FIRST AND TEN

• When ULM lines up against Oklahoma Saturday night, it will mark the sixth straight season that the Warhawks have opened the season against a ranked foe... The streak began in 2008 when ULM faced No. 10 Auburn... Since then, ULM has opened seasons with: No. 2 Texas (2009), No. 14 Arkansas (2010), No. 5 Florida State (2011), and No. 8 Arkansas (2012).

• Saturday's game marks just the ninth time since joining the NCAA ranks in 1975 that ULM has played a game in the month of August... The Warhawks are 4-4 in the month of August.

• After lining up against the Sooners, the Warhawks will have faced eight of the current 10 members of the Big 12 Conference... The only schools ULM has not faced are Texas Tech and West Virginia.

• The contest against the Sooners is the first trip to the state of Oklahoma for the Warhawks since the 1999 season when they defeated Tulsa, 37-34, in the season finale (Nov. 13)... All-time it is just the fourth trip to the state for ULM (at Tulsa, 1977; at Oklahoma State, 1997).

• A total of seven Warhawks earned preseason recognition from either the Sun Belt Conference or a preseason watch list (Josh Allen, OL; Kolton Browning, QB; Kentarius Caldwell, NT; Je'Ron Hamm, WR; Justin Manton, K / P; Tavarrese Maye, WR; Isaiah Newsome, S).

• Four different Warhawks enter their final season in a ULM uniform with 30 or more career starts (Kolton Browning, 36; Isaiah Newsome, 31; Josh Allen, 30; Tavarrese Maye, 30).

• Kolton Browning enters his senior season at the top of the charts with 60 career touchdown passes... He is tied with Steven Jyles (2002-05) with 76 total career touchdowns... Browning meanwhile ranks in the top 10 in seven other categories including the number two spot in passing yards, passing attempts, pass completions, total yards of offense and plays.

• Three other Warhawks enter the 2013 season in the top 10 in various statistical categories... Jyruss Edwards sits fourth in program-history with 21 career rushing touchdowns... Tavarrese Maye ranks seventh with 149 career receptions... Justin Manton is sixth in punting average (39.8) and ninth in total points by a kicker (124).

• A total of seven Warhawks have ties to the state of Oklahoma... Todd Berry (Head Coach) calls Miami his hometown, while Steve Farmer (Asst. Head Coach / Off. Coord. / O-Line) lists Coweta as his hometown... The five players from the state of Oklahoma are: Colby Mitchell (OL; Bartlesville); Ben Risenhoover (OL; Jenks); Jeremy Burton (OL; Muskogee); Brayle Brown (QB; Shawnee); Ray Stovall (LB; Tulsa).

• Last season, the Warhawks played in a FBS-high four overtime games and ULM won three of those contests... ULM def. No. 8 Arkansas, 34-31 (OT; Little Rock, Ark.; Sept. 8); ULM lost at Auburn, 28-31 (OT; Auburn, Ala.; Sept. 15); ULM def. Western Kentucky, 43-42 (OT; Bowling Green, Ky.; Oct. 20); ULM def. FIU, 23-17 (OT; Miami, Fla.; Nov. 24).

• ULM's upset of Arkansas marked the first time a Sun Belt Conference school defeated a team ranked in the top 10... It was also just the second win for the SBC over a ranked foe (Troy def. No. 19 Missouri, 24-14; Sept. 9, 2004)... Arkansas State made it two wins over ranked opponents for the SBC last season as they defeated No. 25 Kent State in the GoDaddy.com Bowl (W, 17-13; Jan. 6).

• ULM won eight games during the record-setting 2012 campaign... The eight wins were the most since the squad won nine games in the final year at the 1-AA level in 1993.

• The Warhawks made their first bowl appearance of the FBS-era as they battled the Ohio Bobcats in the AdvoCare V100 Independence Bowl in Shreveport, La.

ULM coaches and players will be available following practice during the first half of game week. Video and photography are allowed for the first 30 minutes of practice -- practice will then be closed until the conclusion of that day's practice (Thursday practices and Friday walk thrus are always closed). Social media updates are not allowed during practice.

#SoonerSeries

Saturday's matchup between ULM and Oklahoma will be the first ever meeting between the two schools... The Warhawks have faced seven of the 10 members that currently make up the Big 12 Conference... After kickoff at Oklahoma, the only Big 12 Conference schools that ULM will have not battled on the gridiron will be Texas Tech and West Virginia.

#SoonerState

This weekend's trip to Norman, Okla., will be the Warhawk football program's fourth trip all-time to the state of Oklahoma... ULM first visited the state of Oklahoma in 1977 when it dropped a 37-35 decision at Tulsa... In 1997, the squad faced Oklahoma State in the only meeting between the Warhawks and the Cowboys, a contest OSU won, 38-7 (Sept. 27)... ULM last made its way to Oklahoma in 1999 when it defeated Tulsa, 37-34, in the Warhawks' regular season finale (Nov. 13).

#RecordChasing

Senior QB Kolton Browning enters his final season in a Warhawk uniform at the top of the charts with 60 career touchdown passes... During the 42-16 win over North Texas (Nov. 17, 2012), Browning became the new leader as he surpassed Steven Jyles (55 TDs; 2002-05)... Browning is tied with Jyles for the top spot in total career touchdowns with 76... The Mabank, Texas, native also ranks in the top-10 in pass attempts (2nd; 1,225), pass completions (2nd; 751), passing yards (2nd; 8,084), plays (2nd; 1,685), total offense yards (2nd; 9,400), rushing attempts (6th; 460) and rushing touchdowns (10th; 16).

Three other Warhawks enter the 2013 season in the top-10 in various statistical categories... RB Jyruss Edwards sits fourth in program-history with 21 career rushing touchdowns... WR Tavarrese Maye ranks seventh with 149 career receptions... K / P Justin Manton is sixth in punting average (39.8) and ninth in total points by a kicker (124).

#BerryBall

Todd Berry enters his fourth season at the helm of the Warhawk program... Berry returned to Monroe in Dec. 2009 when he was named the program's 14th head coach... Last season, Berry guided ULM to an FBS-era best eight wins as the squad finished tied for second in the Sun Belt (6-2) and made its first appearance in a bowl game since moving up to the FBS ranks (1994-pres)... The Warhawks made the short trip west to Shreveport, La., as they battled the Bobcats of Ohio in the 2012 AdvoCare V100 Independence Bowl.

#PreseasonPolls

On Thursday, Aug. 1, the annual USA Today/Coaches' preseason poll was released and three of ULM's opponents were either ranked or received votes... Oklahoma is ranked 16th in the first poll of the 2013 season... Receiving votes were Baylor (80) and Arkansas State (1)... If the poll was extended, Baylor would be ranked 29th and Arkansas State would be tied for 49th.

The annual preseason AP poll was released on Saturday, Aug. 17 and two of ULM's opponents were either ranked or received votes... Oklahoma was ranked 16th in the poll... Baylor received a total of 92 votes in the poll and if the poll was extended, the Bears would be ranked 27th.

#Reffett'sRegime

In defensive coordinator Troy Reffett's 49 career games in charge of the defense, the Warhawks have forced 90 turnovers and at least one in 45 of the 49 contests... The attacking defense has also recorded 99 sacks and 274 tackles for loss -- at one point, ULM had a sack in 23 straight games under Reffett.

#PutEmOnTheBoard

Since the Warhawks joined the Sun Belt Conference to begin the 2001 season, the club has scored in 128 of its 137 games (dating back to Sept. 1, 2001 vs. Sam Houston State)... ULM was shutout in the 2008 season opener at No. 10 Auburn, snapping a streak of 32 consecutive games of recording at least one score... A 59-0 loss at Ole Miss later that season marked the first time that ULM had been shutout multiple times in the same season since 2000 (Memphis; Middle Tennessee; Central Florida)... Currently the squad has a streak of 24 consecutive games of recording at least one score.

#ULMGrads

Two Warhawks have already received their undergraduate degrees while another seven are set to graduate in December... Madison Tharp and Preston Coleman already have their degrees and will be joined by Kolton Browning, Jyruss Edwards, Tavarese Maye, Austin Moss, Isaiah New-some, Ray Stovall (junior) and Monterrell Washington following commencement in December... Those expected to graduate following the spring semester are Josh Allen, Cameron Blakes, Kentarius Caldwell, Emmanuel Jefferies, Elliot Hilliard (junior) and Roland Veal (junior).

#HighDefinition

The second-largest on-campus high definition videoboard in the Pelican State was installed at ULM's Malone Stadium during the summer of 2010... In addition, a state-of-the-art sound system was installed... The videoboard features nearly 1,600 square feet of total video space, including 23' x 49' area dedicated to video on a board with 15-millimeter pixel spacing.

#PartyLikelt's1999

In last season's 63-10 win at Tulane, the Warhawk defense found the endzone on two different occasions... The two defensive scores marked the first time ULM had two or more touchdowns on the defensive side of the ball since the 1999 season... In 1999, ULM intercepted Northwestern State QB Brad Spangler three times and returned all three for touchdowns as ULM claimed a 38-7 win (Sept. 25).

In the first quarter at Tulane, R.J. Young returned a D.J. Ponder interception 49 yards to the Tulane six-yard line before fumbling into the endzone where it was recovered by Ray Stovall... Young was credited with 55 return yards on the play... The second defensive score of the game came in the third quarter when Darius Lively snagged Ponder's pass attempt out of the air and returned it six yards for a score.

#FourthDownSuccess

ULM was six-of-seven (86%) on fourth down in the squad's win over No. 8 Arkansas to open the 2012 season... The squad finished the season 24-of-35 (69%) on fourth down.

#FridayNightLights

In the 2012 home opener, ULM welcomed Big 12 foe Baylor for a nationally televised game on ESPN on Friday, Sept. 21... The Warhawks and the Bears did not disappoint the record-crowd of 31,175 as the two squads combined for 89 points and 1,109 yards of total offense.

The game also had the eyes of the nation upon it as the game was viewed by more than 12.7 million people with a rating of 1.8 - the highest-rated game in history for a contest involving a Sun Belt Conference team. The previous high was a 1.4 rating for the 2004 showdown between FIU and Louisville in Louisville, Ky.

#PowerOfEight

The ULM football team won eight games during its record setting 2012 campaign... The eight wins by the Warhawks were the most since the squad won nine games during the 1993 campaign, its final season of competition at the 1-AA level... During the eight-win season, ULM posted five straight victories from Sept. 29 - Oct. 27, its first five-game winning streak since the 1993 season.
