FIRST AND TEN

- The Warhawk football program will begin a two-game non-conference road swing as it travels to Winston-Salem, N.C., for its first ever meeting with the Wake Forest Demon Deacons on Saturday afternoon... It will also be just the second trip all-time to the state of North Carolina for the football program (Sept. 24, 1966, at East Carolina, W, 21-14).
- The contest against Wake Forest will be the third contest for ULM against a member of the Atlantic Coast Conference (at No. 25 Clemson, L, 26-49, Sept. 8, 2007; at No. 5 Florida State, L, 0-34, Sept. 3, 2011).
- Following the trip to the state of North Carolina, the Warhawks will travel west to Waco, Texas, for a rematch of last season's shootout in Monroe... In front of a record crowd of 31,175, the two teams combined for 1,109 yards of total offense and 89 points in a 47-42 Baylor win (Sept. 21, 2012).
- ULM evened its season mark at 1-1 with a 48-10 victory over Grambling State at Malone Stadium on Sept. 7 in front of 23,600 fans, the eighth-largest crowd at Malone Stadium.
- The Warhawk rushing attack amassed 367 rushing yards against the Tigers and it marked the first time ULM tallied 350 or more rushing yards in a single game since Nov. 3, 2007 against Middle Tennessee.
- The squad totaled 571 yards of total offense against Grambling State, which was the first 500-plus yard game for ULM since 518 yards of total offense in a 42-16 win over North Texas last season (Nov. 17, 2012, Malone Stadium).
- ULM's 21 points in the first quarter were the most in a single quarter for the club since 21 points in the fourth quarter in the home finale last season against North Texas (Nov. 17, 2012)... The 35 points in the first half were the most since the team had 35 points in the first half en route to a 63-10 win at Tulane last season (Sept. 29, 2012).
- The ULM defense recorded eight tackles for loss, including two sacks, in the win over the Tigers... The defense also limited Grambling State to 237 yards of total offense (143 passing, 94 rushing).
- Kick returner Cortney Davis got the Warhawks on the board first against Grambling State as he returned the opening kickoff 89-yards for a score... Davis' kick return TD was the first for the Warhawks since Luther Ambrose accomplished the feat against FIU on Nov. 19, 2011.
- Jyruss Edwards notched his third career 100-yard rushing performance as the senior finished with 123 yards (on eight carries) and one touchdown... His first quarter touchdown run allowed ULM to move in front 21-7... It was also his 22nd career rushing score, tying him for third all-time with Greg Robinson (1991-92).
- Two other Warhawk running backs tallied 70 or more rushing yards against Grambling State... DeVontae McNeal finished with nine carries for 94 yards and one touchdown, while Nathan Meadors, Jr., totaled 66 yards on seven attempts including a career-long 50 yard rush.
- Kolton Browning finished the home opener 13-of-25 for 171 yards with three touchdowns and one interception... He also rushed twice for 25 yards.
- Kolton Browning, with his 13 completions, inched closer to the career completions mark as he now has 784 career completions and needs just 12 more to become the all-time leader and surpass Steven Jyles who completed 795 passes from 2002-05.
- Cameron Blakes led the Warhawk defense in tackles for the second straight week as he registered seven tackles (two solo, five asst) against Grambling State... In the season opener at No. 16 Oklahoma, Blakes recorded a career high 16 tackles.
- Teyvn Cagins forced his first career fumble in the fourth quarter against Grambling State and it was recovered by Malcolm Edmond for his first career fumble recovery.

PRACTICE / INTERVIEWS

All media wishing to cover a ULM practice / game must either have a season-long credential from the ULM media relations office or must obtain one by contacting Alex Edwards (edwards@ulm.edu / 318-342-5463) at least 24 hours before a practice and 48 hours before a home game.

ULM coaches and players will be available following practice during the first half of game week. Coaches and players will not be available for interviews from Thursday until the conclusion of that week's game (Game weeks featuring a Thursday night game will not allow interviews beginning Wednesday).

#ULMvsWFUSeries

ULM and Wake Forest will meet for the first time on Saturday afternoon in Winston-Salem, N.C... The Warhawks have made just one trip to the state of North Carolina in its history... In 1966, the squad made its way to Greenville, N.C. and claimed a 21-14 victory over the East Carolina Pirates... The contest against the Demon Deacons will also be just the third game for the Warhawks against an opponent from the Atlantic Coast Conference (L, 26-49, at No. 25 Clemson, Sept. 8, 2007; L, 0-34, at No. 5 Florida State, Sept. 3, 2011).

#ScoutingTheDemonDeacons

Wake Forest enters the weekend with a 1-1 record overall and a 0-1 record in ACC play... Despite playing the first two weeks of the season, this weekend's game vs. ULM will be the first game of the season on a Saturday for the Demon Deacons... Wake Forest opened the season with a 31-7 win over FCS-member Presbyterian College (Thursday, Aug. 29)... The squad then opened league play on Friday, Sept. 6 at Boston College, suffering a 24-10 setback.

The Demon Deacon rushing attack has tallied 244 yards over the first two games, with Josh Harris leading the way at 47 yards (21 attempts)... Meanwhile, Jonathan Williams leads all wide receivers with 191 yards (nine catches)... Tanner Price has completed 32 of his 55 passes on the season for 410 yards with two touchdowns and one interception.

Wake Forest has never faced a member of the Sun Belt Conference... Against teams from the state of Louisiana, the Demon Deacons are 0-5 (three losses to LSU; two to Tulane).

#NorthCarolinaFunFacts

Below are 10 things you may or may not know about the Tarheel State:

- The first known Putt-Putt mini-golf course was built in Fayetteville, N.C.
- Mount Mitchell is the tallest mountain in the United States east of the Mississippi River (6,684 feet).
- December 17, 1903 - First successful flight by Wilbur and Orville Wright at Kitty Hawk, N.C.
- The separate towns of Winston and Salem officially became Winston-Salem after a referendum in 1913.
- Texas Pete (1929) and Krispy Kreme (1937) were both created/founded in Winston-Salem.
- Both current US Senators from North Carolina, Richard Burr and Kay Hagan, attended Wake Forest.
- North Carolina has produced three Presidents: Andrew Jackson, James Polk and Andrew Johnson.
- April 12, 1776 - North Carolina became the first state to vote in favor of independence from England.
- 1918 - Fort Bragg established, would later become home of the US Army airborne forces and Special Forces.
- Pepsi was invented and first served in New Bern, N.C., in 1898.

#TigerRewind

After failing to score in the season opener at No. 16 Oklahoma, it took the Warhawks just 10 seconds to get on the scoreboard in the home opener against Grambling State as kickoff returner Cortney Davis returned the opening kickoff 89 yards for a touchdown to help give ULM the early 7-0 lead... After the Tigers evened the contest at 7-7 with 9:44 to play in the first quarter, ULM added two touchdowns to take a 21-7 lead with 3:52 remaining in the quarter (18 yard pass from Browning to Harley Scioneaux; 19 yard run by Jyruss Edwards)... ULM took a 35-7 lead into the locker room thanks to a pair of second quarter touchdowns by Browning (16 yards to Je'Ron Hamm; 11 yards to Kenzee Jackson)... ULM added three scores in the second half (34 yard run by DeVontae McNeal; 31 yard FG by Justin Manton; 38 yard FG by Manton), while Grambling State added a field goal with 5:34 to play to set the final tally at 48-10.

ULM tallied 367 rushing yards, marking the first time since Nov. 3, 2007 that the Warhawks amassed 350 or more rushing yards in one game (360, Middle Tennessee)... The squad also went over the 500-yard mark for total offense with 571 yards of total offense... In 2012, the squad totaled 500 or more yards of offense five times (vs. No. 8 Arkansas, 550; 560, Baylor; 553, at Tulane; 500, at Middle Tennessee; 518, North Texas) and posted a 4-1 record in those five games.

Jyruss Edwards led the Warhawk rushing attack with 123 yards on eight carries with one score... DeVontae McNeal added 94 yards on nine carries with one TD while Nathan Meadors, Jr., rushed for 66 yards on seven attempts... Browning finished with 171 passing yards and three passing touchdowns in the win... Browning and Brayle Brown combined to find a total of 10 different receivers in the victory.

The ULM defense limited the Tiger offense to just 237 yards of total offense (143 passing, 94 rushing)... Cameron Blakes, for the second straight week, led the squad in tackles as he tallied seven... Meanwhile, Isaiah Newsome and Lenzy Pipkins recorded five tackles each... The defense also

tallied eight tackles for loss, two sacks and forced one turnover in the win.

#EditingTheRecordBooks

As a junior, ULM quarterback Kolton Browning became the program's all-time leader in career touchdowns as he connected with Je'Ron Hamm against North Texas to pass Steven Jyles who had 55 touchdown passes from 2002-05... Browning finished his junior season with 60 career touch-down passes and now sits at 63 after two games during the 2013 season... He also became the program's all-time leader in total touchdowns against Grambling State... Browning entered the season tied with Jyles, but now holds the record with 79 career touchdowns (63 passing, 16 rush-ing)... The next record in Browning's crosshairs is career passing completions... The Mabank, Texas native has 784 career completions and needs just 12 completions to become the all-time leader in ULM history (Jyles, 795 completions).

#DavisToTheHouse

In the home opener against Grambling State, Cortney Davis electrified the crowd of 23,600 at Malone Stadium as he returned the opening kickoff (89 yards) for a touchdown (first career return for a TD) to give ULM a 7-0 lead just 10 seconds into the contest... Davis' kickoff return for a score was the first for the Warhawks since Luther Ambrose accomplished the feat against FIU on Nov. 19, 2011... Davis returned another kickoff for 12 yards as he finished with 101 return yards and 103 all-purpose yards (two rushing yards)... Davis also earned Kickoff Returner Performer of the Week Honors from the College Football Performance Awards.

#DualThreat

ULM quarterback Kolton Browning is a dual-threat as the four-year starter has four career games of at least three passing touchdowns and at least one rushing touchdown... Below is a breakdown of active quarterbacks around the country that have three or more games with at least three passing touchdowns and at least one rushing touchdown:

#SixteenTackles

Senior LB Cameron Blakes made his presence felt as he tallied 16 tackles, a new career-best, in the season opener at Oklahoma... His previous career-best came against Middle Tennessee in Monroe on Nov. 12, 2011... Blakes registered three tackles in the first quarter as he and the rest of the Warhawk defense kept the Sooners off of the scoreboard... At the half, Blakes had seven total tackles, before tallying seven tackles during the third quarter... He added two stops in the final quarter to finish with 16 tackles (nine solo, seven asst).

#BerryBall

Todd Berry is in his fourth season at the helm of the Warhawk program... Berry returned to Monroe in Dec. 2009 when he was named the program's 14th head coach... Last season, Berry guided ULM to an FBS-era best eight wins as the squad finished tied for second in the Sun Belt (6-2) and made its first appearance in a bowl game since moving up to the FBS ranks (1994-pres.)... The Warhawks made the short trip west to Shreveport, La., as they battled the Bobcats of Ohio in the 2012 AdvoCare V100 Independence Bowl.

In defensive coordinator Troy Reffett's 51 career games in charge of the defense, the Warhawks have forced 92 turnovers and at least one in 47 of the 51 contests... The attacking defense has also recorded 103 sacks and 285 tackles for loss -- at one point, ULM had a sack in 23 straight games under Reffett.

#PutEmOnTheBoard

Since the Warhawks joined the Sun Belt Conference to begin the 2001 season, the club has scored in 129 of its 139 games (dating back to Sept. 1, 2001 vs. Sam Houston State)... ULM was shutout in the 2008 season opener at No. 10 Auburn, snapping a streak of 32 consecutive games of recording at least one score... A 59-0 loss at Ole Miss later that season marked the first time that ULM had been shutout multiple times in the same season since 2000 (Memphis; Middle Tennessee; Central Florida)... The squad was shutout in the 2013 season opener at Oklahoma, snapping a streak of 24 consecutive games of recording at least one score.

#ULMGrads

Two Warhawks have already received their undergraduate degrees while another seven are set to graduate in December... Madison Tharp and Preston Coleman already have their degrees and will be joined by Kolton Browning, Jyruss Edwards, Tavares Maye, Austin Moss, Isaiah New-some, Ray Stovall (junior) and Monterrell Washington following commencement in December... Those expected to graduate following the spring semester are Josh Allen, Cameron Blakes, Kentarius Caldwell, Emmanuel Jefferies and Roland Veal (junior).

#HighDefinition

The second-largest on-campus high definition videoboard in the Pelican State was installed at ULM's Malone Stadium during the summer of 2010... In addition, a state-of-the-art sound system was installed... The videoboard features nearly 1,600 square feet of total video space, including 23' x 49' area dedicated to video on a board with 15-millimeter pixel spacing.

#PartyLikelt's1999

In last season's 63-10 win at Tulane, the Warhawk defense found the endzone on two different occasions... The two defensive scores marked the first time ULM had two or more touchdowns on the defensive side of the ball since the 1999 season... In 1999, ULM intercepted Northwestern State QB Brad Spangler three times and returned all three for touchdowns as ULM claimed a 38-7 win (Sept. 25).

In the first quarter at Tulane, R.J. Young returned a D.J. Ponder interception 49 yards to the Tulane six-yard line before fumbling into the endzone where it was recovered by Ray Stovall... Young was credited with 55 return yards on the play... The second defensive score of the game came in the third quarter when Darius Lively snagged Ponder's pass attempt out of the air and returned it six yards for a score.

#FridayNightLights

In the 2012 home opener, ULM welcomed Big 12 foe Baylor for a nationally televised game on ESPN on Friday, Sept. 21... The Warhawks and the Bears did not disappoint the record-crowd of 31,175 as the two squads combined for 89 points and 1,109 yards of total offense.

The game also had the eyes of the nation upon it as the game was viewed by more than 12.7 million people with a rating of 1.8 - the highest-rated game in history for a contest involving a Sun Belt Conference team. The previous high was a 1.4 rating for the 2004 showdown between FIU and Louisville in Louisville, Ky.

#PowerOfEight

The ULM football team won eight games during its record setting 2012 campaign... The eight wins by the Warhawks were the most since the squad won nine games during the 1993 campaign, its final season of competition at the 1-AA level... During the eight-win season, ULM posted five straight victories from Sept. 29 - Oct. 27, its first five-game winning streak since the 1993 season.

Buoyed by a powerful rushing attack that racked up 367 yards on the ground, including 123 by senior Jyruss Edwards, ULM earned a 48-10 victory over Grambling State on Saturday evening at Malone Stadium. The 367 rushing yards represented the highest total for the program since recording 360 against Middle Tennessee on Nov. 3, 2007. In addition, the offense crossed the 550-yard mark for the first time since totaling 553 against Tulane on Sept. 29, 2012, with 571 total yards.

POSTGAME NOTES

- ULM Captains: Rashon Ceaser (Offense), Rob’Donovan Lewis (Defense) and Justin Manton (Special Teams).
- Official Attendance: 23,600 -- eighth largest crowd in Malone Stadium history.
- ULM improved to 3-0 all-time against Grambling State.
