FIRST AND TEN

• ULM ended a three-game losing streak as it claimed a 21-14 win at Texas State on October 12... With the victory, the Warhawks improved to 3-4 overall and evened their conference record at 1-1.

• ULM had the week off from competition last week and will return to the gridiron Saturday night when it hosts Georgia State... The upcoming bye week is the first of two bye weeks for the Warhawks... After the contest against the Panthers, ULM will have a short turnaround as it heads to Troy for a Halloween showdown on ESPN3 (Oct. 31, 6:30 p.m.).

• When Georgia State visits Malone Stadium on October 26, it will be the first-ever meeting between the two schools as the Panthers are in their first season of play in the Sun Belt after moving up to the FBS ranks following its stint as a FCS member.

• Centarius Donald finished the game with 14 rushes for 45 yards and one touchdown... The game-winning rushing score for ULM came with just 18 seconds to play in regulation... The TD by Donald was the first rushing score of the season and the fifth of his career.

• Through seven games this season, senior Jyruss Edwards has been tackled in the backfield just one time for a loss of one yard... Edwards has rushed 72 times for a net of 336 yards... He is one of four NCAA FBS players to have rushed 60 or more times and have been tackled in the backfield one or fewer times.

• Tavarese Maye led the Warhawks in both receptions and receiving yards at Texas State... The senior hauled in seven catches for a game-high 74 yards.

• Isaiah Newsome became just the second player in both ULM history and Sun Belt Conference history to record two interception returns for touchdowns in ULM's win at Texas State... He also set conference records in interception return yards (146) and interception return yard average (73.0)... His two interceptions for touchdowns landed him at number five on ESPN SportsCenter's Top 10 and he is one of four weekly nominees for the Capital One Cup Impact Performance of the Week.

• Isaiah Newsome is just one of four players in NCAA FBS history to record two interception returns for scores (both of 70 or more yards) in a single game... He is the second Warhawk to ever return two interceptions for scores and the second player in Sun Belt history to return two interceptions for touchdowns... His 146 interception return yards and 73.0 average per return are both new Sun Belt Conference records.

• In all, Isaiah Newsome earned a total of 12 honors for his outstanding defensive play against Texas State.

• Trey Caldwell made his first career start Saturday against Texas State... He finished the game with five tackles... The five tackles were just one shy of his career high (6; at Tulane; Sept. 29, 2012).

• Cameron Blakes led the Warhawk defense with six total tackles (five solo, one asst) at Texas State.

• Hunter Kissinger was one of four Warhawks to tally five tackles against the Bobcats... Kissinger finished with five solo stops and also tied a career-high with two tackles for loss at Texas State.

• Justin Manton connected on three PATs and is now 16-of-16 on the season... He has also connected on his last 26 PATs... His last PAT miss came at Arkansas State on Nov. 8, 2012... The junior helped flip the field numerous times as he totaled nine punts for 452 yards for an average of 50.2 yards per punt... Manton recorded a game-long punt of 60 yards and finished with three kicks inside the 20 and none landing out of bounds... He also kicked off four times for 232 yards (58.0 avg) with three touchbacks and none out of bounds.

Todd Berry and selected players will meet with the media each Tuesday beginning at 1:45 p.m. in the Scogin Room located inside Malone Stadium. The event will be streamed live via ULMWarhawks.com and the press conference will be posted later in the afternoon. Specific player requests must be made by Noon on Monday.

PRACTICE / INTERVIEWS

All media wishing to cover a ULM practice / game must either have a season-long credential from the ULM media relations office or must obtain one by contacting Alex Edwards (edwards@ulm.edu / 318-342-5463) at least 24 hours before a practice and 48 hours before a home game.

ULM coaches and players will be available following practice during the first half of game week. Coaches and players will not be available for interviews from Thursday until the conclusion of that week's game (Game weeks featuring a Thursday night game will not allow interviews beginning Wednesday).

Video and photography are allowed for the first 30 minutes of practice -- practice will then be closed until the conclusion of that day's practice (Thursday practices and Friday walk thrus are always closed). Social media updates are not allowed during practice.

ULM will hold its annual "Pink Out" game this weekend against Georgia State... Players and coaches will be wearing pink sweatbands and shoe-laces during Saturday night's game... Fans can also purchase the "official" Breast Cancer Awareness T-Shirts at the ULM Bookstore with a portion of the proceeds going back to the Susan G. Komen Foundation of Northeast Louisiana.

#ULMvsGSUSeries

ULM and Georgia State will meet for the first time ever Saturday night at Malone Stadium... The Panthers are in their first season at the FBS level and first season as a member of the Sun Belt Conference.

#ScoutingThePanthers

Georgia State enters Saturday's game with a 0-7 record and a 0-2 mark in league play after suffering a 24-17 setback at Texas State on Oct. 19... The Panthers evened the contest at 10-10 on a Wil Lutz 19-yard field goal with 11:21 to play in the fourth quarter; however, Texas State regained the lead 17-10 with 8:01 to play and then moved in front 24-10 with 1:43 remaining... Georgia State set the final tally at 24-17 with one second to play as Ronnie Bell hit Robert Davis from five yards out.

Ronnie Bell has taken the majority of snaps under center this season as he is 111-of-232 for 1,498 yards... He has thrown 10 touchdown passes and five interceptions during his first seven games of 2013... Albert Wilson leads the squad in receptions (40), receiving yards (763), average per catch (19.1), average per game (109.0) and touchdown receptions (six)... Robert Davis ranks second on the team with 27 receptions for 373 yards and three touchdown grabs... Travis Evans is Georgia State's rushing leader with 308 net rushing yards on 84 attempts... He is also one of two Panther running backs to rush for a touchdown this season (Ronnie Bell is the other).

Joseph Peterson leads the team with 51 total tackles this season (33 solo, 18 asst)... Peterson also has three tackles for loss for eight yards... Tarris Batiste leads Georgia State with six tackles for loss for 17 yards... Batiste also has one interception and one fumble recovery this season... As a team, the Panthers have 40 tackles for loss (110 yards) and seven sacks (30 yards).

#PeachStateFunFacts

Below are 10 things you may or may not know about the state of Georgia:

- Georgia is the largest state east of the Mississippi River.
- Georgia was founded by James Oglethorpe in 1733 and was the 13th British colony in what would become the United States.
- Atlanta is one of only two cities to produce a pair of Nobel Peace Prize winners: Martin Luther King, Jr. and Jimmy Carter.
- Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport is the world's busiest passenger airport.
- The city symbol of Atlanta is the phoenix, symbolizing the city's rise following its destruction in 1864 during the Civil War.
- Atlanta's Westin Peachtree Plaza Hotel is the second-tallest hotel in the Western Hemisphere at 883 feet.
- Atlanta was the site of the 1996 Summer Olympics, one of only four times that the United States has hosted the event.
- Atlanta was one of 13 cities to have a team in each of the four major professional leagues until the Thrashers relocated to become the Winnipeg Jets in 2011.
- The Georgia Dome hosted Super Bowl XXVIII (1994) and XXXIV (2000).
- TBS and CNN both have their network headquarters in Atlanta.

#SCTop10

ULM's Isaiah Newsome returned two interceptions for touchdowns (71 yards; 75 yards) as he helped ULM claim a 21-14 win at Texas State on Oct. 12... His strong defensive play earned him the No. 5 spot on ESPN SportsCenter's Top 10... Newsome became just the second player in ULM history to record two interceptions for touchdowns in a single game (Karlton Washington; vs. Northwestern State; Sept. 25, 1999)... He is also just the second player in Sun Belt history to accomplish the feat (Tony Lukins [New Mexico State]; at Tulsa; Oct. 6, 2001).

He finished the game with 146 interception return yards which are the most in ULM and Sun Belt Conference history... In the ULM record books, he passed Karlton Washington who had 142 interception return yards against Northwestern State on Sept. 25, 1999... In the Sun Belt record books, he surpassed Darin Davis (Middle Tennessee) who had 101 interception return yards against Florida Atlantic on Nov. 27, 2010... He also set new ULM and Sun Belt records in return average (min. 2 interceptions) with 73.0 yards per return.

His 75 yard interception return is the sixth longest in school history (scoring or non-scoring), while his 71 yard return ranks seventh.

#RareFeat

ULM's Isaiah Newsome became just the fourth player in NCAA FBS history to return two interceptions for touchdowns (both of 70 or more yards) in a single game... Newsome returned his first interception of the game 71 yards to give the Warhawks a 7-0 lead with 6:09 to play in the first quarter... In the third quarter, Newsome returned his second interception 75 yards for a touchdown to push ULM's lead to 14-0 with 11:07 to play in the quarter... Below is a breakdown of NCAA FBS players to record two interceptions for TDs (both of 70 or more yards):

#SecondStraightSeason

For the second season in a row, the ULM defense recorded two scores as Isaiah Newsome returned two interceptions for scores in the Warhawks' 21-14 win at Texas State on Oct. 12.

In last season's 63-10 win at Tulane (Sept. 29, 2012), the Warhawk defense found the endzone on two different occasions... The two defensive scores marked the first time ULM had two or more touchdowns on the defensive side of the ball since the 1999 season... In 1999, ULM intercepted Northwestern State QB Brad Spangler three times and returned all three for touchdowns as ULM claimed a 38-7 win (Sept. 25).

In the first quarter at Tulane, R.J. Young returned a D.J. Ponder interception 49 yards to the Tulane six-yard line before fumbling into the endzone where it was recovered by Ray Stovall... Young was credited with 55 return yards on the play... The second defensive score of the game came in the third quarter when Darius Lively snagged Ponder's pass attempt out of the air and returned it six yards for a score.

ULM's Jyruss Edwards is just one of four NCAA FBS running backs to be tackled in the backfield one or fewer times (min. 60 carries) this season... Joining Edwards on the list are Georgia Tech's David Sims, Minnesota's Rodrick Williams and Ohio State's Carlos Hyde.

#FirstCareerStart

ULM sophomore quarterback Brayle Brown made his first career start against WKU on Oct. 3... The Shawnee, Okla., native finished the game with 275 passing yards behind 21 completions (40 attempts) with one interception... He also recorded the team's longest play from scrimmage this season, a 69-yard pass to junior wide receiver Kenzee Jackson... Brown's 275 passing yards are the most by a first-time ULM starting quarterback since Andre Vige threw for 322 yards in a 44-14 win over Nicholls State on Sept. 5, 1998.

#DroughtEnds

ULM punt returner Rashon Ceaser became the first Warhawk since the 2001 season to return a punt for a touchdown... In the third quarter against Tulane, Ceaser recorded a career-long return of 88 yards as he made his way through the Tulane defense to put ULM on the board... Ceaser is the first Warhawk to record a punt return for a touchdown since Mikkal Henry returned a punt 53 yards for a score against Troy on Nov. 10, 2001... Ceaser finished the night with three punt returns for 97 yards... He also caught four passes for 45 yards... Ceaser is currently leading the Sun Belt Conference in punt return yardage with an average of 17.3 yards per return... His 97 total punt return yards are a season-high among SBC punt returners and he is one of three SBC players to return a punt for a TD this season... Ceaser's 88-yard return is the fifth longest punt return in SBC history.

#ThreeStraight

ULM tight end Harley Scioneaux recorded his third touchdown grab of the season in the team's loss at Baylor... The sophomore recorded one

#CareerBoot

ULM punter Justin Manton recorded a career-long 77-yard punt in ULM's road contest at Baylor... His booming third-quarter punt is tied for the second longest punt in ULM history... He is tied with John Kelly who had a 77-yard punt at McNeese State on Oct. 13, 1962... Chick Childress holds the ULM record with an 88-yard punt (at Western Kentucky, 1952).

Manton also recorded a 69-yard punt in the fourth-quarter at Baylor, which places him in a tied for eighth-place in program history... In all, Manton punted nine times for 479 yards (53.2 avg) with five punts of 50 or more yards, three touchbacks, one inside the 20... He also kicked off twice for 130 yards (65.0 avg) and two touchbacks.

Manton was named one of College Football Performance Awards' Honorable Mention Punters of the Week (Sept. 23), Louisiana Sports Writers Association Special Teams Player of the Week (Sept. 23) and Warhawk of the Week (Sept. 24).

#SunBeltOffensivePOW

After setting single-game career-highs in both completions (43) and attempts (68) in ULM's 21-19 win at Wake Forest, senior quarterback Kolton Browning was named the Sun Belt Conference's Offensive Player of the Week on Sept. 16, 2013.

Midway through the second quarter, Browning connected with Je'Ron Hamm for his school-record 796th career completion... Browning took the top spot in the ULM record book as he passed Steven Jyles who tallied 795 career completions from 2002-05.

Browning ended the game with 827 career completions after finishing 43-of-68 for 315 yards and three touchdowns. The Mabank, Texas native found Harley Scioneaux, Kenzee Jackson and Tavarrese Maye for the three Warhawk scores... Browning also rushed nine times for 19 yards in ULM's first-ever win over an ACC program.

#ThirdDownSuccess

ULM faced 28 third-downs in its 21-19 win at Wake Forest and the Warhawks were able to convert on 15 of those (54%)... ULM's 15 third-down conversions were the most ever by a Wake Forest opponent (previous high 14 by North Carolina [1986] and Connecticut [2003])... The Warhawks' 28 attempts is also a Wake Forest opponent record, surpassing the old record of 24 set by Appalachian State (1981) and Boston University (1986).

#EditingTheRecordBooks

As a junior, ULM quarterback Kolton Browning became the program's all-time leader in career touchdowns as he connected with Je'Ron Hamm against North Texas to pass Steven Jyles who had 55 touchdown passes from 2002-05... Browning finished his junior season with 60 career touchdown passes and now sits at 67 after four games during the 2013 season... He also became the program's all-time leader in total touchdowns against Grambling State... Browning entered the season tied with Jyles, but now holds the record with 83 career touchdowns (67 passing, 16 rushing)... The Mabank, Texas native has 856 career completions and at Wake Forest, he surpassed Steven Jyles (795; 2002-05) to become the all-time leader in ULM history... At Baylor, Browning passed Jyles in career yards of total offense -- Browning now ranks number one in program history with 10,458 yards of total offense (9,051 passing; 1,407 rushing)... Jyles amassed 10,234 yards of total offense during his career (8,987 passing; 1,247 rushing)... Against Tulane, Browning became the new leader in career passing yards (9,051) and total plays (1,919)... Jyles threw for 8,987 yards and totalled 1,901 plays during his career.

#DavisToTheHouse

In the home opener against Grambling State, Cortney Davis electrified the crowd of 23,600 at Malone Stadium as he returned the opening kickoff (89 yards) for a touchdown (first career return for a TD) to give ULM a 7-0 lead just 10 seconds into the contest... Davis' kickoff return for a score was the first for the Warhawks since Luther Ambrose accomplished the feat against FIU on Nov. 19, 2011... Davis returned another kickoff for 12 yards as he finished with 101 return yards and 103 all-purpose yards (two rushing yards)... Davis also earned Kickoff Returner Performer of the Week Honors from the College Football Performance Awards.

#SixteenTackles

Senior LB Cameron Blakes made his presence felt as he tallied 16 tackles, a new career-best, in the season opener at Oklahoma... His previous career-best came against Middle Tennessee in Monroe on Nov. 12, 2011... Blakes registered three tackles in the first quarter as he and the rest of the Warhawk defense kept the Sooners off of the scoreboard... At the half, Blakes had seven total tackles, before tallying seven tackles during the third quarter... He added two stops in the final quarter to finish with 16 tackles (nine solo, seven asst).

#BerryBall

Todd Berry is in his fourth season at the helm of the Warhawk program... Berry returned to Monroe in Dec. 2009 when he was named the program's 14th head coach... Last season, Berry guided ULM to an FBS-era best eight wins as the squad finished tied for second in the Sun Belt (6-2) and made its first appearance in a bowl game since moving up to the FBS ranks (1994-pres.)... The Warhawks made the short trip west to Shreveport, La., as they battled the Bobcats of Ohio in the 2012 AdvoCare V100 Independence Bowl.

Since the Warhawks joined the Sun Belt Conference to begin the 2001 season, the club has scored in 134 of its 144 games (dating back to Sept. 1, 2001 vs. Sam Houston State)... ULM was shutout in the 2008 season opener at No. 10 Auburn, snapping a streak of 32 consecutive games of recording at least one score... A 59-0 loss at Ole Miss later that season marked the first time that ULM had been shutout multiple times in the same season since 2000 (Memphis; Middle Tennessee; Central Florida)... The squad was shutout in the 2013 season opener at Oklahoma, snapping a streak of 24 consecutive games of recording at least one score.

#ULMGrads

Two Warhawks have already received their undergraduate degrees while another seven are set to graduate in December... Madison Tharp and Preston Coleman already have their degrees and will be joined by Kolton Browning, Jyruss Edwards, Tavarese Maye, Austin Moss, Isaiah Newsome, Ray Stovall (junior) and Monterrell Washington following commencement in December... The second-largest on-campus high definition videoboard in the Pelican State was installed at ULM's Malone Stadium during the summer of 2010... In addition, a state-of-the-art sound system was installed... The videoboard features nearly 1,600 square feet of total video space, including 23' x 49' area dedicated to video on a board with 15-millimeter pixel spacing.

#FridayNightLights

In the 2012 home opener, ULM welcomed Big 12 foe Baylor for a nationally televised game on ESPN on Friday, Sept. 21... The Warhawks and the Bears did not disappoint the record-crowd of 31,175 as the two squads combined for 89 points and 1,109 yards of total offense.... The game also had the eyes of the nation upon it as the game was viewed by more than 12.7 million people with a rating of 1.8 - the highest-rated game in history for a contest involving a Sun Belt Conference team... The previous high was a 1.4 rating for the 2004 showdown between FIU and Louisville in Louisville, Ky.

#PowerOfEight

The ULM football team won eight games during its record setting 2012 campaign... The eight wins by the Warhawks were the most since the squad won nine games during the 1993 campaign, its final season of competition at the 1-AA level... During the eight-win season, ULM posted five straight victories from Sept. 29 - Oct. 27, its first five-game winning streak since the 1993 season.

Buoyed by a powerful rushing attack that racked up 367 yards on the ground, including 123 by senior Jyruss Edwards, ULM earned a 48-10 victory over Grambling State on Saturday evening at Malone Stadium. Texas State staged a late rally to tie the game, but Centarius Donald's 10-yard touchdown run with just 18 seconds remaining sealed the game for ULM, giving the Warhawks a 21-14 win in dramatic fashion. The win was the first Sun Belt victory of the season for ULM, while the Bobcats dropped their second consecutive game. Isaiah Newsome emerged as a defensive star for the Warhawks on the night, becoming just the second player in Sun Belt Conference history to return two interceptions for touchdowns.

POSTGAME NOTES

- ULM Captains: RB Jyruss Edwards (Offense), DE Joey Gautney (Defense) and K / P Justin Manton (Special Teams).
- ULM held Texas State off the scoreboard in the first quarter... It is the second time the Warhawks have held a team scoreless in the first quarter this season (other occurrence: at Oklahoma, Aug. 31, 2013)... The Warhawks held the Bobcats scoreless for the first 30 minutes... It was the first time ULM held an opponent scoreless for an entire half since the 2011 season (at Florida Atlantic; Dec. 3, 2011; both halves [last ULM shutout]).
- Centarius Donald finished the game with 14 rushes for 45 yards and one touchdown... The game-winning rushing score for ULM came with just 18 seconds to play in regulation... The TD by Donald was the first rushing score of the season for the junior and fifth career.
- Isaiah Newsome became just the second player in ULM history to record two interception returns for TDs with a 75-yard interception return to give ULM a 14-0 lead with 11:07 to play in the third quarter... The only other Warhawk to tally two TDs on interceptions in one game was Karlton Washington against Northwestern State on Sept. 25, 1999... His 75-yard interception return replaces his 71-yard return earlier in the game as the sixth-longest interception return (scoring and non-scoring interceptions).
