FIRST AND TEN

• ULM and Baylor will meet Saturday afternoon in a rematch of last season's shootout in Monroe... The back and forth affair featured 89 total points and 1,109 yards of total offense in the 47-42 Baylor win.

• Baylor is the second opponent from the Big 12 conference on ULM's 2013 schedule... The Warhawks opened the season at No. 16 Oklahoma (L, 0-34, Aug. 31).

• ULM enters the contest on a two-game win streak after defeating Grambling State in the home opener (W, 48-10, Sept. 7) and a road win at Wake Forest (W, 21-19, Sept. 14).

• Following the road tilt at Baylor, ULM will wrap-up its non-conference slate with a home contest against Tulane... ULM's fifth and final non-conference game of the regular-season is scheduled for Saturday, Sept. 28 at 6 p.m.

• The win over the Demon Deacons was the Warhawks' first win against an ACC team and ULM is now 1-2 all-time against teams currently in the ACC (L, 26-49, at No. 25 Clemson, Sept. 8, 2007; L, 0-34, at No. 5 Florida State, Sept. 3, 2011).

• ULM set a new team record as it ran 104 plays in the win at Wake Forest... The club had 38:59 of possession time against the Demon Deacons, meaning ULM ran a play every 22.49 seconds... ULM's 104 plays were 41 more than the total number run by Wake Forest (63)... The previous high for plays for the Warhawks was 103 offensive plays in the win over No. 8 Arkansas last season (W, 34-31 [OT], Sept. 8, 2012).

• At Wake Forest, ULM converted 15 of its 28 third-downs (54%) and the squad also converted two of three fourth down attempts (67%).

• All three of ULM's scoring drives at Wake Forest were 12 plays or more and were 3:58 or longer in duration... The Warhawks opening drive that resulted in a 7-0 lead was a 17 play, 69 yard drive lasting 6:46... The final two touchdown drives for ULM were 14 plays, 81 yards, 3:58 and 12 plays, 74 yards, 4:34.

• The ULM defense limited the option offense of Wake Forest to just 15 rushing yards... The Warhawk defense also recorded eight tackles for loss, including four sacks and recovered one fumble... The last time ULM surrendered 15 or fewer rushing yards came on Sept. 29, 2012 when it held Tulane to -9 yards rushing in the 63-10 win in New Orleans.

• Over its last two games the ULM defense has allowed just 109 rushing yards (94 vs. Grambling State; 15 at Wake Forest), an average of 54.5 rushing yards per game.

• At Wake Forest, Senior QB Kolton Browning became the program's all-time leader in career completions... During the second quarter, Browning connected with Je'Ron Hamm for a 16-yard gain as Browning completed career pass number 796... Browning passed Steven Jyles (795 completions; 2002-05) to become the new leader.

• Kolton Browning finished with a career-high 43 completions as he threw a career-high 68 passes against the Demon Deacons... Browning finished the day with 827 career completions.

• Kolton Browning went over the 300 yard passing mark for the first time this season as he finished with 315 passing yards... He also recorded three passing touchdowns for the second consecutive week.

• Joey Gautney was named College Sports Madness Sun Belt Defensive Player of the Week (Sept. 15) after tallying two tackles for loss (both sacks) for 12 yards at Wake Forest... The junior also forced a fumble as he finished with three total tackles in the win over the Demon Deacons.

• At Wake Forest, Isaiah Newsome led the Warhawk defense with seven tackles (six solo, one asst) and one tackle for loss... Ray Stovall added three tackles, including two for a loss and one sack, while Lenzy Pipkins, Cameron Blakes and Cody Robinson all tallied one tackle for loss.

#ULMvsBUSeries

ULM and Baylor will meet for the second time ever and it will be a rematch of last year's 47-42 shootout in Monroe that saw more than 1,100 yards of total offense in the Baylor win in front of a record crowd of 31,175 at Malone Stadium... Baylor is the second team from the Big 12 that the Warhawks will face this season (L, 0-34, at No. 16 Oklahoma, Aug. 31)... The Warhawks will also be looking for their first win over a Big 12 foe (0-9 all-time vs. the Big 12 Conference).

#2012Rewind

MONROE, La. -- On a historic night inside Malone Stadium, a record crowd of 31,175 fans witnessed a back-and-forth contest in Friday night's home-opener, which Baylor (3-0) came out on top, 47-42, over ULM (1-2). An untimely fumble did the Warhawks in and the lost possession proved to be the difference in the fastbreak affair that featured only three combined punts, five lead changes and one tie.

A solid rushing attack led by junior Jyruss Edwards who collected his second-career 100-yard game as he finished with 120 yards and a touchdown to pace ULM. Monterrell Washington collected his first carries of the season to finish with 86 yards and two touchdowns. Kolton Browning finished 25-for-39 for 272 yards, two touchdowns and one interception and rushed for 49 yards and another score.

Behind a 351 yard, four-touchdown performance by Nick Florence Baylor extended its winning-streak to nine games, second longest in the country behind TCU's 10-game streak.

Baylor did its damage through the air as four pass-catchers finished with at least 50 yards receiving led by Tevin Reese who caught eight passes for 145 yards and two touchdowns.

#ScoutingTheBears

Baylor enters the weekend ranked No. 19 (coaches' poll) and No. 20 (AP poll) with a 2-0 record overall... Baylor defeated FCS member Wofford College in its opener, 66-3, before defeating Buffalo in week two, 70-13... Baylor, who had a bye week last weekend, is averaging 736.5 yards per game and 68 points per contest... Of Baylor's 19 scoring drives this season, 16 of those have taken less than two minutes.

Lache Seastrunk leads the Baylor rushing attack with 28 attempts for 261 yards and five touchdowns... Shock Linwood is second on the team with 135 rushing yards (22 attempts) and three touchdowns... Tevin Reese and Antwan Goodley have combined for 18 receptions, 444 yards and four touchdowns... Starting quarterback Bryce Petty has completed 32 of his 40 passes for 650 yards and four touchdowns.

The Baylor defense has forced five turnovers (three fumbles and two interceptions) this season... The Bears returned one interception for a touchdown against Wofford (25 yards) and returned one fumble for a touchdown (91 yards) against Buffalo.

#LoneStarStateFunFacts

Below are 10 things you may or may not know about the state of Texas:

- Dr. Pepper was invented and first sold in Waco in 1885.
- Texas has three of the top 10 most populous cities in the United States: Houston, Dallas and San Antonio.
- The Reliant Astrodome in Houston, opened on April 9, 1965, was the world's first multipurpose domed stadium.
- Texas was an independent country from 1836 until being annexed by the United States on December 29, 1845.
- The term "six flags over Texas" originates from the state being controlled by six different rulers during its history: Spain, France, Mexico, the Republic of Texas, the Confederate States and the United States.
- Texas is the second-largest state in the U.S. and would be the 40th-largest country if it were independent, just ahead of Burma and Afghanistan.
- The Texas Star, located at Fair Park in Dallas, is the tallest Ferris wheel in North America.
- The Lone Star State has produced two U.S. Presidents: Dwight Eisenhower and Lyndon Johnson.
- Miriam Ferguson was the first female governor of Texas and also the first elected female governor in the United States.
- The Dallas/Fort Worth International Airport is larger than the island of Manhattan.

#LetItFly

Kolton Browning's 68 passing attempts at Wake Forest are the second-most in a single game, while his 43 completions are tied for third nationally in a single game... Only Derek Carr (Fresno State; 73) has more single game passing attempts than Browning this season... Carr also recorded 52 completions earlier this season, while Shane Carden (East Carolina) ranks second with 46... Browning is tied for third nationally with Texas Tech's Baker Mayfield with 43 completions in a game.

#SunBeltOffensivePOW

After setting single-game career-highs in both completions (43) and attempts (68) in ULM's 21-19 win at Wake Forest, senior quarterback Kolton Browning has been named the Sun Belt Conference's Offensive Player of the Week.

Midway through the second quarter, Browning connected with Je'Ron Hamm for his school-record 796th career completion. Browning took the top spot in the ULM record book as he passed Steven Jyles who tallied 795 career completions from 2002-05.

Browning ended Saturday's game with 827 career completions after finishing 43-of-68 for 315 yards and three touchdowns. The Mabank, Texas native found Harley Scioneaux, Kenzee Jackson and Tavares Maye for the three Warhawk scores. Browning also rushed 9 times for 19 yards in ULM's first-ever win over an ACC program.

#ThirdDownSuccess

ULM faced 28 third-downs in its 21-19 win at Wake Forest and the Warhawks were able to convert on 15 of those (54%)... ULM's 15 third-down conversions were the most ever by a Wake Forest opponent (previous high 14 by North Carolina [1986] and Connecticut [2003])... The Warhawks' 28 attempts is also a Wake Forest opponent record, surpassing the old record of 24 set by Appalachian State (1981) and Boston University (1986).

#LimitingTheRun

For the second straight week, the ULM defense held its opponent under 100 rushing yards... The Warhawks allowed just 15 rushing yards to the Demon Deacon's option offense... ULM limited Grambling State to 94 rushing yards, meaning the Warhawk defense has allowed just 54.5 rushing yards per game over the last two weeks.

#ThreeAgain

ULM quarterback Kolton Browning tossed three touchdown passes for the second week in a row as he found Harley Scioneaux, Kenzee Jackson and Tavares Maye for the three Warhawk scores in the 21-19 win at Wake Forest... A week earlier, Browning found Scioneaux, Je'Ron Hamm and Jackson for three passing touchdowns.

#EditingTheRecordBooks

As a junior, ULM quarterback Kolton Browning became the program's all-time leader in career touchdowns as he connected with Je'Ron Hamm against North Texas to pass Steven Jyles who had 55 touchdown passes from 2002-05... Browning finished his junior season with 60 career touchdown passes and now sits at 66 after three games during the 2013 season... He also became the program's all-time leader in total touchdowns against Grambling State... Browning entered the season tied with Jyles, but now holds the record with 82 career touchdowns (66 passing, 16 rushing)... The Mabank, Texas native has 827 career completions and at Wake Forest, he surpassed Steven Jyles (795; 2002-05) to become the all-time leader in ULM history... The next records in Browning's crosshairs is career passing yards and total offense yards... Browning needs 299 passing yards to become the all-time leader, while he needs just 174 yards to become the career leader in total offense.

#DavisToTheHouse

In the home opener against Grambling State, Cortney Davis electrified the crowd of 23,600 at Malone Stadium as he returned the opening kickoff (89 yards) for a touchdown (first career return for a TD) to give ULM a 7-0 lead just 10 seconds into the contest... Davis' kickoff return for a score was the first for the Warhawks since Luther Ambrose accomplished the feat against FIU on Nov. 19, 2011... Davis returned another kickoff for 12 yards as he finished with 101 return yards and 103 all-purpose yards (two rushing yards)... Davis also earned Kickoff Returner Performer of the Week Honors from the College Football Performance Awards.

#DualThreat

ULM quarterback Kolton Browning is a dual-threat as the four-year starter has four career games of at least three passing touchdowns and at least one rushing touchdown... Below is a breakdown of active quarterbacks around the country that have three or more games with at least three passing touchdowns and at least one rushing touchdown:

In the first quarter at Tulane, R.J. Young returned a D.J. Ponder interception 49 yards to the Tulane six-yard line before fumbling into the endzone where it was recovered by Ray Stovall... Young was credited with 55 return yards on the play... The second defensive score of the game came in the third quarter when Darius Lively snagged Ponder's pass attempt out of the air and returned it six yards for a score.

#FridayNightLights

In the 2012 home opener, ULM welcomed Big 12 foe Baylor for a nationally televised game on ESPN on Friday, Sept. 21... The Warhawks and the Bears did not disappoint the record-crowd of 31,175 as the two squads combined for 89 points and 1,109 yards of total offense.... The game also had the eyes of the nation upon it as the game was viewed by more than 12.7 million people with a rating of 1.8 - the highest-rated game in history for a contest involving a Sun Belt Conference team... The previous high was a 1.4 rating for the 2004 showdown between FIU and Louisville in Louisville, Ky.

#PowerOfEight

The ULM football team won eight games during its record setting 2012 campaign... The eight wins by the Warhawks were the most since the squad won nine games during the 1993 campaign, its final season of competition at the 1-AA level... During the eight-win season, ULM posted five straight victories from Sept. 29 - Oct. 27, its first five-game winning streak since the 1993 season.

Buoyed by a powerful rushing attack that racked up 367 yards on the ground, including 123 by senior Jyruss Edwards, ULM earned a 48-10 victory over Grambling State on Saturday evening at Malone Stadium.
