

FIRST AND TEN

- ULM returns to Monroe for its first home game of the 2013 season as it welcomes Grambling State to Malone Stadium for a Saturday night contest... It will be the third meeting all-time between the two Northeast Louisiana schools... The Warhawks own a 2-0 record in the series.
- Last season, ULM posted a 3-2 record at home, including wins over Florida Atlantic (35-14), South Alabama (38-24) and North Texas (42-16)... The Warhawks dropped last season's home opener to Baylor in a 47-42 shootout as well as falling to UL-Lafavette (40-24).
- Following the home tilt against Grambling, the Warhawks will hit the road for its next two contests... The team will travel to Winston-Salem, N.C. next weekend to face Wake Forest, followed by a trip to Waco, Texas for a Sept. 21 showdown against Baylor.
 ULM fell in its 2013 opener at No. 16 Oklahoma, 34-0, on Aug. 31 in Norman, Okla... It was the first time the Warhawks were shutout since a 34-0 loss at No. 5 Florida State to open the 2011 season... Saturday's shutout ended the Warhawks streak of 24 straight games of recording at least one score.
- ULM held the Sooners to just 124 passing yards, marking the first time since 2011 the Warhawks held an opponent below 150 passing yards... In the season finale against Florida Atlantic (Dec. 3, 2011), ULM limited the Owls to 79 passing yards.
- Senior LB Cameron Blakes led the Warhawk defense at Oklahoma as he recorded a career-high 16 tackles (9 solo, 7 asst).
- Michael Johnson, making his first collegiate start, set a new personal best with six tackles (3 solo, 3 asst) at Oklahoma.
- The redshirt-freshman trio of Justin Backus, Lenzy Pipkins and Tevyn Cagins combined to record 11 tackles in their debuts... Backus tallied six tackles, while Pipkins and Cagins added three and two. respectively.
- Senior QB Kolton Browning completed 20 passes at Oklahoma and the Mabank, Texas native now sits just 25 completions shy of becoming the new all-time leader in ULM history... Browning has 771 career completions, trailing only Steven Jyles (2002-05) who tallied 795 in four seasons at ULM.
- Last Saturday's game at Oklahoma marked the sixth straight season that the Warhawks have opened the season against a ranked foe... The streak began in 2008 when ULM faced No. 10 Auburn... Since then, ULM has opened seasons with: No. 2 Texas (2009), No. 14 Arkansas (2010), No. 5 Florida State (2011) and No. 8 Arkansas (2012).
- The road game at Oklahoma was the ninth time since joining the NCAA ranks in 1975 that ULM has played a game in the month of August... The Warhawks are now 4-5 in the month of August (since 1975)
- After facing the Oklahoma Sooners, the Warhawks have now faced eight of the current 10 members of the Big 12 Conference... The only schools ULM has not faced are Texas Tech and West Virginia.
- A total of seven Warhawks earned preseason recognition from either the Sun Belt Conference or a preseason watch list (Josh Allen; Kolton Browning; Kentarius Caldwell; Je'Ron Hamm; Justin Manton; Tavarese Maye; Isaiah Newsome).
- Last season, the Warhawks played in a FBS-high four overtime games and ULM won three of those contests... ULM def. No. 8 Arkansas, 34-31 (OT; Little Rock, Ark.; Sept. 8); ULM lost at Auburn, 28-31 (OT; Auburn, Ala.; Sept. 15); ULM def. Western Kentucky, 43-42 (OT; Bowling Green, Ky.; Oct. 20); ULM def. FIU, 23-17 (OT; Miami, Fla.; Nov. 24).
- ULM won eight games during the record-setting 2012 campaign... The eight wins were the most since the squad won nine games in the final year at the 1-AA level in 1993.

ULM and Grambling State last met on the gridiron on Sept. 10, 2011 at Malone Stadium with the Warhawks claiming a 35-7 victory... ULM leads the all-time series 2-0 as the squad earning a 28-14 victory in the first ever meeting between the two schools on Nov. 10, 2007.

#SoonerRewind

ULM dropped its 2013 season opener at No. 16 Oklahoma by a score of 34-0 on Aug. 31 in Norman, Okla... Kolton Browning inched closer to the career completions record as he now sits just 25 completions shy of become the program leader... Browning has 771 career completions and trails only Steven Jyles, who had 795 completions from 2002-05... Cameron Blakes tallied a career-best 16 tackles at Oklahoma as he registered nine solo and seven assisted tackles... His previous high was 12 against Middle Tennessee on Nov. 12, 2011... Michael Johnson also set a new career-mark as he finished with six tackles in the contest, including one for a loss... Cordero Smith recorded the first turnover of the season for the Warhawk defense as he picked off Trevor Knight in the fourth quarter... A total of 10 different players made their Warhawk debut at Oklahoma: Justin Backus (RS-Fr.), Tevyn Cagins (RS-Fr.), Ajalen Holley (RS-Fr.), Tre' Hunter (RS-Fr.) Kenzee Jackson (Jr.), Trey Martin (Fr.), Nathan Meadors, Jr. (RS-Fr.), Alec Osborne (RS-Fr.), Lenzy Pipkins (RS-Fr.) and Diontre Thomas (RS-Fr.).

#SixteenTackles

Senior LB Cameron Blakes made his presence felt as he tallied 16 tackles, a new career-best, in the season opener at Oklahoma... His previous career-best came against Middle Tennessee in Monroe on Nov. 12, 2011... Blakes registered three tackles in the first quarter as he and the rest of the Warhawk defense kept the Sooners off of the scoreboard... At the half, Blakes had seven total tackles, before tallying seven tackles during the third quarter... He added two stops in the final quarter to finish with 16 tackles (nine solo, seven asst).

#BerryBall

Todd Berry is in his fourth season at the helm of the Warhawk program... Berry returned to Monroe in Dec. 2009 when he was named the program's 14th head coach... Last season, Berry guided ULM to an FBS-era best eight wins as the squad finished tied for second in the Sun Belt (6-2) and made its first appearance in a bowl game since moving up to the FBS ranks (1994-pres.)... The Warhawks made the short trip west to Shreveport, La., as they battled the Bobcats of Ohio in the 2012 AdvoCare V100 Independence Bowl.

Oklahoma is ranked 16th in the first poll of the 2013 season... Receiving votes were Baylor (80) and Arkansas State (1)... If the poll was extended, Baylor would be ranked 29th and Arkansas State would be tied for 49th.

The annual preseason AP poll was released on Saturday, Aug. 17 and two of ULM's opponents were either ranked or received votes... Oklahoma was ranked 16th in the poll... Baylor received a total of 92 votes in the poll and if the poll was extended, the Bears would be ranked 27th.

#MaloneStadium

The 2013 season marks the 36th consecutive year that the Warhawks have called Malone Stadium on the campus of ULM home... Dedicated to legendary head football coach James L. Malone (1934-52) on Sept. 27, 1980, Malone Stadium has seen ULM teams post a 113-68-1 (.624) record... #PutEmOnTheBoard

Since the Warhawks joined the Sun Belt Conference to begin the 2001 season, the club has scored in 128 of its 138 games (dating back to Sept. 1, 2001 vs. Sam Houston State)... ULM was shutout in the 2008 season opener at No. 10 Auburn, snapping a streak of 32 consecutive games of recording at least one score... A 59-0 loss at Ole Miss later that season marked the first time that ULM had been shutout multiple times in the same season since 2000 (Memphis; Middle Tennessee; Central Florida)... The squad was shutout in the 2013 season opener at Oklahoma, snapping a streak of 24 consecutive games of recording at least one score.

#ULMGrads

Two Warhawks have already received their undergraduate degrees while another seven are set to graduate in December... Madison Tharp and Preston Coleman already have their degrees and will be joined by Kolton Browning, Jyruss Edwards, Tavarese Maye, Austin Moss, Isaiah Newsome, Ray Stovall (junior) and Monterrell Washington following commencement in December... Those expected to graduate following the spring semester are Josh Allen, Cameron Blakes, Kentarius Caldwell, Emmanuel Jefferies and Roland Veal (junior).

#HighDefinition

The second-largest on-campus high definition videoboard in the Pelican State was installed at ULM's Malone Stadium during the summer of 2010... In addition, a state-of-the-art sound system was installed... The videoboard features nearly 1,600 square feet of total video space, including 23' x 49' area dedicated to video on a board with 15-millimeter pixel spacing.

#PartyLikelt's1999

In last season's 63-10 win at Tulane, the Warhawk defense found the endzone on two different occasions... The two defensive scores marked the first time ULM had two or more touchdowns on the defensive side of the ball since the 1999 season... In 1999, ULM intercepted Northwestern State QB Brad Spangler three times and returned all three for touchdowns as ULM claimed a 38-7 win (Sept. 25).

In the first quarter at Tulane, R.J. Young returned a D.J. Ponder interception 49 yards to the Tulane six-yard line before fumbling into the endzone where it was recovered by Ray Stovall... Young was credited with 55 return yards on the play... The second defensive score of the game came in the third quarter when Darius Lively snagged Ponder's pass attempt out of the air and returned it six yards for a score.

#FridayNightLights

In the 2012 home opener, ULM welcomed Big 12 foe Baylor for a nationally televised game on ESPN on Friday, Sept. 21... The Warhawks and the Bears did not disappoint the record-crowd of 31,175 as the two squads combined for 89 points and 1,109 yards of total offense.

The game also had the eyes of the nation upon it as the game was viewed by more than 12.7 million people with a rating of 1.8 - the highest-rated game in history for a contest involving a Sun Belt Conference team. The previous high was a 1.4 rating for the 2004 showdown between FIU and Louisville in Louisville, Ky.

#PowerOfEight

The ULM football team won eight games during its record setting 2012 campaign... The eight wins by the Warhawks were the most since the squad won nine games during the 1993 campaign, its final season of competition at the 1-AA level... During the eight-win season, ULM posted five straight victories from Sept. 29 - Oct. 27, its first five-game winning streak since the 1993 season.

Cameron Blakes racked up a career-high 16 tackles and 1.5 tackles for loss, but ULM could not overcome a strong Oklahoma rushing attack on Saturday night, falling 34-0 to the Sooners at the Gaylord Family Oklahoma Memorial Stadium in the season opener for both teams. For the Warhawk offense, Kolton Browning went 20-of-39 for 128 yards and an interception. Rashon Ceaser and Je'Ron Hamm each notched five receptions, with Ceaser gaining 39 yards to Hamm's 38.
