FIRST AND TEN

• ULM will make its second and final trip to the state of Texas this season as it travels to San Marcos to battle Texas State in the squad's first conference road game of 2013... The Warhawks lead the all-time series, 7-2, but it is the first meeting between the two teams since a 27-7 win by the Bobcats at Malone Stadium on Sept. 30, 2000.

• The Warhawks will appear on television for the eighth consecutive game as Saturday's contest will air on the Longhorn Network... ULM appeared on ESPN in the 2012 AdvoCare V100 Independence Bowl vs. Ohio... In 2013, the Warhawks have appeared on ESPN3 (Grambling State; Tulane), ESPN (WKU), Fox Sports 1 (Baylor), Fox Sports PPV (Oklahoma) and Raycom Sports Network (Wake Forest).

• In the final meeting as Sun Belt Conference foes, WKU claimed a 31-10 win at Malone Stadium to take a 5-4 lead in the all-time series... ULM still holds the all-time SBC series lead, 3-2.

• Brayle Brown made his first collegiate start in the conference opener against WKU... The sophomore completed 21 passes for 275 yards against the Hilltoppers... Brown's 275 passing yards are the most by a first-time ULM starting quarterback since Andre Vige threw for 322 yards against Nicholls State on Sept. 5, 1998.

• Brayle Brown connected with Kenzee Jackson late in the first quarter for a 69-yard play... The 69-yard pitch and catch is the longest pass of Brown's career and longest reception of Jackson's career... It is also the longest play from scrimmage for the Warhawks this season.

• Jyruss Edwards recorded his second rushing touchdown of the season in the Thursday night game against WKU... Edwards now has 23 career rushing scores and is in sole possession of third place in program-history as he broke the tie with Greg Robinson (22; 1991-92).

• Centarius Donald's 28-yard run in the second quarter against WKU was his longest of the season... It is also his longest run since the 2011 season... Donald finished the game with season-highs in both carries (nine) and rushing yards (54).

• Harley Scioneaux hauled in a career-long 23 yard reception in the second quarter against WKU... The sophomore finished the game with career-highs in receptions (four) and receiving yards (29).

• Mitch Lane recorded his first interception of the season and second of his career as he picked off WKU's Brandon Doughty in the fourth quarter... However, Lane's biggest play of the night came at the end of the first half as he broke through the line and stopped Hilltopper running back Antonio Andrews at the one-yard line to keep ULM within four points at the break.

• Cordero Smith tied a career-high as he recorded a game-high 12 tackles (seven solo, five asst) against WKU.

• Against WKU, Justin Backus set a career-high with eight tackles as he recorded seven solo stops and assisted on another tackle.

• Hunter Kissinger recorded six total tackles against WKU (two solo, four asst) to tie a career-high.

• Cody Robinson recorded his first career sack against WKU... Robinson sacked WKU's Brandon Doughty in the third quarter for the only Warhawk sack of the contest... Robinson also set a new-career high with two tackles for loss against the Hilltoppers.

• Cortney Davis set a new career-best with 122 all-purpose yards against WKU... Davis totaled 83 kickoff return yards and 39 receiving yards in the Thursday night contest... His previous career-high came on Oct. 20, 2012 with 115 all-purpose yards at WKU... He finished that game with 85 kickoff return yards and 30 receiving yards.

• Justin Manton connected on his third field goal of the season with 9:19 to play in the second quarter against the Hilltoppers... Manton's 34-yard field goal closed the Warhawk deficit to just four points (14-10).

Todd Berry and selected players will meet with the media each Tuesday beginning at 1:45 p.m. in the Scogin Room located inside Malone Stadium. The event will be streamed live via ULMWarhawks.com and the press conference will be posted later in the afternoon. Specific player requests must be made by Noon on Monday.

PRACTICE / INTERVIEWS

All media wishing to cover a ULM practice / game must either have a season-long credential from the ULM media relations office or must obtain one by contacting Alex Edwards (edwards@ulm.edu / 318-342-5463) at least 24 hours before a practice and 48 hours before a home game.

ULM coaches and players will be available following practice during the first half of game week. Coaches and players will not be available for interviews from Thursday until the conclusion of that week's game (Game weeks featuring a Thursday night game will not allow interviews beginning Wednesday).

#ULMvsTXTSeries

ULM and Texas State will meet for the first time as Sun Belt Conference foes on Saturday night in San Marcos, Texas... It will also be the first time the two programs will face each other as FBS-members as the Bobcats joined the FBS ranks to start the 2011 season... The Warhawks lead the all-time series, 7-2, but it will be the first meeting between the two schools since 2000... ULM is 3-1 in games at Texas State and it is the first trip to San Marcos since a 40-21 victory on Oct. 16, 1993.

#ScoutingTheBobcats

Texas State enters the weekend with a 3-2 record overall and a 0-1 mark in Sun Belt Conference play after suffering a 48-24 setback at UL-Lafayette on Oct. 5... Texas State totaled just 196 yards of offense, while ULL tallied 572 yards of offense... Kickoff returner Brandon Smith returned two kickoffs for touchdowns in the loss... He was named the conference's Special Teams player of the Week after returning the two kickoffs for touchdowns (92 yards; 100 yards) and totaled 211 kickoff return yards... David Mayo paced the Bobcat defense with 13 total tackles (12 solo, 1 asst) at ULL.

A total of 12 different Bobcats have recorded a rushing attempt this season with Robert Lowe and Chris Nutall leading the way... Lowe has 54 attempts for 302 yards and five scores, while Nutall has 237 yards on 37 carries and four touchdowns... Tyler Arndt and Tyler Jones have taken the majority of snaps under center this season... Arndt has completed 39 of his 62 attempts for 366 yards with one interception... Meanwhile, Jones is 24-of-33 for 262 yards and one passing TD... Isaiah Battle is leading the team in receptions with 15, while Bradley Miller has a team-best 147 receiving yards.

David Mayo leads the team with 42 total tackles in 2013 and he also has a team-high two interceptions... Michael Orakpo leads Texas State in tackles for loss (6.5) and sacks (3.5)... Orakpo has also forced a Bobcat best three fumbles.

#AustinMetroFunFacts

Below are eight things you may or may not know about the Austin-San Marcos area:

- San Marcos is the county seat of Hays County between Austin and San Antonio.
- San Marcos was the fastest growing city in the United States between 2010 and 2012.
- Ty Detmer, the 1990 Heisman winner for BYU, hails from San Marcos.
- San Marcos also produced Lyndon B. Johnson, the 36th President of the United States.
- Texas State was originally established in San Marcos as the Southwest Texas State Normal School in 1899.
- Austin is known as the "Live Music Capital of the World" because of its strong music scene.
- Austin is named for Stephen F. Austin, considered the "Father of Texas" who led 300 American families to colonize the region.
- Austin is the 11th-largest city in the United States and the second-largest state capital with 842,592 residents.

#FirstCareerStart

ULM sophomore quarterback Brayle Brown made his first career start against WKU on Oct. 3... The Shawnee, Okla., native finished the game with 275 passing yards behind 21 completions (40 attempts) with one interception... He also recorded the team's longest play from scrimmage this season, a 69-yard pass to junior wide receiver Kenzee Jackson... Brown's 275 passing yards are the most by a first-time ULM starting quarterback since Andre Vige threw for 322 yards in a 44-14 win over Nicholls State on Sept. 5, 1998.

#DroughtEnds

ULM punt returner Rashon Ceaser became the first Warhawk since the 2001 season to return a punt for a touchdown... In the third quarter against Tulane, Ceaser recorded a career-long return of 88 yards as he made his way through the Tulane defense to put ULM on the board... Ceaser is the first Warhawk to record a punt return for a touchdown since Mikkal Henry returned a punt 53 yards for a score against Troy on Nov. 10, 2001... Ceaser finished the night with three punt returns for 97 yards... He also caught four passes for 45 yards... Ceaser is currently leading the Sun Belt Conference in punt return yardage with an average of 17.3 yards per return... His 97 total punt return yards are a season-high among SBC punt returners and he is one of three SBC players to return a punt for a TD this season... Ceaser's 88-yard return is the fifth longest punt return in SBC history.

#ThreeStraight

ULM tight end Harley Scioneaux recorded his third touchdown grab of the season in the team's loss at Baylor... The sophomore has recorded one touchdown reception in three straight games (Grambling State, at Wake Forest, at Baylor) and now has six career touchdown receptions.

#CareerBoot

ULM punter Justin Manton recorded a career-long 77-yard punt in ULM's road contest at Baylor... His booming third-quarter punt is tied for the second longest punt in ULM history... He is tied with John Kelly who had a 77-yard punt at McNeese State on Oct. 13, 1962... Chick Childress holds the ULM record with an 88-yard punt (at Western Kentucky, 1952).

Manton also recorded a 69-yard punt in the fourth-quarter at Baylor, which places him in a tied for eighth-place in program history... In all, Manton punted nine times for 479 yards (53.2 avg) with five punts of 50 or more yards, three touchbacks, one inside the 20... He also kicked off twice for 130 yards (65.0 avg) and two touchbacks.

Manton was named one of College Football Performance Awards' Honorable Mention Punters of the Week (Sept. 23), Louisiana Sports Writers Association Special Teams Player of the Week (Sept. 23) and Warhawk of the Week (Sept. 24).

#LetItFly

Kolton Browning's 68 passing attempts at Wake Forest are the second-most in a single game, while his 43 completions are tied for fourth nationally in a single game... Only Derek Carr (Fresno State; 73) has more single game passing attempts than Browning this season... Carr also recorded 52 completions earlier this season, while Shane Carden (East Carolina) ranks second with 46... Browning is tied for third nationally with Texas Tech's Baker Mayfield with 43 completions in a game.

#SunBeltOffensivePOW

After setting single-game career-highs in both completions (43) and attempts (68) in ULM's 21-19 win at Wake Forest, senior quarterback Kolton Browning was named the Sun Belt Conference's Offensive Player of the Week on Sept. 16, 2013.

Midway through the second quarter, Browning connected with Je'Ron Hamm for his school-record 796th career completion... Browning took the top spot in the ULM record book as he passed Steven Jyles who tallied 795 career completions from 2002-05.

Browning ended the game with 827 career completions after finishing 43-of-68 for 315 yards and three touchdowns. The Mabank, Texas native found Harley Scioneaux, Kenzee Jackson and Tavares Maye for the three Warhawk scores... Browning also rushed nine times for 19 yards in ULM's first-ever win over an ACC program.

#ThirdDownSuccess

ULM faced 28 third-downs in its 21-19 win at Wake Forest and the Warhawks were able to convert on 15 of those (54%)... ULM's 15 third-down conversions were the most ever by a Wake Forest opponent (previous high 14 by North Carolina [1986] and Connecticut [2003])... The Warhawks' 28 attempts is also a Wake Forest opponent record, surpassing the old record of 24 set by Appalachian State (1981) and Boston University (1986).

#EditingTheRecordBooks

As a junior, ULM quarterback Kolton Browning became the program's all-time leader in career touchdowns as he connected with Je'Ron Hamm against North Texas to pass Steven Jyles who had 55 touchdown passes from 2002-05... Browning finished his junior season with 60 career touchdown passes and now sits at 67 after four games during the 2013 season... He also became the program's all-time leader in total touchdowns against Grambling State... Browning entered the season tied with Jyles, but now holds the record with 83 career touchdowns (67 passing, 16 rushing)... The Mabank, Texas native has 856 career completions and at Wake Forest, he surpassed Steven Jyles (795; 2002-05) to become the all-time leader in ULM history... At Baylor, Browning passed Jyles in career yards of total offense -- Browning now ranks number one in program history with 10,458 yards of total offense (9,051 passing; 1,407 rushing)... Jyles amassed 10,234 yards of total offense during his career (8,987 passing; 1,247 rushing)... Against Tulane, Browning became the new leader in career passing yards (9,051) and total plays (1,919)... Jyles threw four 8,987 yards and totalled 1,901 plays during his career.

#DavisToTheHouse

In the home opener against Grambling State, Cortney Davis electrified the crowd of 23,600 at Malone Stadium as he returned the opening kickoff (89 yards) for a touchdown (first career return for a TD) to give ULM a 7-0 lead just 10 seconds into the contest... Davis' kickoff return for a score was the first for the Warhawks since Luther Ambrose accomplished the feat against FIU on Nov. 19, 2011... Davis returned another kickoff for 12 yards as he finished with 101 return yards and 103 all-purpose yards (two rushing yards)... Davis also earned Kickoff Returner Performer of the Week Honors from the College Football Performance Awards.

The second-largest on-campus high definition videoboard in the Pelican State was installed at ULM's Malone Stadium during the summer of 2010... In addition, a state-of-the-art sound system was installed... The videoboard features nearly 1,600 square feet of total video space, including 23' x 49' area dedicated to video on a board with 15-millimeter pixel spacing.

In the 2012 home opener, ULM welcomed Big 12 foe Baylor for a nationally televised game on ESPN on Friday, Sept. 21... The Warhawks and the Bears did not disappoint the record-crowd of 31,175 as the two squads combined for 89 points and 1,109 yards of total offense.... The game also had the eyes of the nation upon it as the game was viewed by more than 12.7 million people with a rating of 1.8 - the highest-rated game in history for a contest involving a Sun Belt Conference team... The previous high was a 1.4 rating for the 2004 showdown between FIU and Louisville in Louisville, Ky.

Buoyed by a powerful rushing attack that racked up 367 yards on the ground, including 123 by senior Jyruss Edwards, ULM earned a 48-10 victory over Grambling State on Saturday evening at Malone Stadium. The 367 rushing yards represented the highest total for the program since recording 360 against Middle Tennessee on Nov. 3, 2007. In addition, the offense crossed the 550-yard mark for the first time since totaling 553 against Tulane on Sept. 29, 2012, with 571 total yards.
