## FIU Panthers (2-5; 2-1 SBC) vs.ULM Warhawks (4-4; 3-2 SBC)

**THE GAME** – It's Homecoming week for the Panthers as FIU looks to get back in the win column when they host the ULM Warhawks. FIU is coming off a loss to rival Florida Atlantic in Shula Bowl IX, while the Warhawks are coming off an impressive 28-14 home win over Sun Belt Conference powerhouse Troy. With a victory against the Warhawks, FIU would notch its third Sun Belt victory of the year, matching the program's highest total for conference victories. FIU is looking for its first victory over the ULM Warhawks, as they dropped a 48-35 decision in Monroe last time the teams met.

**T.Y. 2K –** With 124 receiving yards against Florida Atlantic (10/30/10), junior wide receiver T.Y. Hilton became the third Panther ever to go over 2,000 receiving yards for his career, with 2,067. It was also Hilton's sixth-career 100-yard receiving game.

WHEELS KEEP ON ROLLIN' – Against WKU (10/9/10), the FIU running game had its best night in nearly three years, picking up 235 yards on the ground, the best total since FIU had 264 yards against Louisiana on November 17, 2007. FIU also scored four touchdowns on the ground, which is tied for the most-ever in a game by FIU. The following week, against North Texas (10/16/10), FIU maintained the successful running game, picking up 191 yards on the ground. The wheels kept on rolling against Florida Atlantic (10/30/10) as the Panthers picked up 150 rushing yards. The 576 rushing yards in three consecutive games are the most FIU has had since picking up 558 in consecutive games in 2005 (168 vs WKU - 11/19/05, 266 vs Florida Atlantic - 11/26/05 & 124 vs Middle Tennessee - 12/3/05).

**CROSS RHODES** – Freshman Kedrick Rhodes had a breakout performance against Florida Atlantic (10/30/10), rushing for 100 yards on 18 carries. Rhodes became the first Panther to rush for over 100 yards since Kendall Berry did it against Middle Tennessee on November 7, 2009.

**JACK-ED UP –** Sophomore kicker Jack Griffin went 3-for-3 on field goal attempts against Florida Atlantic, setting a new career-high. For his efforts, Griffin was named one of collegefootballperformance.com's Kicker Performer of the Week

**GAITOR BAIT** – Known as one of the best pass defenders in the conference, Anthony Gaitor's biggest contributions in FIU's victory over WKU (10/9/10) came behind the line of scrimmage. With WKU driving towards a potential game-tying touchdown, Gaitor made a stop behind the line of scrimmage on an end-around that put WKU in a 4th-and-8 situation after a loss of four yards. Two drives earlier, Gaitor forced WKU to punt after sacking Kawaun Jakes on third down. Gaitor was back at it against North Texas, picking up another sack. On the season, Gaitor now has career-highs of 6.5 tackles for loss and three sacks.

After picking off five passes in 2008, Anthony Gaitor had just two interceptions in 2009. Already in 2010, Gaitor has picked off two passes, which ranks second in the country. Gaitor's latest interception was a big one as he took it 54 yards for a touchdown that gave FIU a 20-6 lead over the Texas A&M Aggies. Gaitor also sacked Jerrod Johnson, forcing a fumble that FIU recovered and turned into a field goal that gave the Panthers a 3-0 lead at the time.

**FOUR OF A KIND** – With his 100-yard performance against FAU, Kedrick Rhodes now has 260 rushing yards, becoming the fourth Panther to rush for over 200-yards this year. Rhodes, Jeremiah Harden (242), Darriet Perry (236) and Darian Mallary (224) are the only quartet in FIU history to each run for over 200 yards in a season.

**FORGED IN STEELE** – The FIU football team received 11 Phil Steele Midseason All-Sun Belt Conference selections, including three players on the first-team. FIU's 11 selections are the third-most in the conference, trailing only Troy (15) and Arkansas State (12).

T.Y. Hilton, Anthony Gaitor and Jonathan Cyprien were selected to the first-team. Hilton also received second-team honors as a kick returner and he was joined on the second-team by Greg Ellingson and Brad Serini. Caylin Hauptman, Cedrick Mack, Jarvis Wilson, Winston Fraser and Jack Griffin all were third-team selections.

**D IS FOR DOMINANT –** FIU's defense, which was ranked second in the country after the season-opener against Rutgers, has returned to its dominat form over the last few weeks. After allowing just 285 yards of offense to North Texas (64 of them coming on a fake punt), FIU's defense is now ranked 39th in the country in total defense.

FIU is especially stingy against the pass as the Panthers rank 15th in pass defense and 28th in pass efficiency defense. Much of that success can be attributed to the relentless pass rush as FIU ranks 32nd in the country in sacks per game. The relentless rush has also translated into seven tackles for loss per game, good for 24th in the country.

**ELLING\$ON** – "Money Plays" are defined as plays resulting in a first down or touchdown. This season, senior wideout Greg Ellingson has been FIU's go-to "Money Man." Ellingson leads the team with 20 such receptions (18 1st downs/ 2 TD). Through his careeer, Ellingson has been one of FIU's most consistent and reliable receivers. This season has been no different as he leads the team with 363 receiving yards on 23 receptions. Ellingson now has 1,769 career receiving yards, which is the fifth-best total in FIU history.

**OUT OF THE GATES** – The FIU defense is yet to allow a first-quarter touchdown this season. FIU has outscored opponents 44-6 in the first quarter.

**YOU CAN'T TOUCH THIS –** The FIU offensive line went through a major overhaul this offseason. Not only did Alex Mirabal take over as new offensive line coach, but FIU lost three starters off last year's O-line. With the addition of Caylin Hauptmann, the emergence of Cedric Mack, Giancarlo Revilla and Rupert Bryan, and of course, Rimmington Watchlist member Brad Serini, the FIU offensive line has been dominant in the passing game, allowing just eight sacks through the first seven games. The 1.17 sacks-per-game allowed rank 30th in the country.

**PANTHER CUBS** – As it seems to be the case every year for FIU, numerous freshmen have seen playing time for FIU in 2010. A total of 15 freshmen and redshirt-freshmen have seen action this season for the Panthers. All-in-all, 36 underclassmen (Fr., R-Fr., So., R-So.) have seen the field this year for FIU.

**OOH...AHH** – Darian Mallary, nicknamed "Ooh" for his ability to make people miss, had a breakout game against Western Kentucky (10/9/10). Mallary set a career-high with 97 rushing yards on just nine carries for an ooh-inspiring 10.8 yards per carry.

**PAYDIRT FOR DP –** Darriet Perry found the endzone once against WKU (10/9/10) after scoring two rushing touchdowns against Pitt (10/2/10). Perry has now scored five rushing touchdowns, which matches his total from his first two seasons. Perry now has 10-career rushing touchdowns, which is tied for the third-best total in FIU history. Rashod Smith holds the record with 24.

**HELMET STICKER FOR ALL** – For their efforts against Texas A&M on September 18, the entire FIU defense was awarded an ESPN.com Helmet Sticker. The award was one of four given out to members of schools from non-BCS conferences.

FIU was again awarded a helmet sticker after their 28-21 victory over WKU (10/9/10). This time it was head coach Mario Cristobal who received the honor for his team's performance against the Hilltoppers.

**TWO AWARDS FOR NUMBER SEVEN** –For his outstanding performance on September 18 against Texas A&M, Gaitor was named the Sun Belt Conference Defensive Player of the Week. This marks the second time Gaitor has received the honor, the first coming in 2008 after intercepting two passes and returning one for a touchdown against Middle Tennessee (10/11/08). For his efforts, Gaitor was also named Honorable Mention Defensive Back Performer of the Week by collegefootballperformance.com.

**THE NOT-SO-DIRTY DOZEN –** On September 25 against Maryland, Wesley Carroll set an FIU record by completing 12-consecutive passes at one point. Carroll's streak began in the second quarter when he connected with T.Y. Hilton for an eight-yard gain. The streak carried into the third-quarter until a 2nd-and-14 attempt to Ty Frierson fell incomplete. Included in the 12 completions were touchdown passes to Greg Ellingson and Jonathan Faucher.

FLINGIN' IT – In FIU's 42-28 loss to Maryland on September 25, quarterback Wesley Carroll set the FIU record for most pass attempts (58) and most completions (35).

**SPREADING THE LOVE –** On September 25 against Maryland, Wesley Carroll set an FIU record by completing a pass to 12 different receivers. In setting the FIU record for

completions, Carroll connected with T.Y. Hilton (7), Greg Ellingson (6), Wayne Times (5), Jonathan Faucher (3), Junior Mertile (3), Jeremiah Harden (3), Ty Frierson (2), Kedrick Rhodes (2), Darriet Perry (1), Darrian Mallary (1), Jairus Williams (1), and Jacob Younger (1).

**THEY'RE ALWAYS WATCHING** – For the third-consecutive year, senior center Brad Serini has been named to the Rimmington Award Watchlist. The prestigious award is given each year to the nation's best center. Serini has been a staple on the FIU offensive line, starting all 37 games since his arrival at FIU. Serini's leadership will be crucial in 2010 as he leads a very talented, but very young offensive line. Several sophomores and freshmen are expected to compete for starting roles and playing time along the o-line, and Serini will be looked upon to be the anchor of the FIU front-five.

**WELL THAT'S NEW –** In 2010, the FIU Panthers will look very different to opposing teams. Not only will several impact players make their on-field debut, but two impact coaches will make their debut on the FIU sidelines as well. New offensive and defensive coordinators Scott Satterfield and Geoff Collins will bring a new look to the FIU attack and defense as they begin their first seasons with the Panthers. Satterfield comes to FIU after successful stints at Appalachian State and Toledo. Collins brings his scheme to FIU after helping UCF become one of the best defenses in Conference USA.

A HOME A LONG WAY FROM HOME - Caylin Hauptmann, one of the nation's top junior college offensive tackles last year, is expected to start for FIU.

Hauptmann, a 6-4, 312 lb. sophomore from College of the Canyons in Santa Clarita, Calif., was able to meet the academic requirements to leave College of the Canyons early and head to Miami to play for Mario Cristobal and the FIU Panthers. "Caylin has the ability to be an instant difference-maker in the trenches," said Cristobal about his latest recruit. "We're extremely excited about having Caylin join the FIU family."

In coming to FIU, Hauptman turned down offers from several Pac-10 schools like California, UCLA and Washington

**ONE OF A KIND** - In 2010, FIU hauled in, arguably, its best recruiting class ever. Ranked by several recruiting services as the best class in the Sun Belt Conference, FIU's 2010 class was highlighted by Willis Wright. The 6-1, 200 lb. wideout was the only ESPNU Top-150 recruit to sign with a non-BCS team in 2010. Nicknamed "The Manchild," Wright has all the physical tools to be an impact player right away.

**BALL CONTROL** – FIU has done a good job of controlling the football this year, winning the time of possession battle in five of the seven games. On September 25 against Maryland, the Panthers ran 98 plays to the Terrapins' 55 and held the ball for over 34 minutes.

#### THE T.Y. FILE

Despite being limited by injuries in 2009, T.Y. Hilton still managed to leap up several all-time rankings at FIU.

Hilton is already the all-time leader in career all-purpose yards at FIU with 3,513. His two single-season totals (2,163, 1,350) are the top-two in FIU history. He also holds four of the top-five single-game all-purpose yardage performances.

As a receiver, Hilton is also quickly climbing to the top of the all-time chart. His 11 receptions against ULM tied an all-time best for FIU, while his 57 catches in '09 are the fourth-best total ever. Hilton has caught 98 passes in his career, already the fifth-best total in FIU history. His 12 TD catches are tied for the second-most ever by a Panther.

MR. DO-IT-ALL - In 2008, T.Y. Hilton became the only player this decade to score a TD in five different ways (Reception, Pass, Rush, Kick Return and Punt Return). The first time Hilton touched the ball in his freshman year at Kansas (8/30/08), he returned a punt 74 yards for a TD. He returned a kick off 90 yards for a TD at Louisiana (11/1/08) and he threw for a TD against Arkansas State (11/8/08). He then rushed for a TD against FAU (11/29/09). He also had seven receptions for TD.

**HILTON HEAVE** - Maybe his best game or moment as a Panther came on what is now called the "**Hilton Heave**", when T.Y. set a new school record with 199 receiving yards and recorded his fourth-straight game of 200-plus all-purpose yards against Arkansas State. But the Coup De Gras for Hilton against the Red Wolves was his 38-yard touchdown pass that clinched a 22-21 FIU victory. Afterwards, he not only earned Sun Belt Conference Player of the Week accolades, but he also was given an ESPN.com Helmet Sticker.

**General Statement:** Credentials for FIU home football games are for working media only. Spouses, dates, children under 18 and other non-workers are not permitted in working media areas in compliance with the working codes of the Football Writers Association of America (FWAA).

**Press Policies:** Working space in the press box is assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. Credentials will be issued according to the following criteria:

- Local and state newspapers by circulation, wire services, national publications, newspapers from opponent's area and student newspapers from FIU and opponent's schools.
- 2.) Other daily newspapers with preference to those that regularly cover FIU.
- 3.) Radio and television personnel not broadcasting but considered reporting (seats may be provided in the stands).
- 4.) Non-daily newspapers with preference to those that regularly cover FIU.
- 5.) Scouts.

Freelance and/or non-daily writers may be asked to produce copies of actual publications in which their work has appeared. In some cases, these materials will be requested as verification of a writer's status.

**Photo credentials** will be issued on a game-by-game basis. FIU adheres to all NCAA guidelines regarding sideline photography that limits shooting to outside the restraining line enclosing the playing field and outside the 25-yard line.

**Practice Attendance:** Working media may only attend the first 20 minutes of weekday practice sessions. During the season, the team's day off is Monday. Media planning on attending practices should first check in with Associate Sports Information Director Ivan Irizarry. THE FIU LOCKER AND ATHLETIC TRAINING ROOMS ARE OFF LIMITS TO THE MEDIA.

HEAD COACH MARIO CRISTOBAL (Miami, Fla., 1993) begins his fourth season as head football coach at FIU with a 9-27 career record...Prior to his appointment at FIU, Cristobal spent three seasons as tight ends/offensive line coach at the University of Miami (Fla.) where the Hurricanes compiled a 24-12 record and appeared in the 2004 and '05 Chick-fil-A Peach Bowl and the 2006 Micron PC Bowl...Cristobal spent the prior three years as an assistant at Rutgers, helping turn the Scarlet Knights into one of the top programs in the BCS...He was a four-year letterwinner and member of the UM football team from 1988-92, earning All-BIG EAST honors as an offensive tackle in 1992...Cristobal signed with the Denver Broncos as an undrafted rookie in 1994 and played for the Amsterdam Admirals in NFL Europe in 1995 and '96 before beginning his coaching career...Cristobal is the third-youngest head coach at the Football Bowl Subdivision level. Only Northwestern's Pat Fitzgerald (35) and USC's Lane Kiffin (35) are younger than Cristobal who turns 39 on September 24.

- Offensive Coordinator/Quarterbacks **Scott Satterfield** (1st season): Scott Satterfield joins the FIU staff after spending a season as the passing game coordinator/quarterbacks coach at Toledo. Last year, the Rockets averaged 438 yards of offense, including 278 in the passing game. Prior to Toledo he spent both his playing and coaching career at Appalachian State. - Special Teams Coordinator/RBs **Apollo Wright** (3rd season): Helped FIU to finish third among Sun Belt Conference teams in kick-off returns, punt returns and punting...Spent six seasons at Villanova as the running backs coach and special teams coordinator and helped with the development of Philadelphia Eagles All-Pro Brian Westbrook.
- Defensive Line **Cedric Calhoun** (1st season): Cedric Calhoun comes to FIU after spending four seasons at Dartmouth as the linebackers coach for the Big Green. Calhoun joined the Big Green staff in 2006 after serving as defensive line coach at Alabama A&M University from 2002-05.

## GAME ONE ● FIU 14 - RUTGERS 19 • SEPTEMBER 11, 2010 • FIU STADIUM, MIAMI FLA.

FIU was statistically superior to Rutgers in every category in the Panthers' season-opener, with the exception of one department - the final score. The Scarlet Knights, who were bullied by the Panthers defense throughout Saturday night, squeaked out a 19-14 win at FIU Stadium in front of an all-time record crowd of 19,872 on a warm, muggy evening.

FIU committed five turnovers, had two punts blocked, and committed 14 penalties for 126 yards. Rutgers capitalized, scoring each time following an FIU turnover or blocked punt. The mistakes overshadowed a ferocious effort by the FIU defense, which played its first game under new defensive coordinator Geoff Collins.

At halftime, Rutgers had just 93 total yards and the Scarlet Knights tallied just 172 yards for the game. Rutgers running back Joe Martinek, who ran for 121 yards against FIU in last year's game, could only rush for 28 yards on Saturday.

FIU led 14-13 early in the fourth quarter. The Panthers went three-and-out on their first possession of the final period and had to punt. On fourth down, Rutgers' special teams blocked FIU punter Josh Brisk's kick and took over at the FIU 24.

The Scarlet Knights needed just one play when receiver Mohamed Sanu, operating out of the Wildcat, ran around the left side for a 24-yard touchdown to give Rutgers a lead it would not relinquish.

After trailing 3-0 early in the first quarter, FIU took a 7-3 lead near the end of the first quarter when Wesley Carroll, playing in his first game as Panther after transferring from Mississippi State, connected with Wayne Times on a 28-yard touchdown pass.

Rutgers regained the lead in the second quarter with the help of an FIU interception and a blocked punt. The Scarlet Knights led 13-7 at the half before the Panthers. A Rutgers fumble opened the door for FIU to go back on top coming out of the locker room in the third quarter. The Scarlet Knights bobbled the snap at their 32 and there was FIU defensive back Jose Cheeseborough to scoop up the ball. Three plays later, Carroll connected with new FIU running back Jeremiah Harden for a 17-yard touchdown. Harden led FIU with 88 yards rushing in his Panthers debut.

**COLLEGE STATION**, **Texas** - FIU entered its game against Texas A&M as heavy underdogs, but the Panthers battled for four quarters before just falling short in a 27-20 loss to the Aggies in College Station, Texas.

Down by seven points with no timeouts, less than four minutes left in the game and needing to go more than 70 yards to score, the Panthers drove to the Aggies 7.

On fourth-and-goal, FIU quarterback Wesley Carroll connected with receiver T.Y. Hilton, but Hilton was tackled short of the end zone at the 3 to turn the ball over on downs to the Aggies.

The Panthers didn't make it easy on the Aggies. Texas A&M had to rally from a two-touchdown deficit in the fourth quarter. The Aggies scored 21 unanswered points to spark their comeback victory.

For most of the game, the Panthers defense – which entered the game ranked as the No. 2 defense in the nation – dominated the Aggies offense and Heisman Trophy candidate quarterback Jerrod Johnson.FIU sacked Johnson six times in the first half and allowed just 203 total yards to Texas A&M through three quarters. The Panthers also forced five turnovers against the Aggies.

After a first half defensive struggle between the teams that resulted in two field goals by both the Panthers and Aggies, FIU took advantage of a couple of Johnson interceptions in the third quarter.

On the first possession of the second half, FIU safety Ash Parker picked off Johnson at the Aggies 19. Three plays later, Panthers running back Darriet Perry scored from one yard out to give FIU a 13-6 lead.

Midway through the third quarter, FIU defensive back Anthony Gaitor swooped into the middle of the field and intercepted Johnson. Gaitor sprinted 54 yards for a touchdown and extended the Panthers lead to 20-6.

It was Perry's third score of the season, and gave FIU a 7-3 lead with 8:35 to go in the first half. Deep in Pitt territory and facing third-and-four, Wayne Times took a reverse all the way to the Pitt one-yard line to prolong the drive and set up the score. FIU picked up five first downs on the drive, one on the reverse, two on completions to Ellingson and the another two on hard-nosed runs by Perry.

The lead didn't last long for FIU, as Pitt came right back with a rushing touchdown of their own to take a 10-7 lead at the 7:02 mark of the second quarter. The score came on a Graham 34-yard run.

FIU's offense went back to work right away, putting together a 16-play, 67-yard drive that ended on a 27-yard field goal by Jack Griffin. The score tied the game at 10 with 1:01 to go in the first half.

After taking a 13-10 lead into the half, Pitt led 16-10 through three quarters. The Pitt offense then took over, scoring three rushing touchdowns and one through the air to put away FIU.

MIAMI - The FIU football team tied a program-record with four rushing touchdowns en route to a 28-21 victory over the WKU Hilltoppers, Saturday afternoon at FIU Stadium, The win, FIU's first of the season, is all the more important as it comes on FIU's Sun Belt Conference opener.

The Panthers got off to a 21-0 lead with 12:24 left in the first half, but WKU battled back to make a game of it late as the score was 28-21 with under a minute to play. On fourth down, from FIU's 22, WKU quarterback Kawaun Jakes launched a pass into the endzone, but senior cornerback Dez Johnson broke up the play to

Sophomore running back Darian Mallary led the rushing attack for the Panthers, scoring once and racking up a career-high 97 yards on nine carries. Junior Darriet Perry added 65 yards and a score on 14 carries, while freshman Kedrick Rhodes ran for 59 yards. T.Y. Hilton and Wesley Carroll each added a rushing touchdown.

On defense, safety Jonathan Cyprien set a career-high with 13 tackles. Jose Cheesborough and Winston Fraser added eight tackles apiece. Senior cornerback Anthony Gaitor had another big game for FIU, picking up a sack, and two tackles for loss, including one on a crucial third-down play during WKU's final possession.

FIU jumped ahead on their second drive as Hilton scored his first touchdown of the season. The Panthers drove 73-yards in just 1:37 to take a 7-0 lead with 9:23 remaining in the first quarter. On the drive, Kedrick Rhodes got FIU into the redzone on a 39-yard run, and Hilton put FIU on top on a 12-yard reverse.

FIU doubled its lead with 12:24 to go in the second guarter when Mallary scored on a five-yard carry. The score was set up by a 37-yard run by Mallary, which was the longest of his career. The score was made possible by a Hilton 33-yard catch on third down that extended the FIU drive.

The Panthers made the score 21-0 with 8:09 to go in the first half when Perry scored on a four-yard run. It was Perry's 10th-career rushing score, which is tied for 3rd all-time at FIU. The scoring drive lasted eight plays and covered 60 yards. On the drive, Carroll completed six passes for 51 yards.

WKU cut into the FIU lead with 3:28 left in the first half when Kawaun Jakes found tight end Jack Doyle for a six-yard touchdown, making the score 21-7. The Hilltoppers would score two more touchdowns before FIU stopped them on fourth-and goal late in the game to seal the victory.

**Denton, Texas** - The FIU football team scored 17 first-quarter points and never looked back as the Panthers handled the North Texas Mean Green, 34-10, Saturday night in Denton, Texas. With the win, FIU moves to 2-4 on the season, but more importantly, 2-0 in the Sun Belt Conference.

Facing the second-ranked defense in the conference, FIU racked up 479 yards of total offense, led by Wesley Carroll who threw for 288 yards and two scores. Greg Ellingson led all receivers with 80 yards on three catches, and he also scored once. T.Y. Hilton finished the game with four catches for 65 yards and his first receiving touchdown of the year. On the ground, the Panthers ran for 192 yards, paced by Darriet Perry's 98.

Defensively the Panthers held North Texas to 285 yards, holding the Sun Belt's leading rusher, UNT's Lance Dunbar, to just 30 yards on the ground. Toronto Smith led all FIU defenders with nine tackles, including two sacks and three tackles for loss.

FIU got the ball to open the game and wasted little time taking the lead as Carroll connected with Ellingson for a 50-yard touchdown with 12:43 to go in the first quarter. FIU picked up a pair of first downs on the drive, before Carroll found Ellingson over the middle and the senior receiver out-ran the Mean Green defense for six.

With the Score 10-3, North Texas' drive ended abruptly when Jerrico Lee picked up his first-career sack to force a UNT punt from its own one-yard line. Hilton returned the punt 27 yards to the UNT 19, setting up the Panthers' offense with great field position.

The FIU offense took full advantage of the field position, scoring a touchdown on a Wayne Times 10-yard run with 2:36 to go in the first quarter, making the score 17-3. Times' score came out of the "Wild Panther" offense as he took the snap on third-and-goal and scored up the middle for his first-career rushing touchdown.

FIU never looked back, as they poured on another 17 points and held North Texas' offense down to seal the 34-10 victory.

With 8:57 to go in the first half, Griffin connected on a 35-yard field goal to double FIU's lead to 6-0.

The Owls took a 7-6 lead at the 4:55 mark of the second quarter on a 20-yard touchdown pass from Jeff Van Camp to Lester Jean.

After the Panthers turned the ball over on downs near mid-field, FAU had a chance to add to its lead but a field goal attempt with 12 seconds to play in the first half sailed wide left, keeping the score at 7-6 going into the break.

FIU re-took the lead with 10:39 to go in the third quarter on Griffin's third field goal of the day, this one from 26 yards. Griffin's third field goal gave the sophomore a career-high three field goals in a game.

Alfred Morris put the Owls ahead once again with 6:07 left in the third on a 16-yard touchdown run that capped a 76-yard drive.

Midway through the fourth quarter, FIU began a drive on its own one-yard line, and drove all the way down to the FAU one. Down by five, FIU chose to go for it on fourth-and-goal, but was stopped. On the ensuing possession, FAU scored on a 65-yard run by Willie Floyd to extend the Owls' lead to 21-9.
