire game. Texas has now been held without a sack just three times in its last 41 games.

## WHAT'S IN A NAME?

There is something missing from the Warhawks' uniforms this season as the players' last names have been removed from the back of the jerseys.

The coaching staff has told the players the names will be returned to the jerseys upon receiving a bowl game invitation.

## STATE-OF-THE-ART PLAYING SURFACE

The latest addition to Malone Stadium features a ProPlay monofilament fiber "grass" with a shock and drain pad and Envirofill clear coated sand infill. In addition to looking more like natural grass, ULM's new playing surface has measures in place to help prevent injuries and drain water at a rate of 10 inches per hour. The clear-coated sand used has obvious benefits over its predecessor (ground-up black rubber) in that it does not absorb as much heat, does not compact over time, and does not migrate during use. The first game played on the new surface was the 2007 season opener against Tulsa on ESPN2HD.

## PRESEASON PRAISE

Four Warhawks were named to the Sun Belt Preseason All-Conference Team, which was voted on by the league's nine head coaches and select members of the media.



### Cardia Jackson, Sr., Linebacker, Monroe, La.

- Ranked eighth in the NCAA last season averaging 10.6 tackles per game
- Ranked fourth in the NCAA last season averaging 6.3 solo tackles per game
- Top returning tackler in the Sun Belt Conference
- First team All-Sun Belt last season
- 127 tackles in 2008 tied him for the most at ULM since current Carolina Panther Chris Harris had the same number in 2002 -- nobody totaled more since 1998



### Greg James, Sr., Safety, Monroe, La.

# TEAM NOTES

## 79 YEARS STRONG

ULM begins its 79th season of college football this season and ninth as a member of the Sun Belt Conference. The Warhawks began playing in 1931 as a junior college and won the first of the school's two national championships with an 8-0 record in 1935. ULM became a senior college in 1951 and joined the NAIA where it stayed until 1975 when the Warhawks became a Division I independent. The Warhawks joined Division I-AA in 1982 and won the school's second national championship in 1987, going 13-2. ULM made the final step to college football's top stage in 1994 as a I-A independent and then joined the Sun Belt in 2001.

## WARHAWKS VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

ULM is 0-17 all-time against ranked opponents (since 1994) and 0-5 in season openers against a ranked opponent. The Warhawks closest upset bid against a ranked foe came at No. 22 Auburn in a 28-24 loss in 1996.

The Warhawks have played four ranked teams the past three seasons. In 2007, ULM played No. 25 Clemson and No. 15 Texas A&M in back-to-back weeks. Last year, the Warhawks opened the season at No. 10 Auburn. ULM opened the 2009 season at No. 2 Texas.

The Warhawks have played the No. 2 team in the country twice -- Florida in 2001 and Texas in 2009.

The Warhawks have opened the season five times against a ranked foe: 1994 at #8 Colorado (L, 13-48), 2003 at #13 LSU (L, 7-49), 2004 at #17 Auburn (L, 0-31), 2008 at #10 Auburn (L, 0-34), 2009 at #2 Texas (L, 20-59).

ULM has played an SEC team every year since moving to Division I-A in 1994.

With games scheduled against Arkansas and Auburn in 2010, Alabama in 2011 and Arkansas in 2012, the streak will continue out at least three more years.

## CW MOVING UP THE WINS LIST

Head coach Charlie Weatherbie continues to move up ULM career coaching wins list. With six victories in 2009, Weatherbie will tie Dixie B. White (1964-71) with 31 victories for third place (Senior college era).

Pat Collins holds the all-time senior college record with 57 victories, 20 more than Dave Roberts. James Malone has 95 career victories at ULM with 83 coming during the junior college years (1934-50).

## MALONE HOME TO TV

Malone Stadium will host three televised games in 2009, including a nationally televised contest.

The Warhawks host Arkansas State on Oct. 13 on ESPN2HD. It marks the second time in three years that ULM has welcomed ESPN2 to campus. ULM opened the 2007 season against Tulsa on the Worldwide Leader.

The newly formed Sun Belt Network will televise ULM's home games against Florida International on Oct. 3 and Middle Tennessee on Nov. 28.

## TURKEY WITH THE WARHAWKS

ULM's home contest against Middle Tennessee on Nov. 28 is the Saturday following Thanksgiving.

The game is the latest regular season home game in ULM history. The Warhawks played home games in December in 1987, but those contests were D-IAA playoff games.

## LOADS OF EXPERIENCE

The Warhawks open the 2009 season with 23 players who are in their fourth or fifth years with the program.

ULM returns eight starters on offense, 10 starters on defense and its returning punter and kicker.

## ULM IN SEASON OPENERS

The Warhawks are 15-20-1 in season openers since 1975 (first year in NCAA) and 5-11 in season openers since moving to I-A in 1994.

## LOVE IS BOOMING

ULM senior punter Scott Love is in his third season as the Warhawks full-time starter.

He currently ranks 17th in the NCAA among active players with his 40.6 career per-punt average.

Love holds the ULM single-season and single-game records for punts inside the 20-yard line and ranks fourth all-time with his career punt average.

## JABOUR EARNS STATE HONOR

ULM sophomore place kicker Radi Jabour was named Louisiana Special Teams Player of the Week, the Louisiana Sports Writers Association announced Tuesday afternoon.

Jabour, a native of LaPlace, La., was a perfect 4-for-4 on his kick attempts in ULM's season opener at No. 2 Texas this past Saturday. He hit field goals of 24 and 21 yards and made both of his extra point attempts. Jabour shared the weekly honor with Southeastern Louisiana's freshman punter Beau Mothe.

This is Jabour's first-ever weekly conference or state honor in his career. ULM players earned three LSWA honors last season with all three coming on the defensive side of the ball.

## SHOULDER PADS TO COLLARED SHIRTS

ULM's newest assistant coach, Marty Humphrey, is not even one full year removed from his playing days with the Warhawks. A former walk-on for the Warhawks, Humphrey will be remembered by ULM fans for years to come as the player who caught the game-winning touchdown pass in ULM's 21-14 victory at Alabama.

Humphrey, who completed his eligibility last season, finished his ULM career with 45 receptions for over 600 yards.

He began his coaching career as a graduate assistant for the Warhawks in the spring and summer before being promoted to the wide receivers coach on July 23.

## NUMBERS ON THE BOARD

ULM has scored in 77-of-81 games dating back to Sept. 14, 2002, against McNeese State. The Warhawks were shutout 34-0 in the 2008 season opener at No. 10 Auburn snapping a streak of 32 straight games of recording at least one score. A 59-0 loss to Ole Miss later in the season marked the first time that ULM had been shutout multiple times in the same season since 2000 -- Memphis (28-0), Middle Tennessee (38-0) and Central Florida (55-0).

Prior to the Auburn game, the last time the Warhawks were shutout came on Sept. 10, 2005, at Wyoming. The only other time during the streak came in a season-opening loss at Auburn 31-0 in 2004.

The 32-game streak passed the previous best mark of 22 which was set from Sept. 14, 2002-Nov. 22, 2003. The next milestone was 82 games; ULM was not shutout from Sept. 9, 1989-Nov. 4, 1995 -- the steak ended at Louisville on Nov. 11, 1995 in a 39-0 defeat.

## SAPP IS BACK

After sitting out last season due to academics, senior All-Sun Belt wide receiver LaGregory Sapp is back for the Warhawks. Checking in at 6-foot-3 and 209 pounds, Sapp has proven to be a game-changing receiver. He made three catches for 27 yards in the opener at Texas.

He caught 43 passes for a team-high 796 yards his sophomore year and has six touchdown receptions in his two-plus years of action. Sapp made SportCenter's Top 10 Plays after an acrobatic touchdown reception in the 2007 season opener against Tulsa.

## EIGHT-DEEP

The Warhawks feel that they can go eight-deep at the wide receiver position in 2009. Luther Ambrose, Julian Griffin, Brent Leonard, Anthony McCall, J.J. McCoy, Darrel McNeal, LaGregory Sapp and Tim Taylor are all expected to be big contributors this season.

In the opener, seven of the eight caught at least one pass (Julian Griffin).

## THE A-TRAIN

Junior tight end Alvin Jordan had some big shoes to fill this season replacing two-time All-Sun Belt tight end Zeek Zacharie. In his first game as the No. 1 tight end, Jordan led the Warhawks with 48 receiving yards and tied LaGregory Sapp for the team lead with three receptions.

## MCCALL SETS FRESHMAN MARK

Anthony McCall set the ULM freshman record with his six touchdown receptions last season.

He had touchdown catches against Arkansas (2), Alabama A&M, Florida Atlantic, Middle Tennessee and Florida International. He finished the year ranked eighth among all freshmen in the NCAA with his six touchdown receptions.

## BALL SECURITY

ULM ranked seventh in the nation last season with just 14 turnovers on the year. The Warhawks lost just five fumbles on the year to rank fifth in the NCAA and threw just nine interceptions to rank 23rd in the NCAA.

## STANDING STRONG

The ULM offensive line did something that only two other teams had done in the previous 40 games -- hold the Texas defense without a sack.

The unit also paved the way for ULM running backs to tally 101 yards rushing against a Texas team that allowed just 83.5 yards per game on the ground last season -- third best in the nation.

## MAC ATTACK

The ULM wide receiver corps last season was turned into the Mac Attack show as the Warhawks top three wide receivers all shared the common Mc prefix in their last name.

Darrell McNeal, Anthony McCall and J.J. McCoy accounted for 1,171 of the 1,397 (83.8%) receiving yards by the ULM wideouts. The trio accounted for 12 of ULM's 20 receiving touchdowns.

## D-MAC AMONG THE NATION'S BEST

Wide receiver Darrell McNeal ranks among the NCAA's best in several career categories for active players.

- 17th in catches (131)
- 10th in punt returns (43)
- 17th in punt returns/game (1.2)

## D-MAC IS THE NEW SLASH

You might as well just call ULM wide receiver Darrell McNeal "Slash" from now on.

Last season the senior from Monroe led the Warhawks in receptions and receiving yards, rushed for four touchdowns and also threw a touchdown pass.

His four rushing touchdowns were a ULM record by a wide receiver.

McNeal's 10 catches at Middle Tennessee tied him for the most during Charlie Weatherbie's tenure at ULM. His 149 yards receiving at Arkansas State rank as the most since Mack Vincent had 166 in 2003 against Louisiana-Lafayette. Both games were in 2008.

## FINDING THE END ZONE

The Warhawks had an incredible streak of 18 consecutive scoring drives that resulted in a touchdown last season. The streak ended with a Radi Jabour 48-yard field goal against Troy.

It was the second straight season that the Warhawks had pieced together such a streak. In 2007, ULM scored touchdowns on 24-of-27 scoring drives to end the season. ULM ended 2008 scoring touchdowns on 26 of its final 28 scoring drives.

## OFFENSIVE IMPROVEMENT

Over the past two seasons the Warhawks have averaged their highest point output of their I-A era. ULM averaged 23.5 points per game in 2007 and then followed that up with a 23.7 per game average last season. If you take out ULM's two shutout losses last season (Auburn & Ole Miss), the Warhawks averaged 28.4 points per game.

## ULM OFFENSE -- TAKE TWO

ULM's number two offense saw the field early at Texas in the season opener. On its third possession of the game, the ULM coaches sent out the entire second unit for a series.

## COMBINED STARTS

The starting 11 players for ULM on offense in the season opener at Texas have combined to start 107 games in their career -- 9.7 starts per player.

## GOING DEEP

Trey Revell and Luther Ambrose hooked up for a 75-yard touchdown pass and catch in the second quarter against Texas. It was the longest play against the Texas defense since Sept. 23, 2003, and it was ULM's longest offensive play since a 77-yard touchdown pass from Steve Jyles to Drouzon Quillen against Florida International in 2004.

## IT'S TREY'S TURN

After serving for two seasons as Kinsmon Lancaster's backup, redshirt-junior Trey Revell gets his chance to be the full-time starter at quarterback for the Warhawks. Revell has made one start each of the past two seasons and has played in 14 games during his career.

The defining moments of his career the past two seasons came at North Texas in 2007 and against Troy last season.

Against the Mean Green, he threw three touchdown passes in the second half as he tried to rally the Warhawks from an early 21-0 deficit.

In the game against Troy, Revell led the Warhawks on a 7-play game-winning drive late in the fourth quarter.

## GOODIN GETS IT GOING

ULM running back Frank Goodin had a little trouble finding yards early against Texas, but turned it on late.

Goodin was held to a loss of three yards over his first eight carries of the game, but tallied 63 yards on his final seven carries of the game, including a touchdown.

## RECEPTIONS STREAK

Darrell McNeal ranks 13th in the nation with a 23 straight games with a catch. His last game without at least one catch came in the '07 season opener against Tulsa.

The 85 yards against Auburn, 33 of which came on one pass play, was the third fewest allowed by a ULM defense under Charlie Weatherbie and the fewest for Auburn since 2006 when Georgia held the Tigers to just 35 yards.

## TOUGH AS A TRUX

Senior Hawk James Truxillo returns for his senior season after missing the majority of last season due to an ACL injury.

Truxillo (trucks-ill-o) went down in the second quarter against Arkansas in the second game of the season.

One of the true leaders on the team, Truxillo continued to honor his captain responsibilities traveling with the team the remainder of the season and going out for the opening coin toss.

## QUICK OFF THE EDGE

Senior defensive end Aaron Morgan broke onto the scene last season with six sacks and 13 tackles for loss.

His sack total ranked third best in the Sun Belt Conference and was the most by a Warhawk since 2005.

With the new defensive scheme in place, look for Morgan's numbers to increase this season.

In the opener at Texas, Morgan had a sack and two tackles for loss.

## PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

ULM players earned defensive player of the week honors four times last season.

Cardia Jackson was a two-time Louisiana Player of the Week, Nate Brown earned one Louisiana Player of the Week honor and Josh Thompson was named Sun Belt Player of the Week once.

## TURNOVERS & SACKS

The ULM defense in its first game running the 3-3-5 scheme forced three turnovers, recorded a pair of sacks and totaled five tackles for loss against No. 2 Texas.

In comparison, last season the Warhawks averaged 1.3 turnovers, 1.1 sacks and 5.2 tackles for loss per game.

## PRELOW IN PRIMETIME

Sophomore defensive back Darius Prelow came on strong at the end of last season recording 14 tackles over the final four contests.

In the season opener at Texas, Prelow led the Warhawks with 10 tackles and also had a pass breakup.

## CARDIA IS DEALING

Last season Cardia Jackson finished eighth in the NCAA average 10.6 tackles per contest. He entered this season as the Sun Belt Conference's top returning tackler after finishing with 127 last season.

Jackson tallied eight tackles in the opener at Texas, including one for an eight-yard loss.

# ULM HEAD COACH CHARLIE WEATHERBIE



Charlie Weatherbie begins his seventh season at the helm of the ULM football program.

Weatherbie led the Warhawks to one of their most memorable seasons in the program's history in 2007. The 2007 season marked the first year that ULM was bowl eligible since it made the jump to Division I-A in 1994. The Warhawks won five of their last six games on the season including one of the biggest upsets in all of college football, knocking off Alabama 21-14 in Tuscaloosa, Ala., on Nov. 17.

Weatherbie guided 10 players to All-Sun Belt Conference honors that year and oversaw ULM running back Calvin Dawson's climb to greatness as he set the ULM career rushing record. Dawson and the rest of the Warhawk offense posted the highest per game

scoring average in the ULM Division I-A era.

Last year the Warhawks defeated Troy 31-30 marking the second straight season that ULM was the lone Sun Belt Conference team to defeat the eventual conference champion. The Weatherbie led Warhawks also came within one point of defeating Arkansas (28-27) in Little Rock, Ark.

The Warhawks came within five points of finishing 7-5 on the season and becoming bowl eligible -- two one-point losses and a three-point loss.

Seven players earned All-Sun Belt Conference honors in 2008 including Cardia Jackson and Zeek Zacharie, who were tabbed to the first team.

Under his direction, the Warhawk football program has made significant strides improving from winning one game in 2003 to winning the 2005 Sun Belt Conference Championship in just three seasons.

Weatherbie, ULM's 13th head coach, took over the program a little less than three months before kicking off the 2003 season.

The 2006 Warhawks finished the season by winning three of their last four games, including a win over Louisiana-Lafayette for the fourth time in five years, and coming close to upsetting bowl-bound Kentucky. Quarterback Kinsmon Lancaster and Dawson created a high-powered offense for ULM with a league-leading 350.7 yards per game. It was the first time a Warhawk had rushed for over 1,000 yards in the Weatherbie era. Dawson and safety Kevin Payne joined the growing list of all-Sun Belt first team members during Weatherbie's tenure.

The 2005 squad made its mark by winning ULM's first conference title since 1992. The Warhawks finished the season with a 5-2 Sun Belt record and had 10 players receive all-Sun Belt honors, including Sun Belt Player of the Year Steven Jyles. Jyles re-wrote the ULM passing and total offense record books and has gone on to play for the Edmonton Eskimos and Saskatchewan Rough Riders in the Canadian Football League.

The 2004 squad won five of their last seven games, including four wins in Sun Belt play. ULM's 4-3 Sun Belt record put Weatherbie's squad in a tie for third place. The season also saw ULM beat intrastate rival Louisiana-Lafayette for the third season in a row.

In 2003, his first season at the helm, ULM lost seven games by seven points or less and highlighted the season with a win over Louisiana-Lafayette.

Weatherbie continues to be excited about the challenge of winning Sun Belt Conference championships at ULM and representing the league in a bowl game.

When asked at his first ULM press conference on May 7, 2003 whether he was an "offensive-minded" or "defensive-minded" coach, Weatherbie responded, "I'm a win-minded coach".

The enthusiasm that Weatherbie brings to a community has been continually shown at each of his stops. Since Weatherbie arrived on the ULM campus, attendance at Warhawk games has seen a significant increase of over 10,000 fans per game.

Weatherbie has twice proven that he can take over sub .500 football programs and transform them into winning teams. At Utah State University, he inherited a program that had not had a winning season in 12 years and took the Aggies to their first Big West Conference championship in 15 years, their first bowl game in 32 years and their first bowl victory ever, after beating Ball State 42-33 in the 1993 Las Vegas Bowl. He was 12-11 in his first two seasons, 1992-93, leaving after the third season to take the same position at the United States Naval Academy. The Aggies' 1993 win over Brigham Young still stands as Utah State's only win in the last 18 meetings with their in-state rival.

At Navy, Weatherbie had similar success. He took the Midshipmen, who had suffered through 12 consecutive losing seasons prior to his arrival, to a 9-3 record and the championship of the 1996 Aloha Bowl in his second season. The nine wins were the most by a Navy team in 18 years. At the time, he was just the third coach in academy history to win a bowl game.

In 1997, Weatherbie led Navy to a 7-4 mark, the first time since the 1981-82 seasons that the Midshipmen had compiled back-to-back winning seasons. The 16 wins over two years tied for the third most in academy history. He was named ECAC Coach of the Year and was the head defensive coach at the Kelly Tire Blue/Gray Classic.

Weatherbie's first team at Annapolis went 5-6 in 1995, after Navy had won just nine games the previous four seasons combined.

Weatherbie entered the coaching ranks in 1977 as a graduate assistant at his alma mater, Oklahoma State.

After three years playing professionally, Weatherbie was hired as an assistant coach at Wyoming. Serving as the quarterbacks coach, Wyoming led the nation in fewest interceptions in 1981.

He left Wyoming after the 1983 season to be an assistant coach at the United States Air Force Academy. During his six seasons on legendary head coach Fisher DeBerry's staff, Air Force was an overall 48-25-1 and participated in four bowl games. The Falcons had five winning seasons during his tenure, finishing 8-4 and winning the Independence Bowl in 1984. The next season the Falcons went 12-1, finished the year ranked No. 5 nationally and were Bluebonnet Bowl champions.

The University of Arkansas would be the next stop on Weatherbie's coaching journey. He spent two seasons on the Razorback staff before being named the head coach at Utah State in 1992.

During Weatherbie's years as a head coach, he has had numerous current NCAA Bowl Sub-division head coaches and NFL coaches work under his tutelage, including Gary Patterson (TCU), Brent Guy (Utah State), Paul Johnson (Naval Academy), and Jim Zorn (Seattle Seahawks).

Weatherbie graduated from Fort Scott High School in Kansas in 1973. He was a quarter-

back during his scholastic playing days, earning all-state and honorable mention All-America honors in football. He also participated in basketball and track, serving as team captain in all three sports.

The native of Sedan, Kan., continued his playing career at Oklahoma State, where he was a three-year starter and a team captain from 1974-76. He earned a bachelor's degree in health, physical education and recreation from OSU in 1977. He was a member of the Dean's Honor Roll.

Weatherbie signed with the Houston Oilers in 1978 and the San Diego Chargers in 1979 before spending his final two playing seasons in the Canadian Football League. He played for the Hamilton Tiger Cats and Ottawa Rough Riders in 1979 and 1980.

Weatherbie, 54, is married to the former Leann Jonas of Stillwater, Okla. They have two sons, Lance and Jonas, a daughter-in-law, Brittany, a granddaughter, Hannah, and two grandsons, Braxton and Jonas, Jr.

AUSTIN, Texas - Heisman Trophy finalist Colt McCoy threw for 317 yards and two touchdowns to lead No. 2 Texas past ULM 59-20 in both teams' season opener in front of a Texas Memorial Stadium record crowd of 101,096.

Cody Johnson scored the first three touchdowns of the night for the Longhorns (1-0) on 1-yard runs. Texas became the highest-ranked team that the Warhawks (0-1) have squared off against in a season opener.

McCoy, who finished second behind Oklahoma quarterback Sam Bradford for the Heisman Trophy last year, completed 21-of-29 passes on the night.

In his third career start and first as ULM's number one quarterback, junior Trey Revell completed 14-of-30 passes for 197 yards and one touchdown. Sophomore wide receiver Luther Ambrose showed his big-play capability with a 75-yard touchdown reception, 25 rushing yards and 105 kick return yards.

ULM's new 3-3-5 defense was tested by the high-powered Texas offense, but came up with some big plays. Otis Stamps intercepted McCoy in the second quarter and the Warhawks forced a trio of fumbles and recovered two. Two of Texas' touchdowns came on a short field due to ULM turnovers.

The Warhawks gave Texas the one thing it didn't need, a short field on its first possession of the game. After a bad snap led to a fumble on ULM's second play of the game, Johnson found the end zone four plays later.

Following Johnson's second touchdown of the game and a ULM three-and-out, the Warhawk defense gave ULM its first scoring opportunity of the night. Jordan Landry forced a Vondrell McGee fumble and Josh Thomas ran it back 29 yards to the Longhorns' 8-yard line.

Radi Jabour gave the Warhawks their first points of the season four plays later connecting on a 24-yard field goal with 4:23 to play in the opening quarter. He would later add a 21-yard field goal in the fourth quarter.

Johnson, who finished the game with 27 yards on 11 carries, scored his third touchdown of the night with 11:02 to play in the opening half to stretch the Texas lead out to 21-3.

On the ensuing possession, Revell and Ambrose hooked up for a 75-yard touchdown pass down the ULM sideline - the longest play for ULM since 2004 and the longest against a Texas defense since 2003.

D.J. Moore quickly killed any momentum ULM had built up taking the following kickoff back 89 yards for a touchdown and a 28-10 Texas lead.

The Warhawks had a prime opportunity to get back into the game after Stamps' interception, which he returned to the Texas 39-yard line, with just over nine minutes to play in the opening half. However, ULM was not able to capitalize on the turnover as the Longhorns forced a punt.

McCoy quickly atoned for his interception as he completed a 14-yard pass on a third-and-long from Texas' 8-yard line and then found Jordan Shipley for a 78-yard touchdown on the very next play. Hunter Lawrence added a 32-yard field goal as time expired in the second quarter to give Texas a 38-10 lead at the break.

McCoy moved over the 10,000-yard mark for his career with a 14-yard touchdown pass to John Chiles on the Longhorns opening drive of the second half. McGee tacked on a 4-yard touchdown run on the first play of the fourth quarter to extend the lead out to 52-10.

The ULM offense found its groove in the fourth quarter putting together a pair of nine-play, 60-plus yard drives. Jabour's second field goal of the night capped the first drive and a 13-yard run by Frank Goodin was the final score of the night.

Texas' freshman quarterback Garrett Gilbert split the two scores with a 12-yard keeper for a touchdown to extend the Longhorns lead to 59-13.
